[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an illuminable calendar holder or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of an illuminable calendar holder or similar article showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view; FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view; and FIG. 5 is a reduced scale bottom plan view.

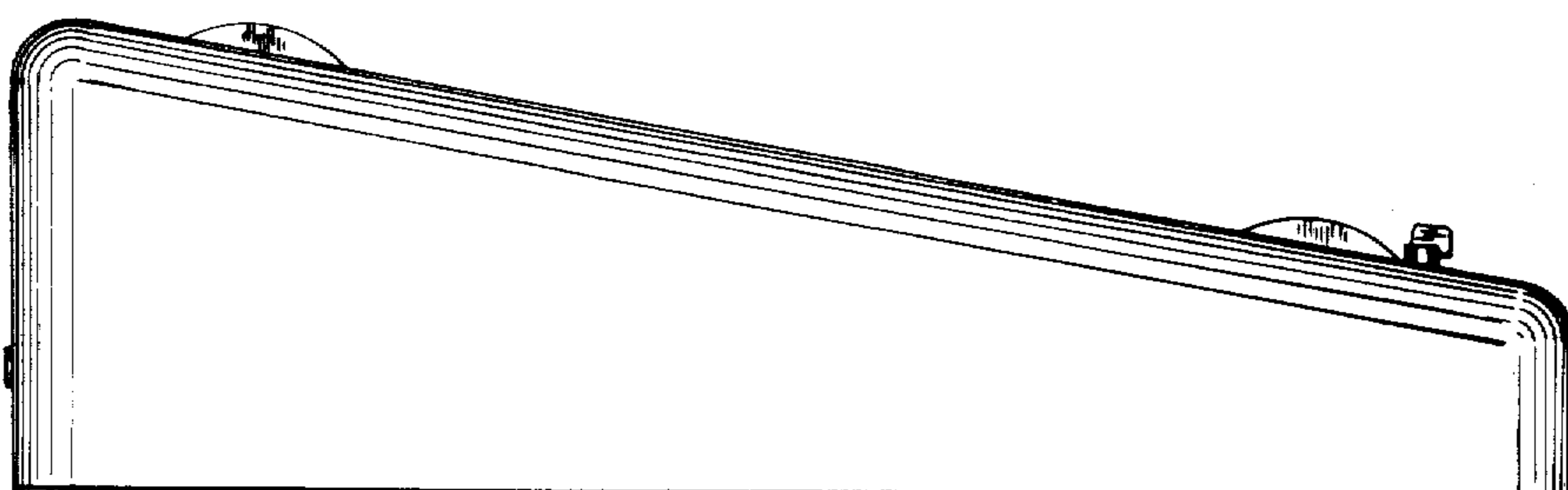
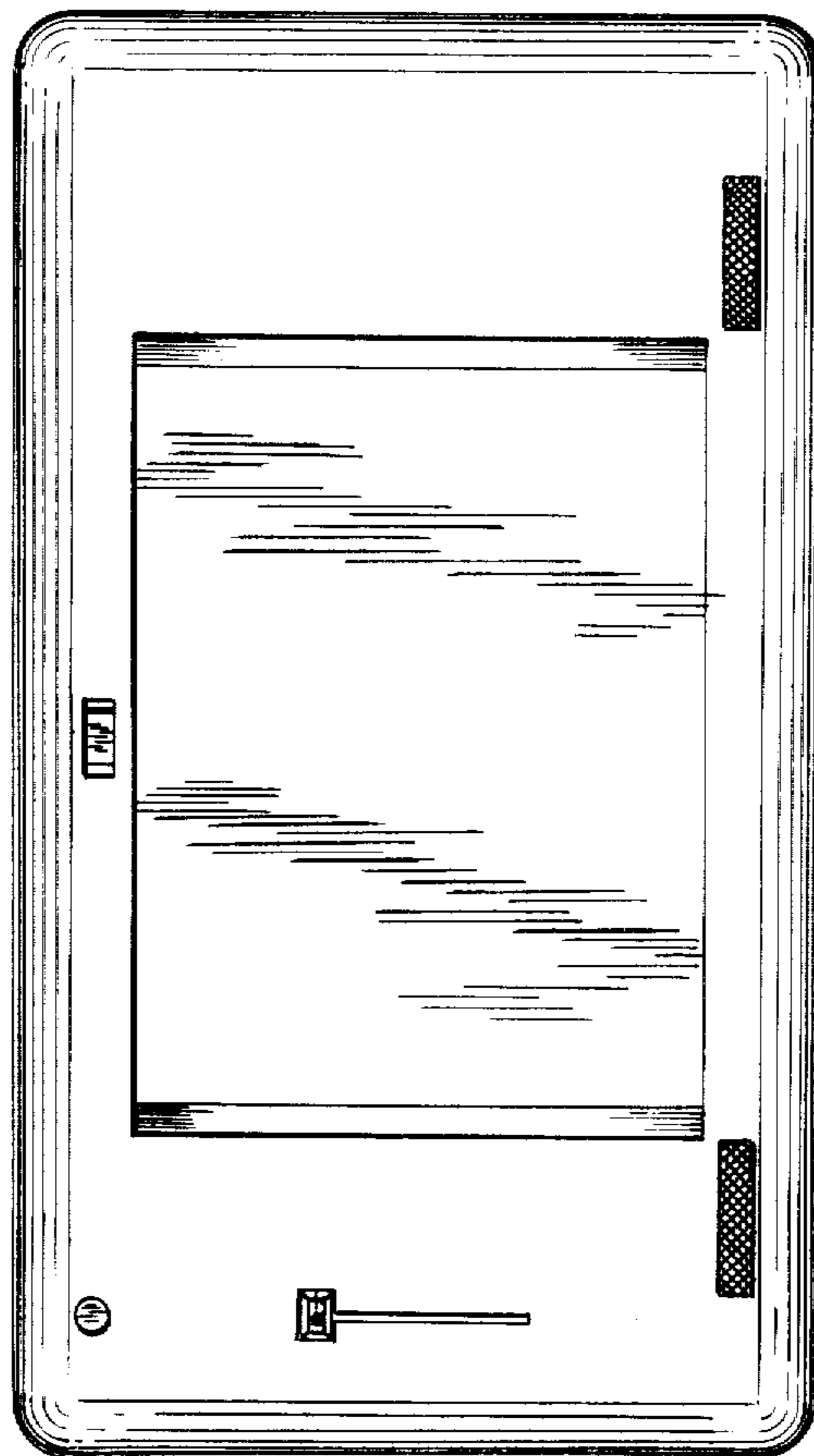

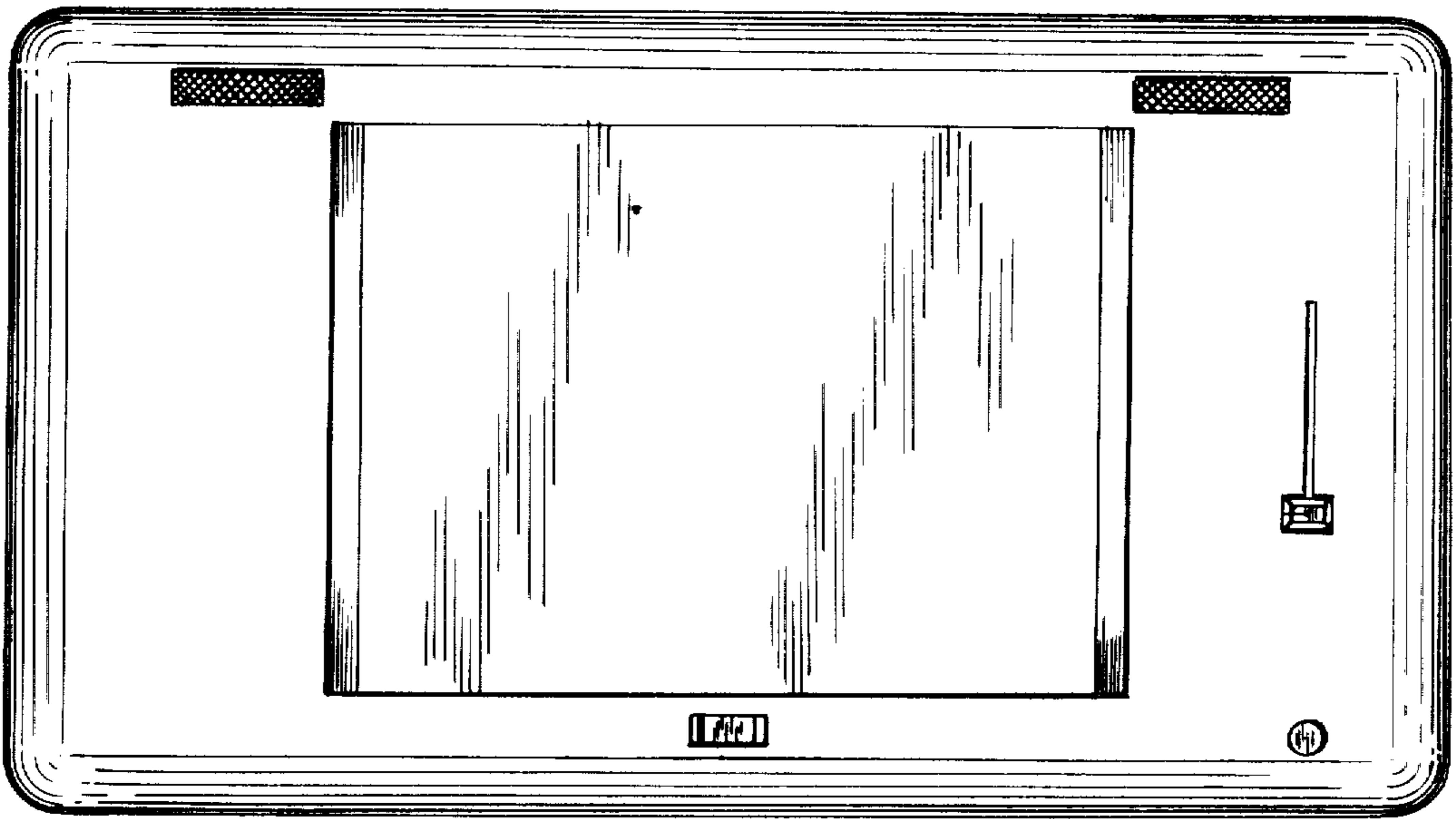

