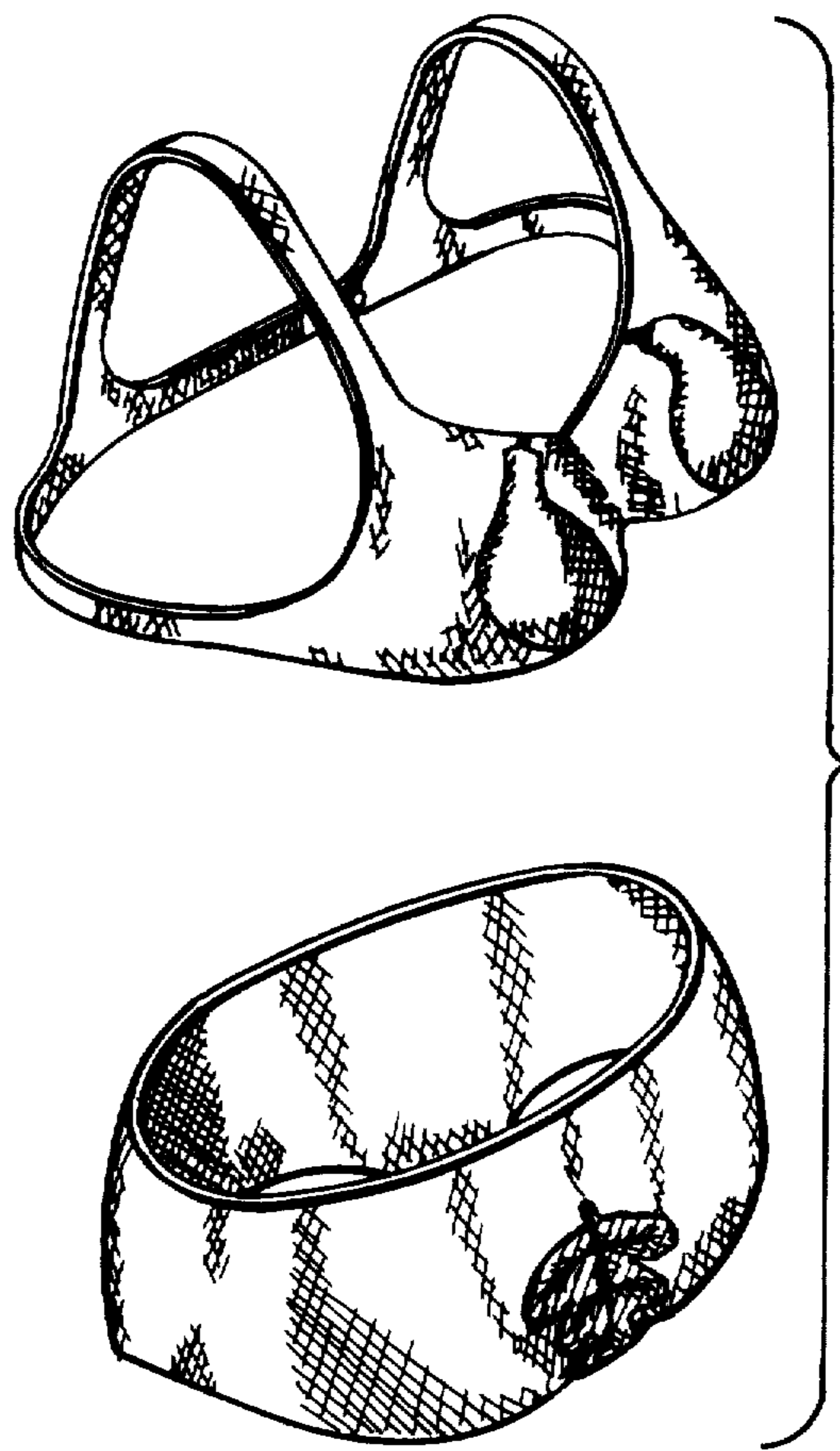

