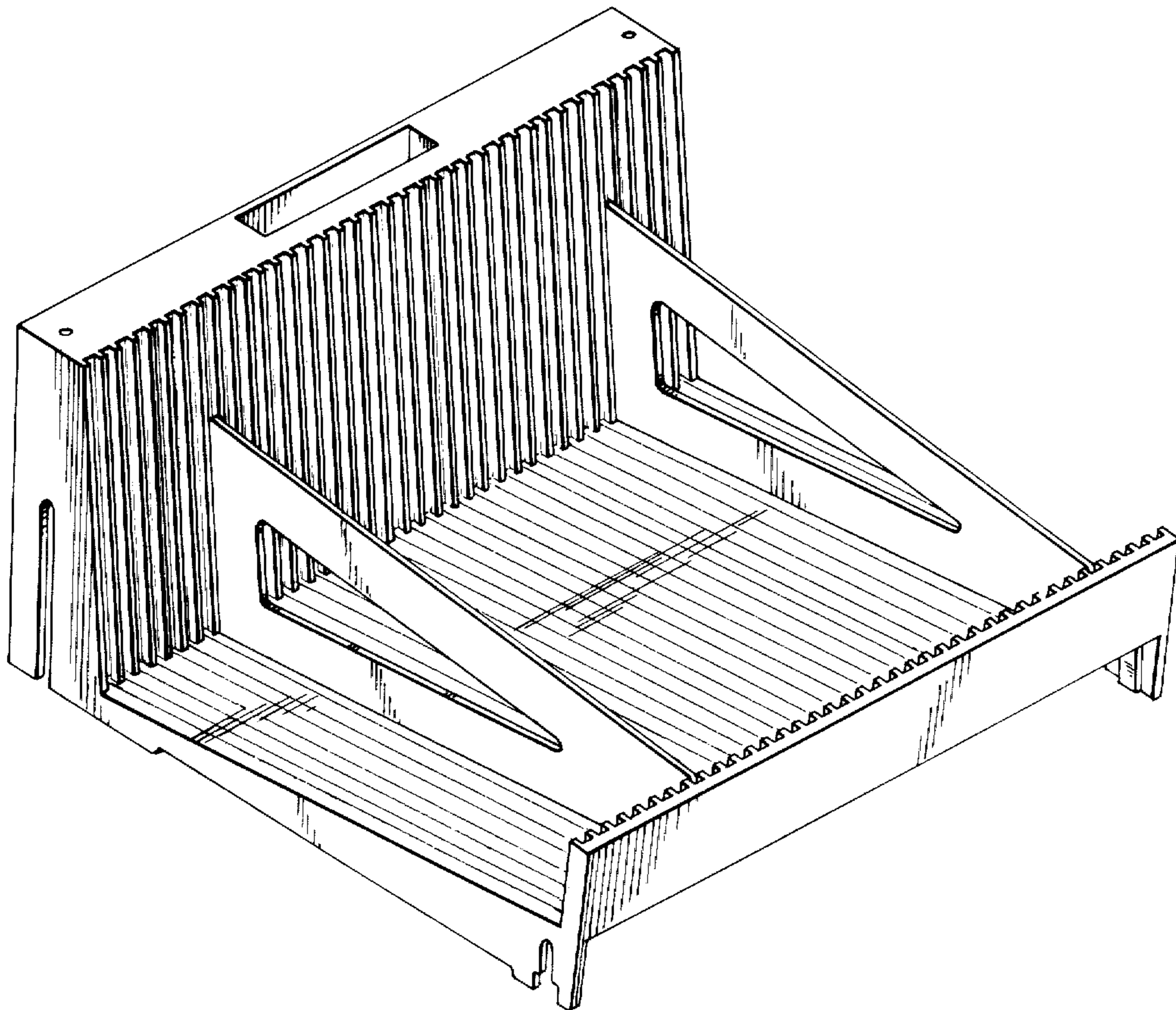

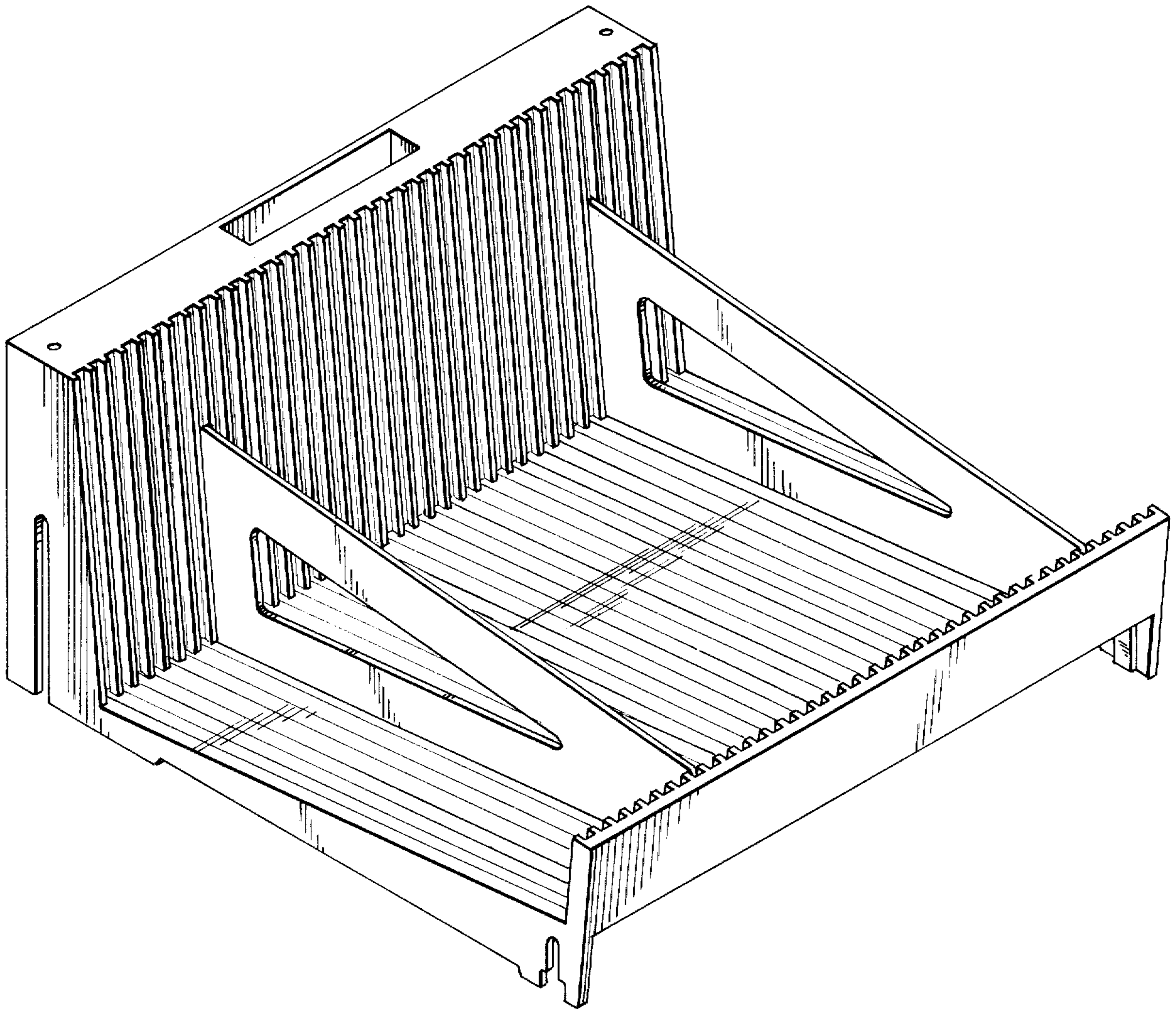
The ornamental design for a merchandise display module, substantially as shown.

