**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 5 is a transverse sectional view taken on line 5 — 5 of FIG. 1.

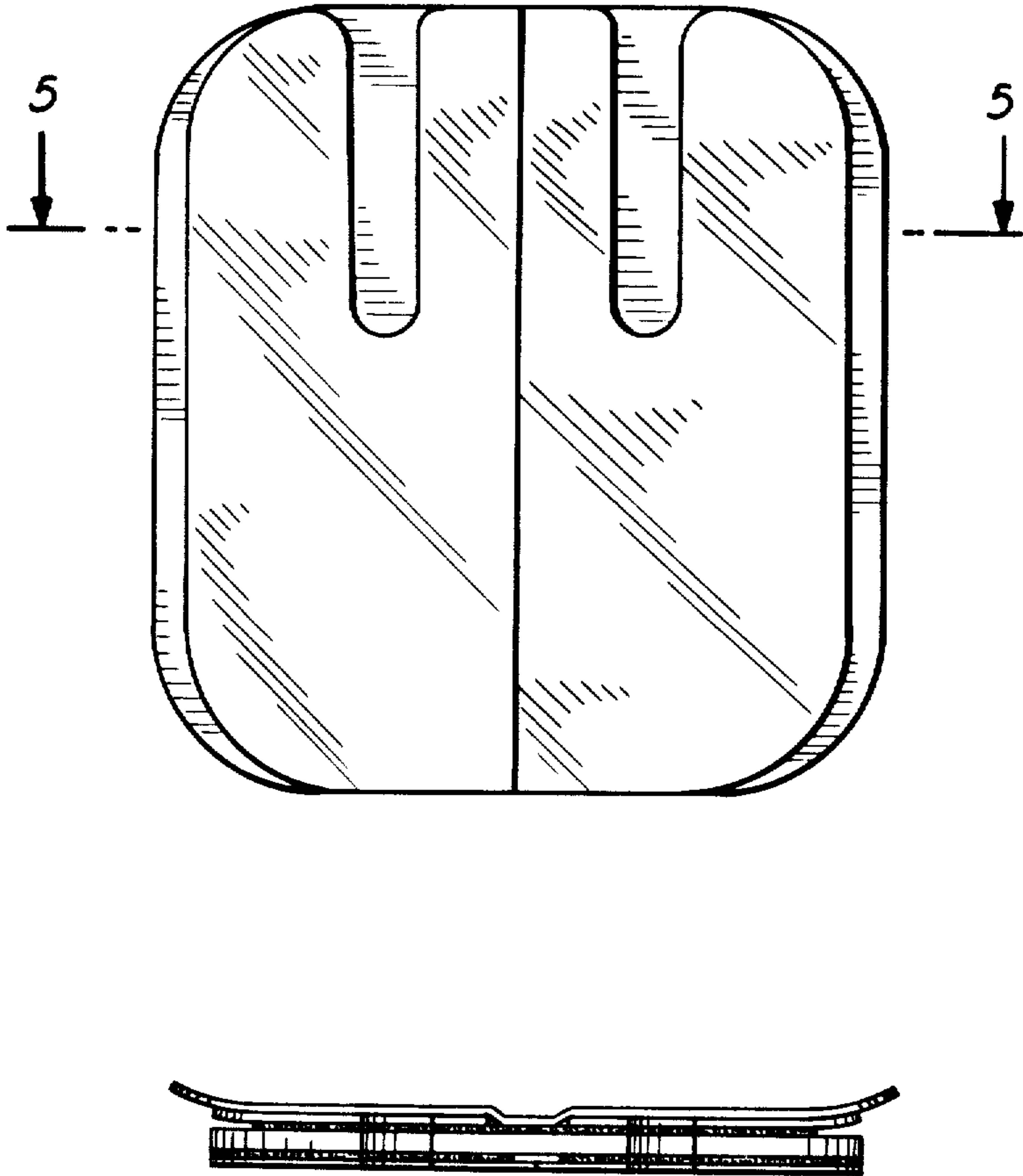

