DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a pocket baseball game box
showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a perspective view thereof.
It is noted that the rear elevational view is a mirror
image of the front elevational view.

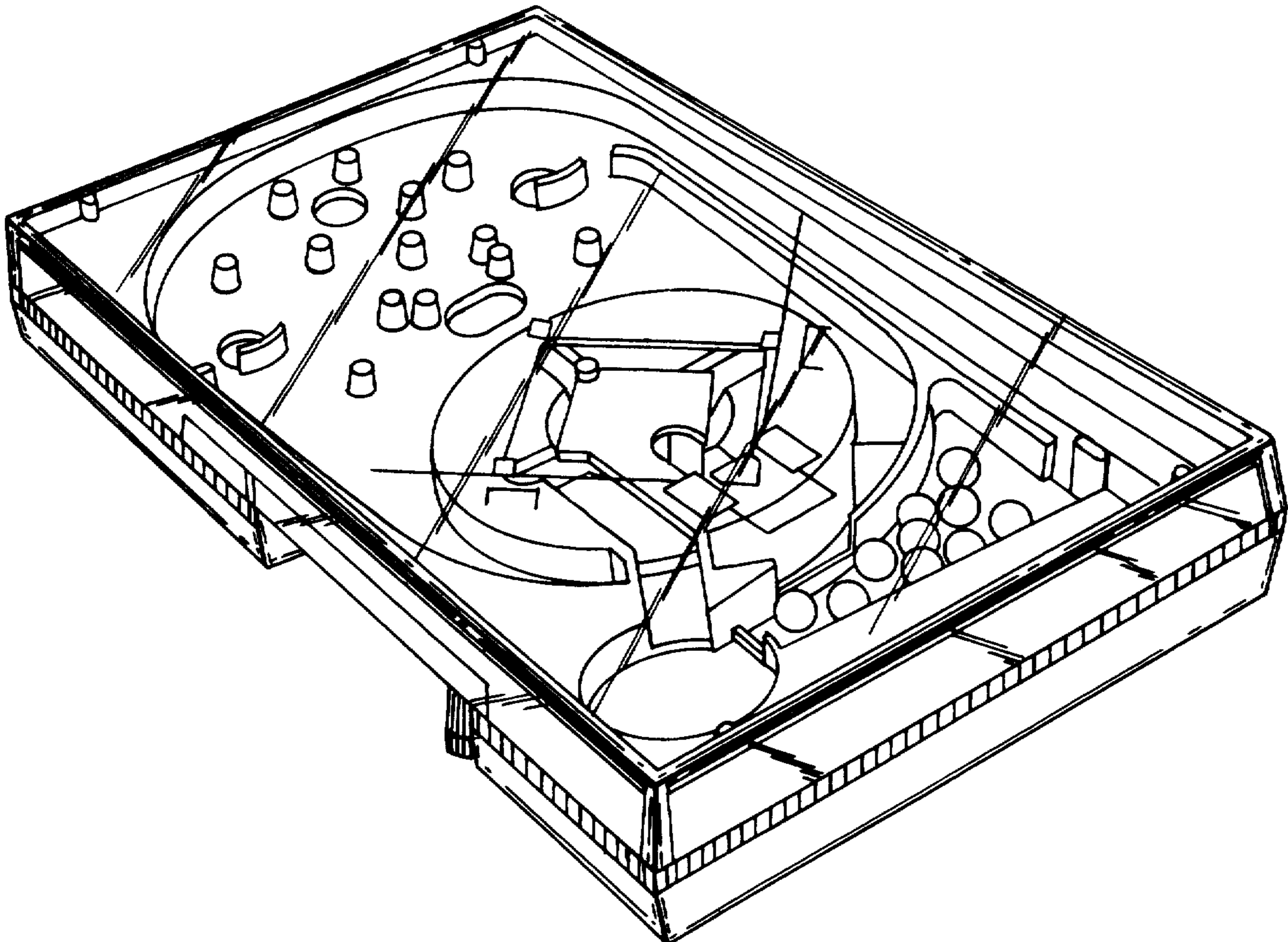

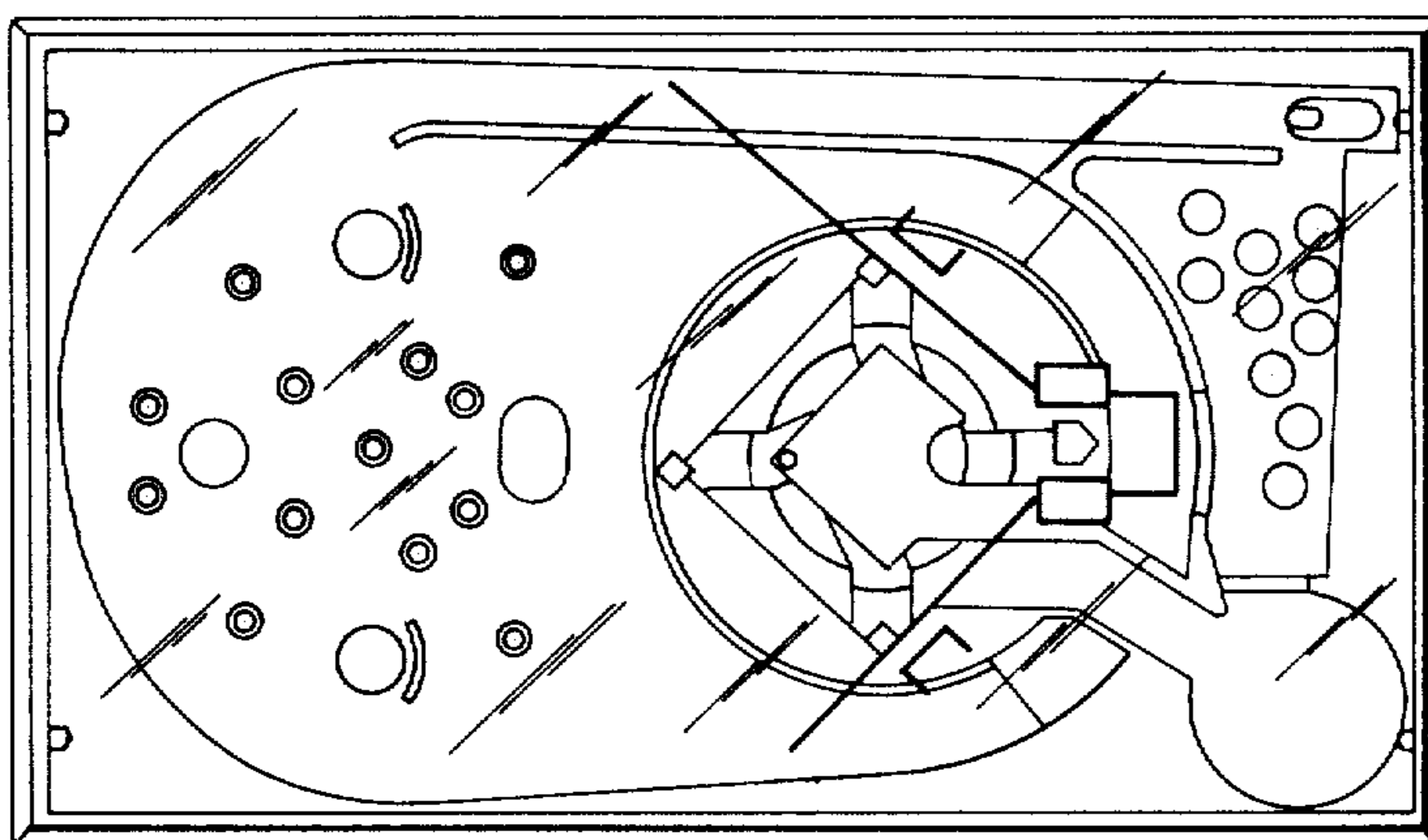

