DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a color mixing head for a photographic enlarging apparatus showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof.

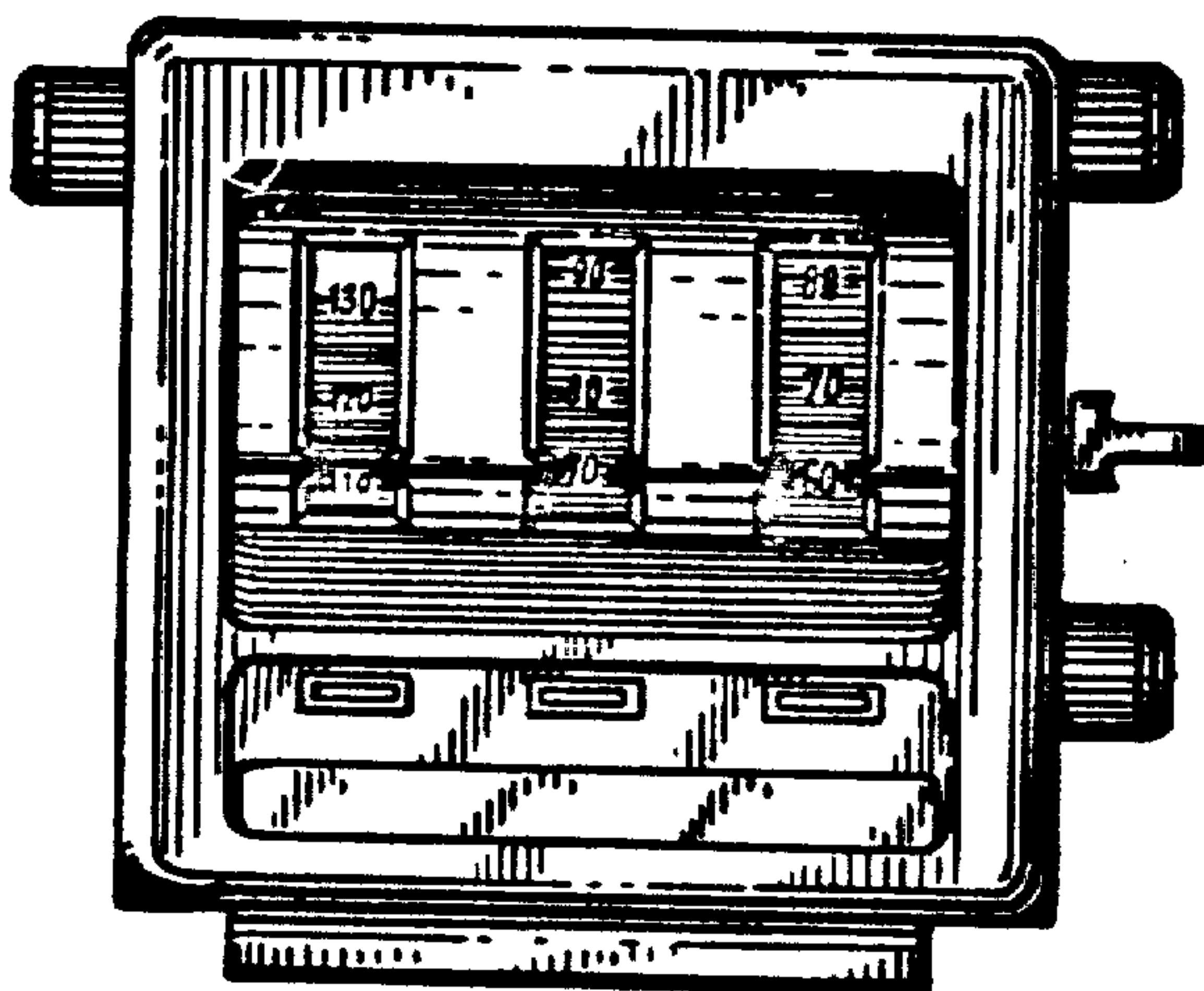

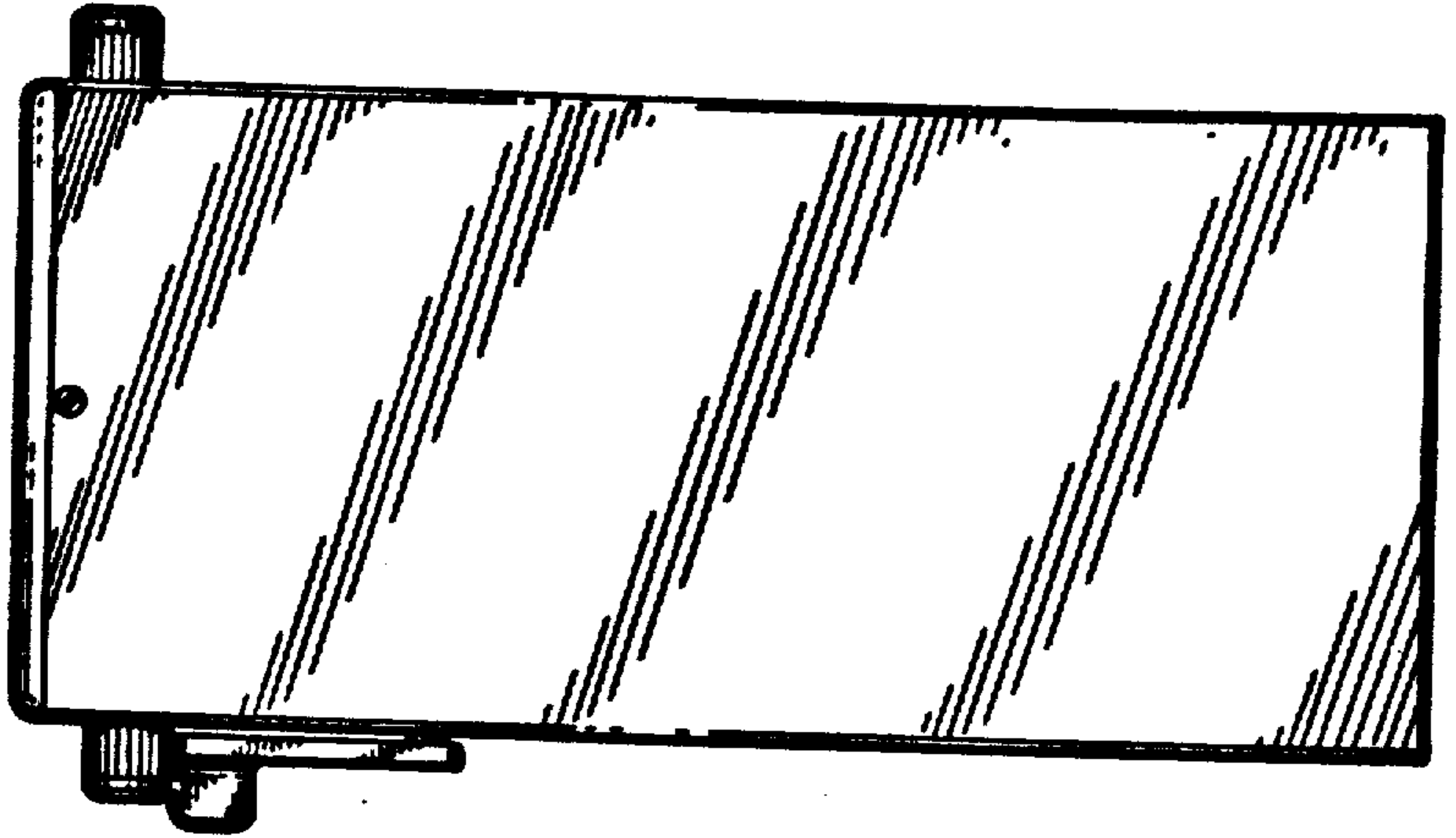

