The ornamental design for a combined candle and holder therefor, as shown and described.

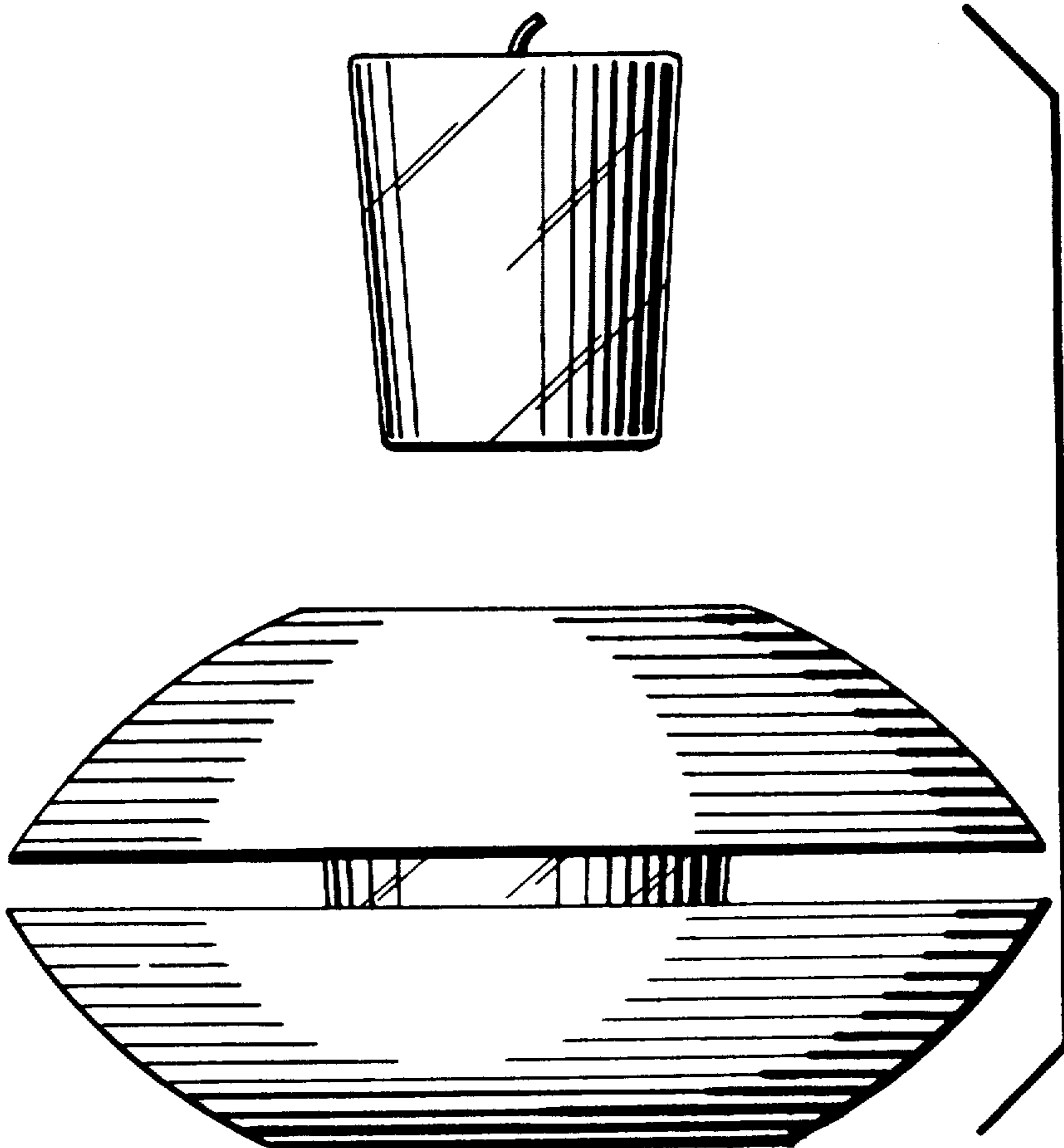
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an exploded side elevational view of the combined candle and holder therefor showing my new design;

FIG. 4 is a sectional view in reduced scale taken on the line 4-4 of FIG. 2.



