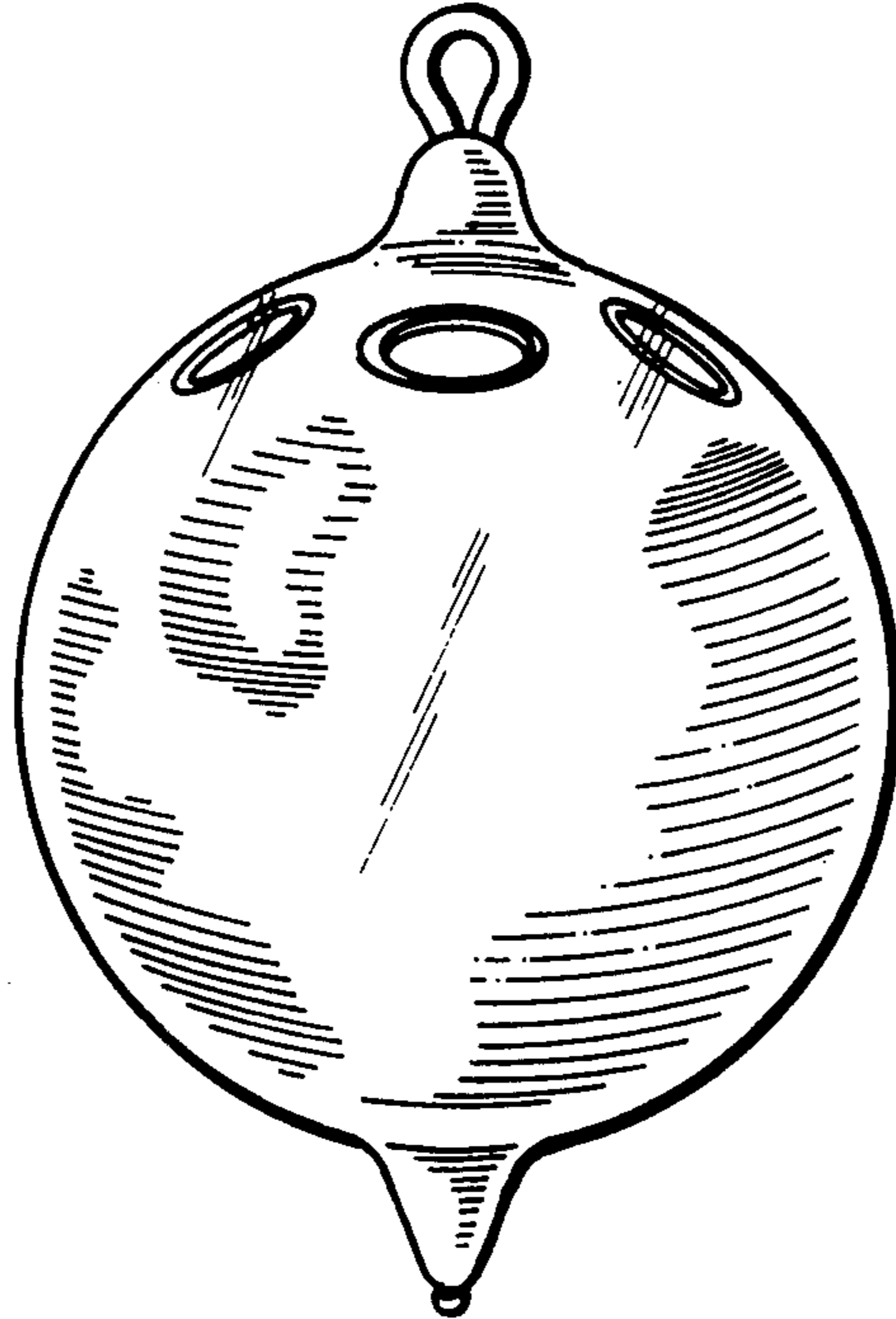

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