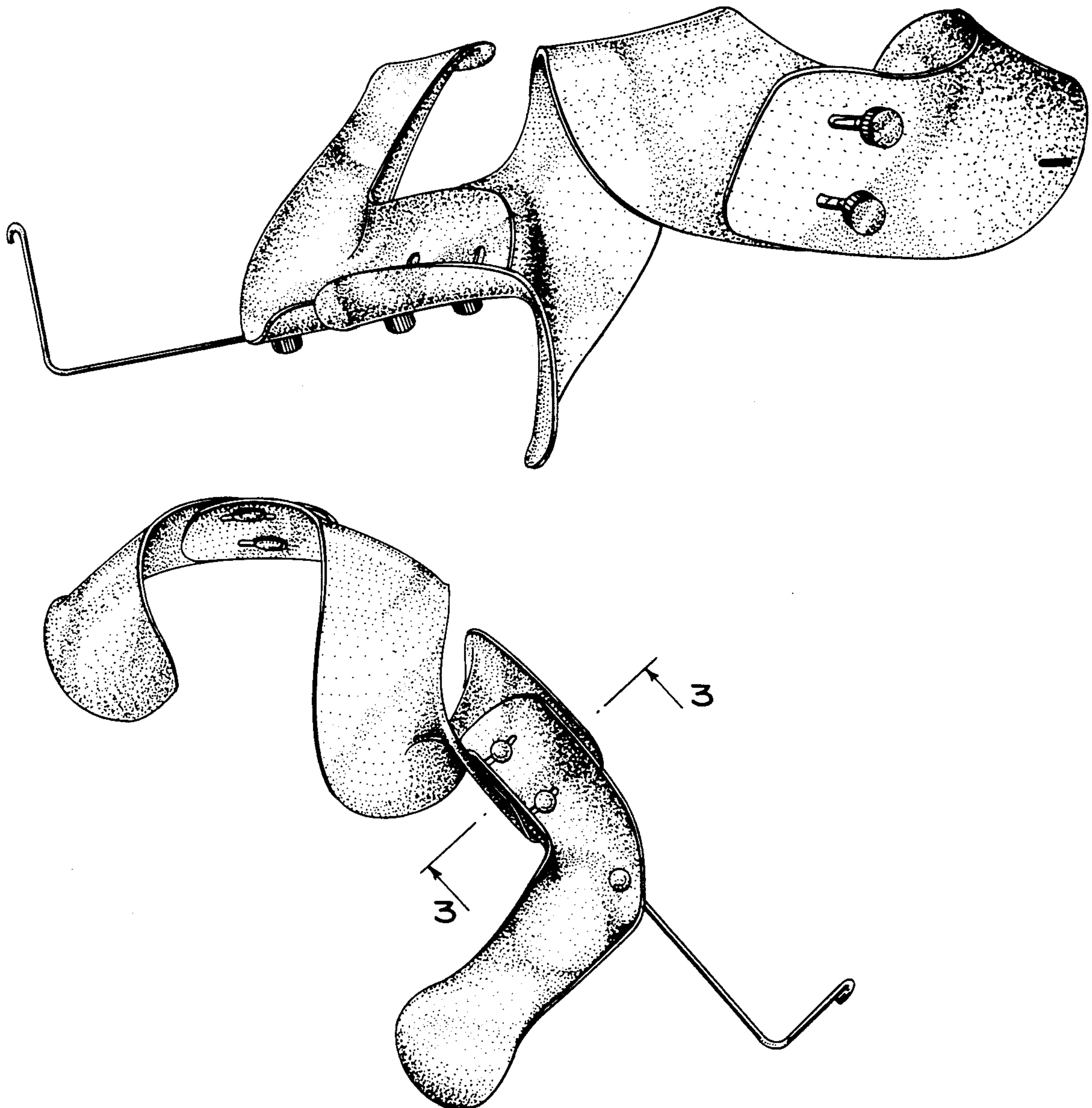

FIG. 3 is a cross section taken on line 3—3 of FIG. 2.



