The ornamental design for a bicycle, as shown.

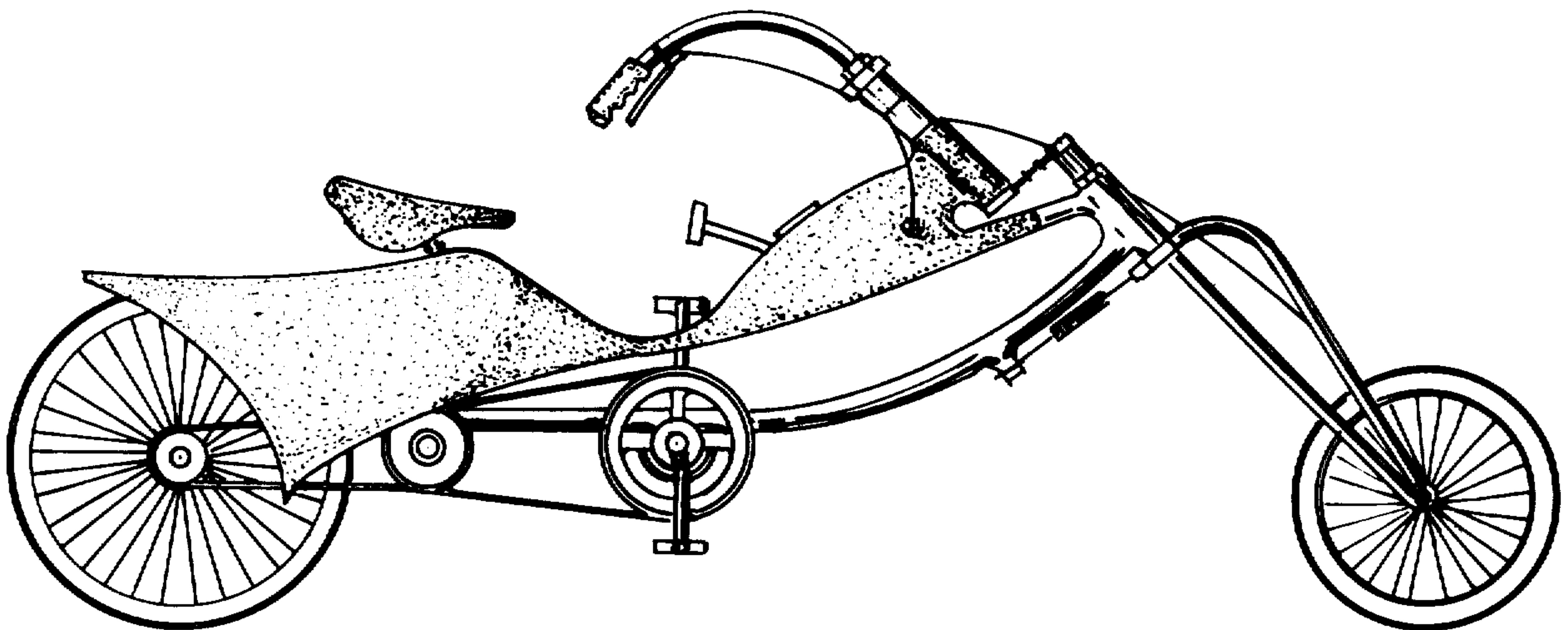
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a rear end elevational view thereof.



