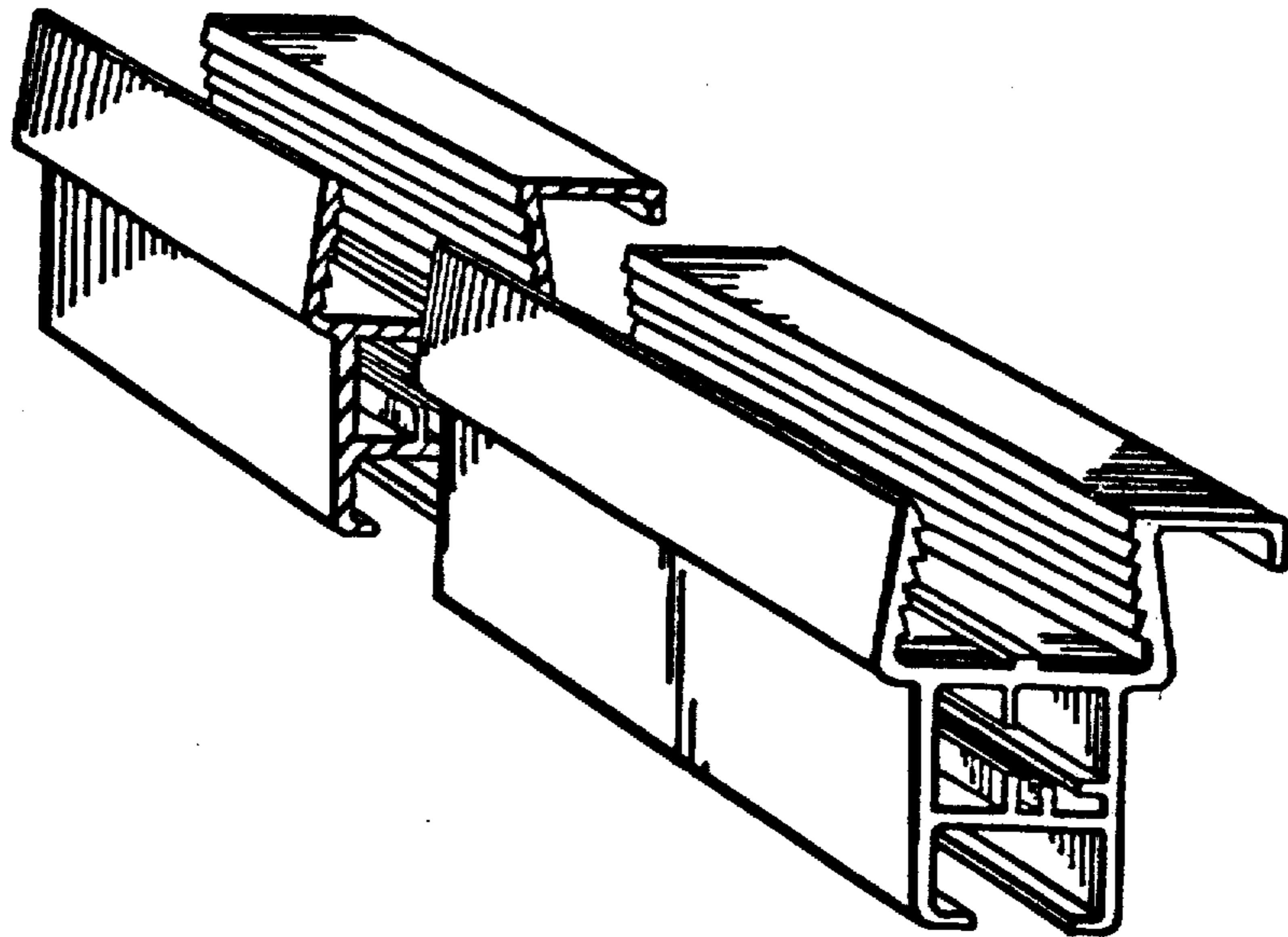

FIG. 1 is a broken perspective of one side of an extruded side rail for a window, and FIG. 2 is a corresponding broken perspective from the opposite side of an extruded side rail for a window compared to FIG. 1.



