same with a plain base.



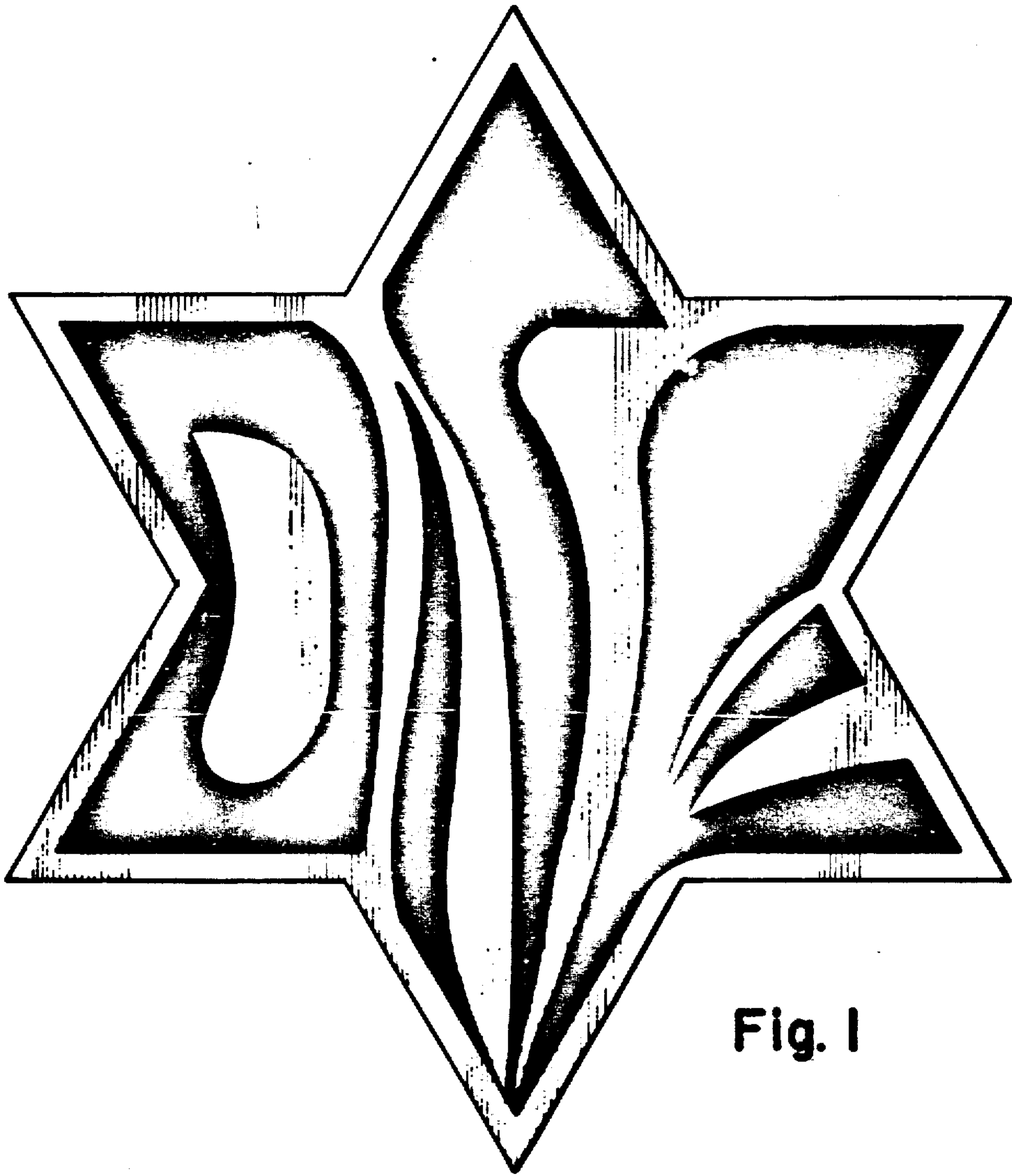