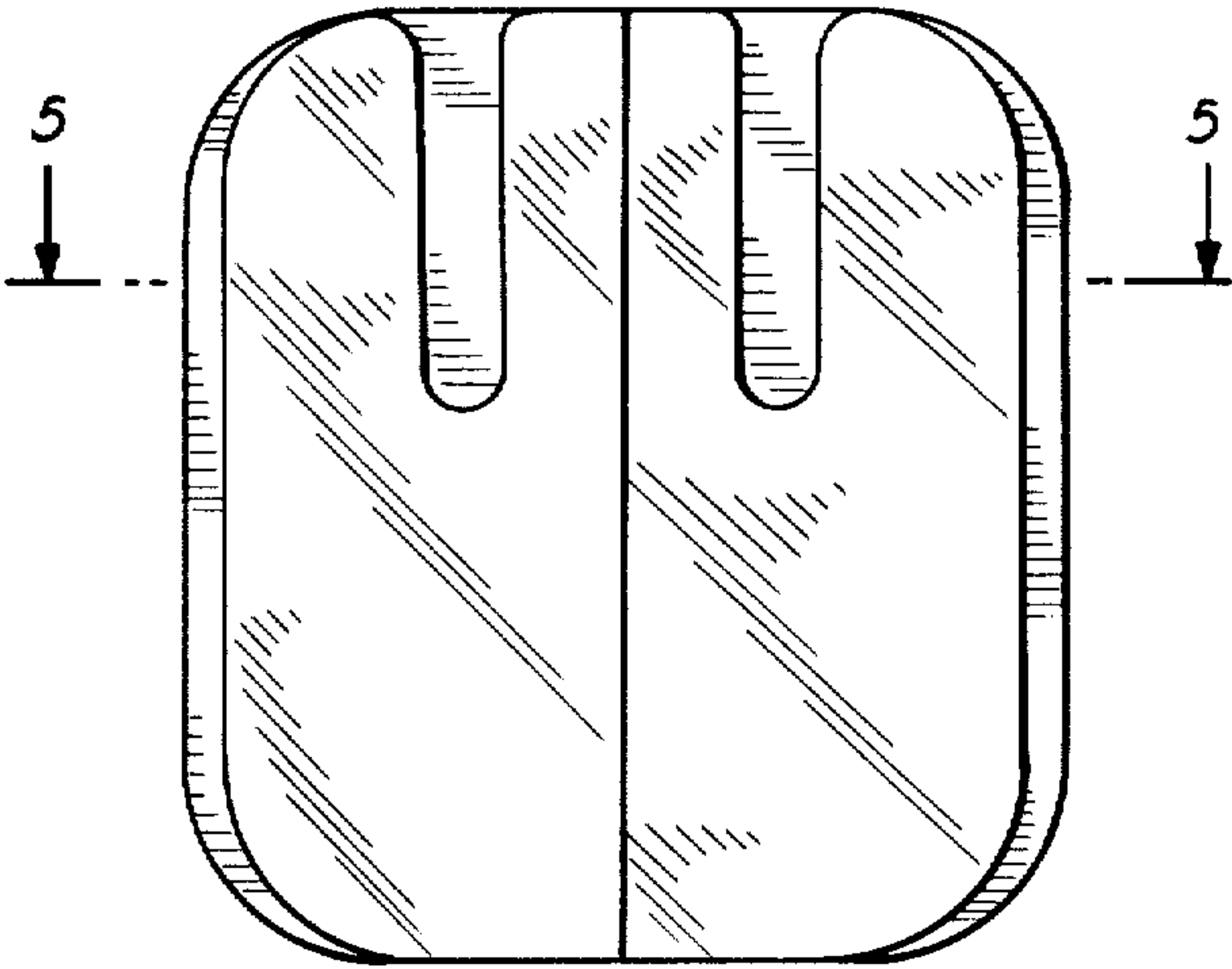

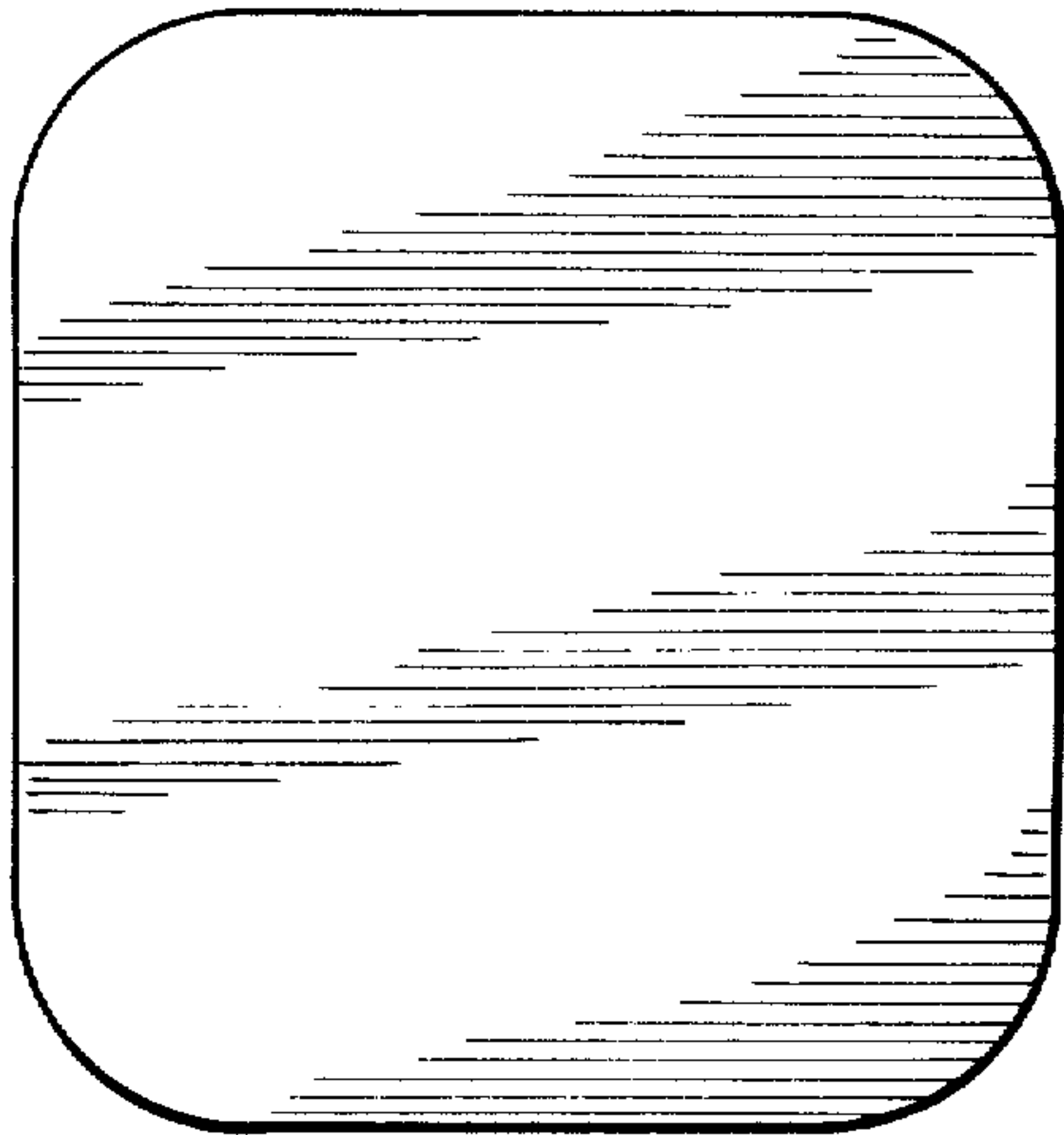
