**DESCRIPTION**

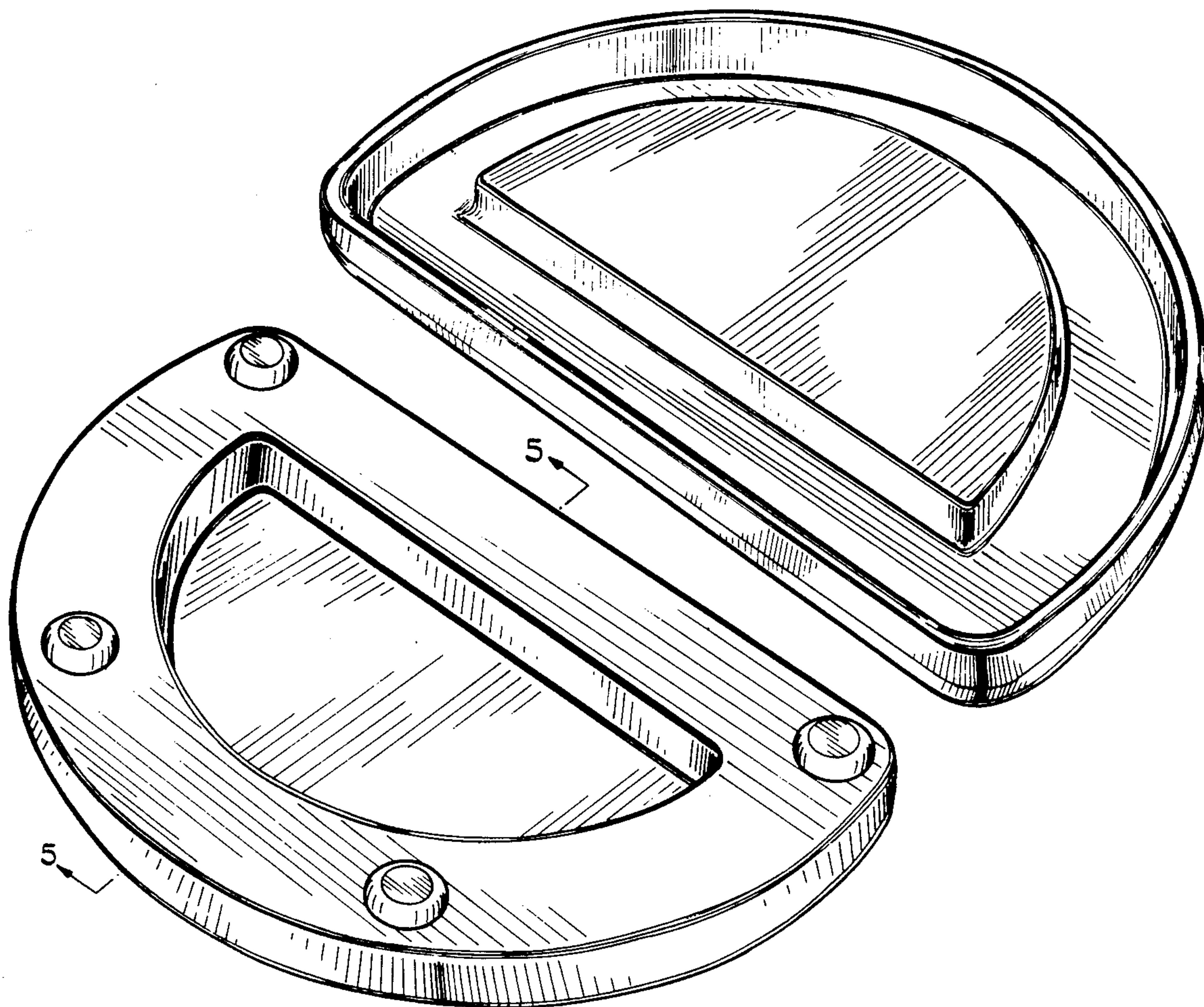
FIG. 1 is an upper perspective view showing one side

FIG. 5 is a section along the line 5—5 of FIG. 4.



