The characteristic features of my design reside in the appearance and configuration of the bottom of the combined cup and token or the like.

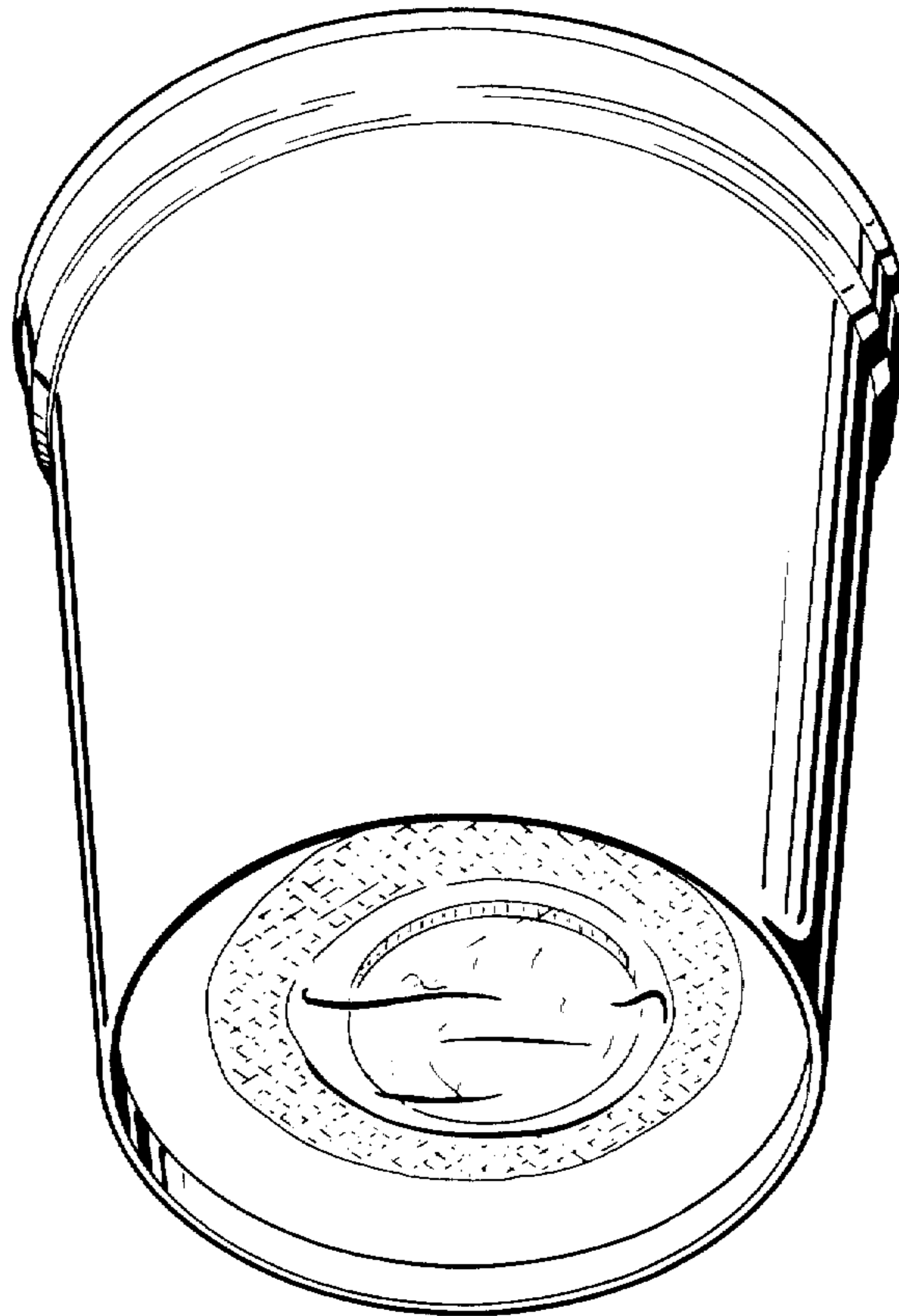

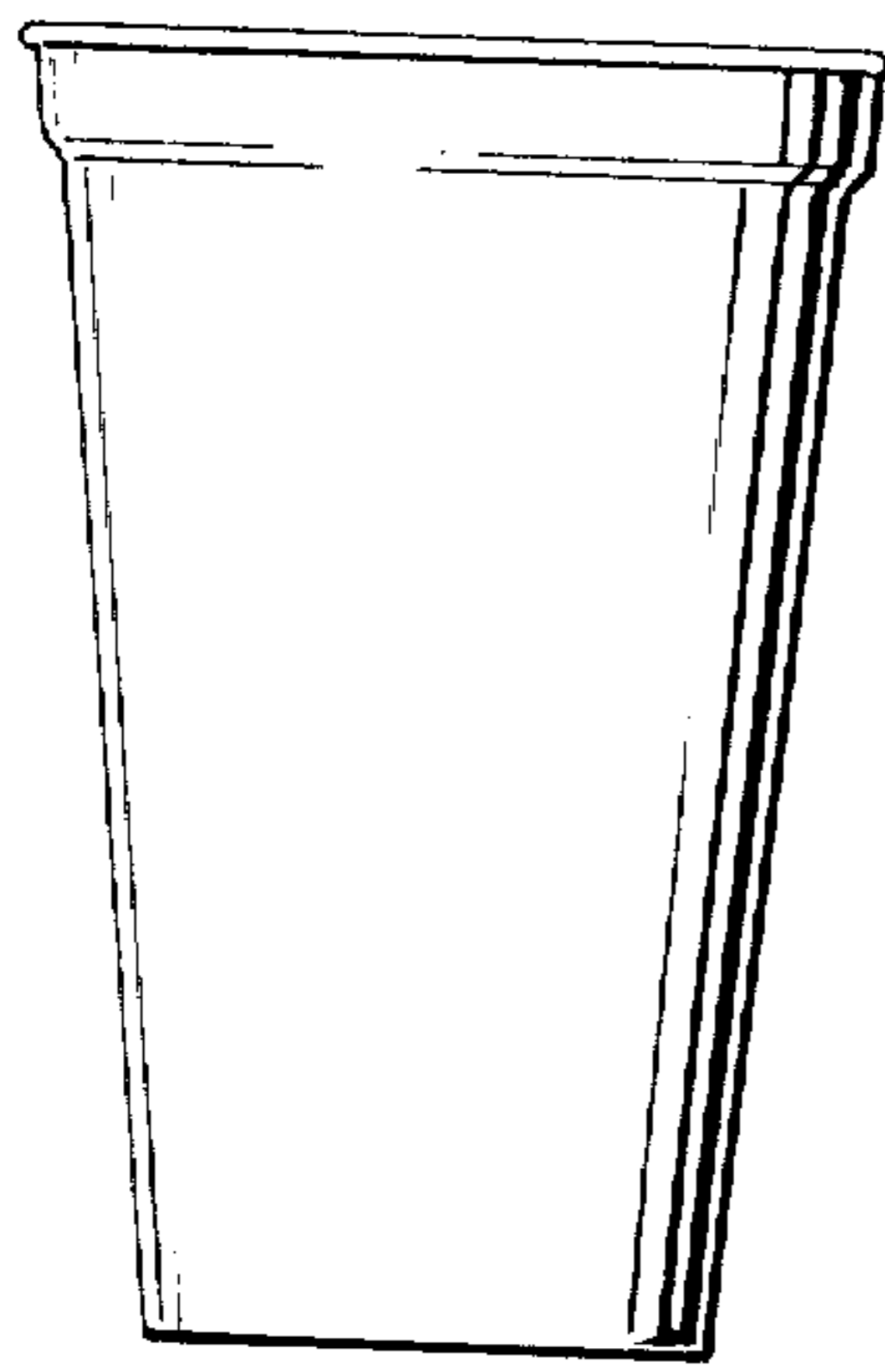