a hanging container for rooting plants, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a hanging container for rooting plants showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



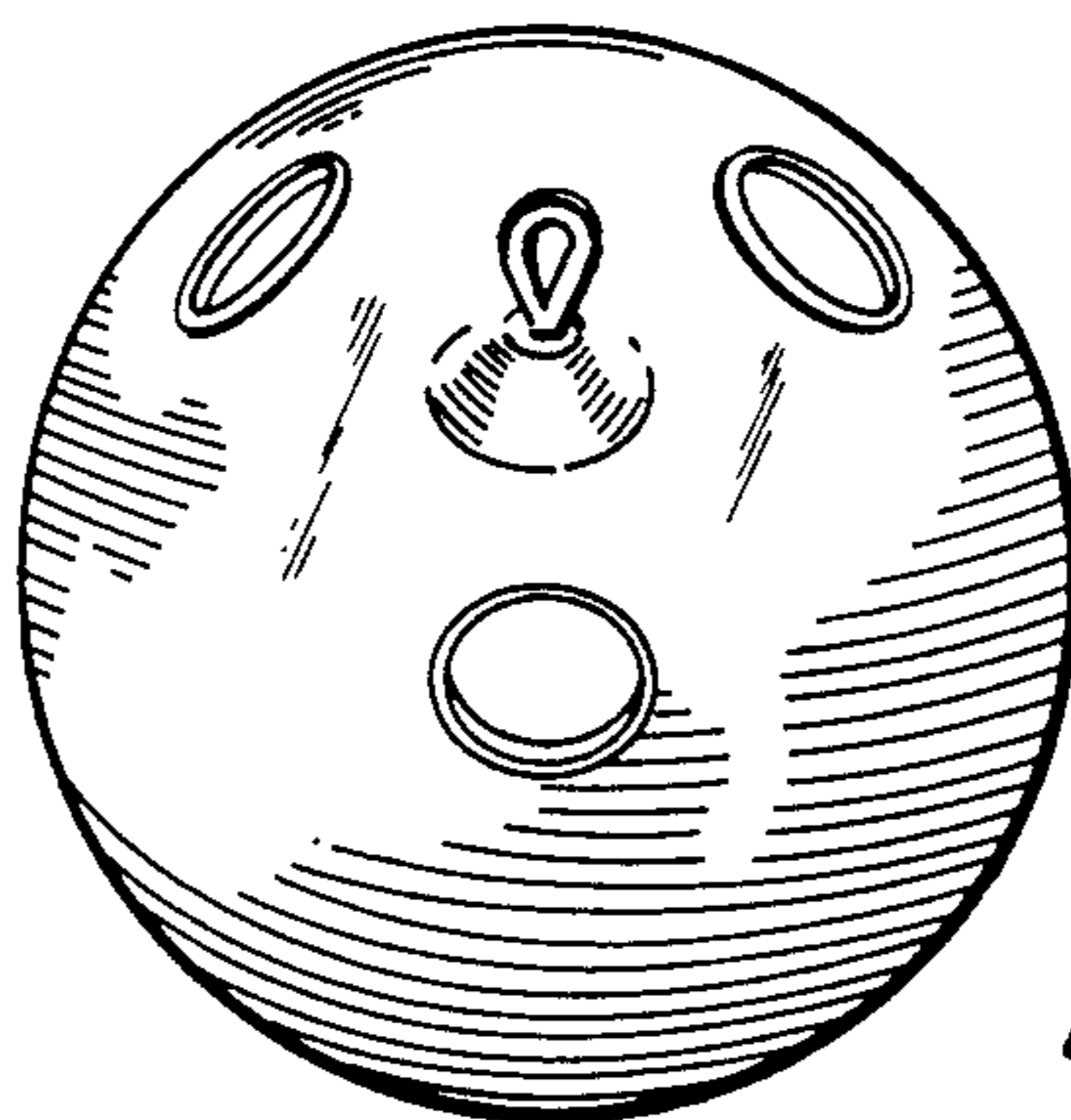