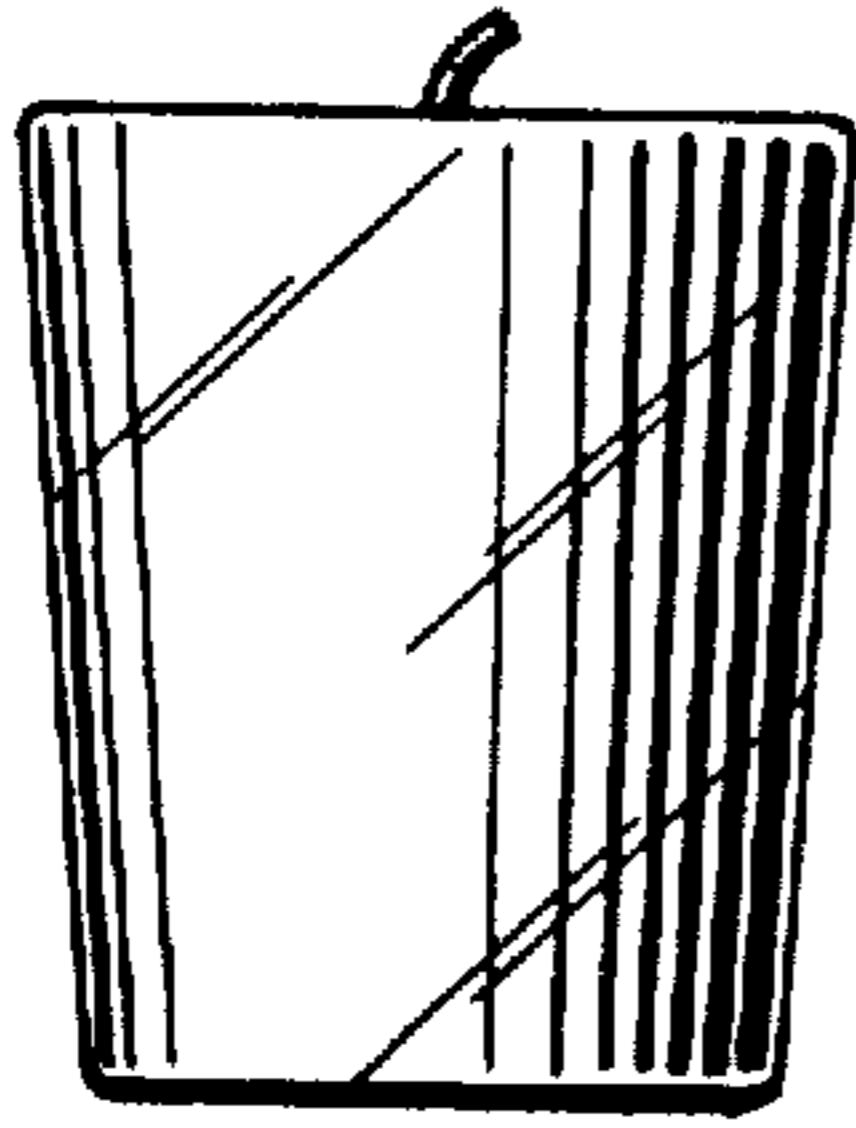