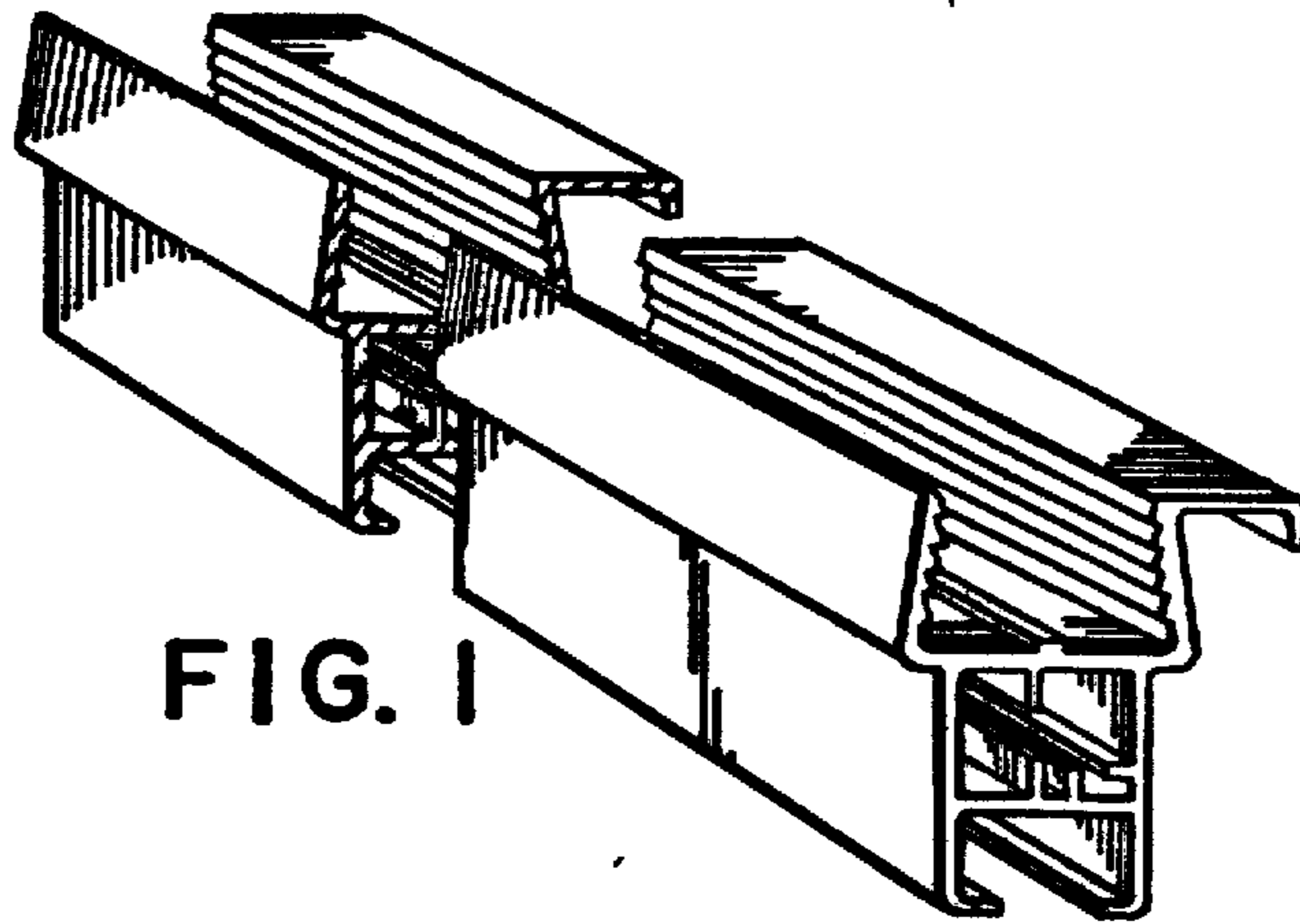