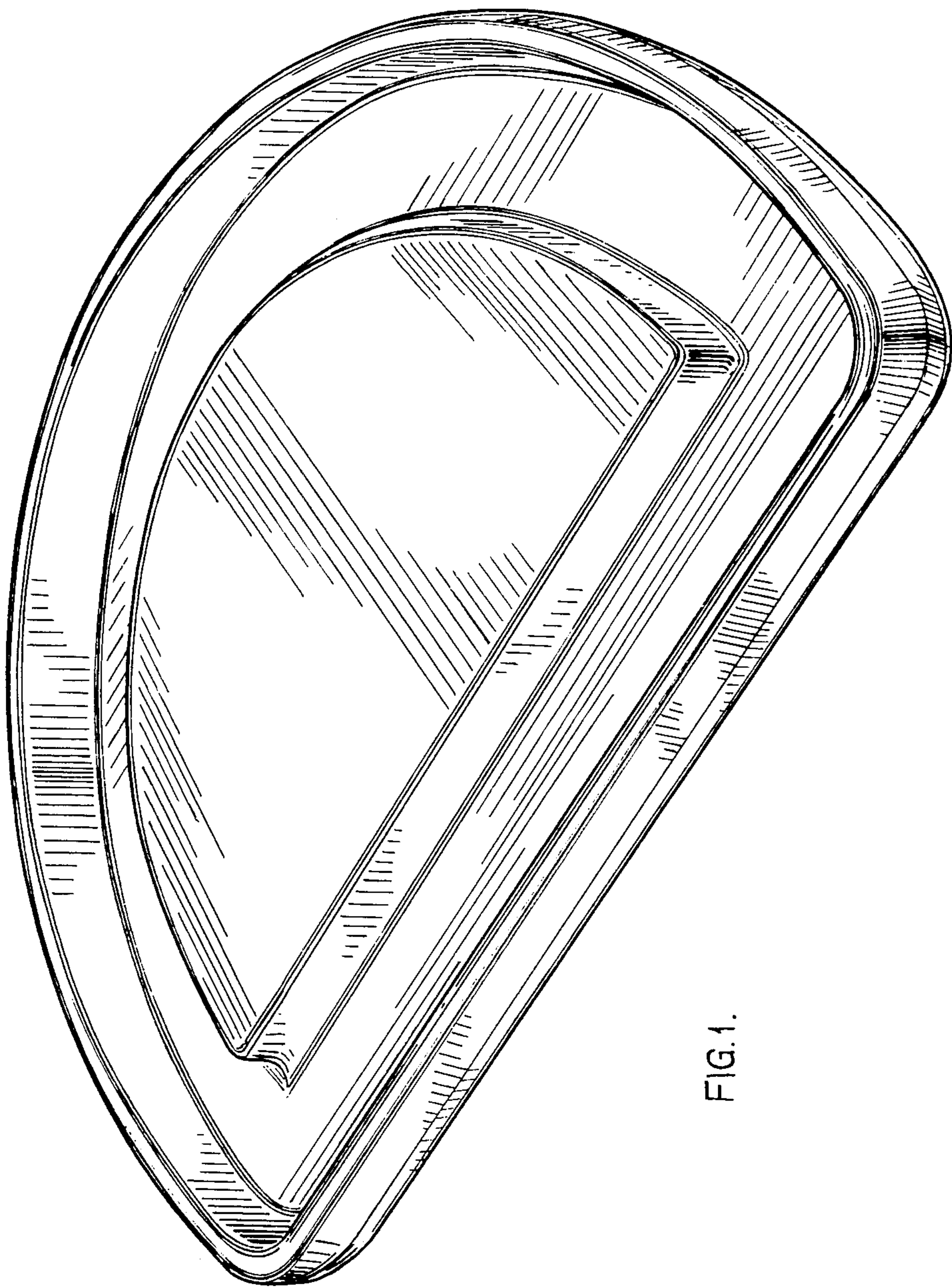