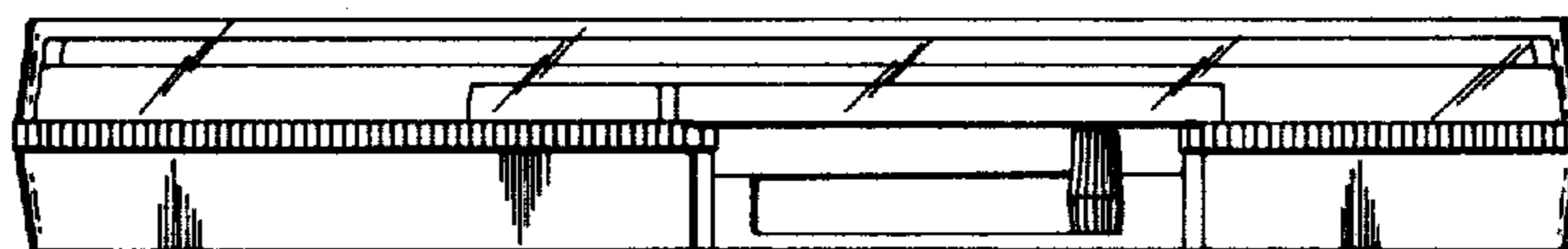

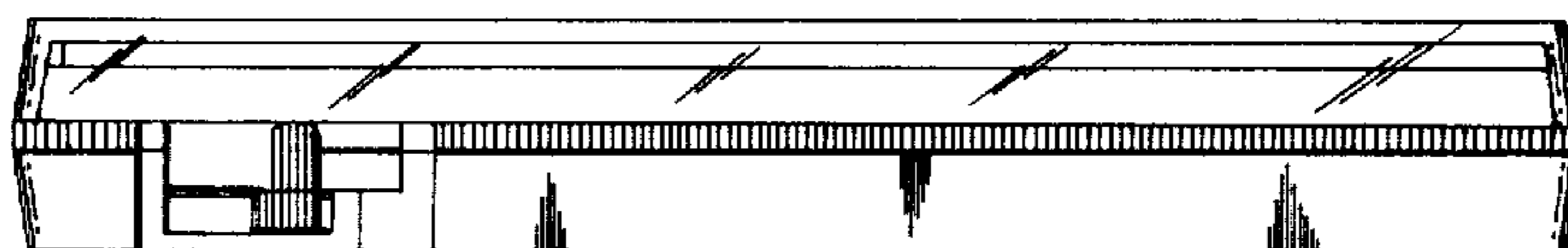