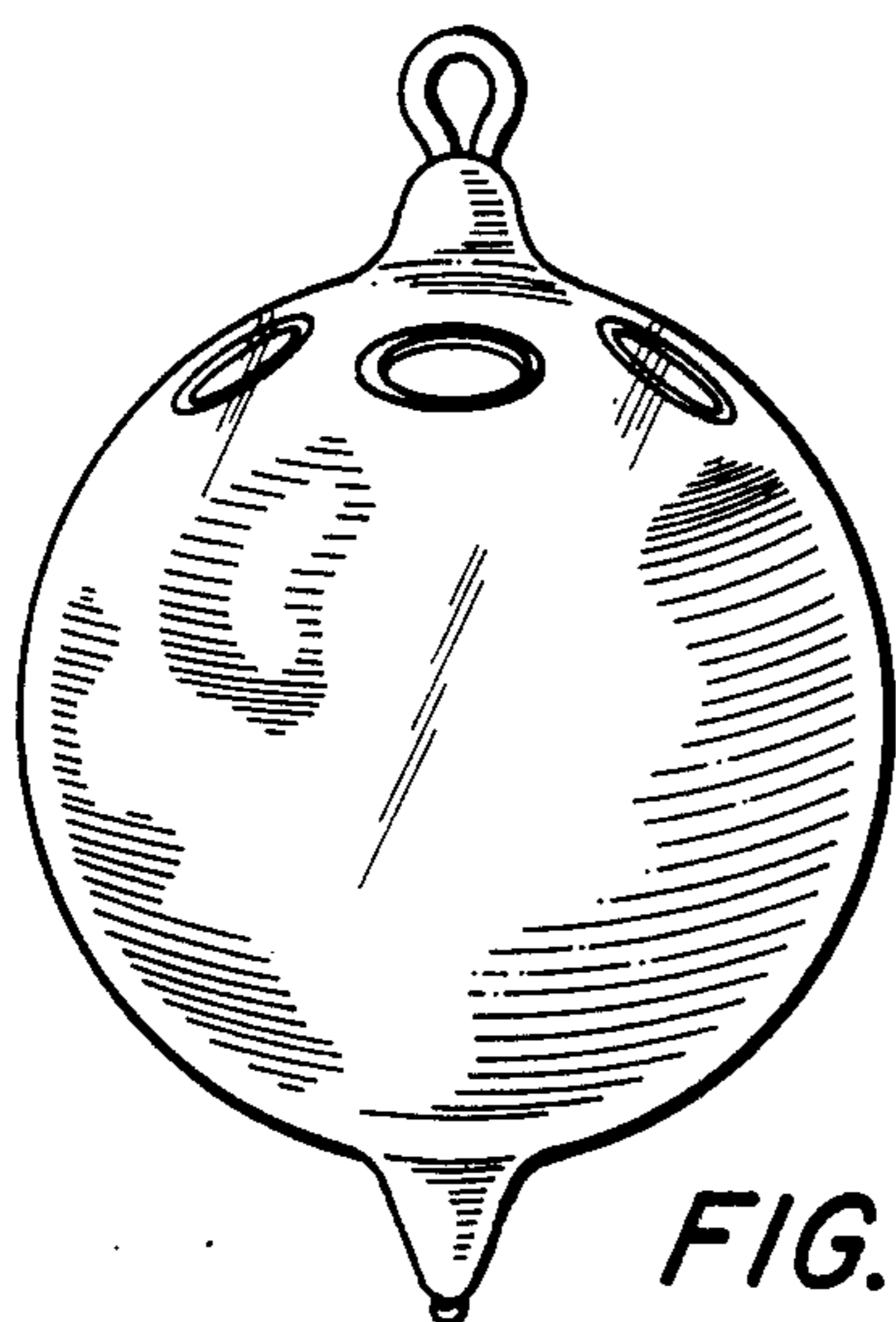

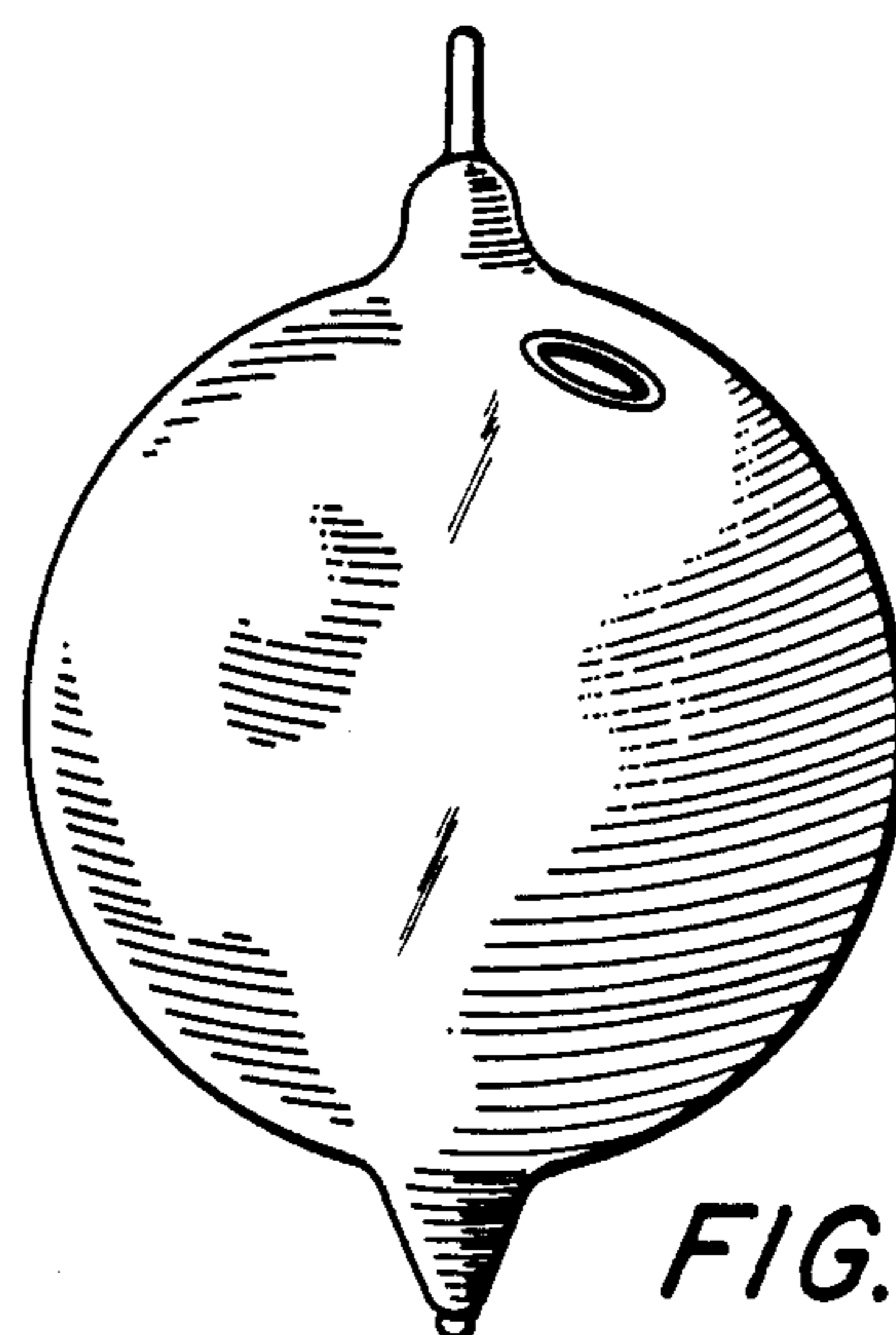

