The ornamental design for a container for food or the like, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an end elevational view of a container for food or the like showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is an end elevational view showing the end opposite that seen in FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view;
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view;
FIG. 6 is a side elevational view showing the side opposite that seen in FIG. 4;
FIG. 7 is an enlarged cross sectional view taken along line B—B in FIG. 4;
FIG. 8 is an enlarged cross sectional view taken along line A—A in FIG. 5;
FIG. 9 is an enlarged cross sectional view taken along line C—C in FIG. 5;
FIG. 10 is an enlarged cross sectional view taken along line D—D in FIG. 6;
FIG. 11 is a top plan view with the sealing cap removed; and
FIG. 12 is a top plan view with the sealing cap and inner container removed.

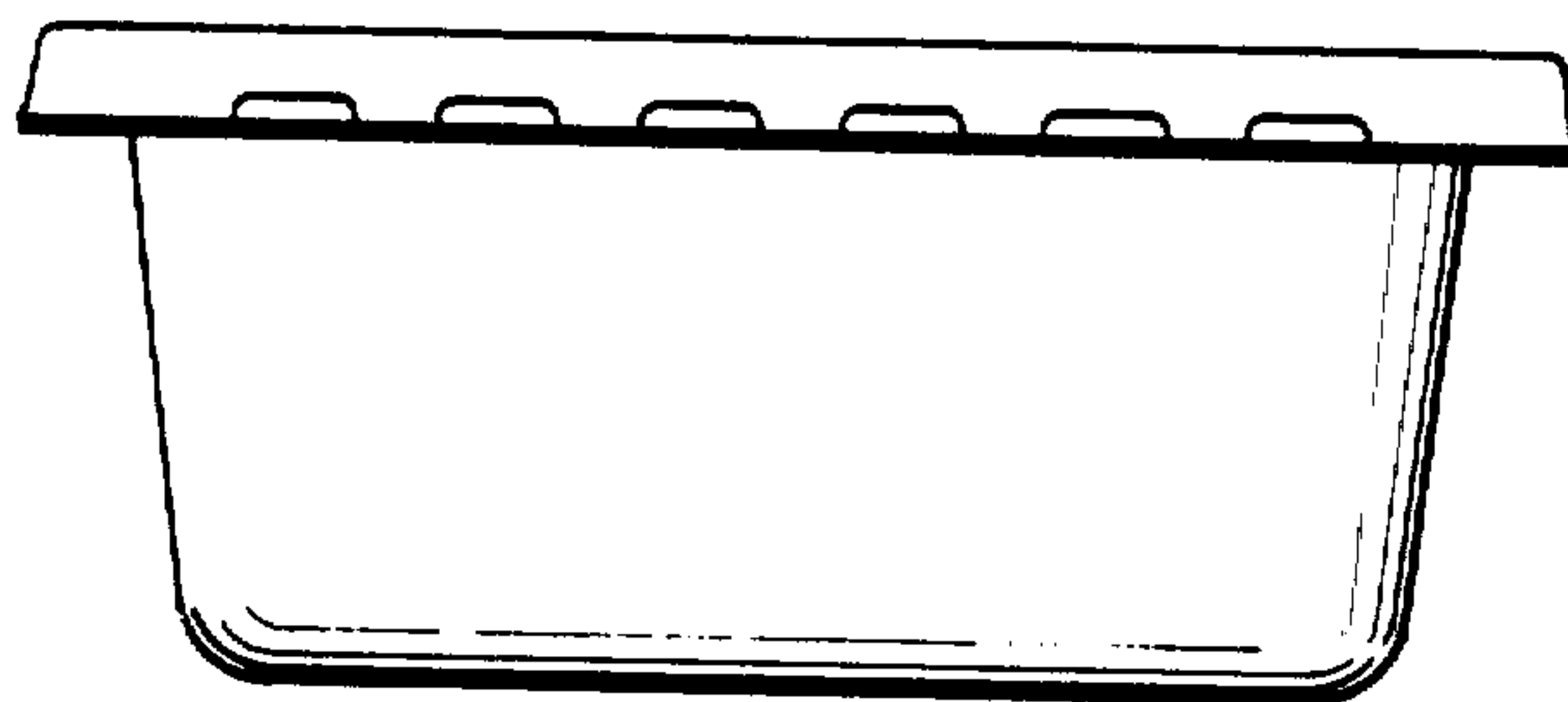

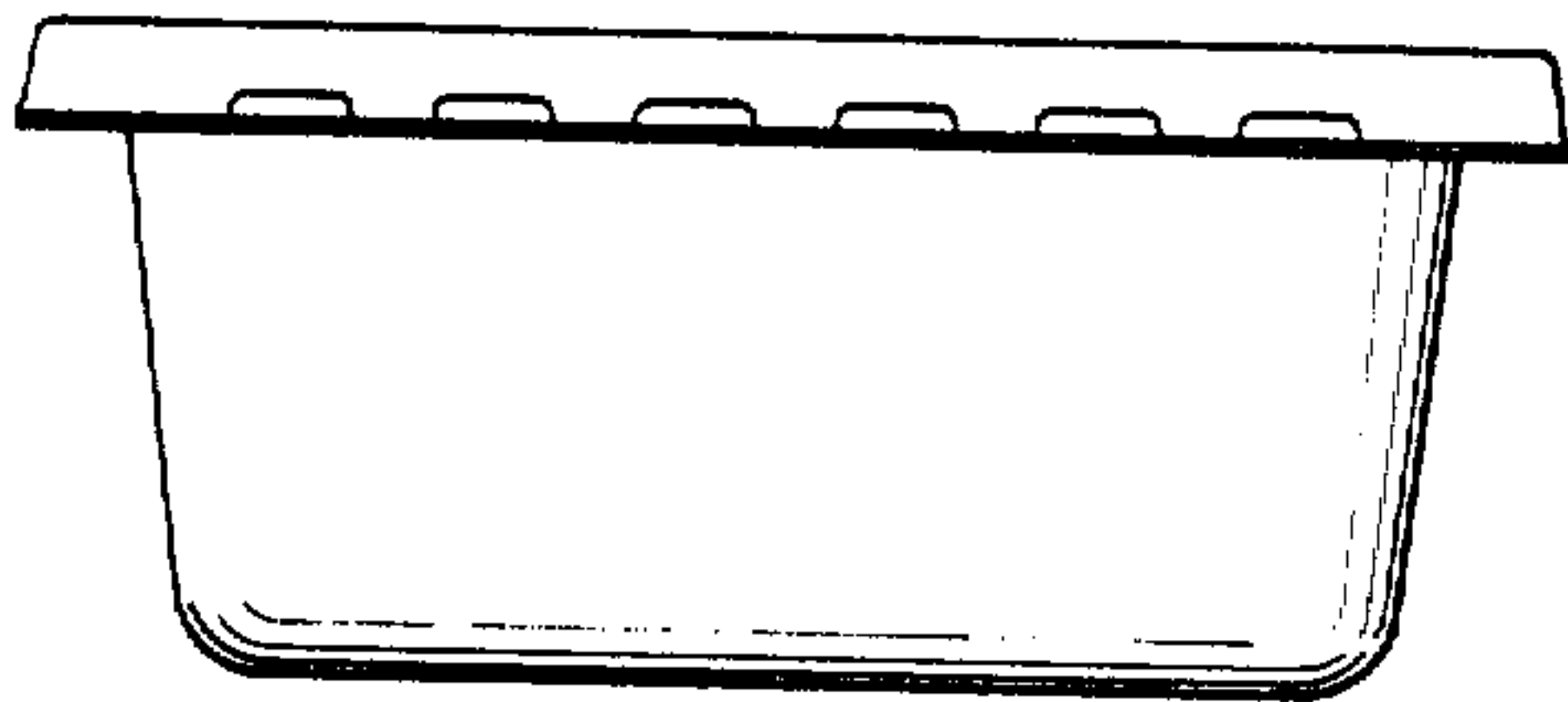

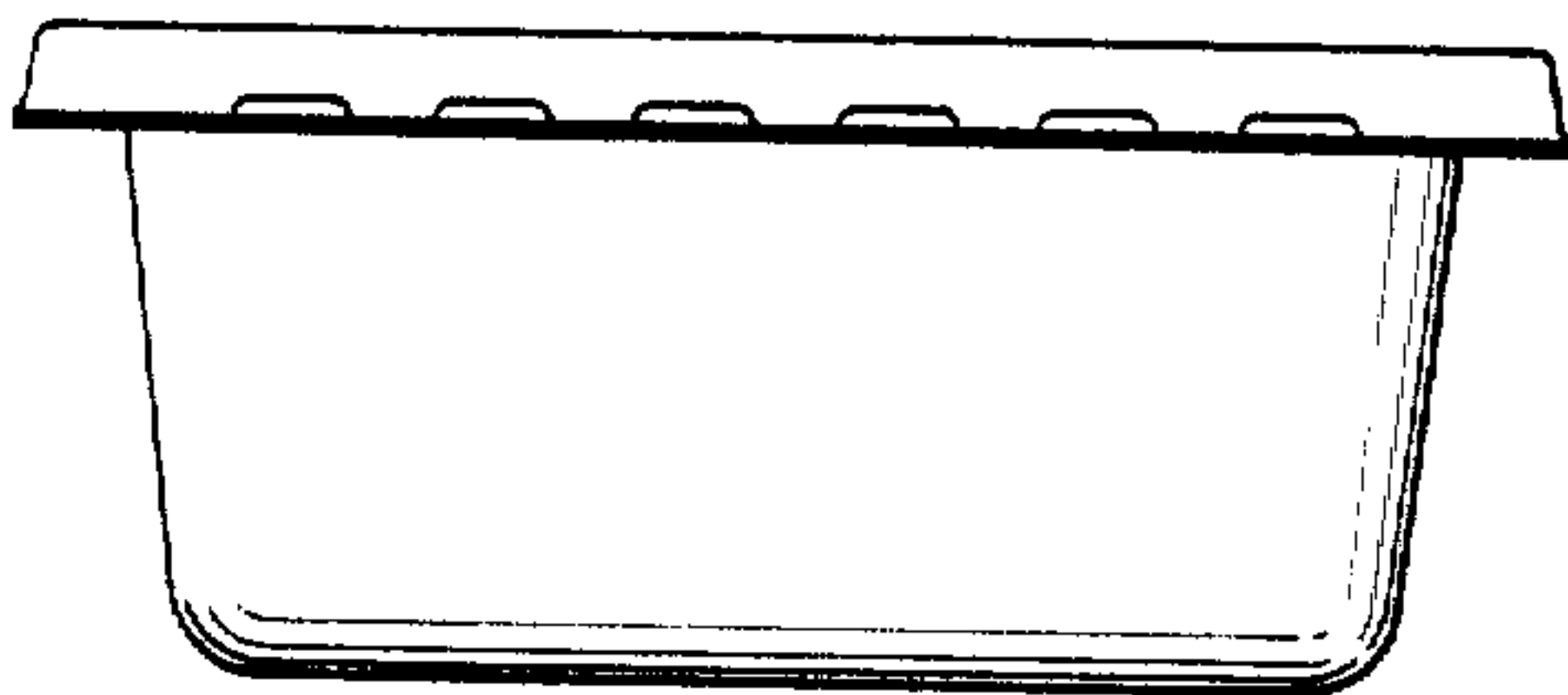