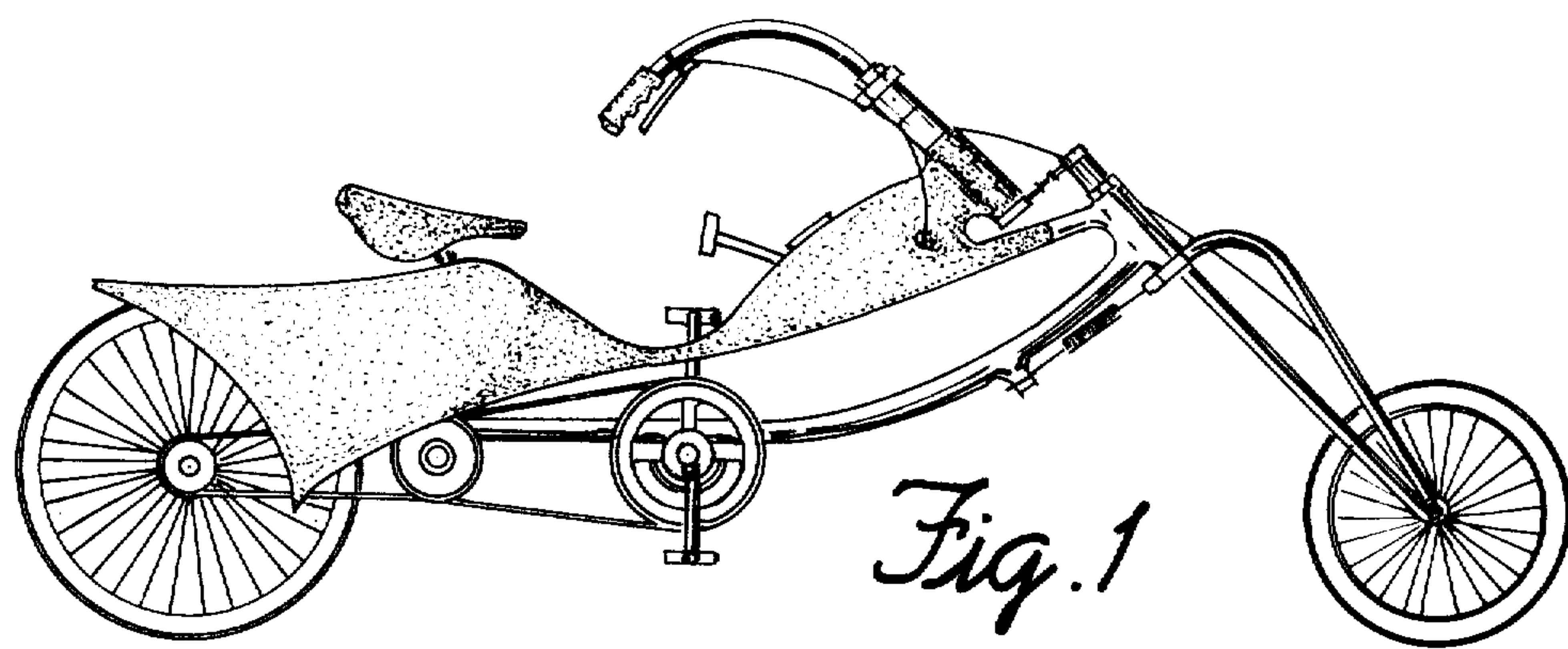

