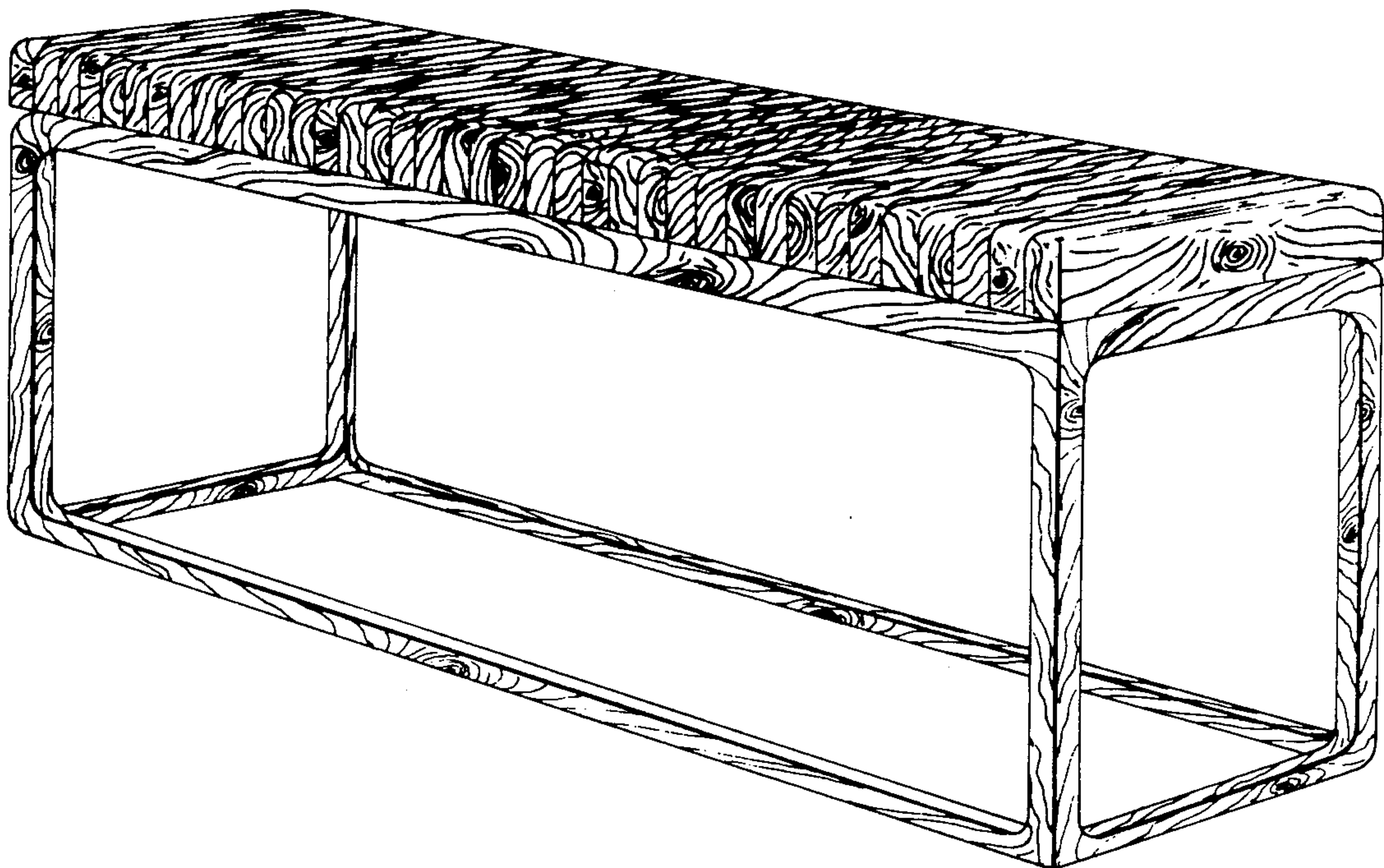

FIG. 3 is a view in side elevation taken from the left in FIG. 1.