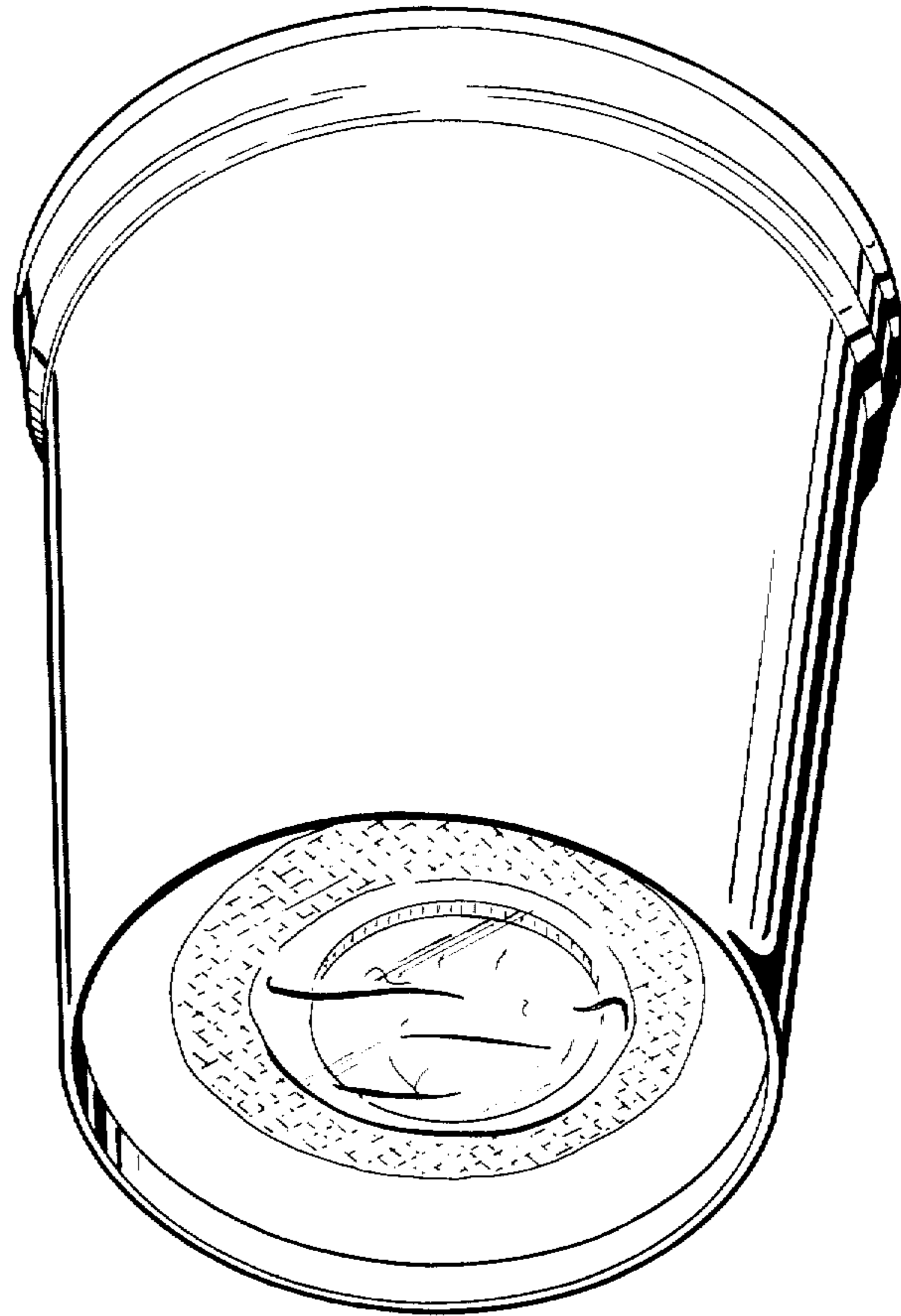

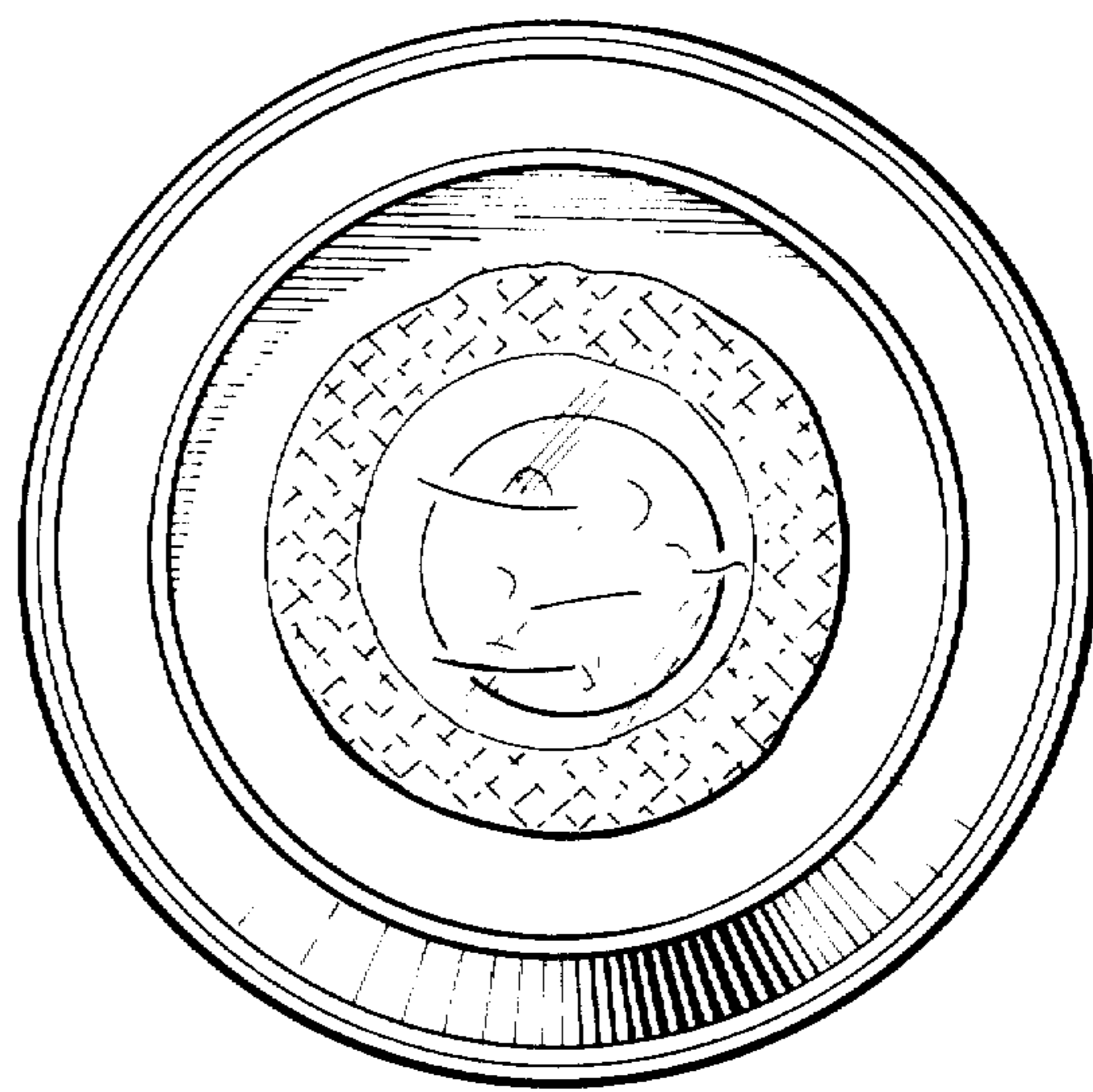