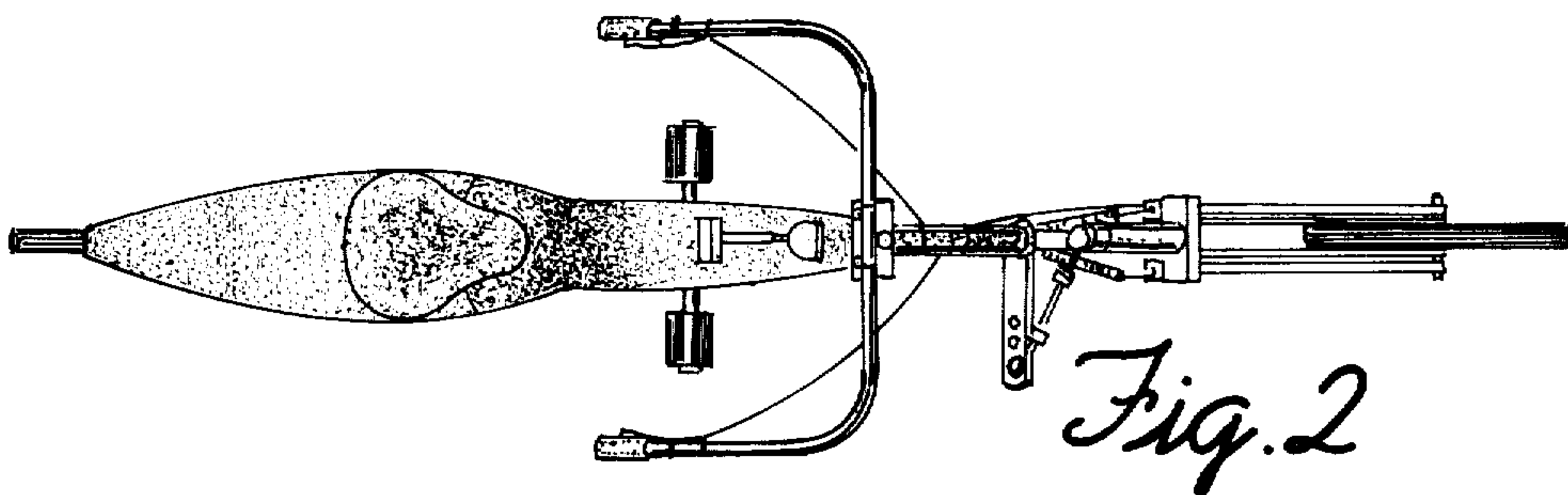

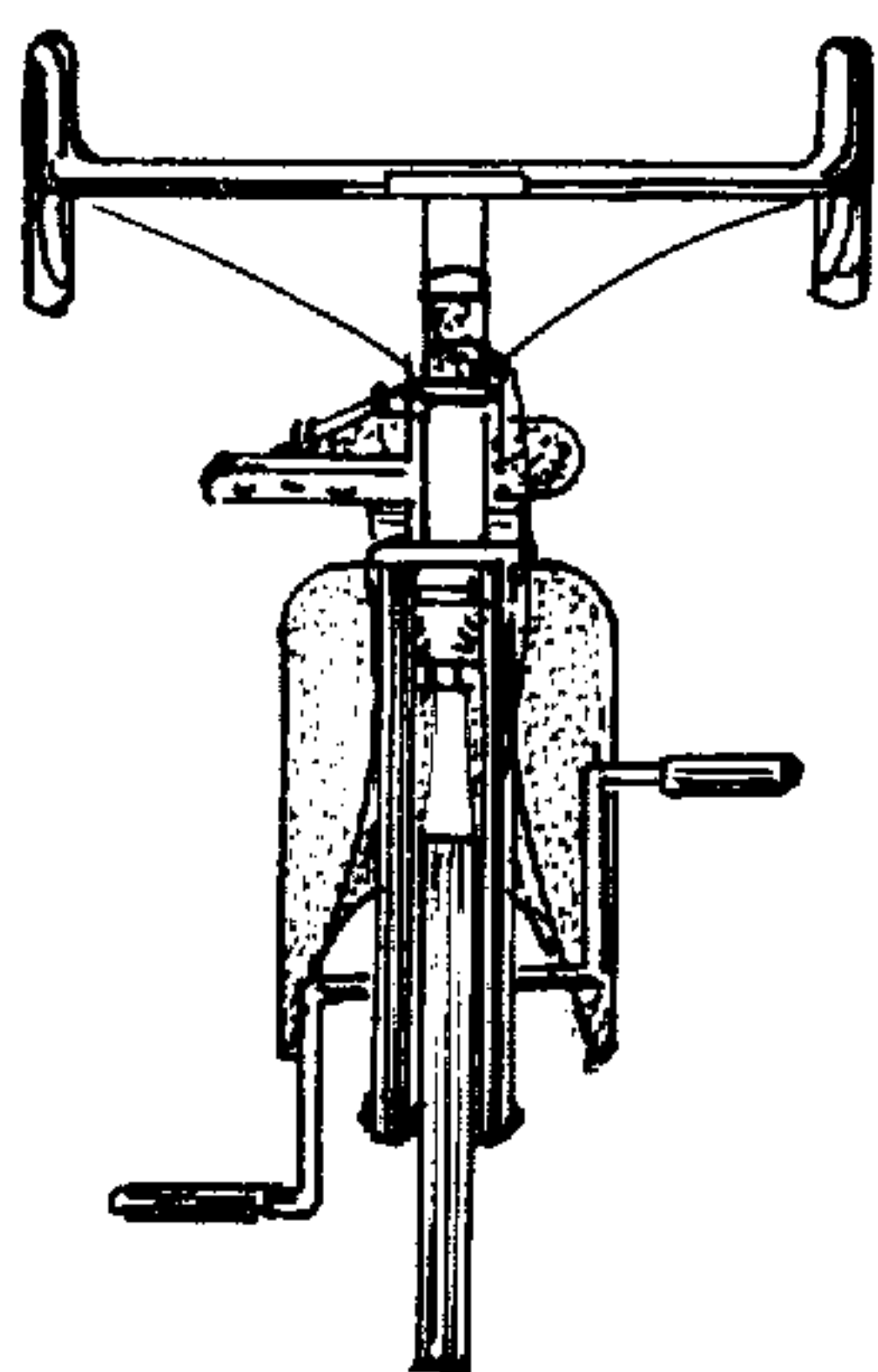