**DESCRIPTION**

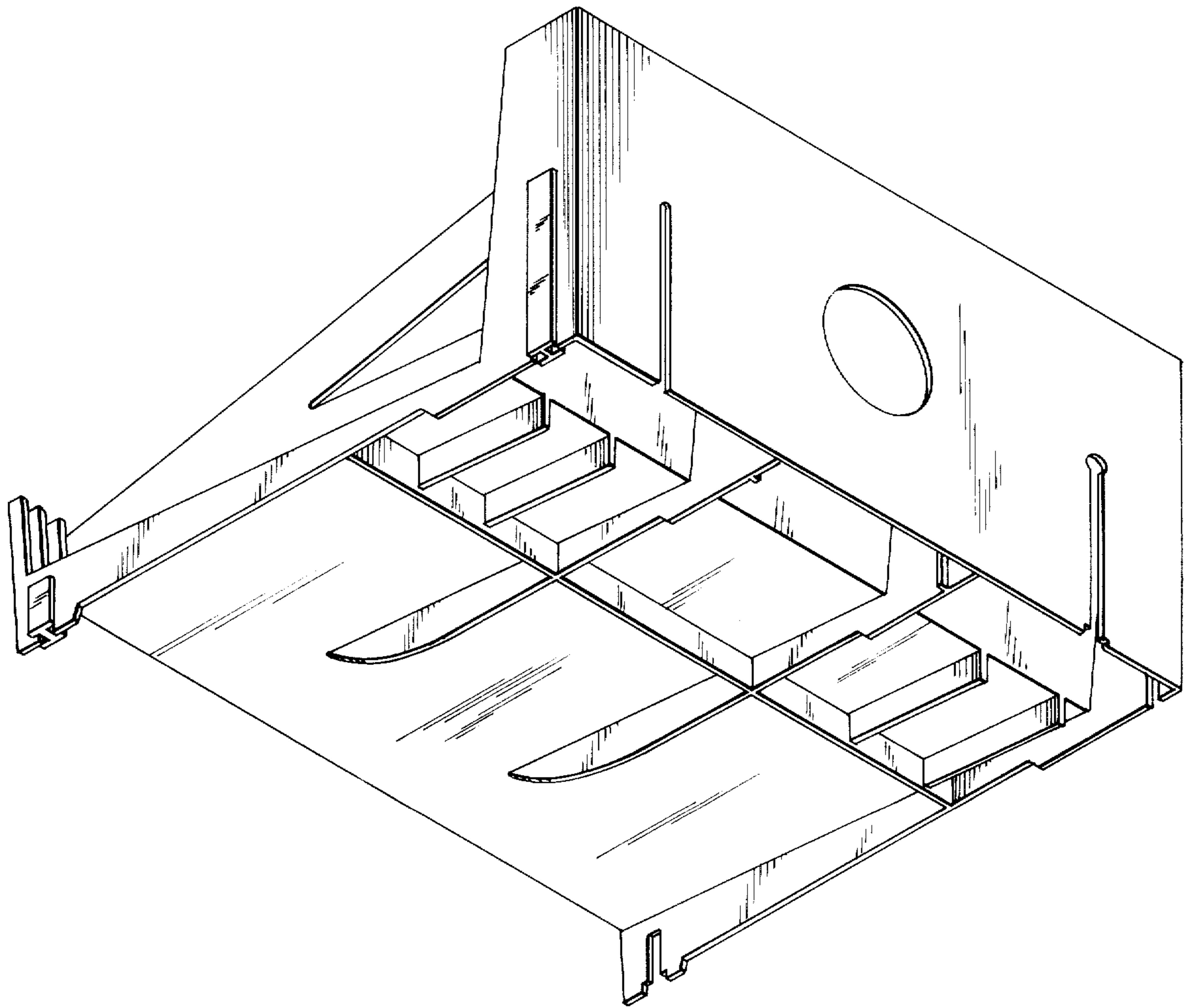
FIG. 1 is a top, front, and right side perspective view of a merchandise display module showing my new design; and
