The ornamental design for a plastic sleeve - encased bottle, substantially as shown and described.

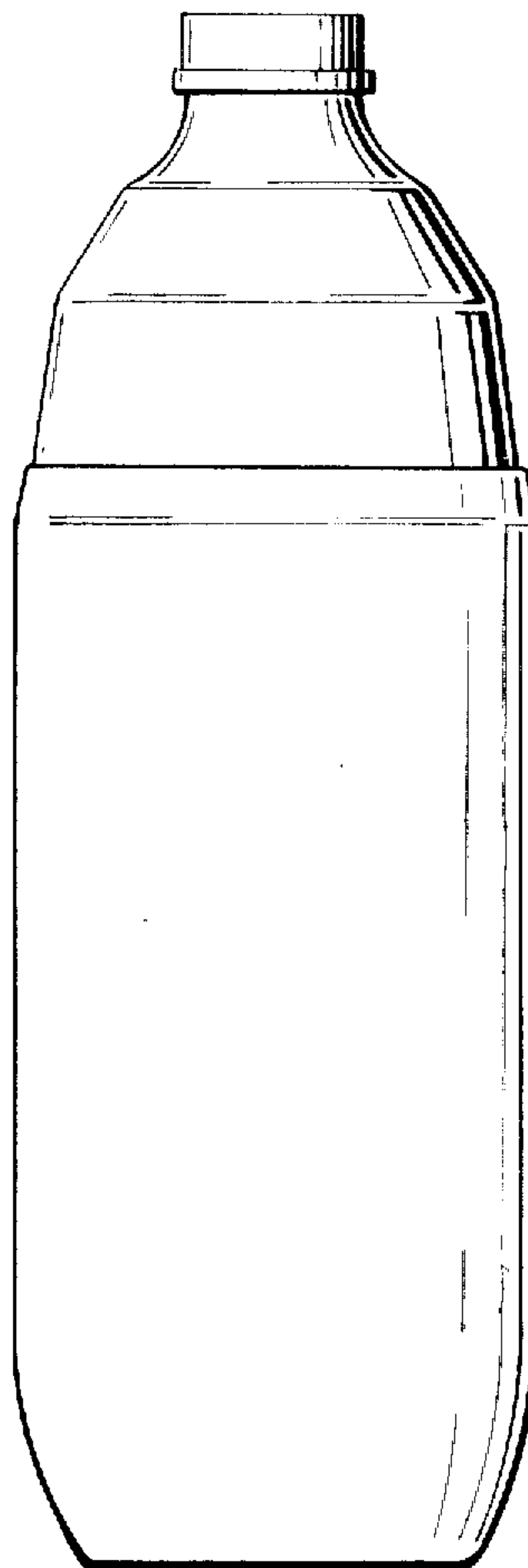
