bottles and glasses, as shown.

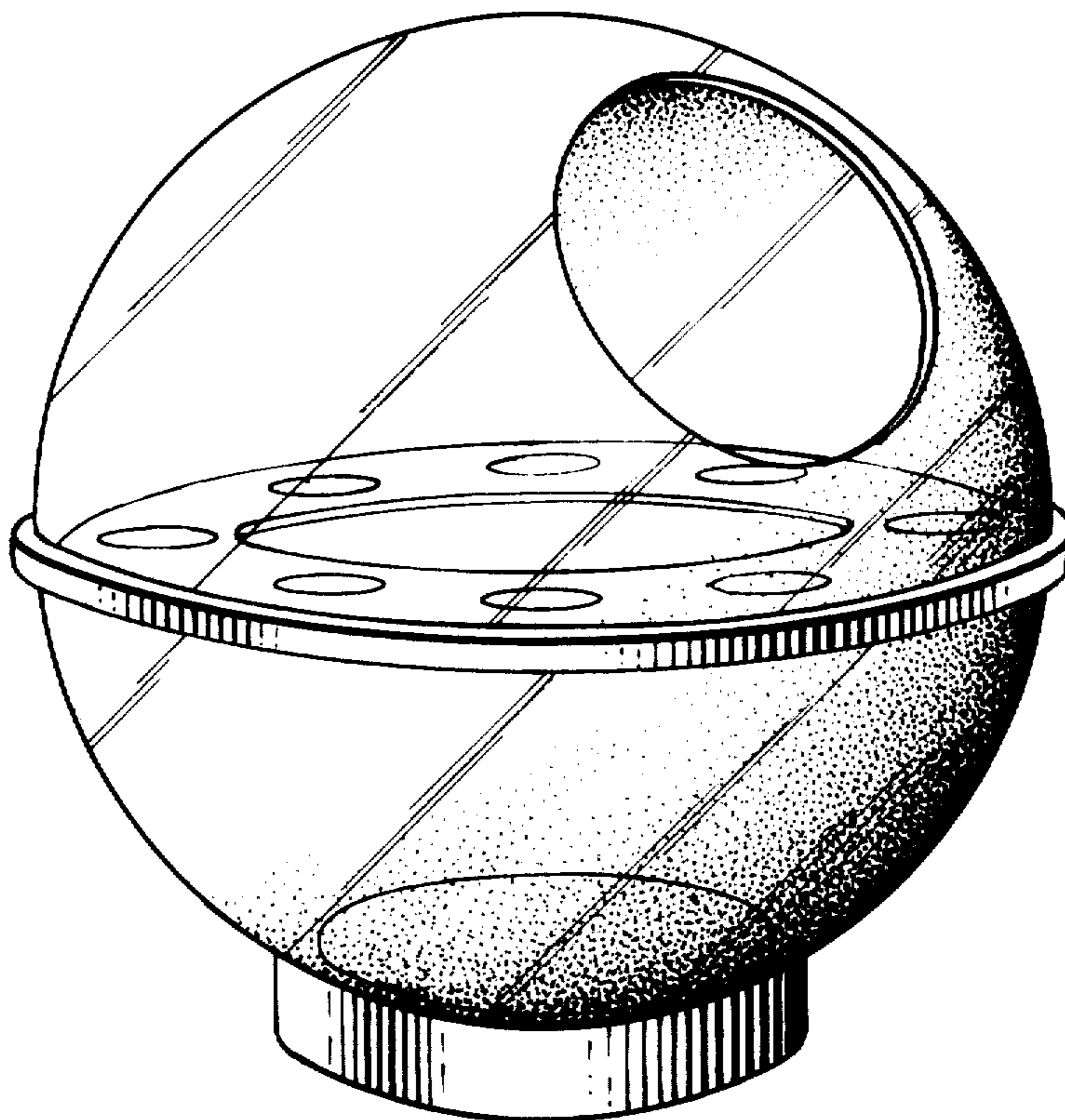