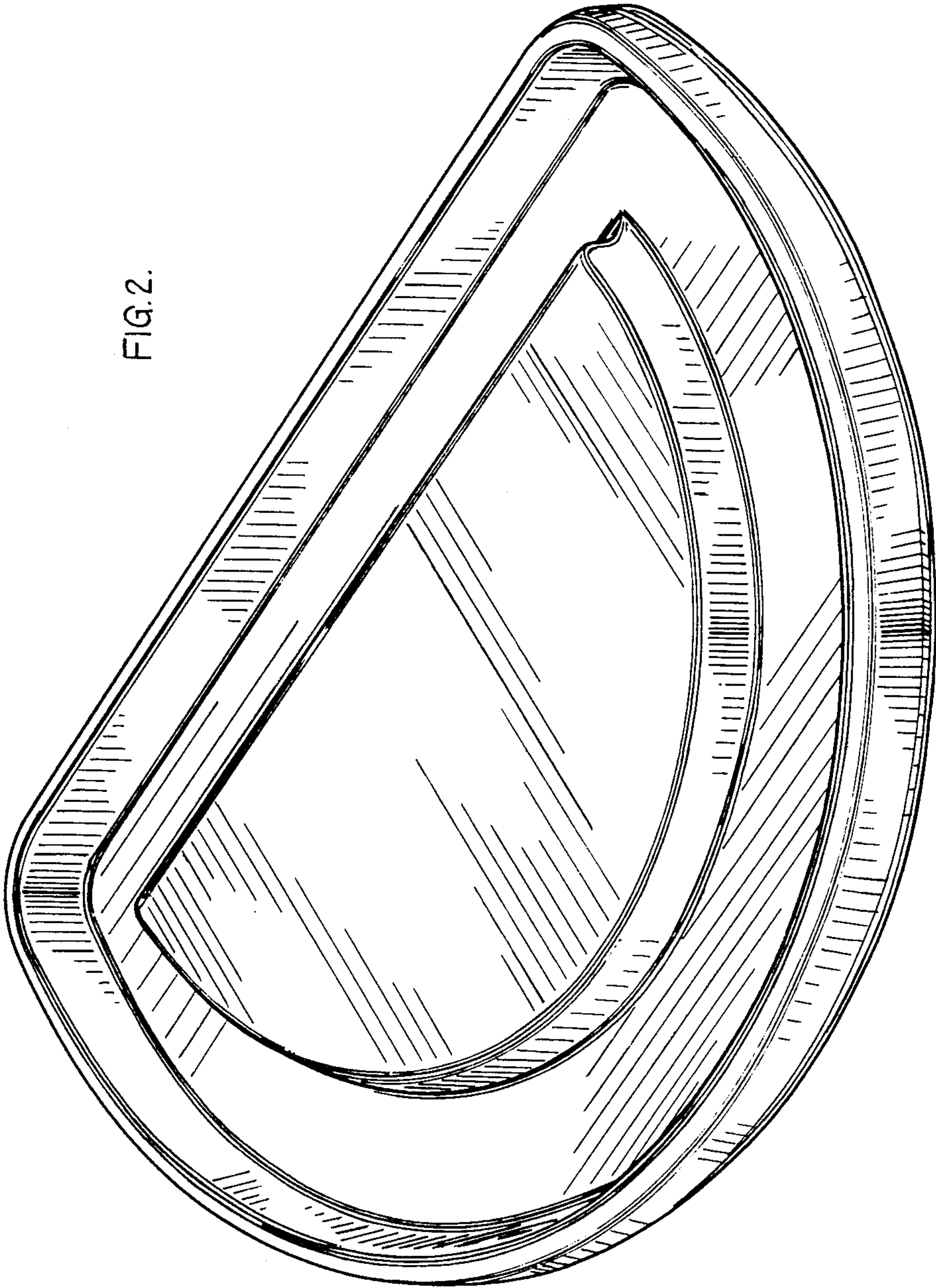