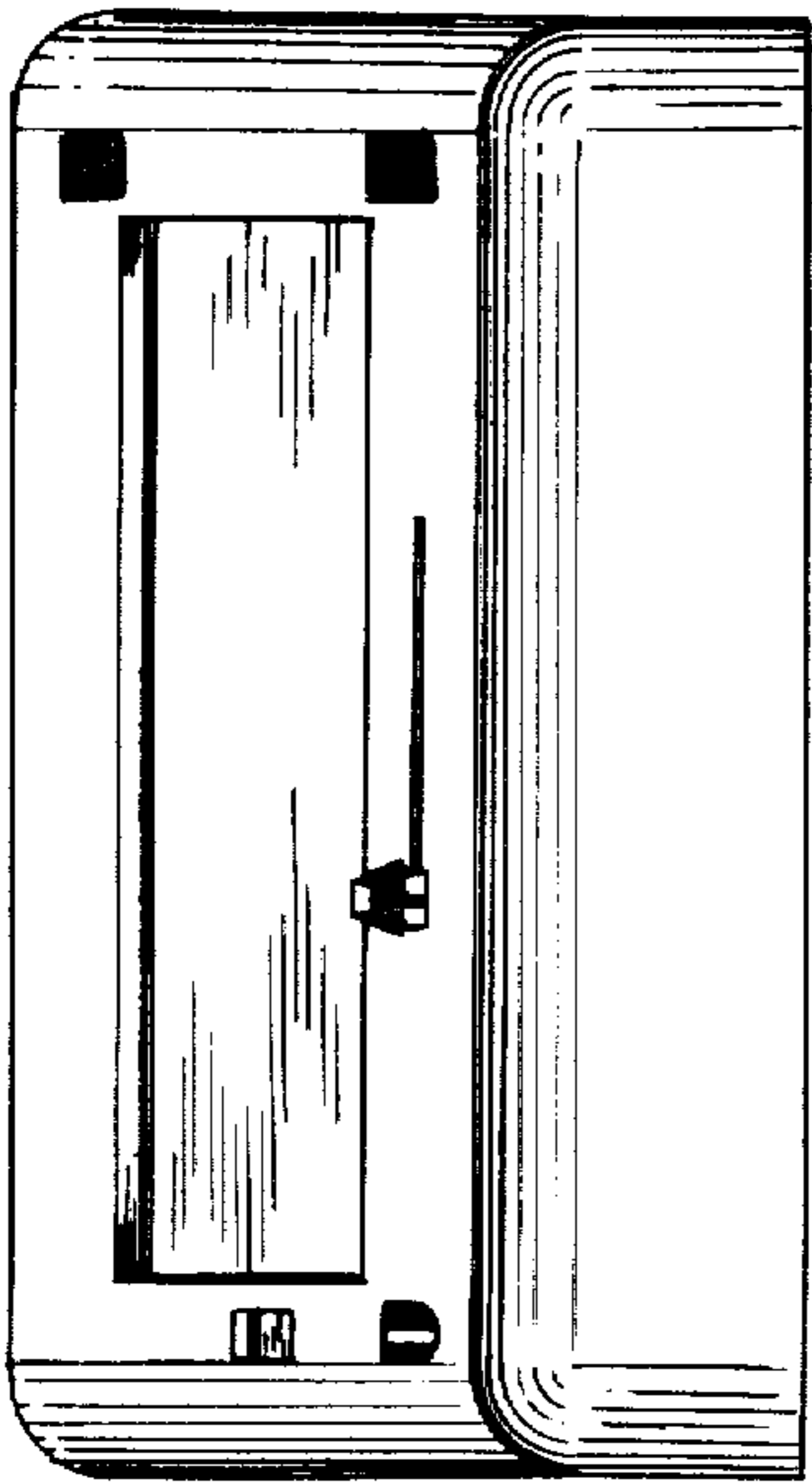

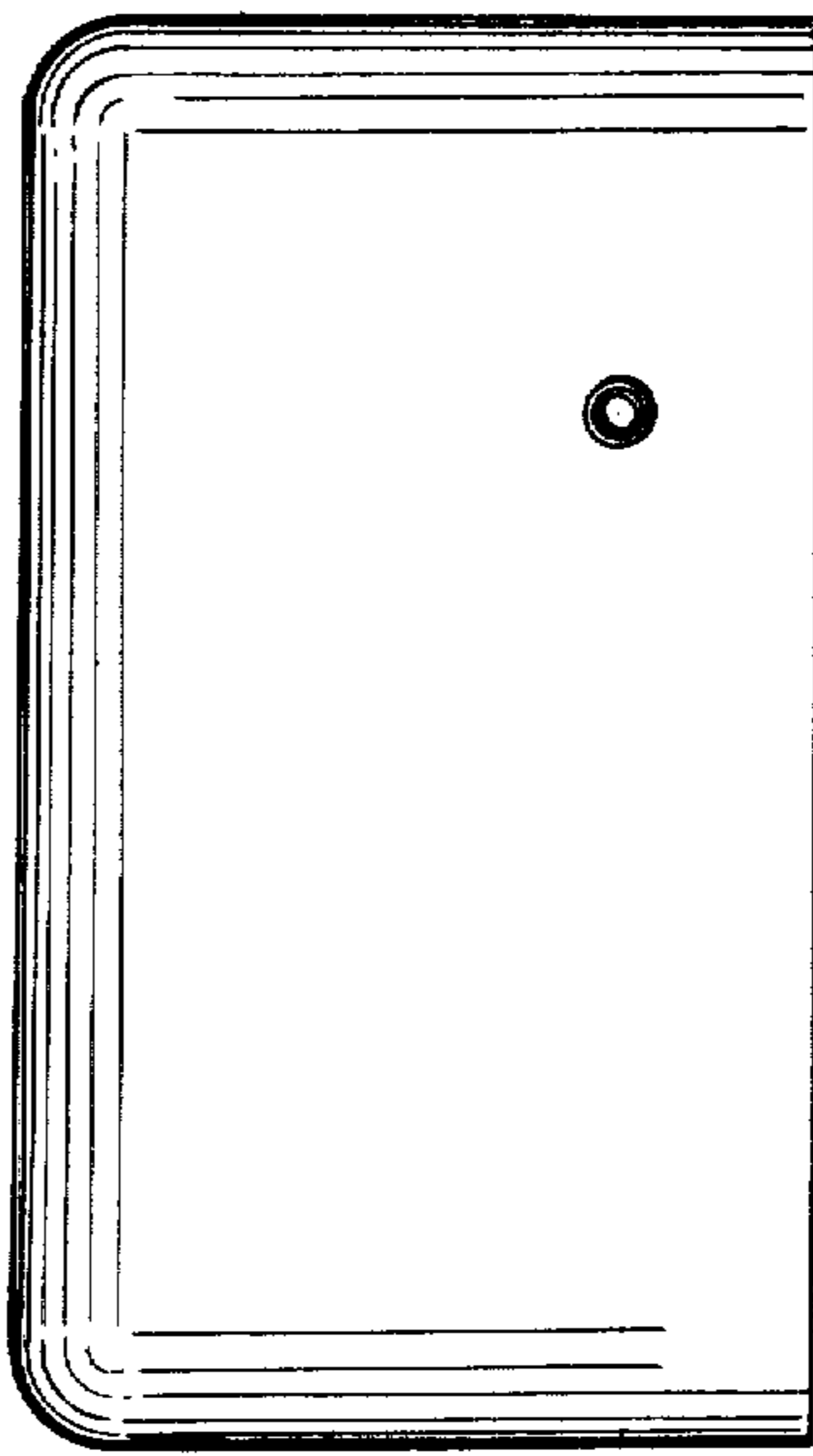

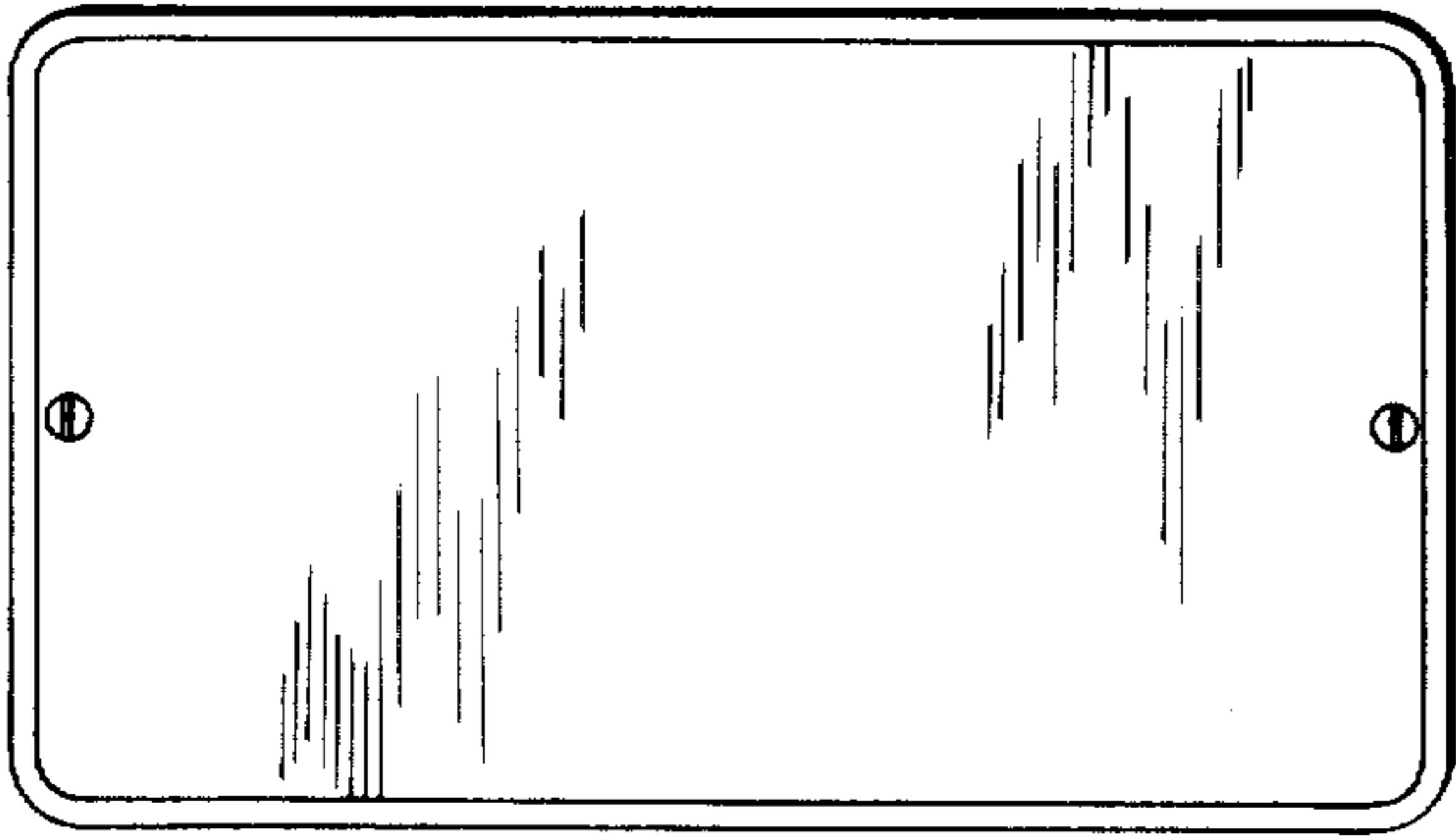