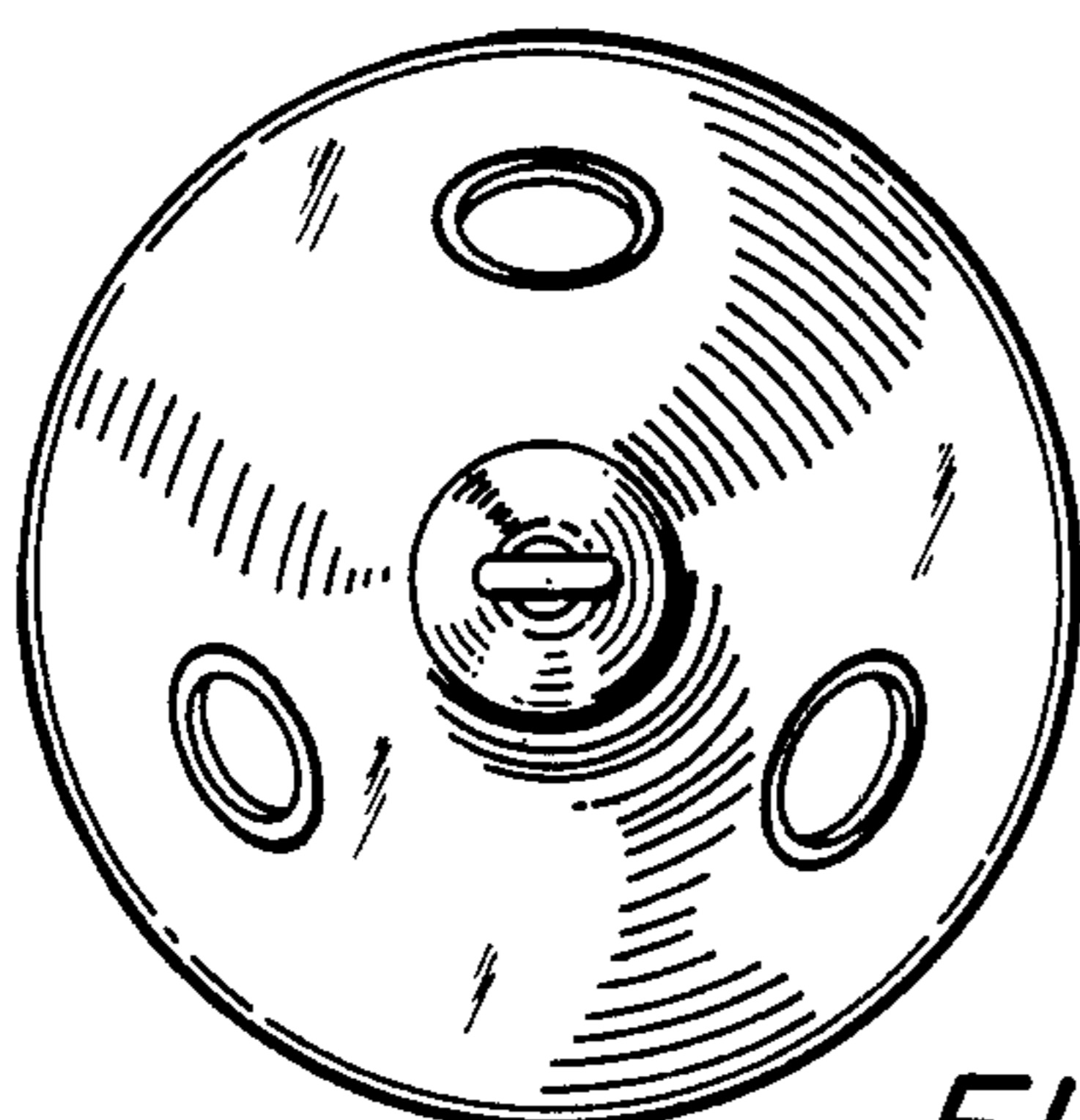

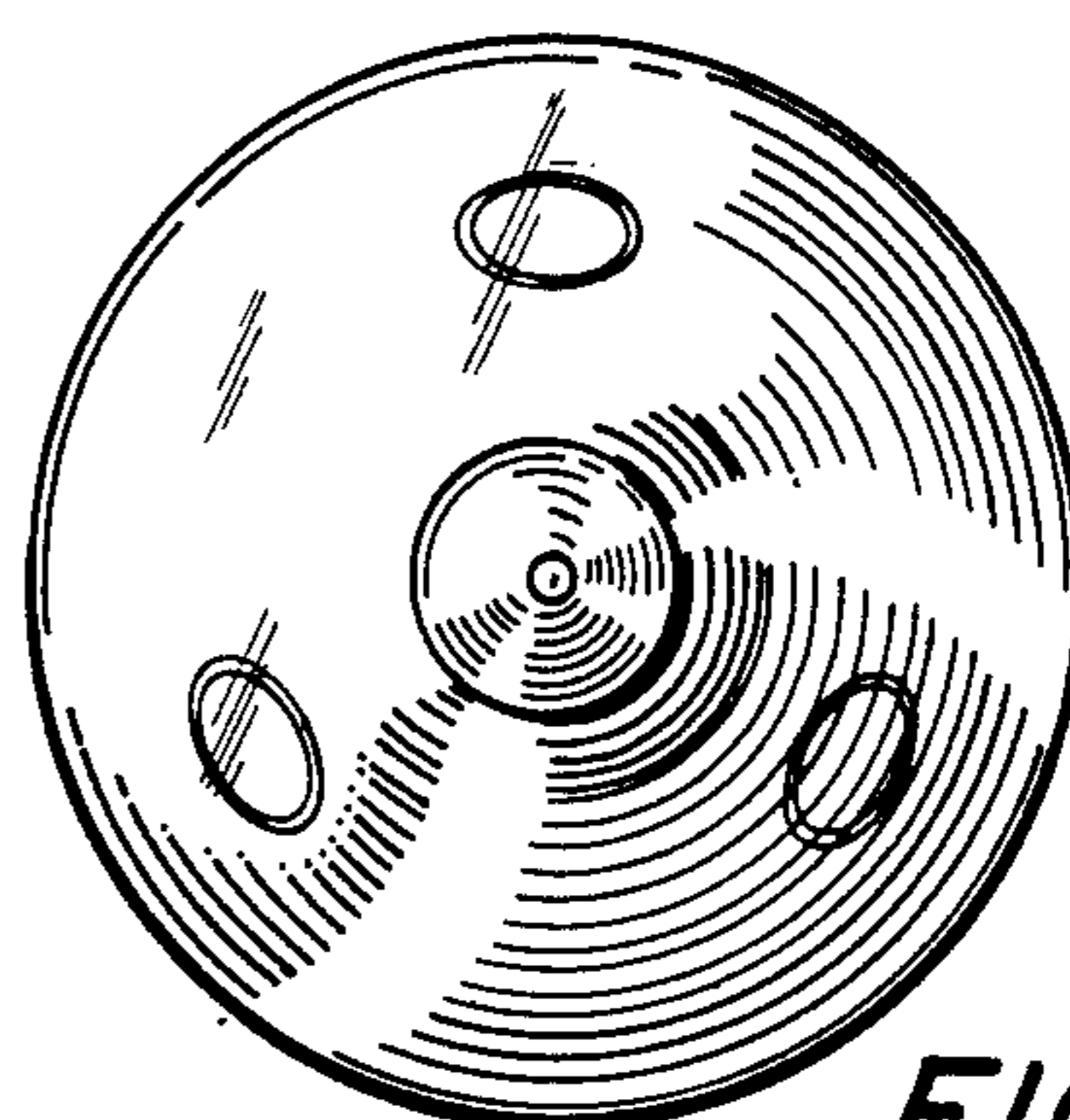