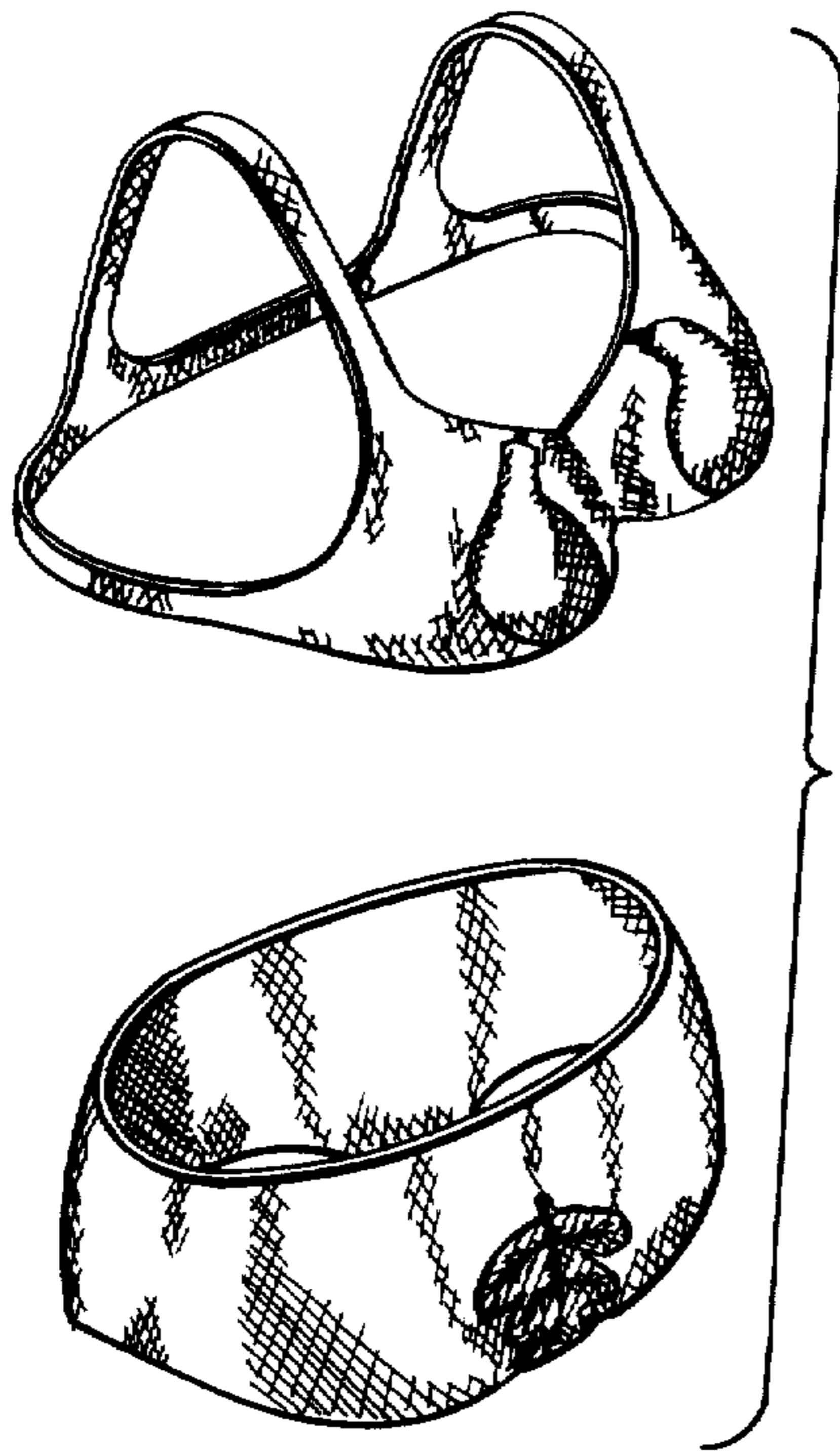
[57] **CLAIM**

ing suit, as shown.