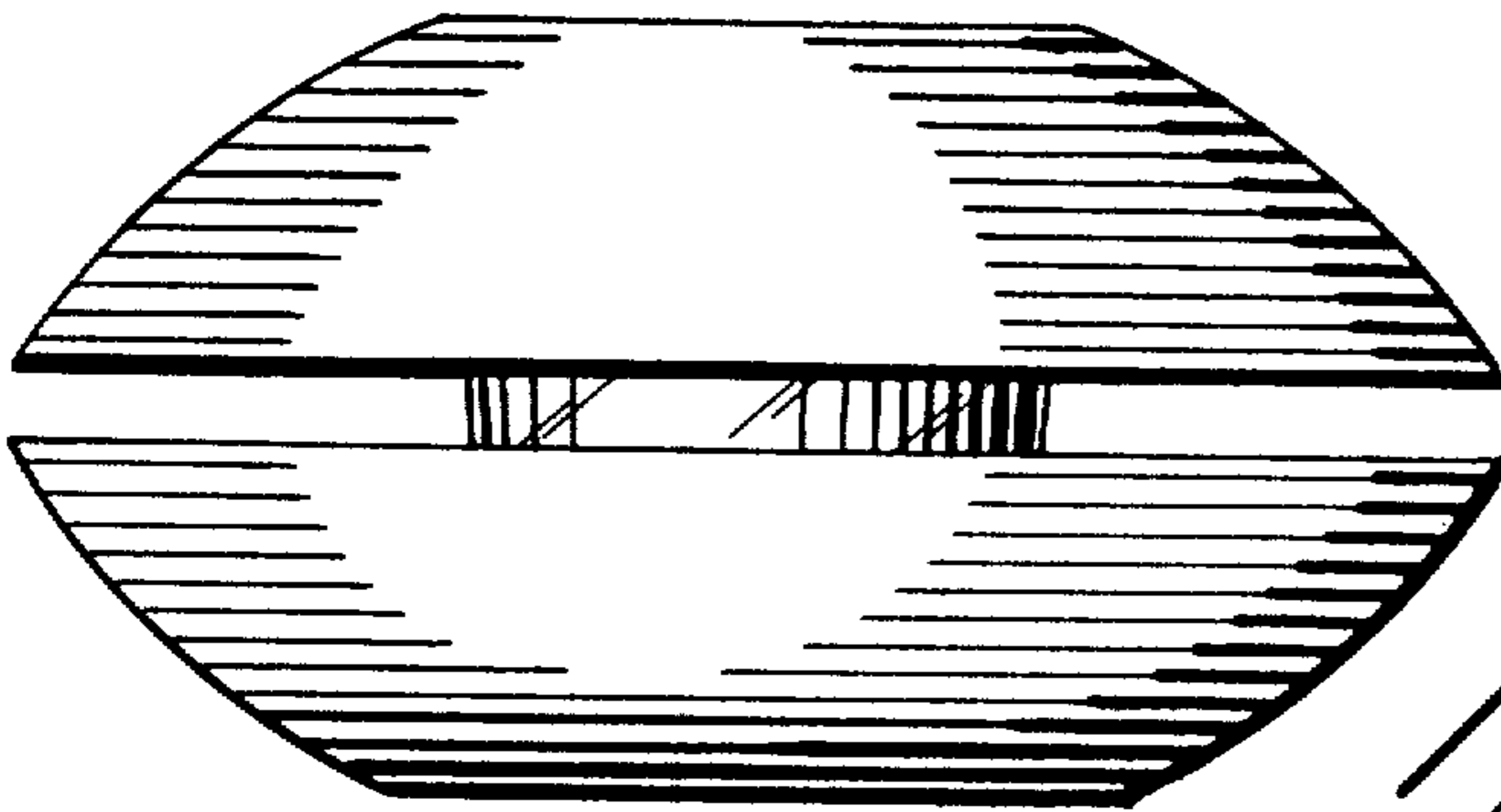
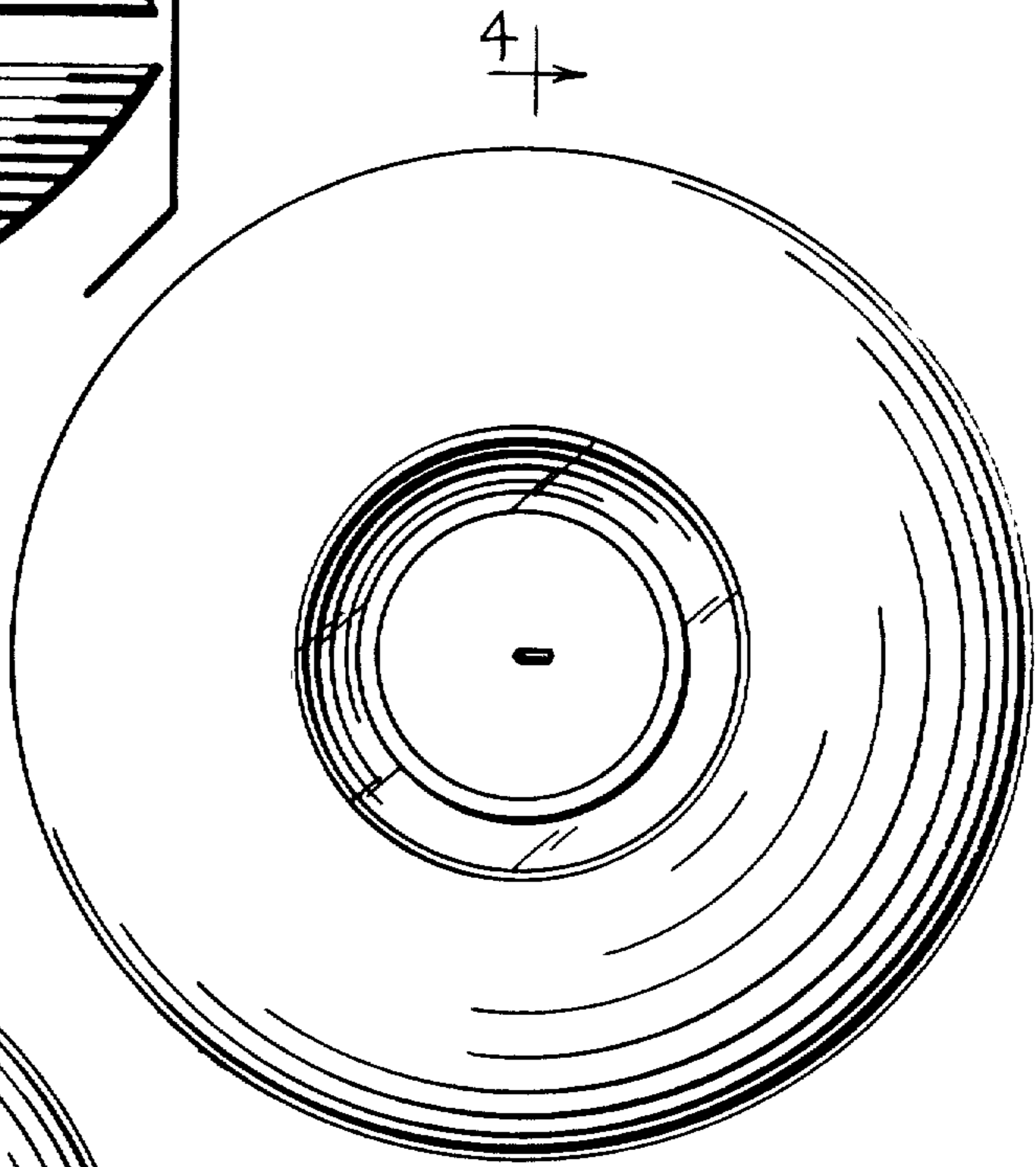