**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a plastic sleeve-encased bottle showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a sectional view taken on line 4 of FIG. 3.



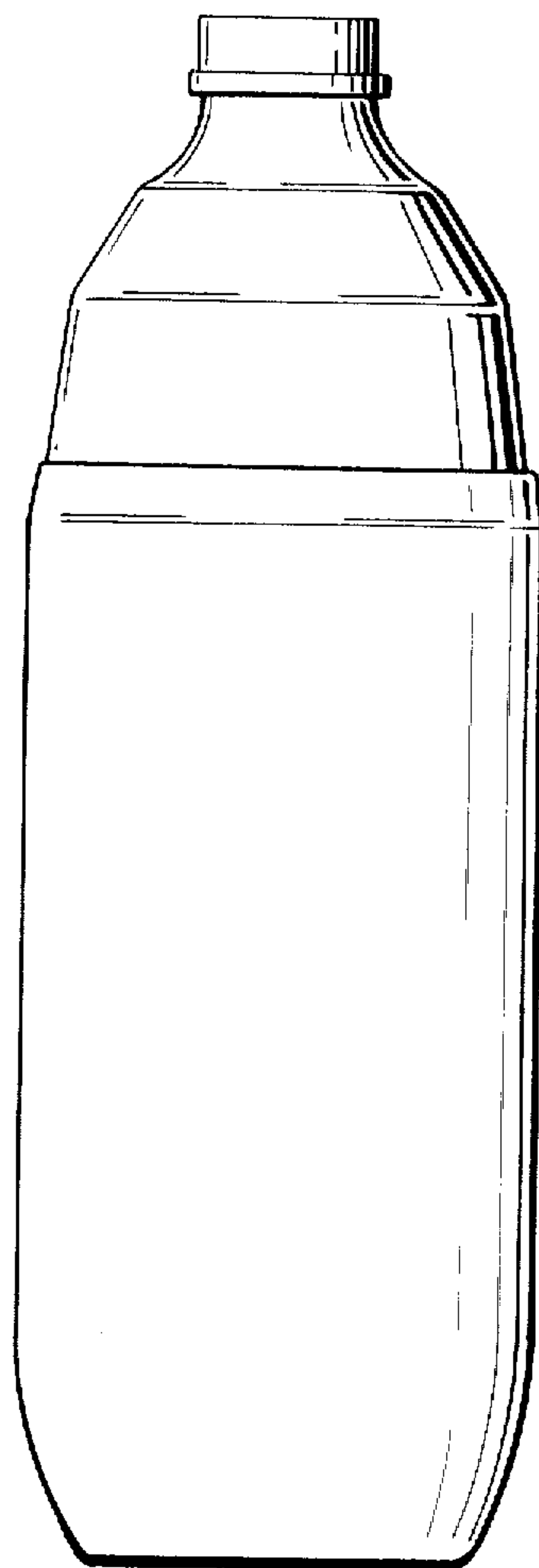