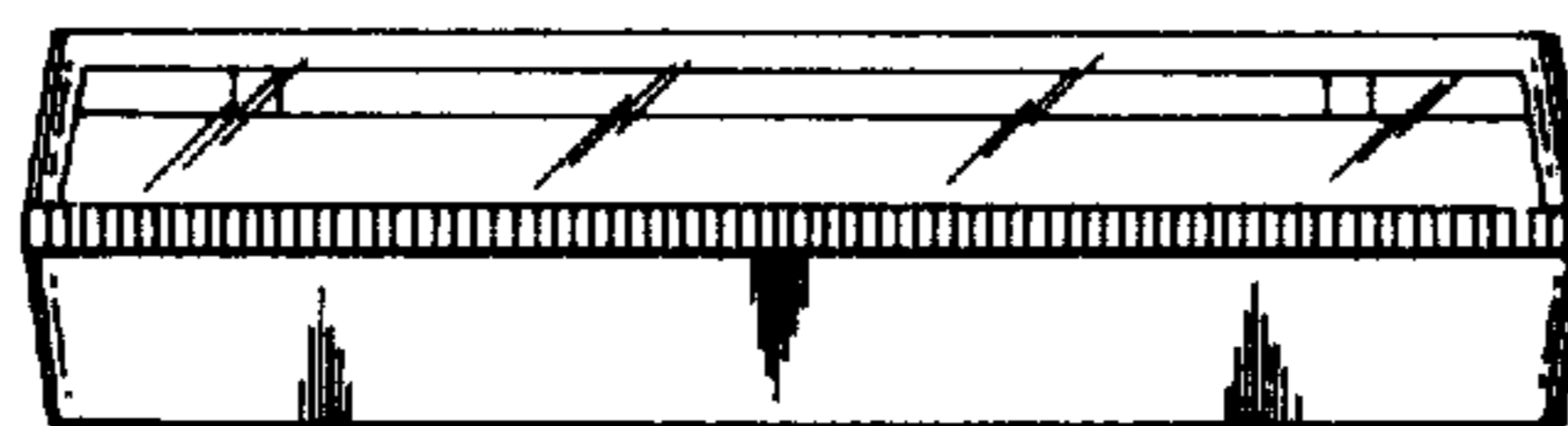
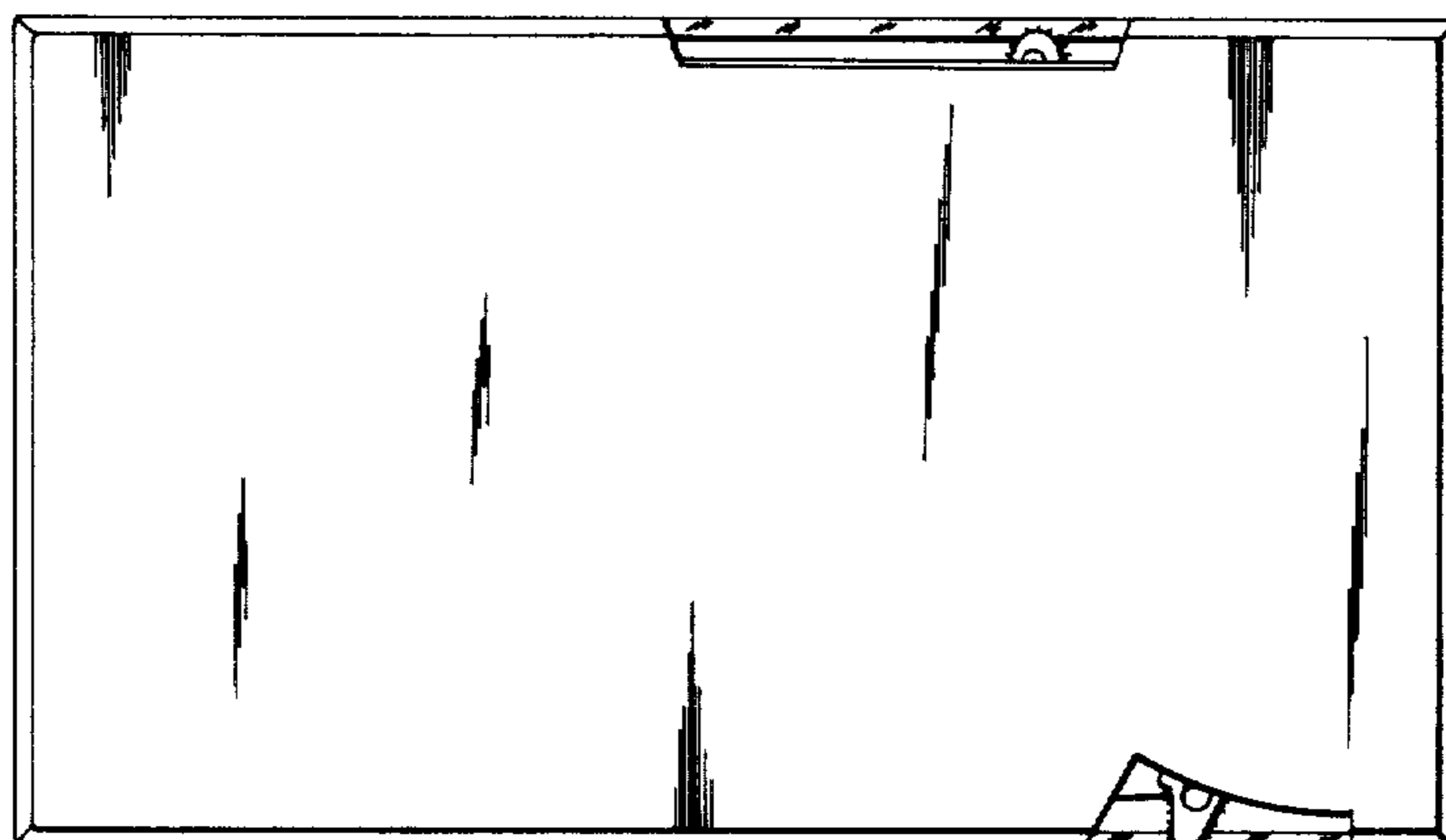

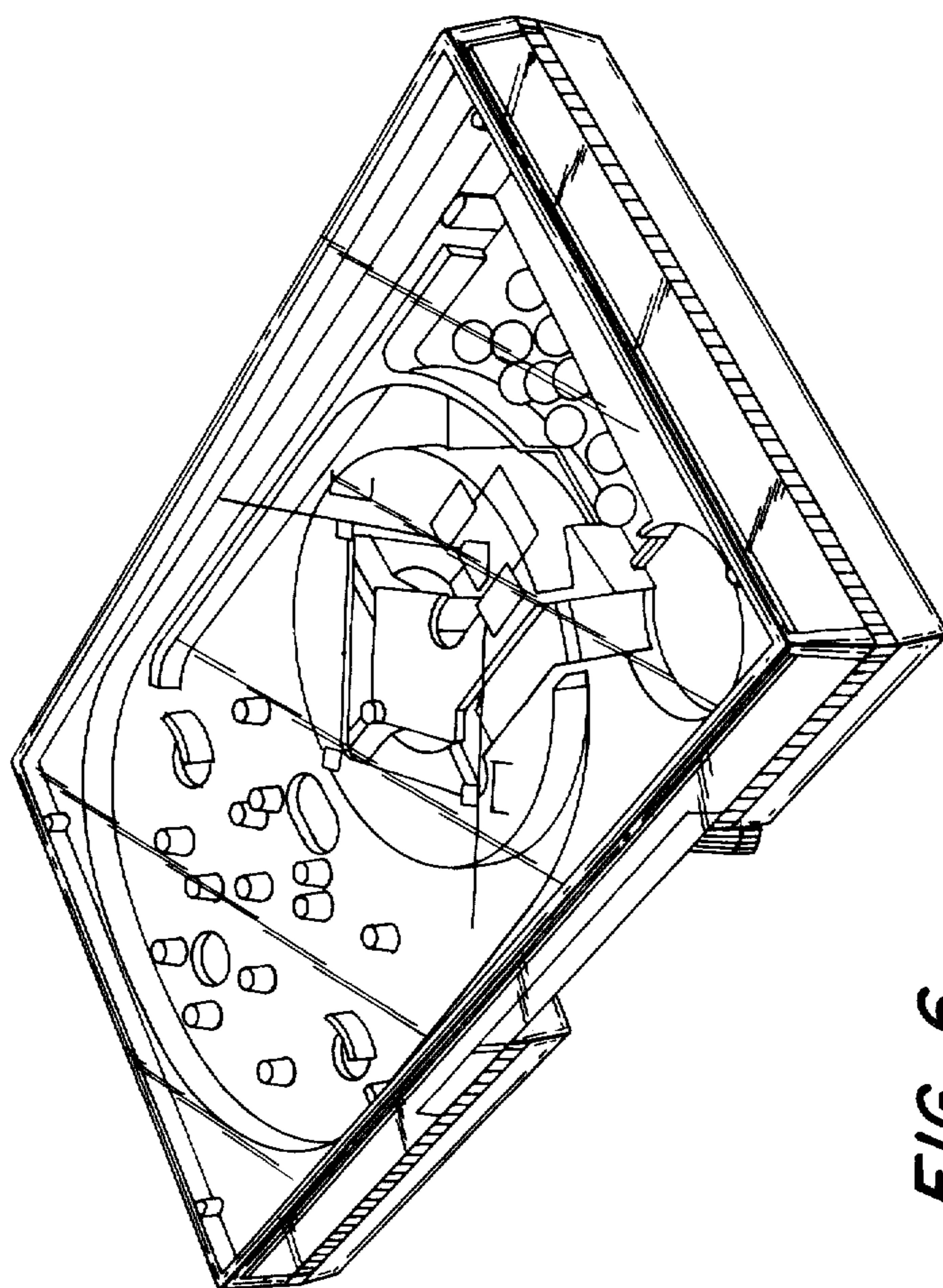