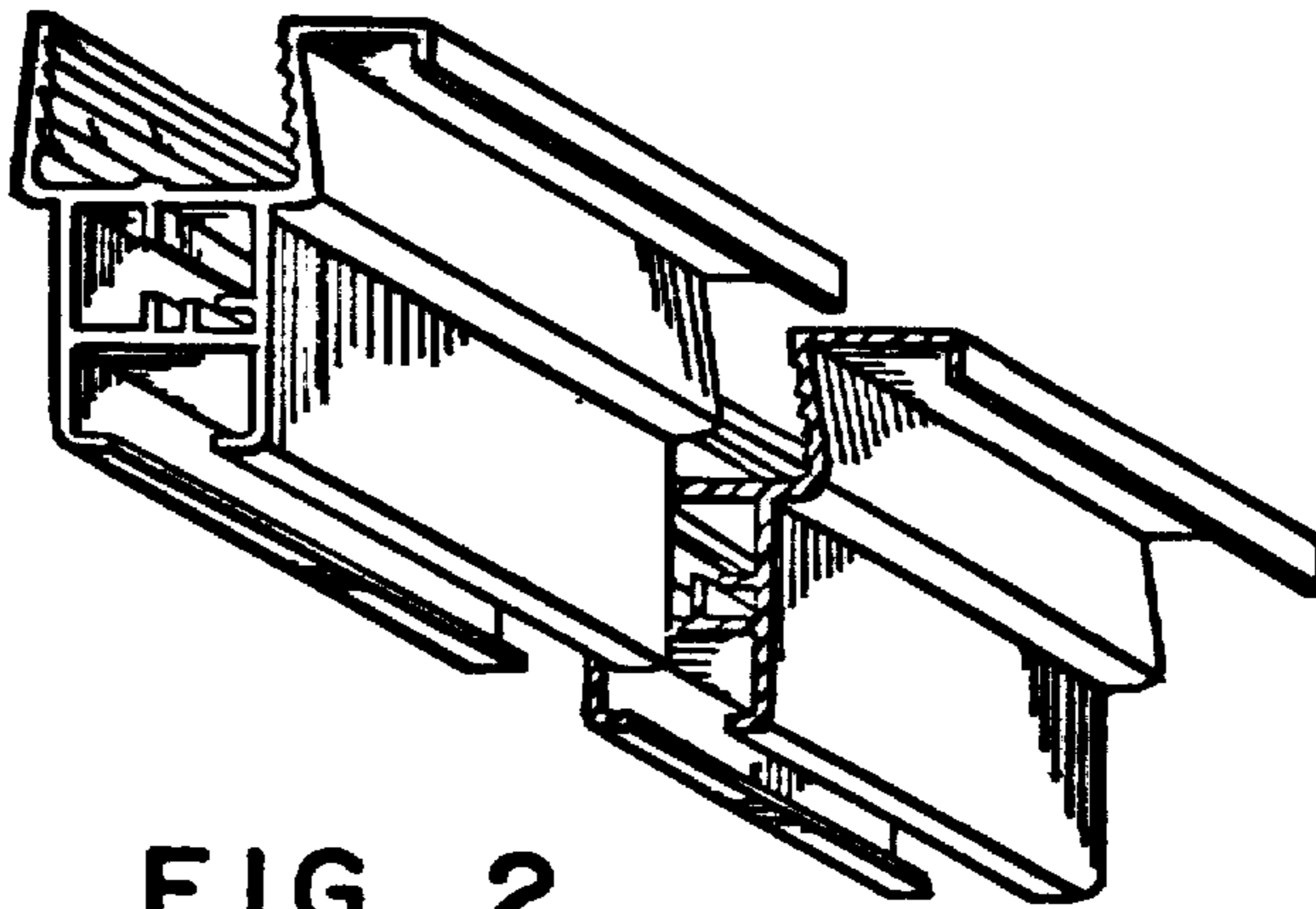