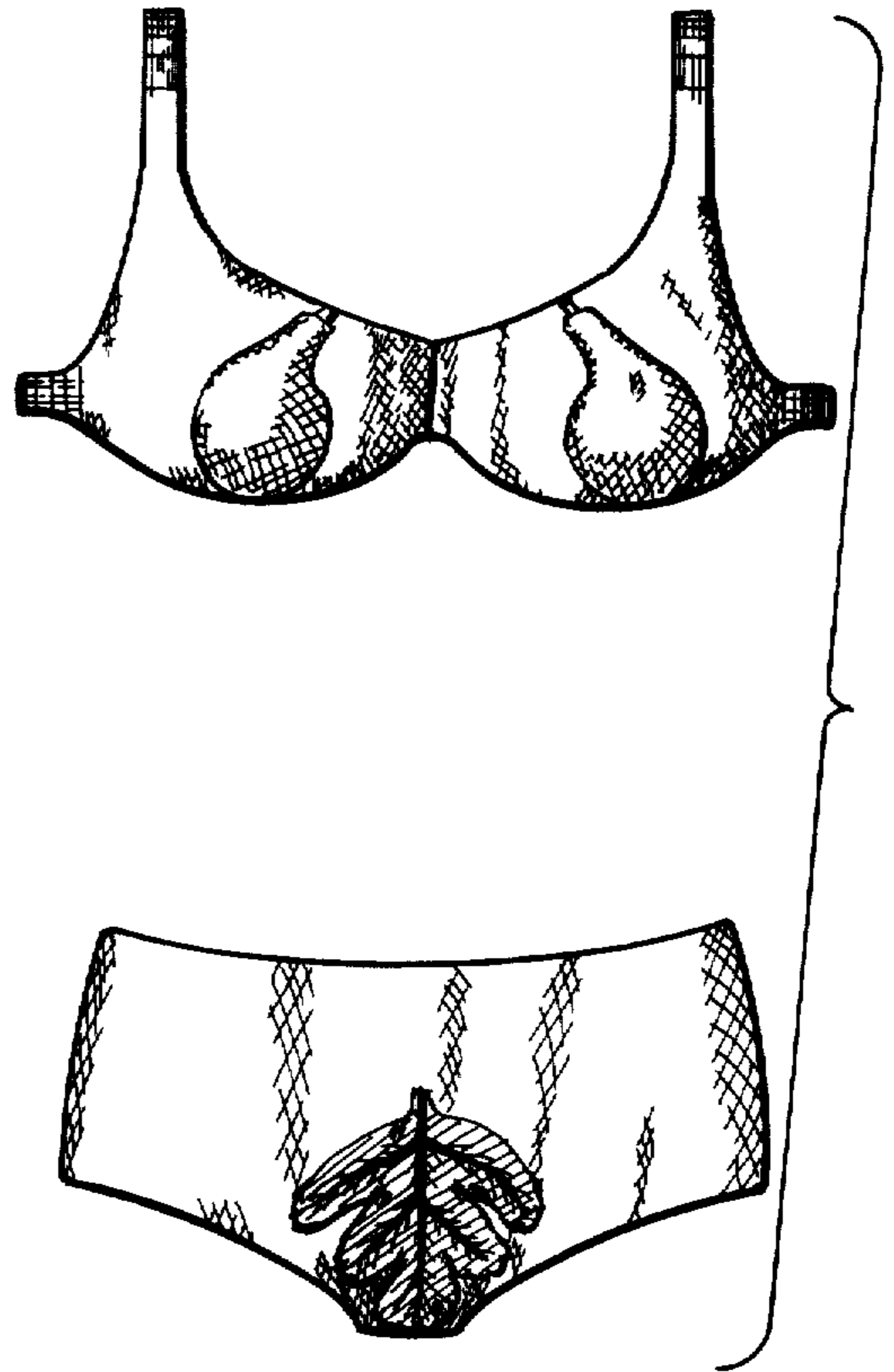
**DESCRIPTION**

 FIG. 3 is a rear elevation.