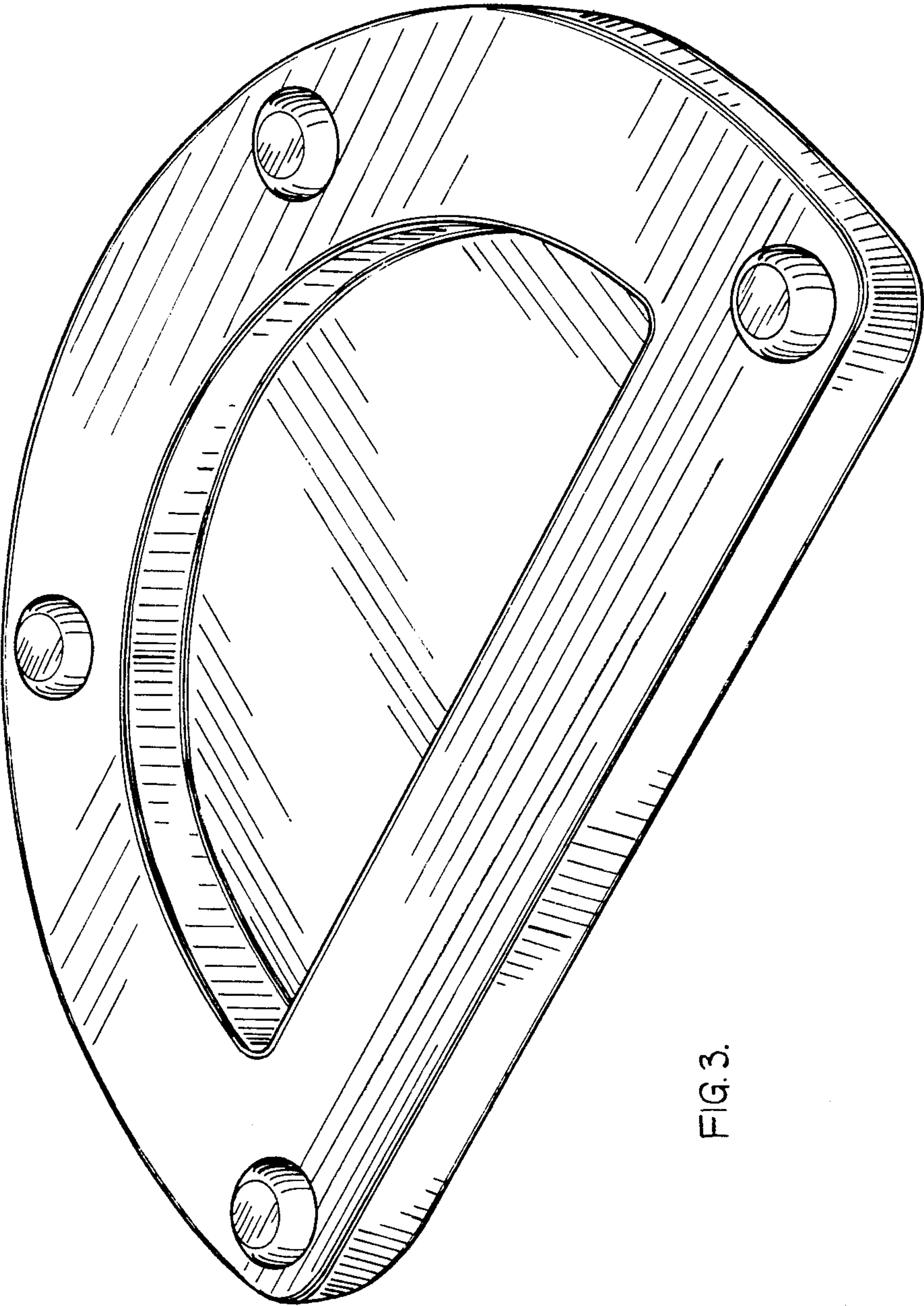

