[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a seat, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view looking from the front of a chair embodying the present design;

FIG. 2 is a perspective view of the chair of FIG. 1 looking from above and to the front of said chair;

FIG. 3 is a perspective view of said chair looking from the rear and a side thereof;

FIG. 4 is a perspective view similar to FIG. 2 of a modified chair embodying the design;

FIG. 5 is a perspective view of the chair of FIG. 4 looking from the front and a side thereof;

FIG. 6 is a perspective view looking from the rear and a side thereof;

FIG. 7 is a perspective view of a loveseat embodying the present design;

FIG. 8 is a perspective view of the loveseat of FIG. 7 looking from the front thereof;

FIG. 9 is a view similar to FIG. 8 of a three-cushion sofa embodying the present design;

FIG. 10 is a perspective view of the sofa of FIG. 9 looking from a side and the rear thereof;

FIG. 11 is a perspective view similar to FIG. 9 of a four-cushion sofa embodying the present design; and FIG. 12 is a perspective view looking from the rear and a side of the sofa of FIG. 11.
