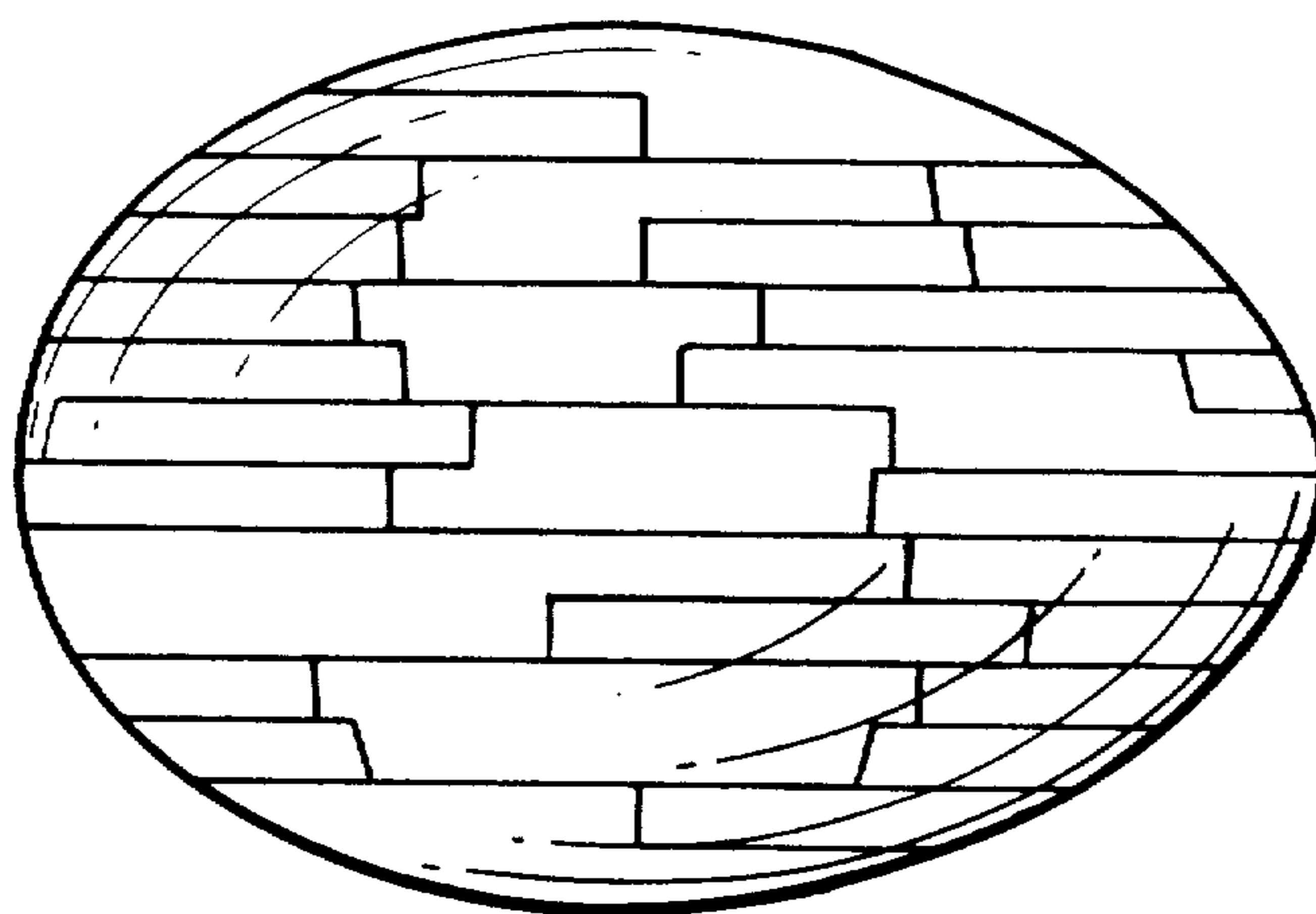

FIG. 5 is an exploded view showing the layers into which the puzzle is divided, and the central pin which locks the sections together in the form shown in FIGS. 1 - 4.