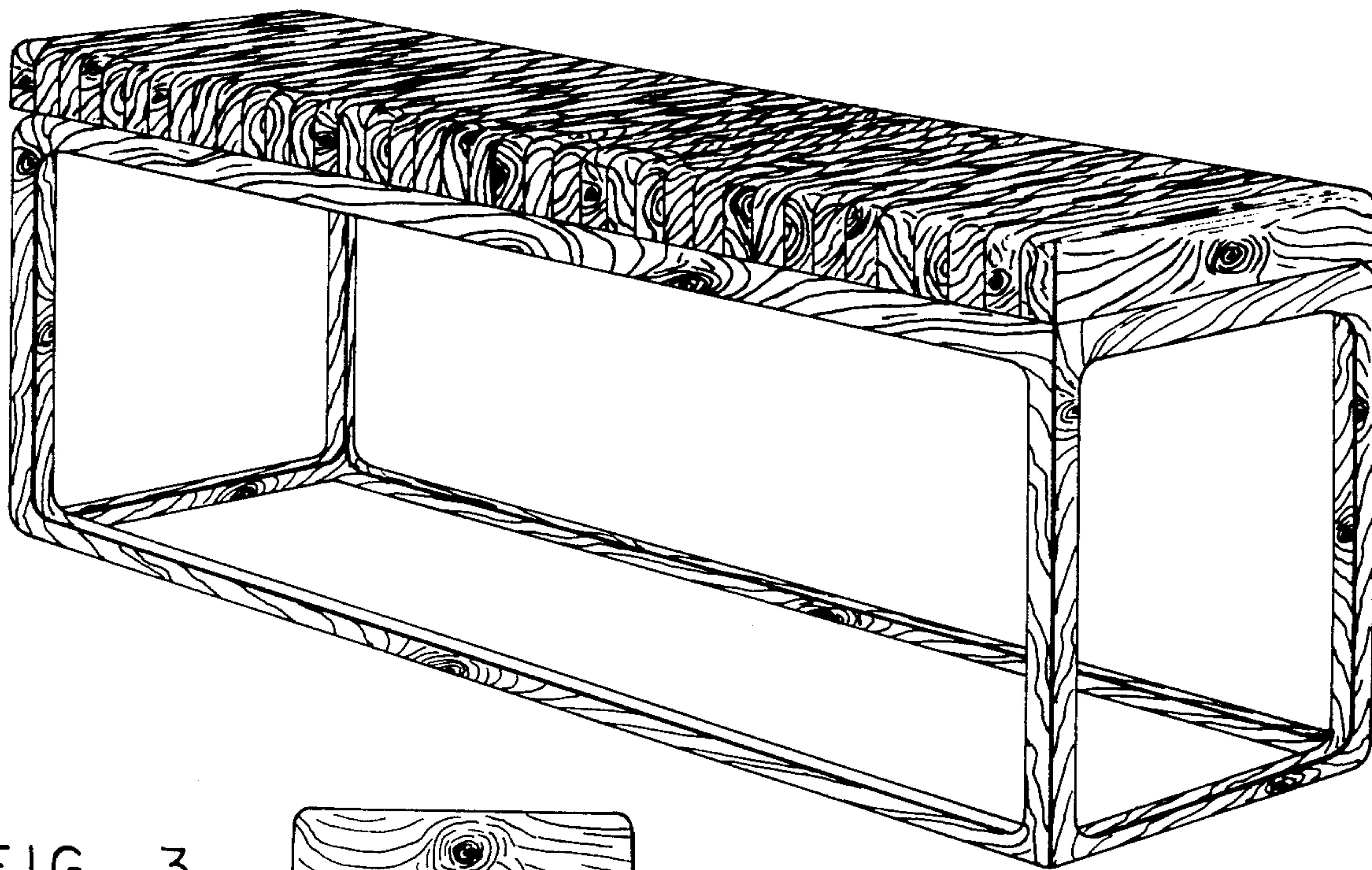