DESCRIPTION

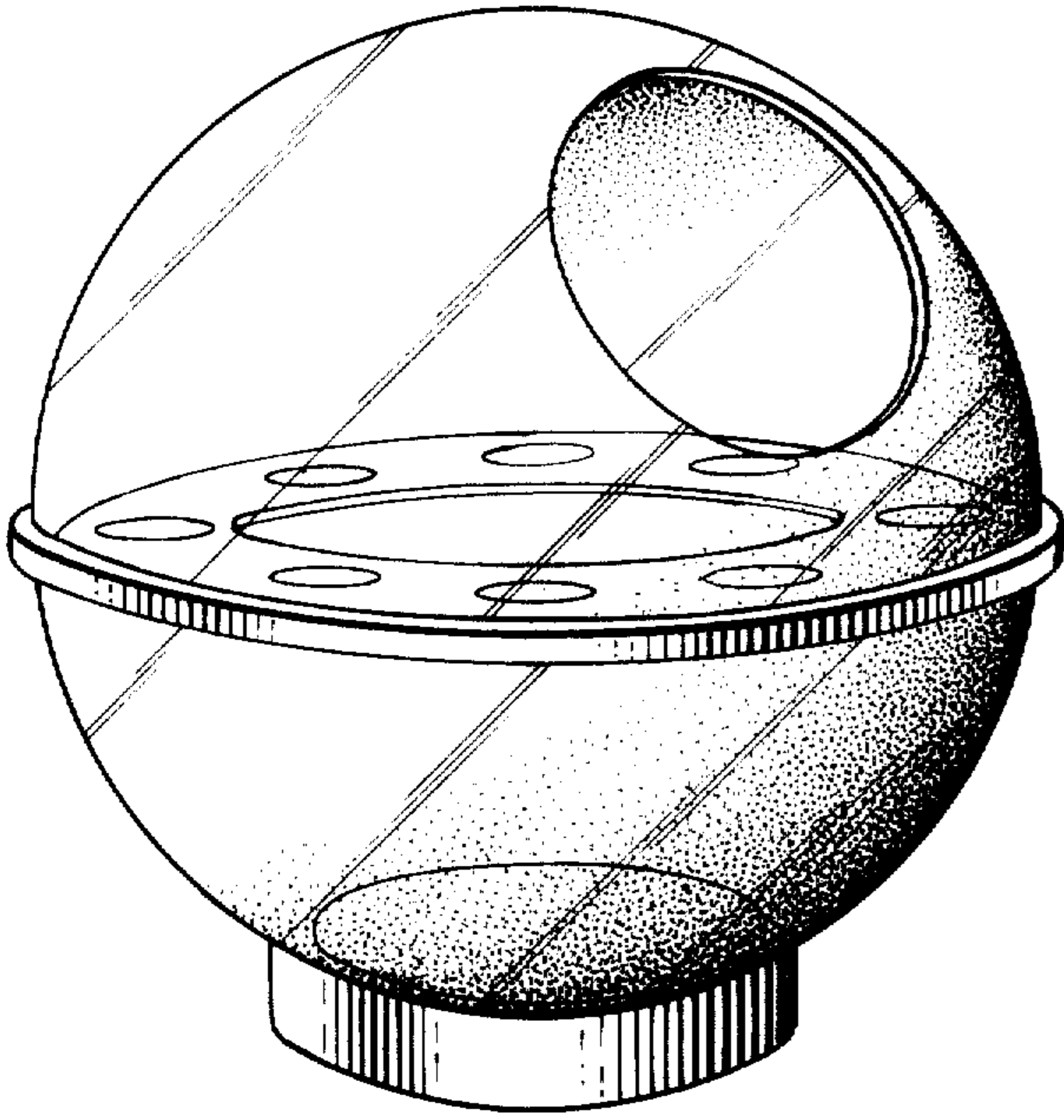

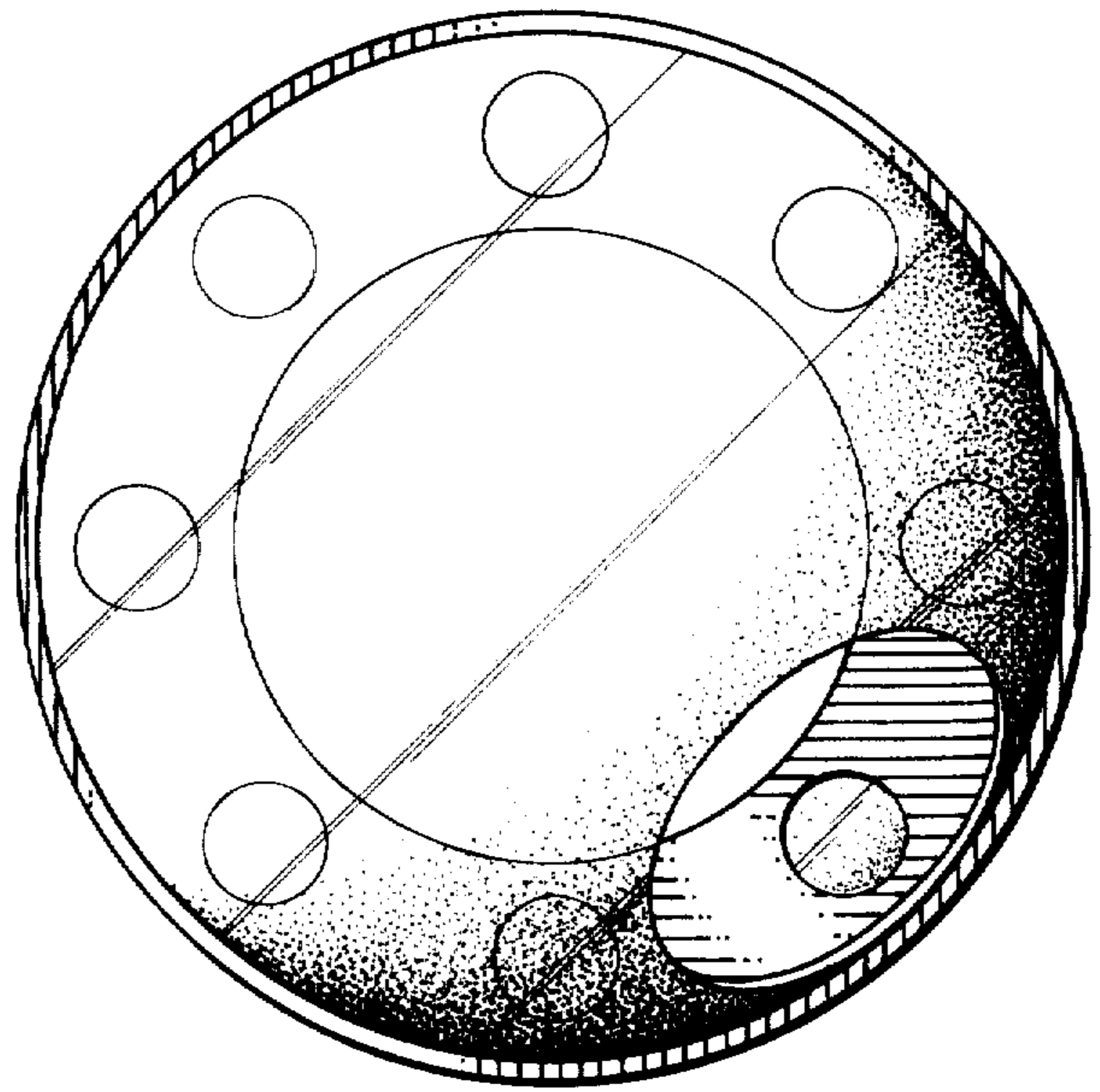