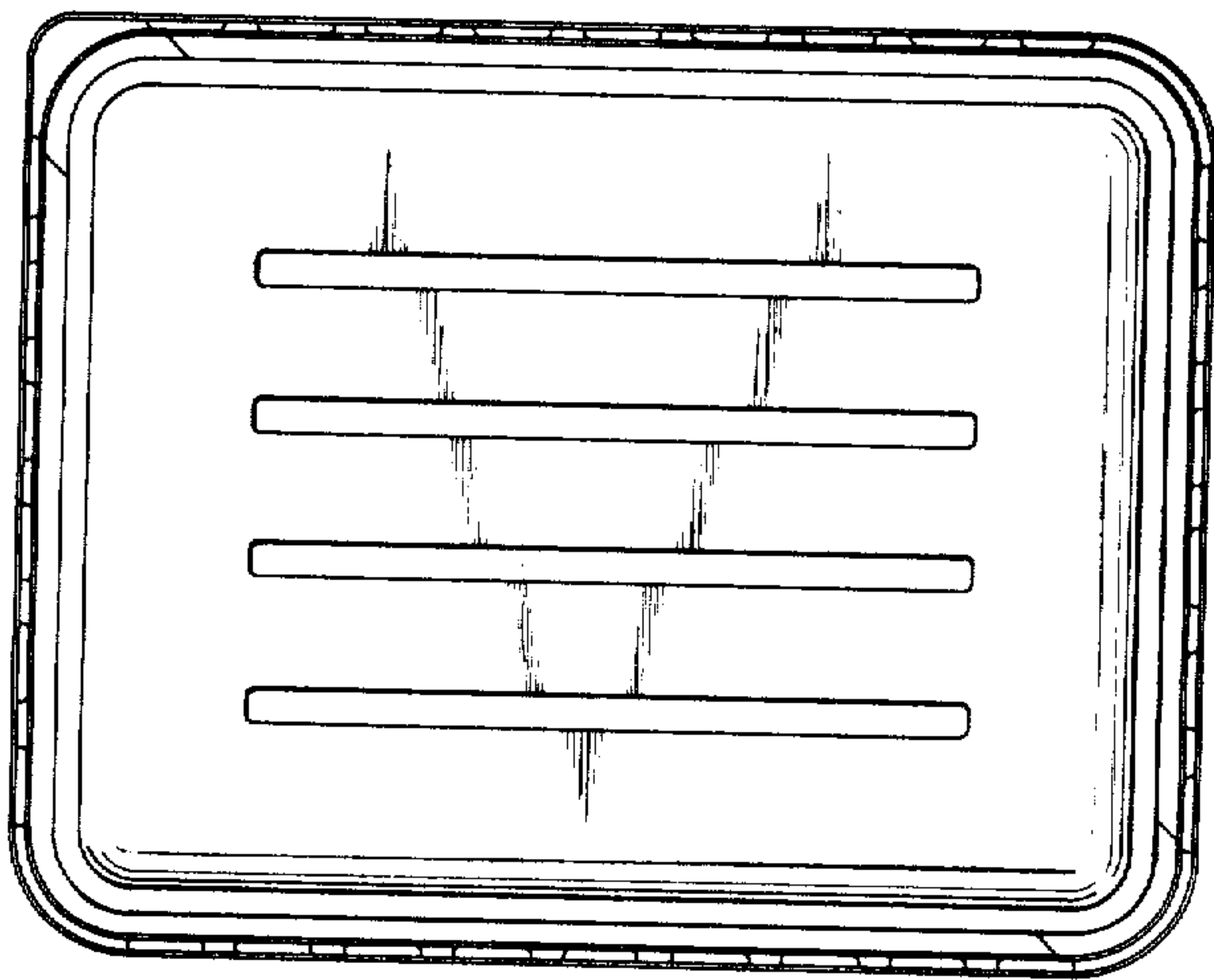

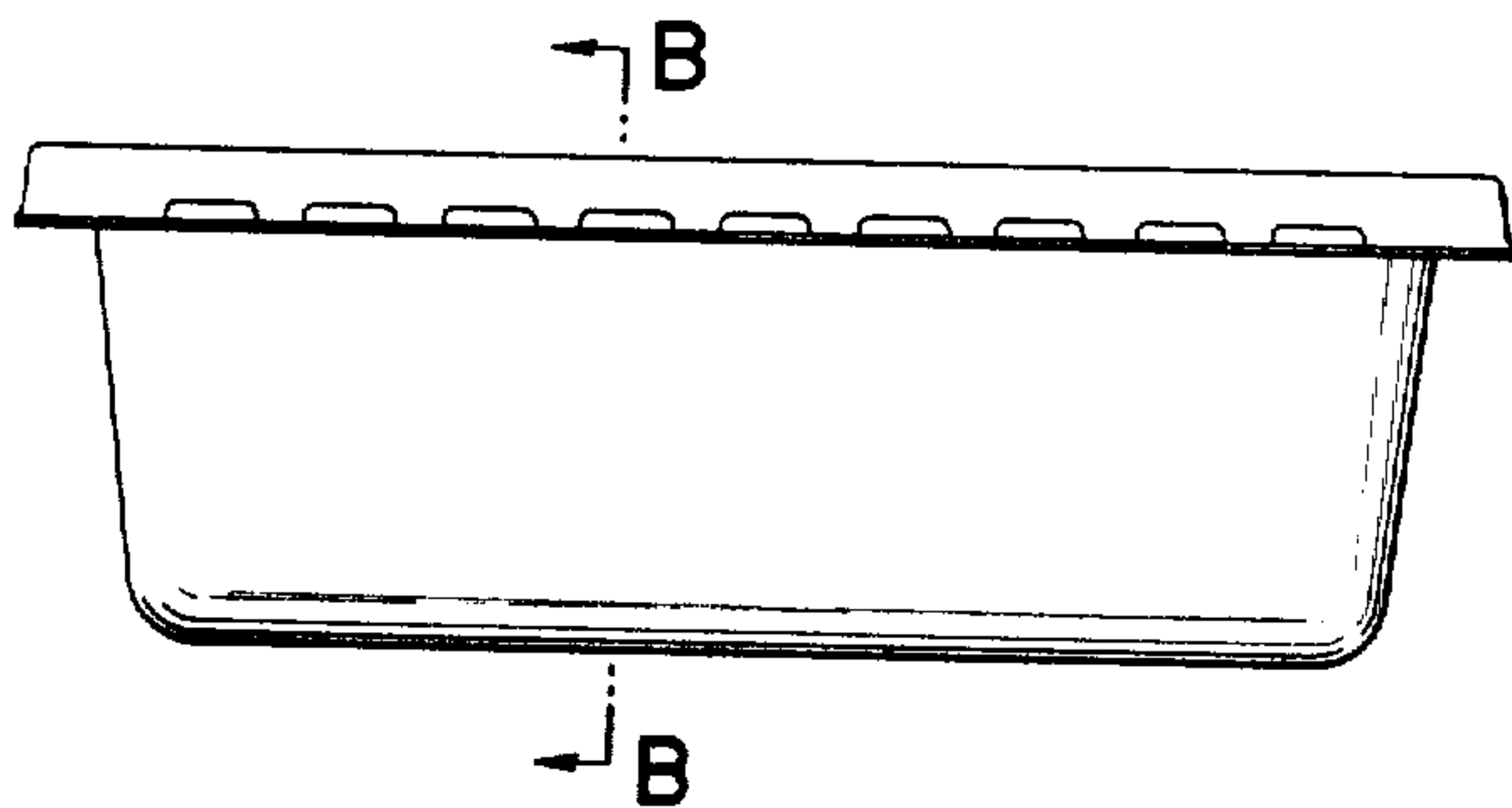

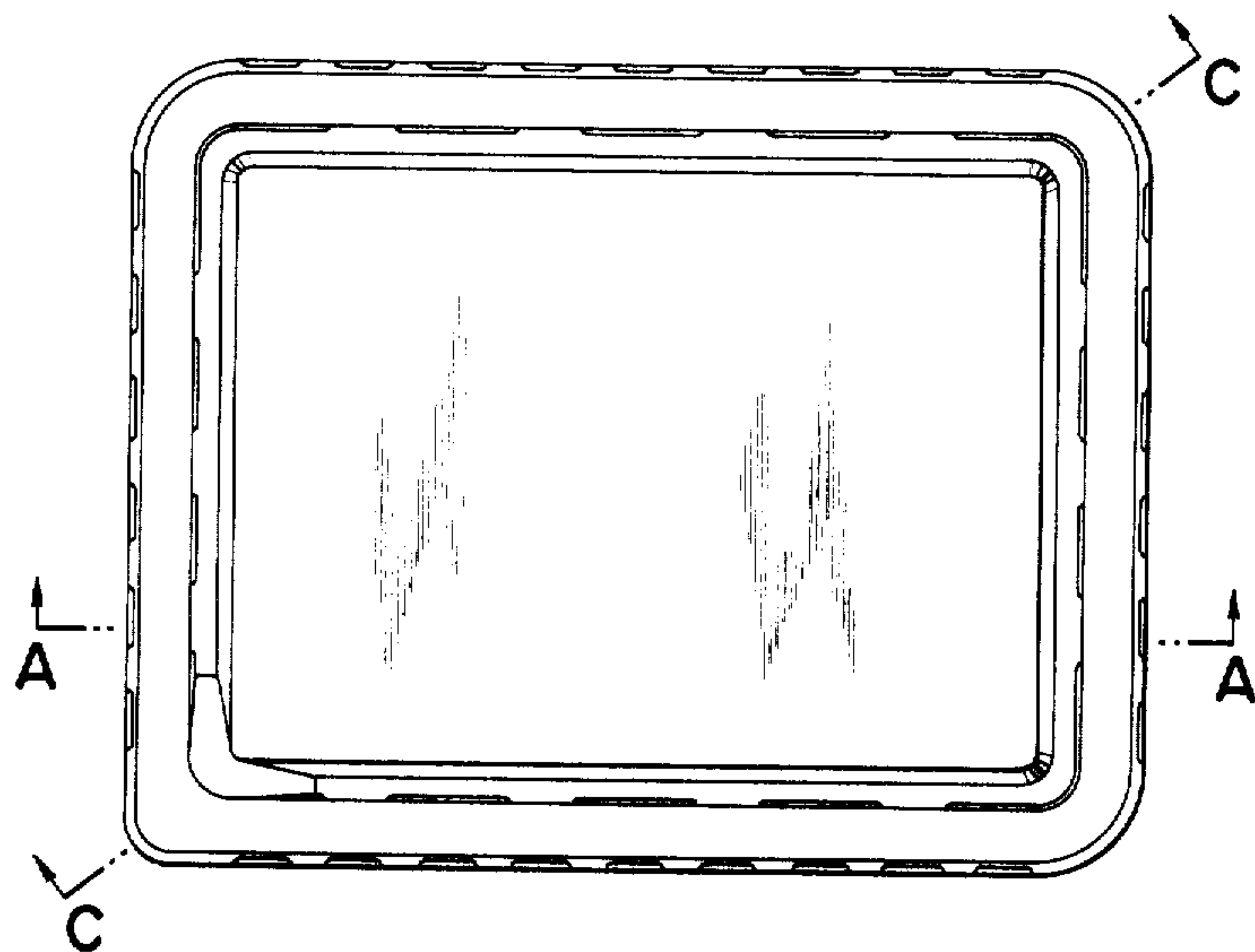

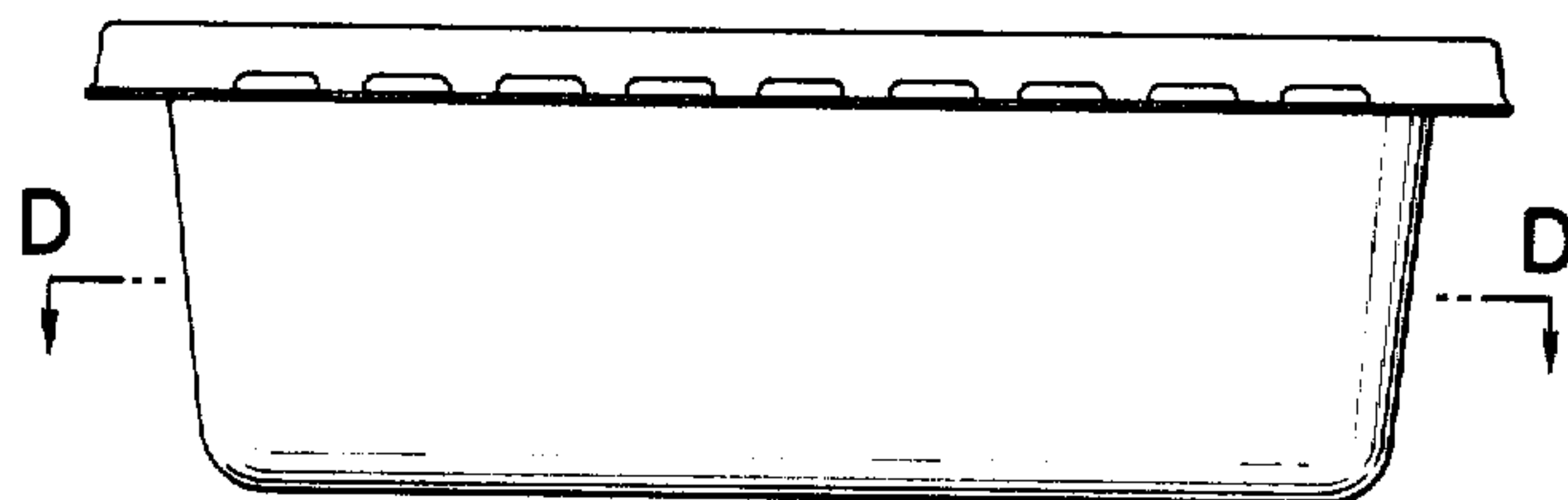

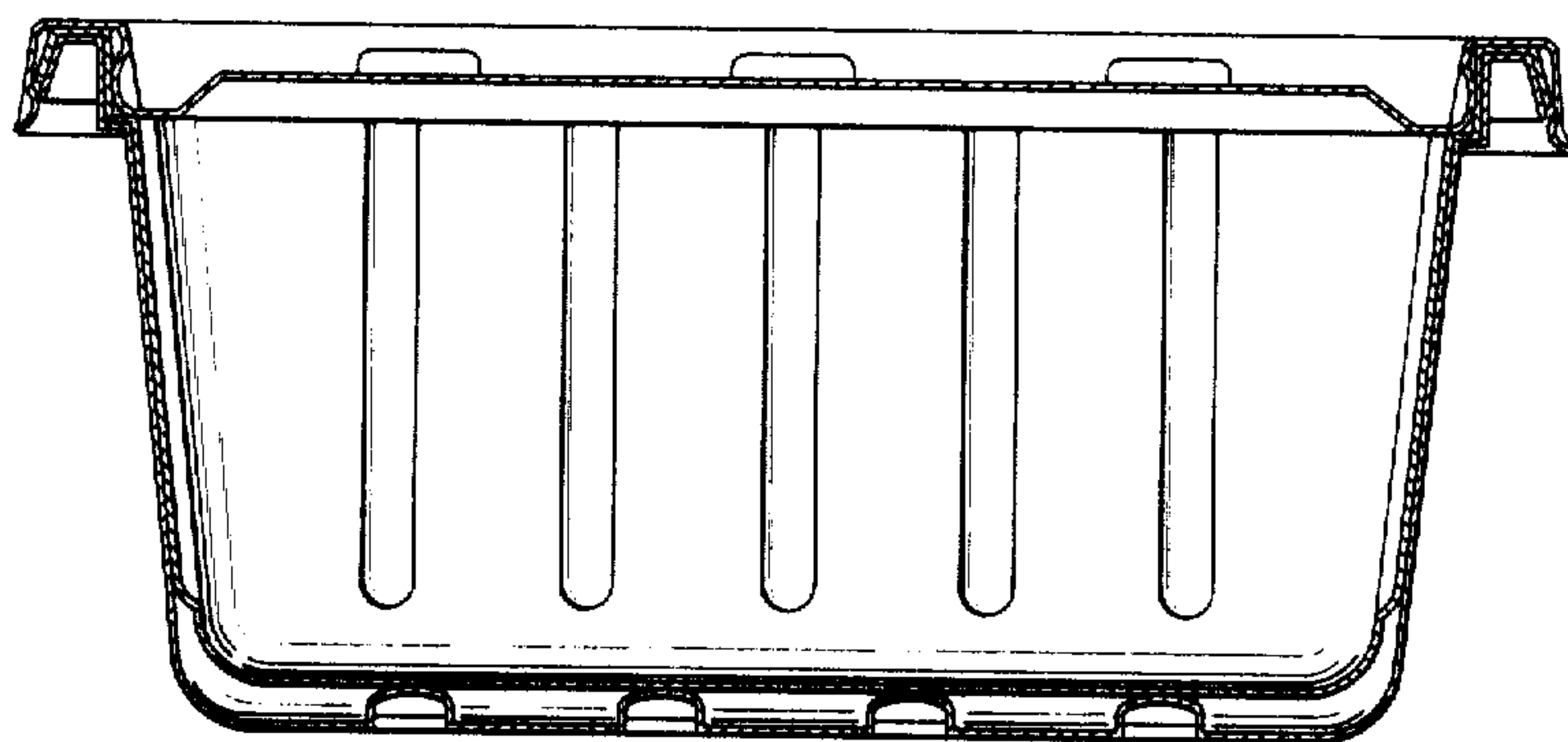