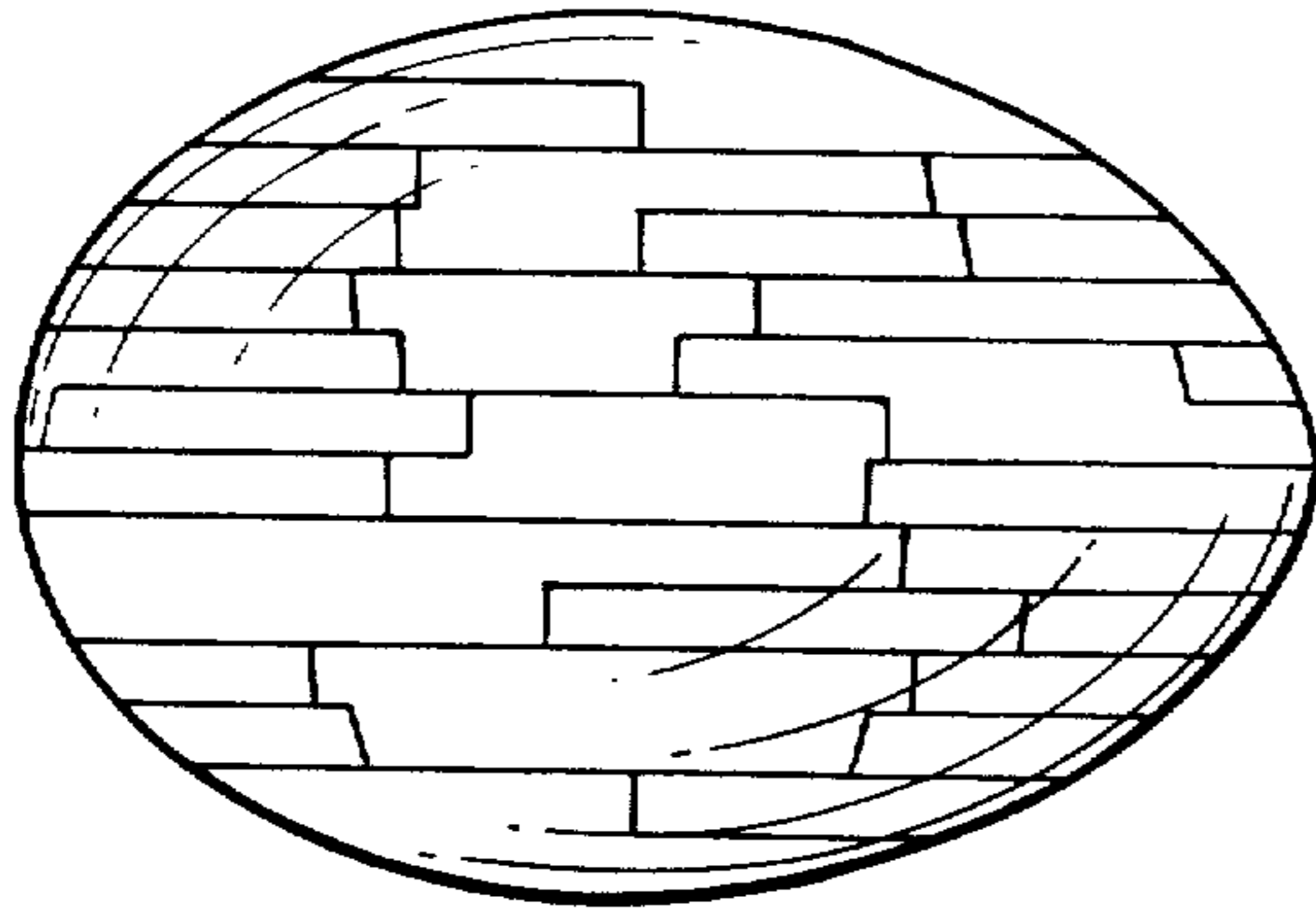