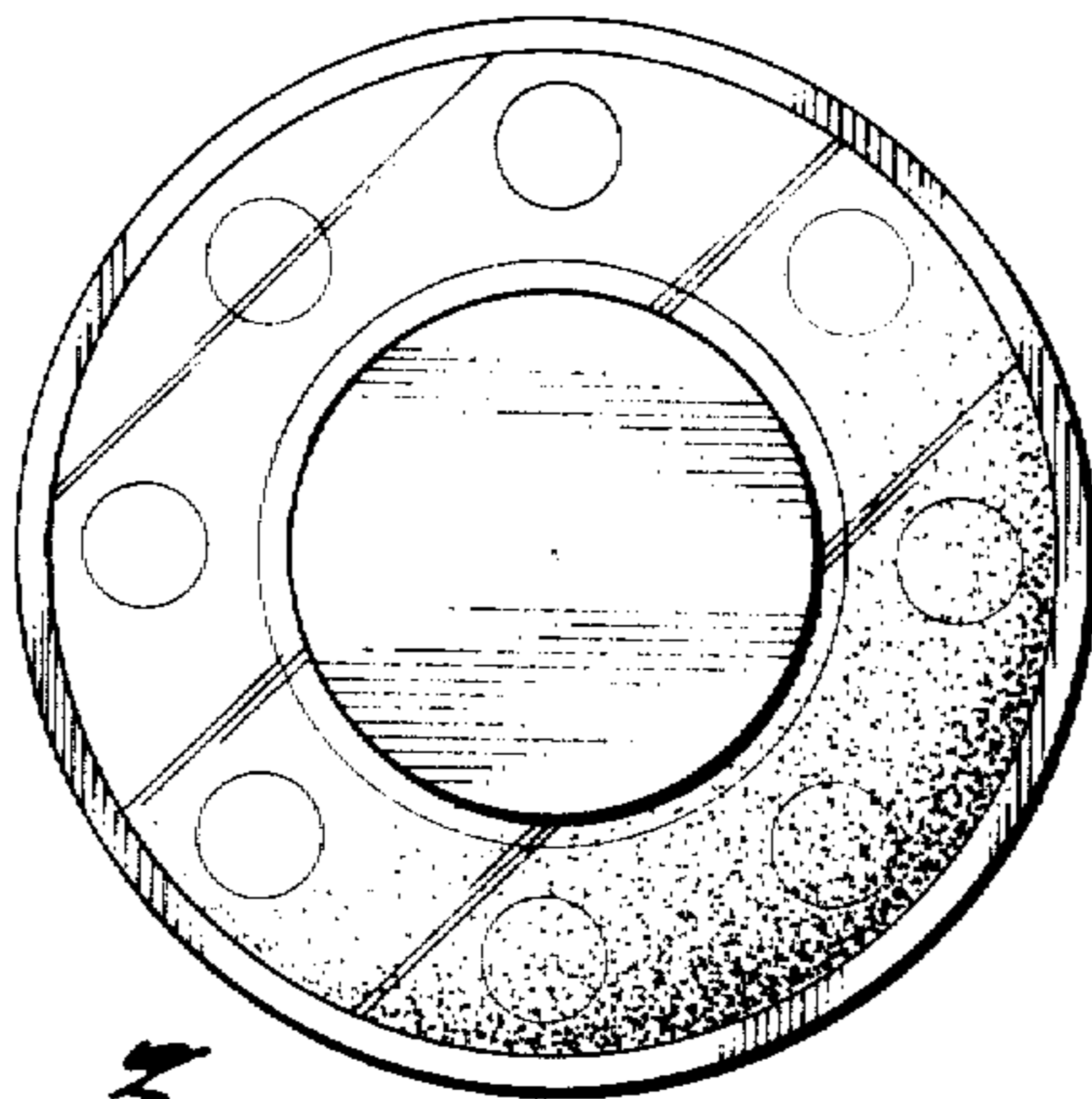