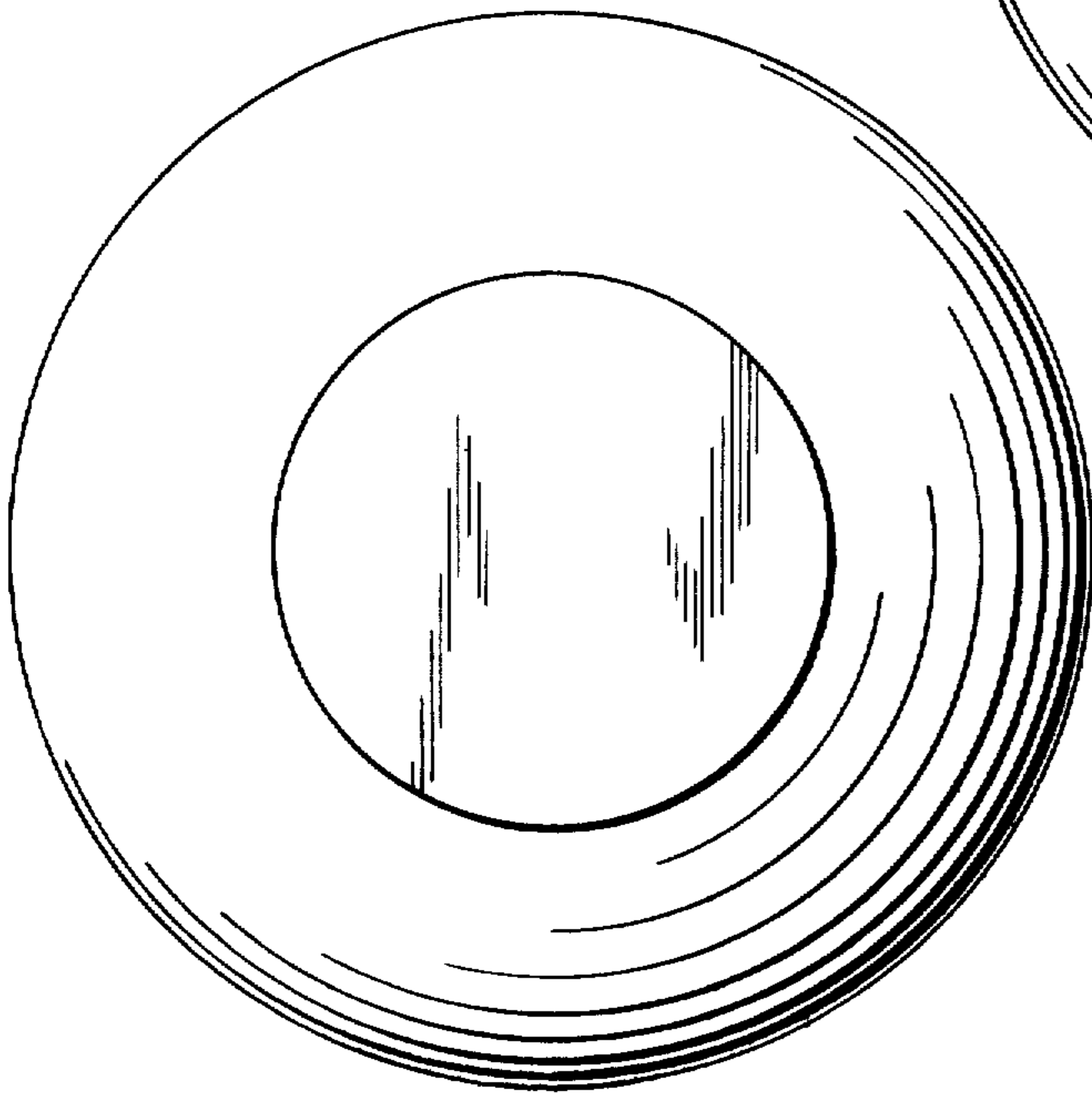