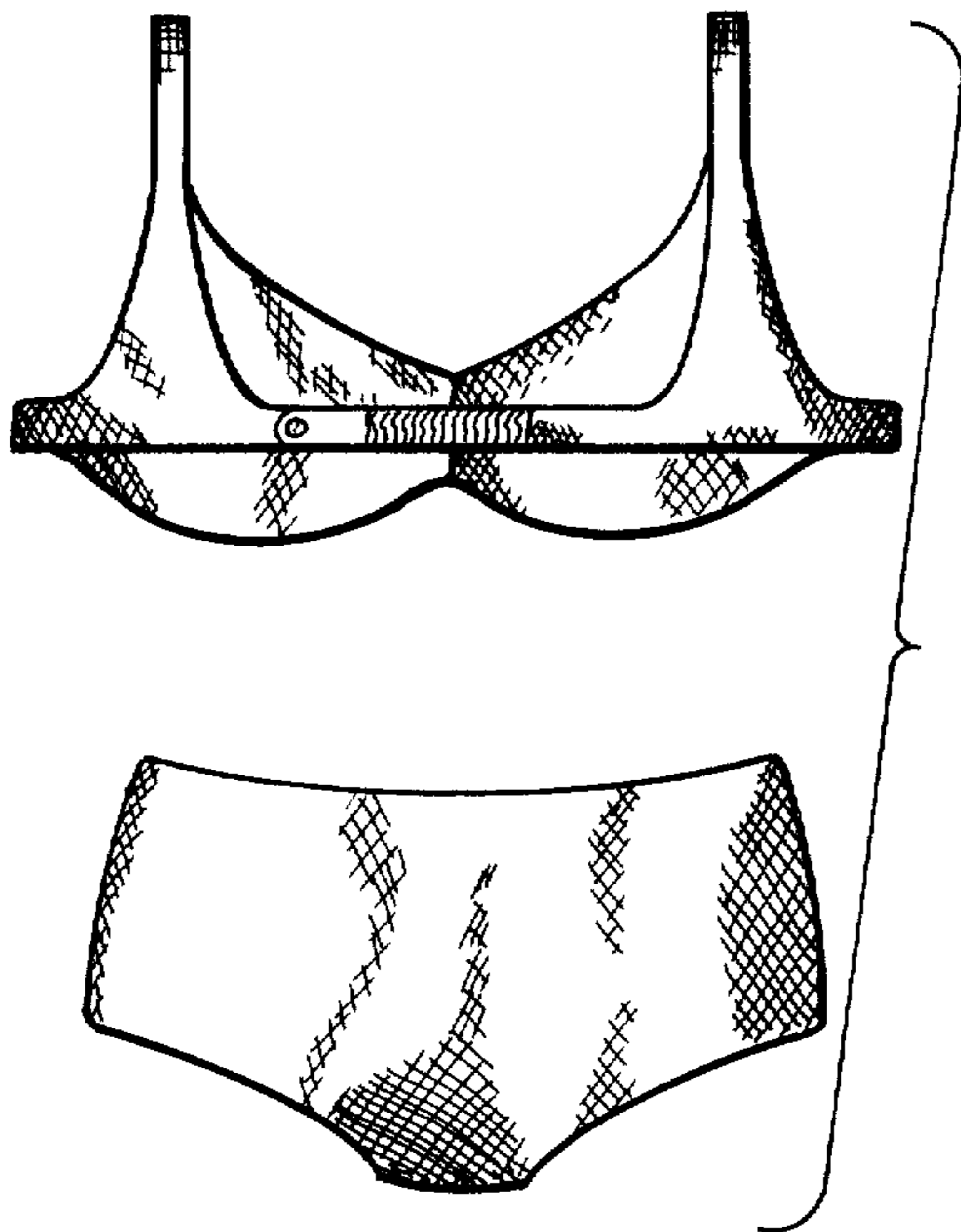