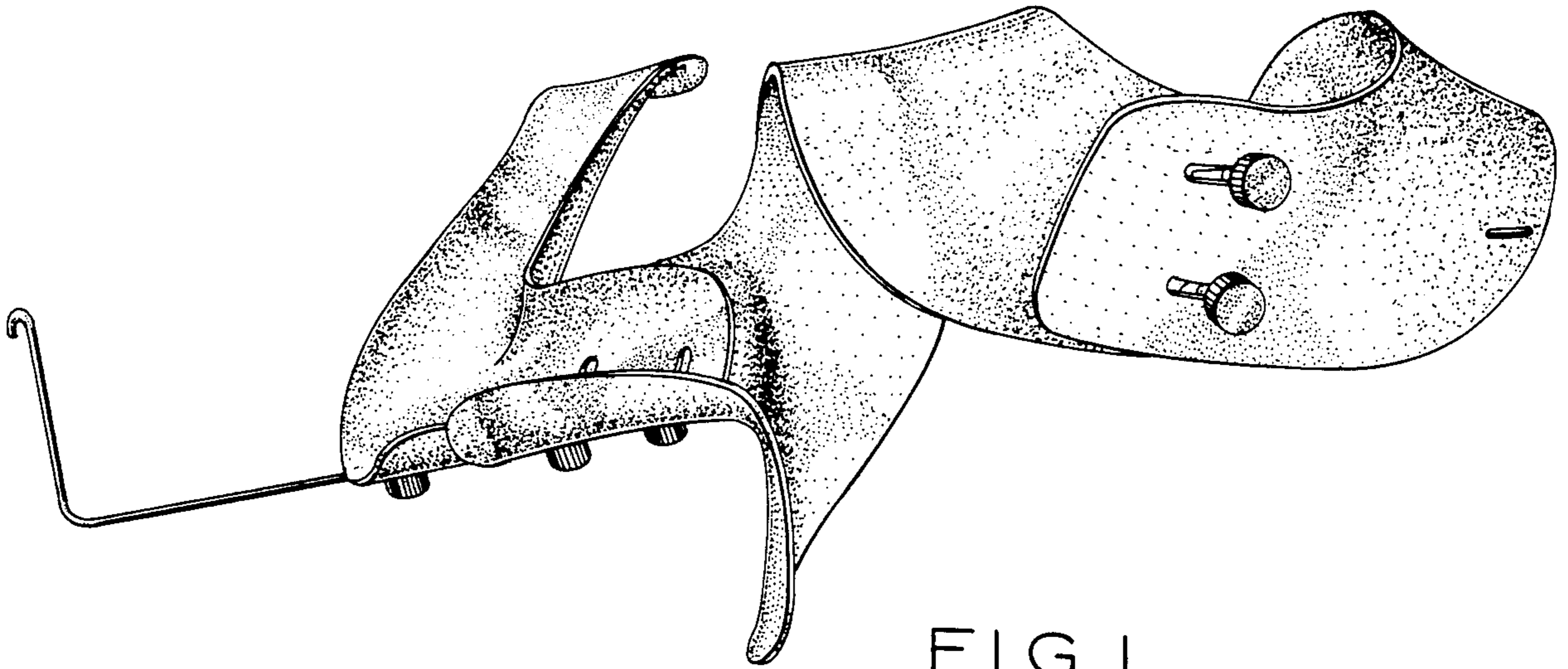