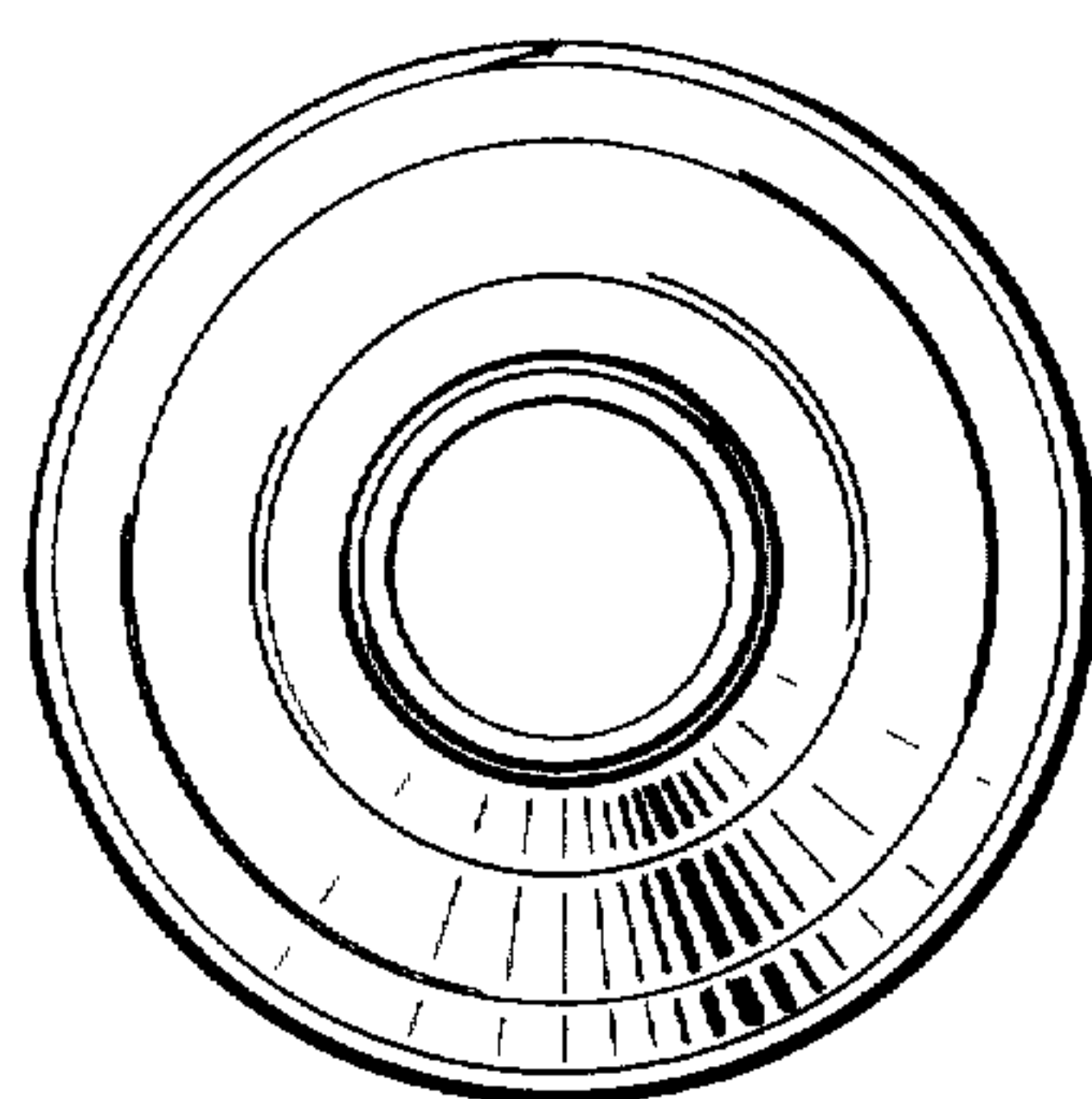

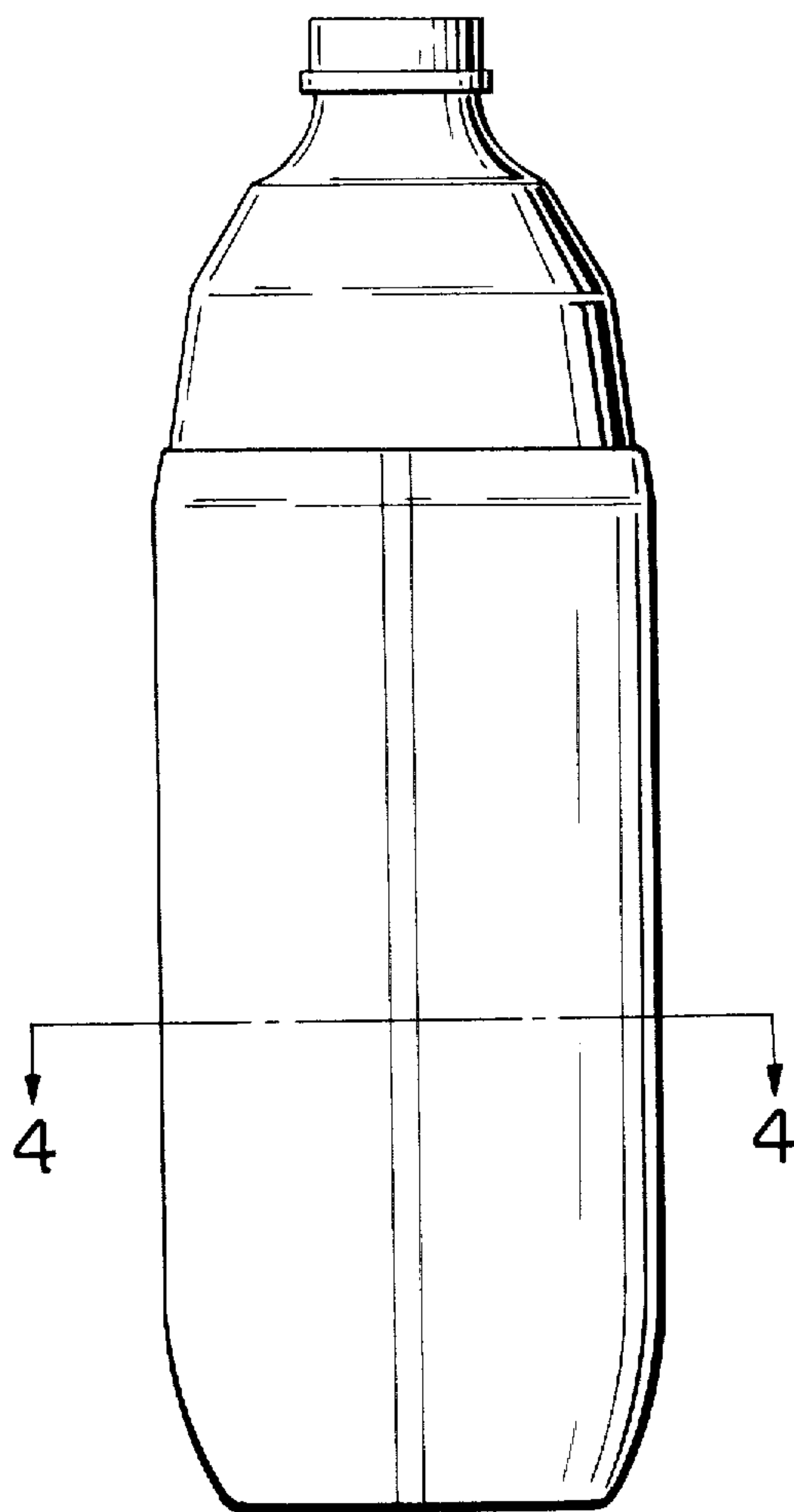

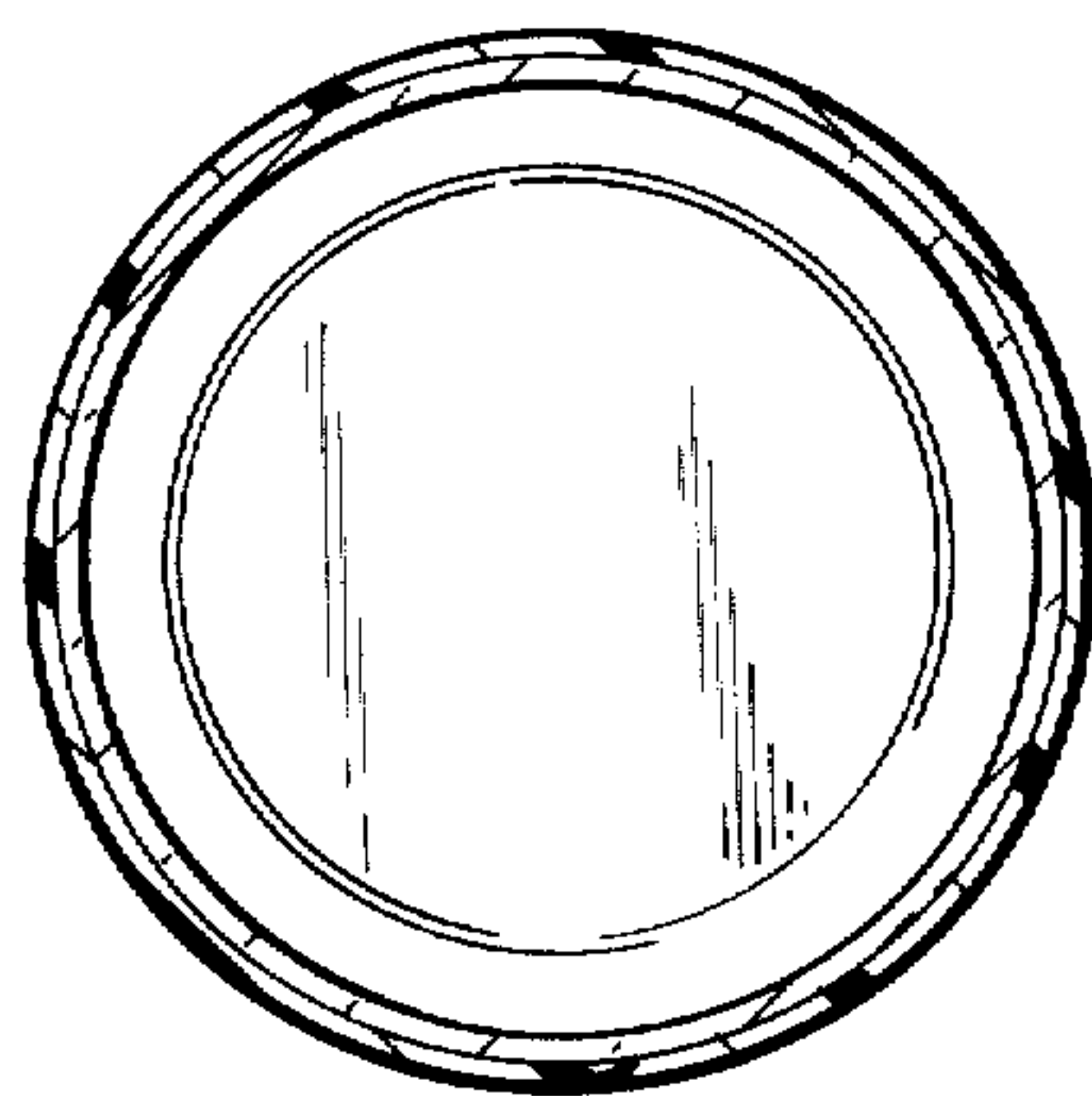