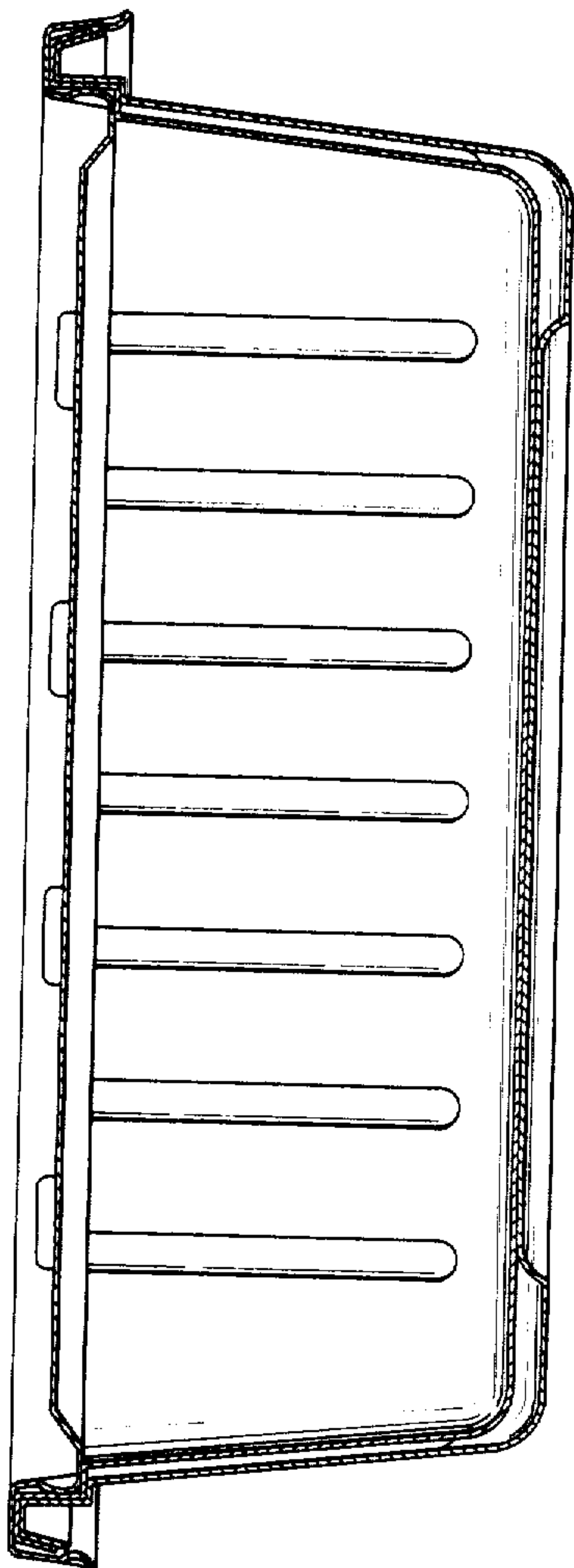

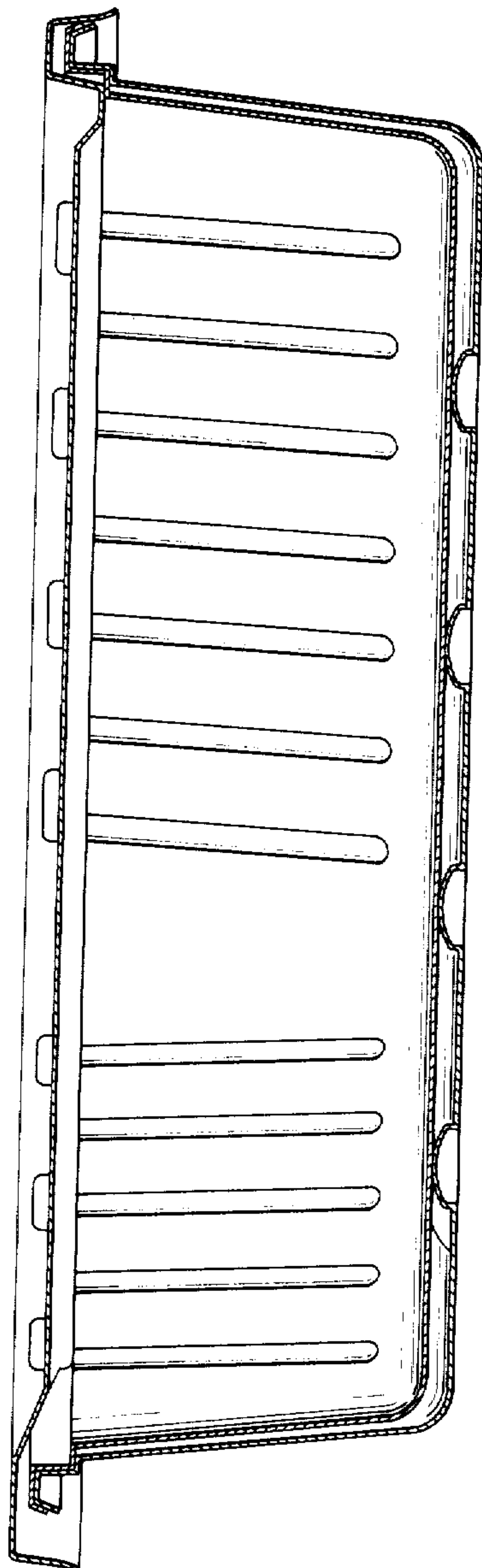

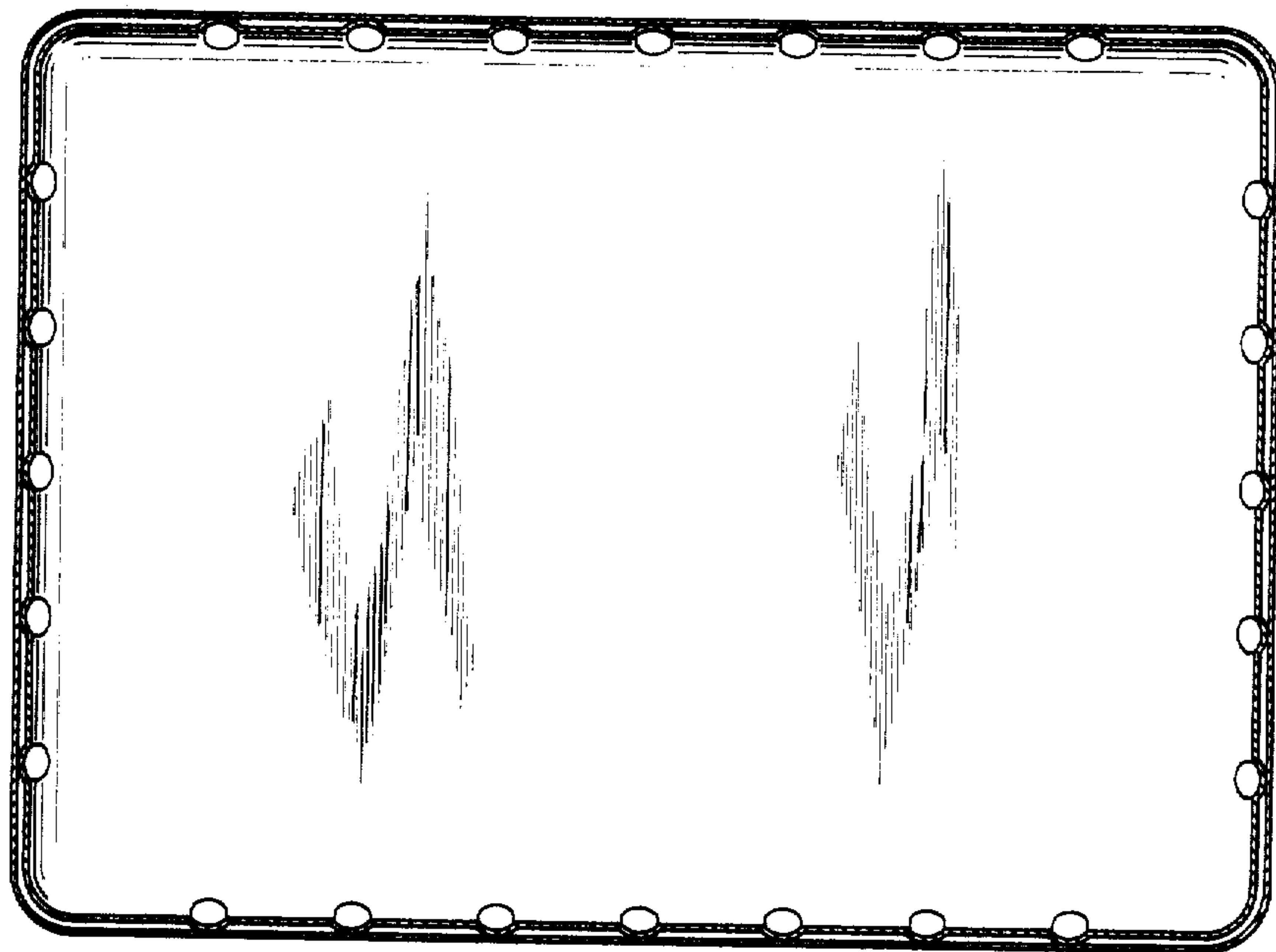

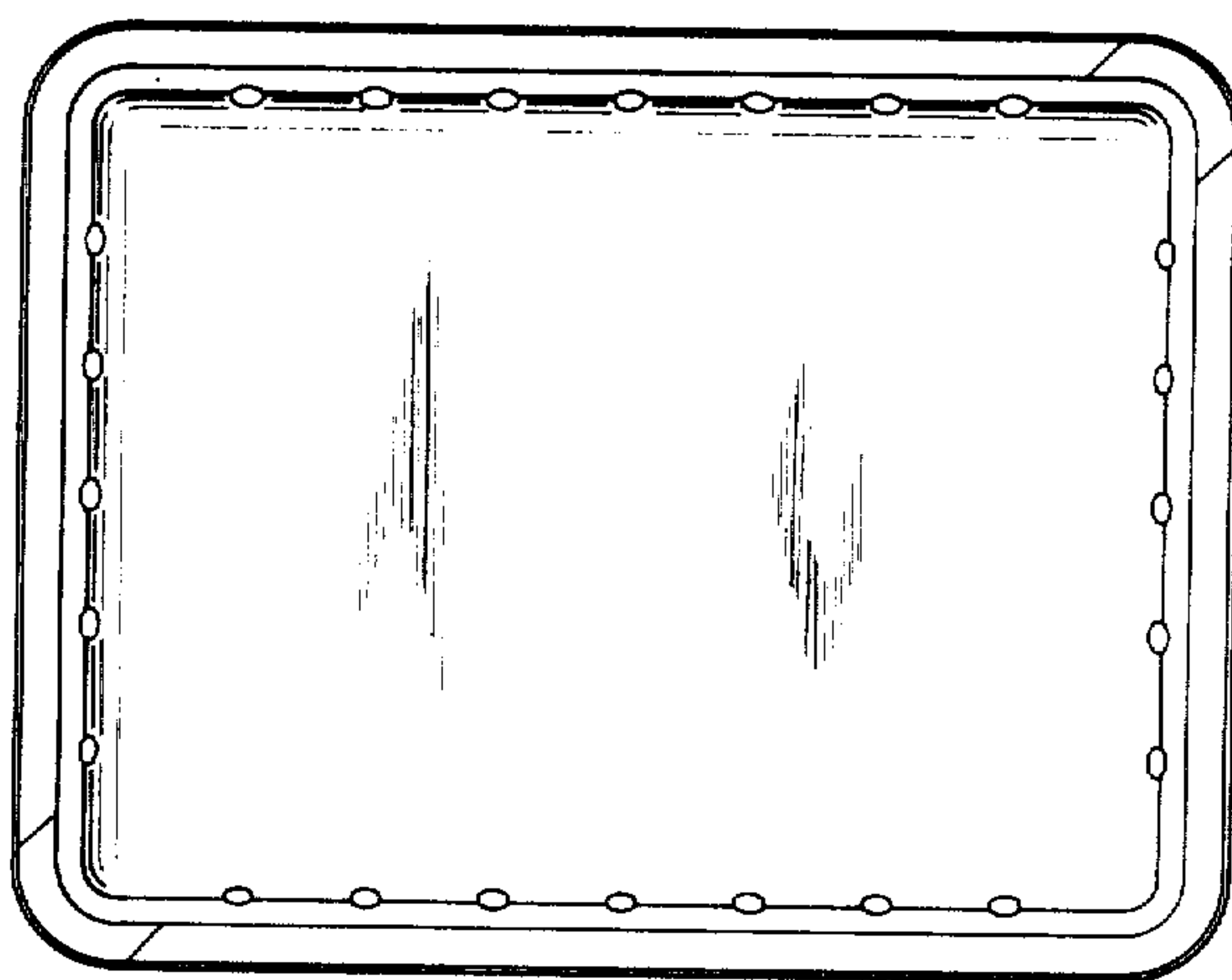