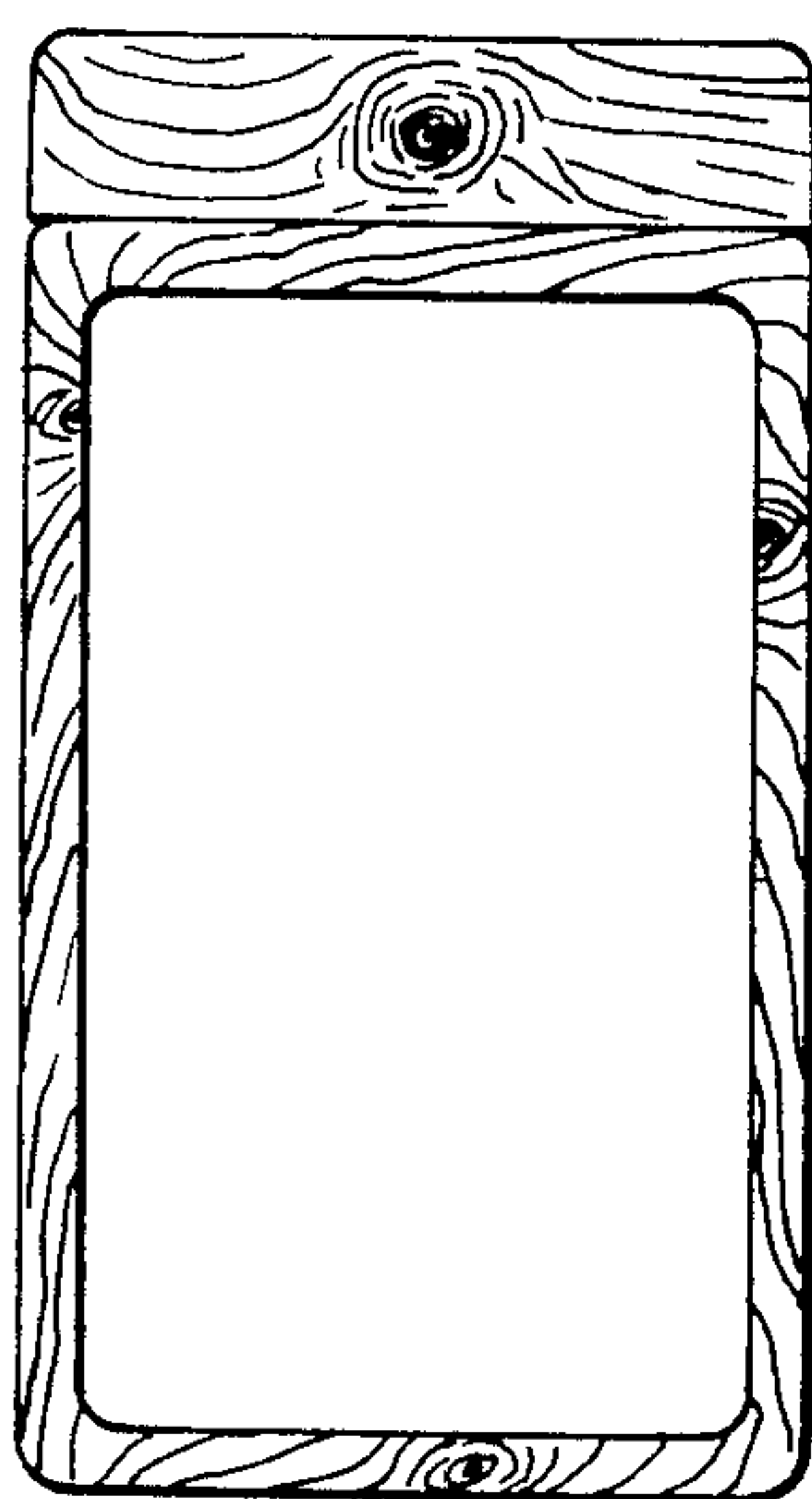