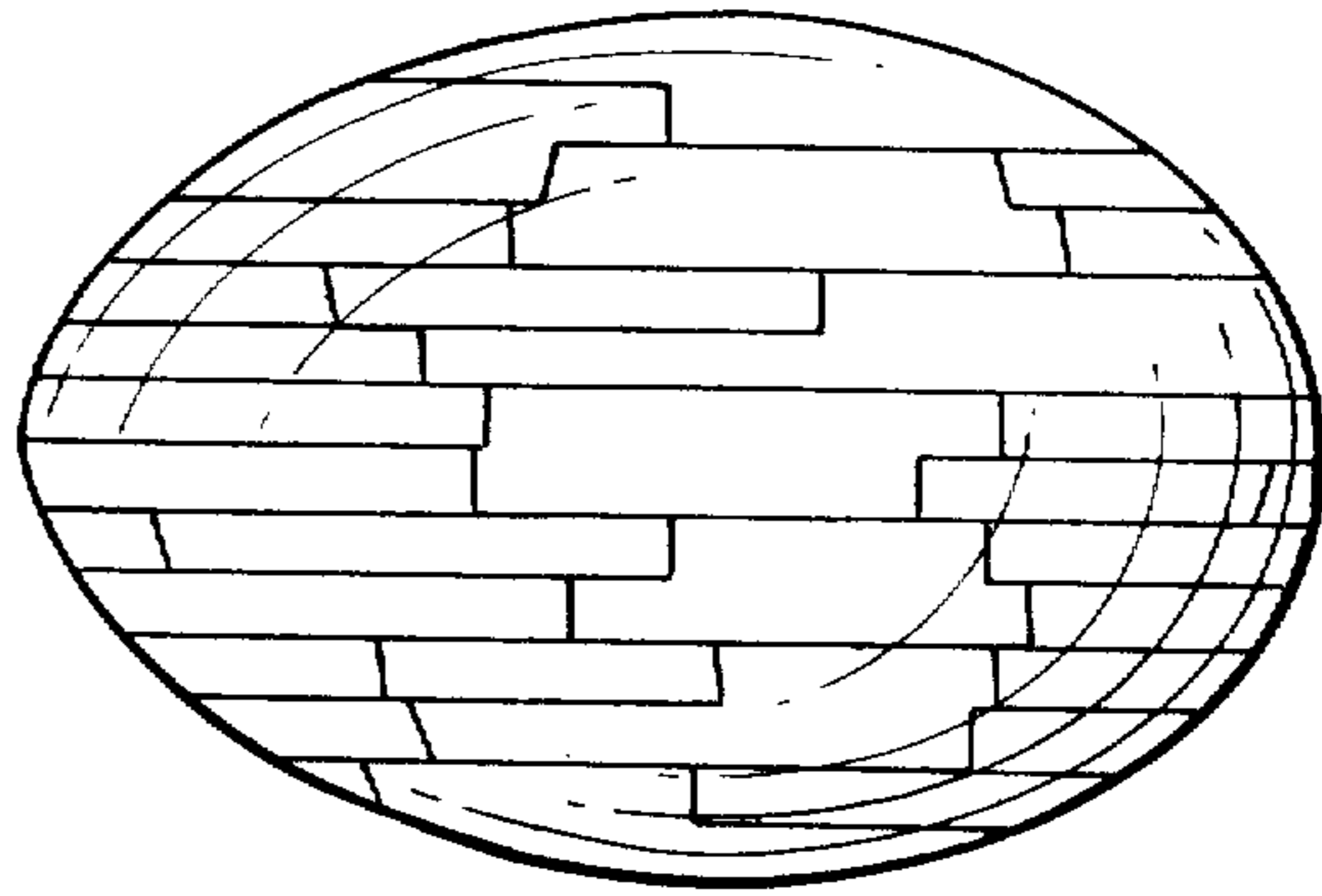