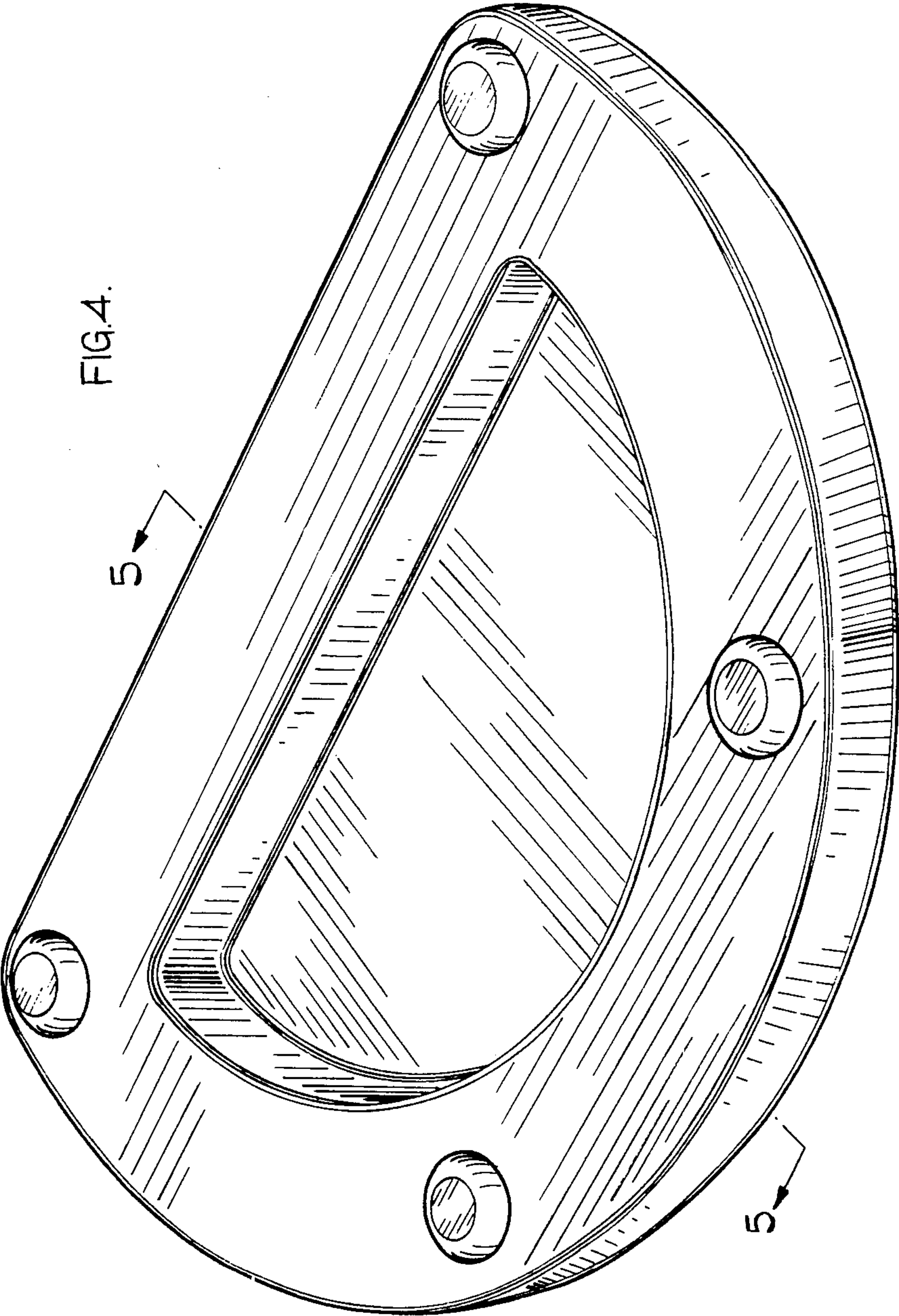