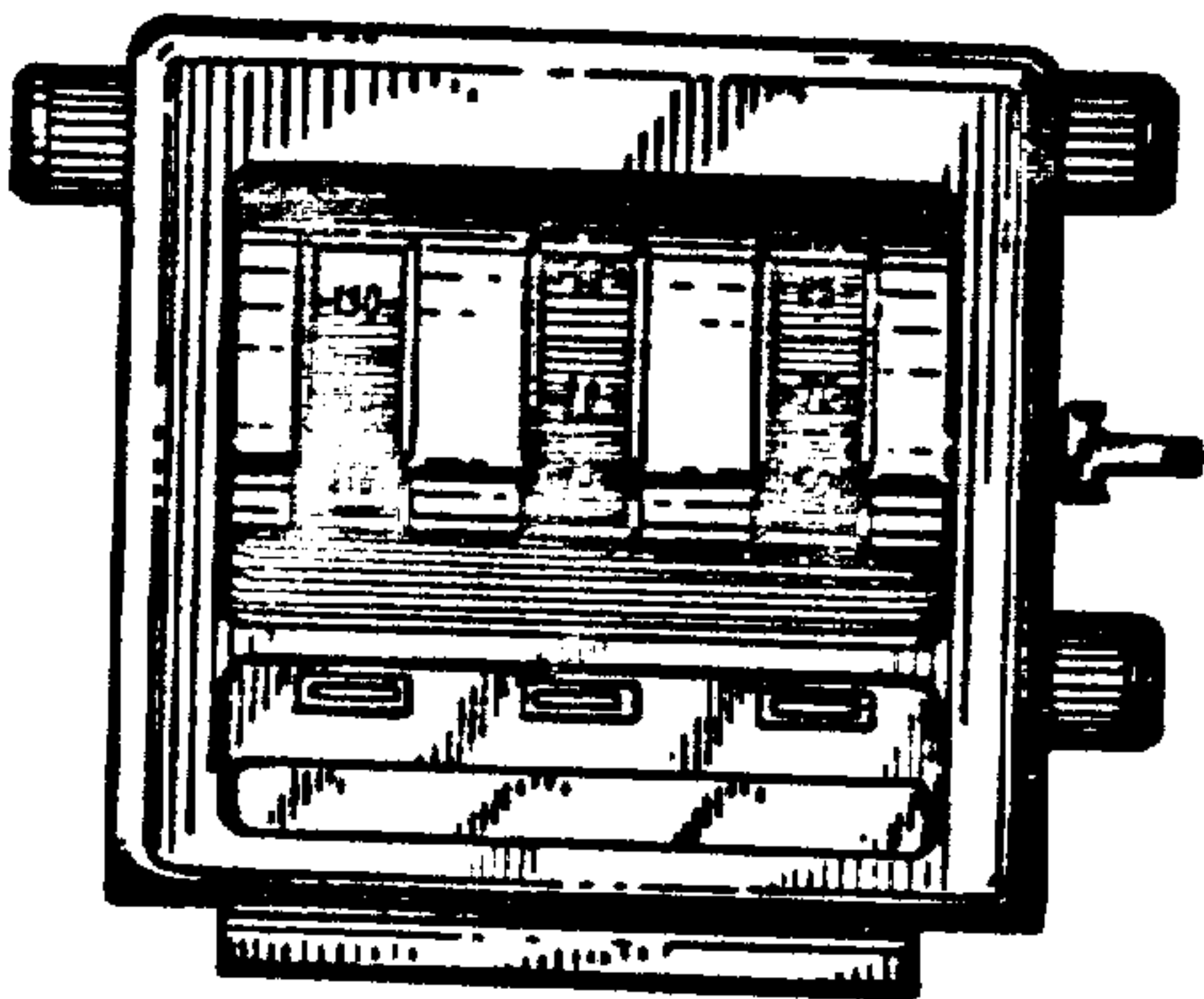

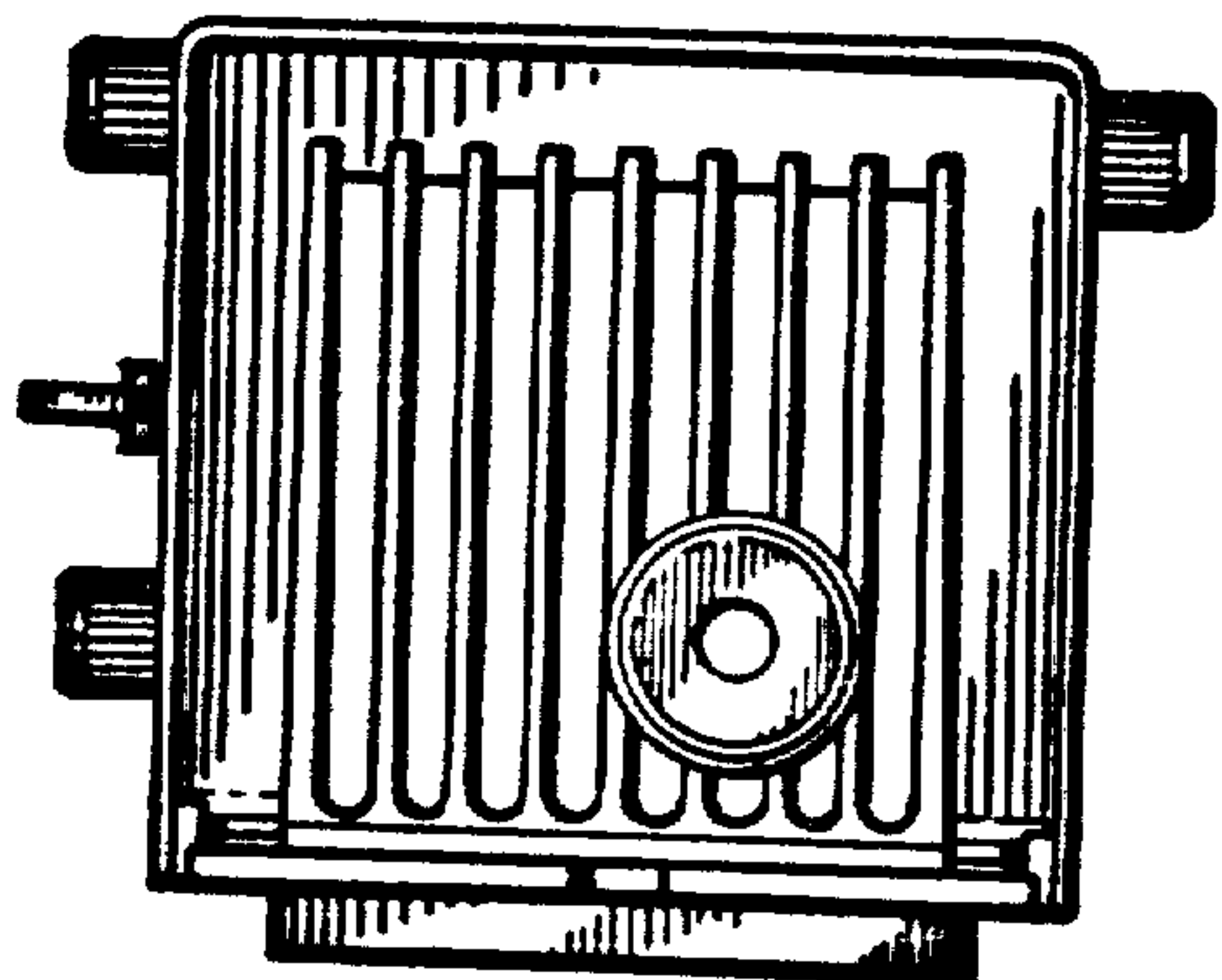