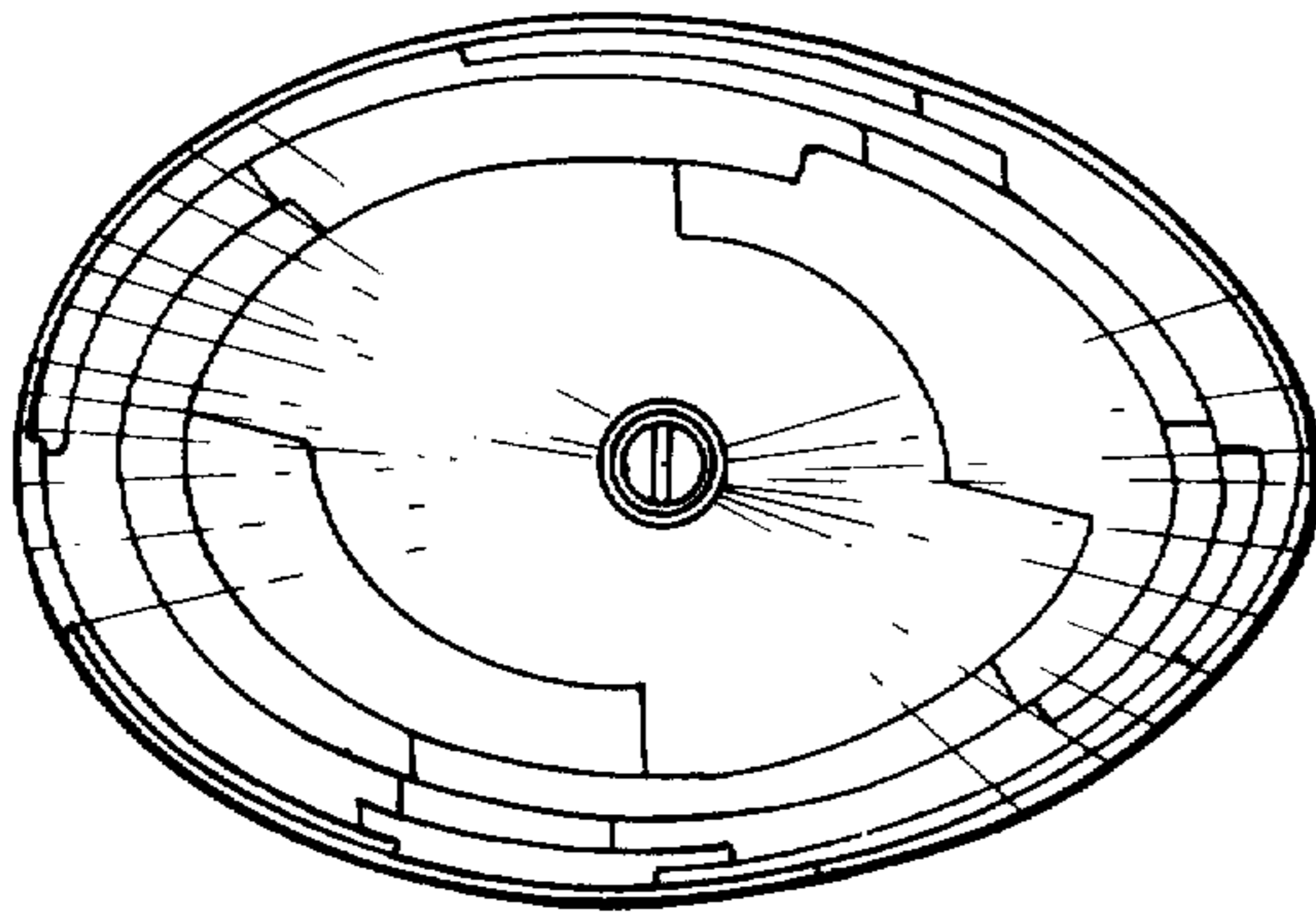