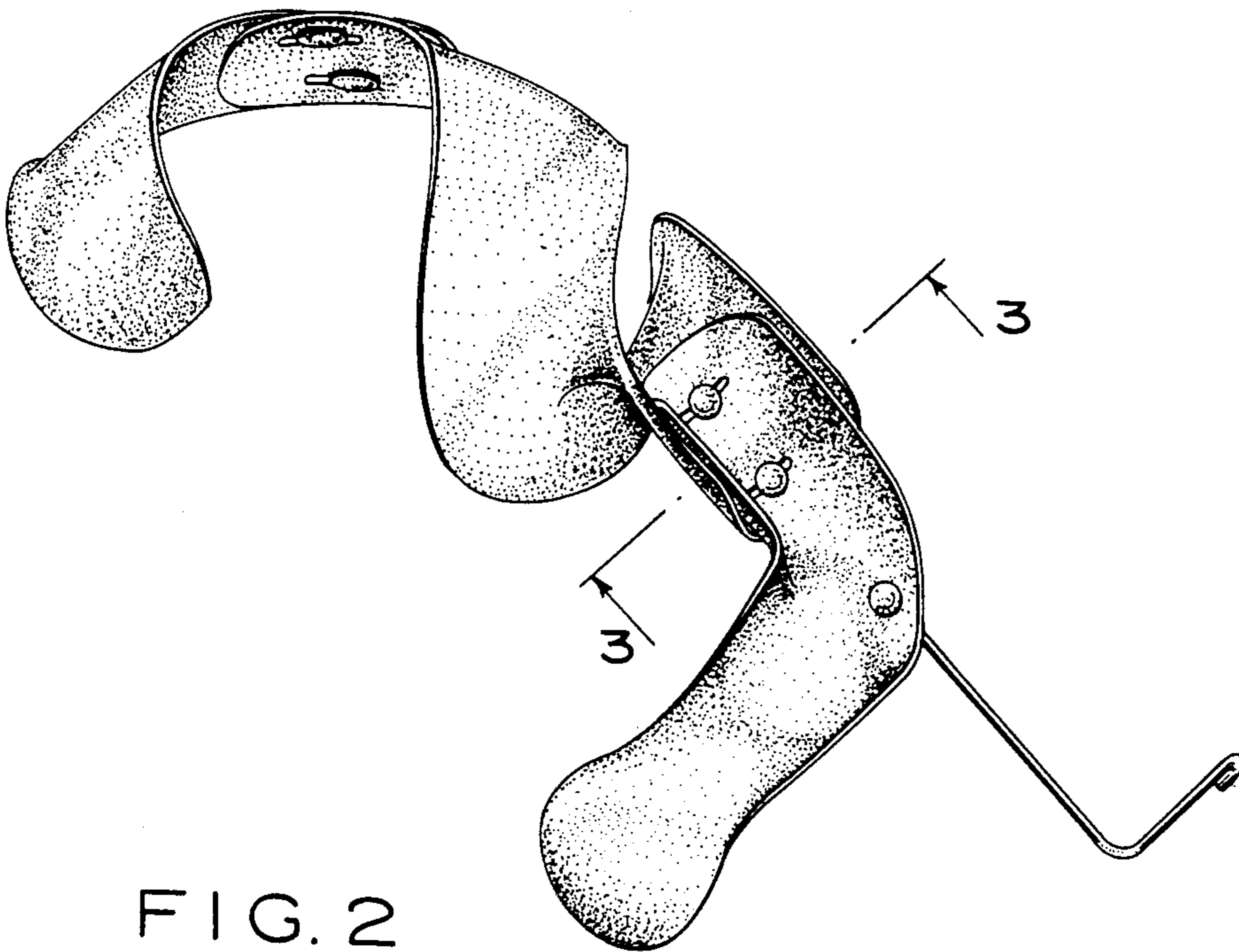

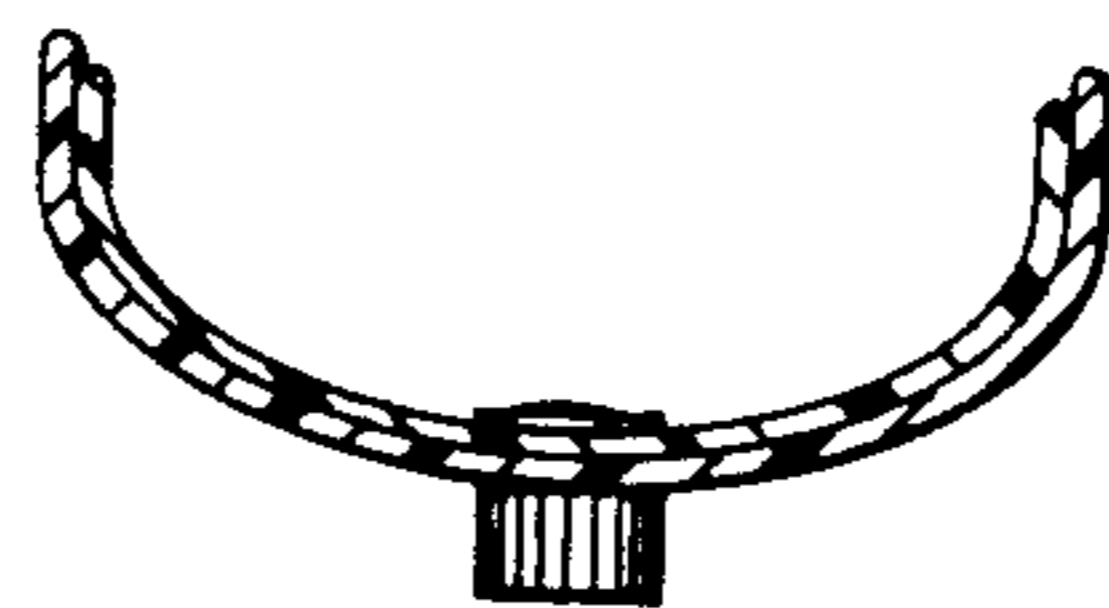