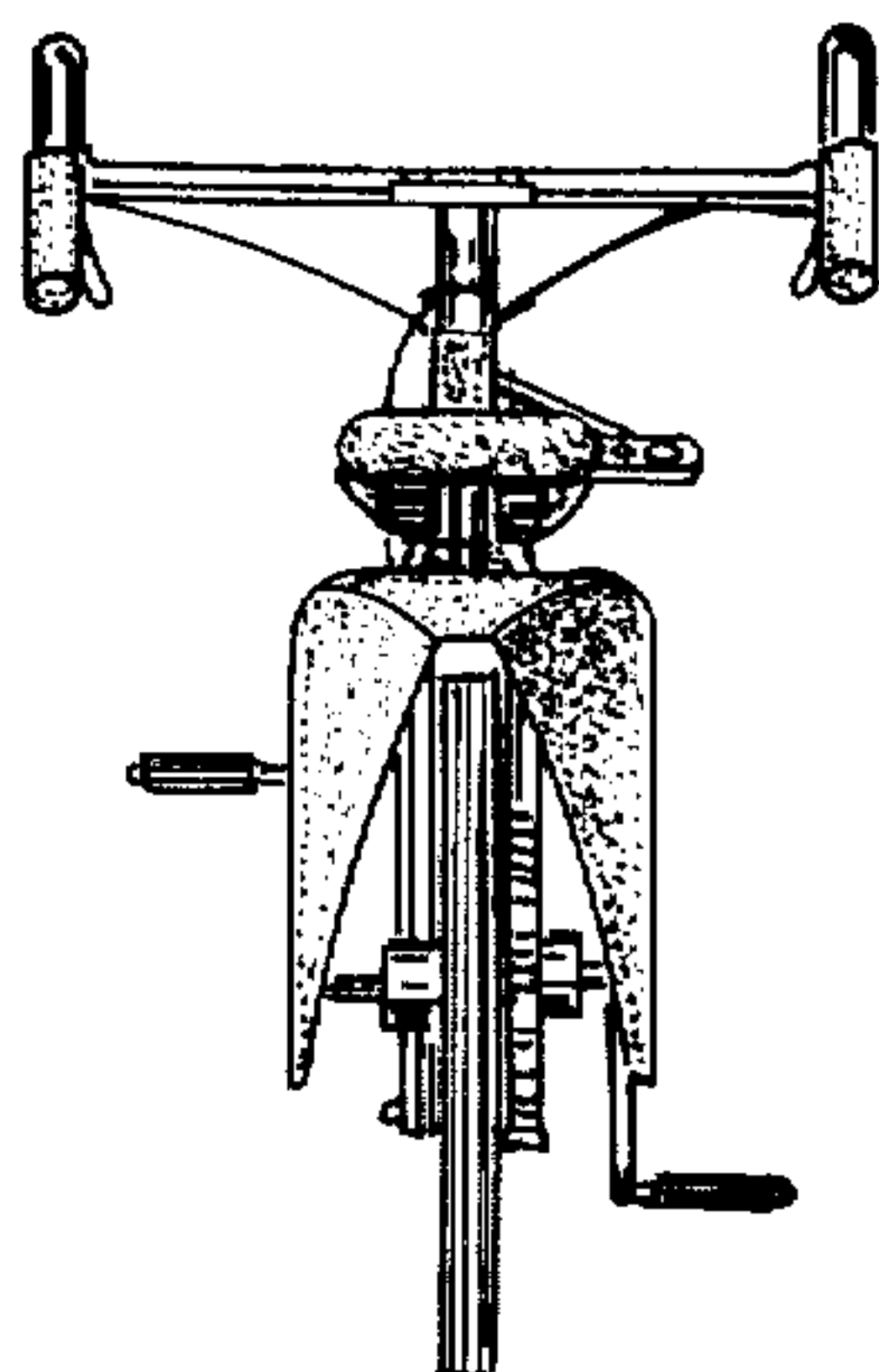