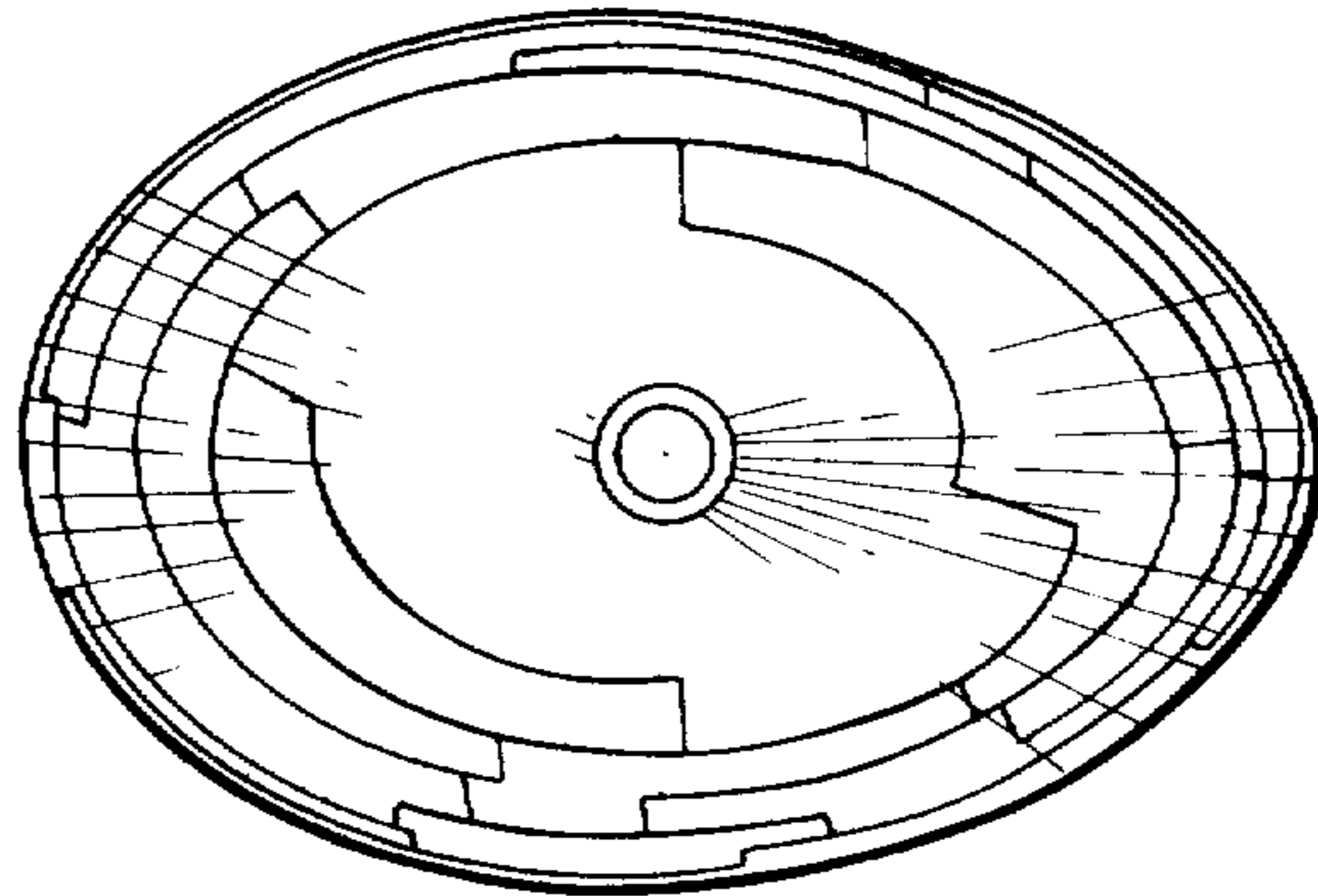
