An ornamental design for eyeglass frame, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

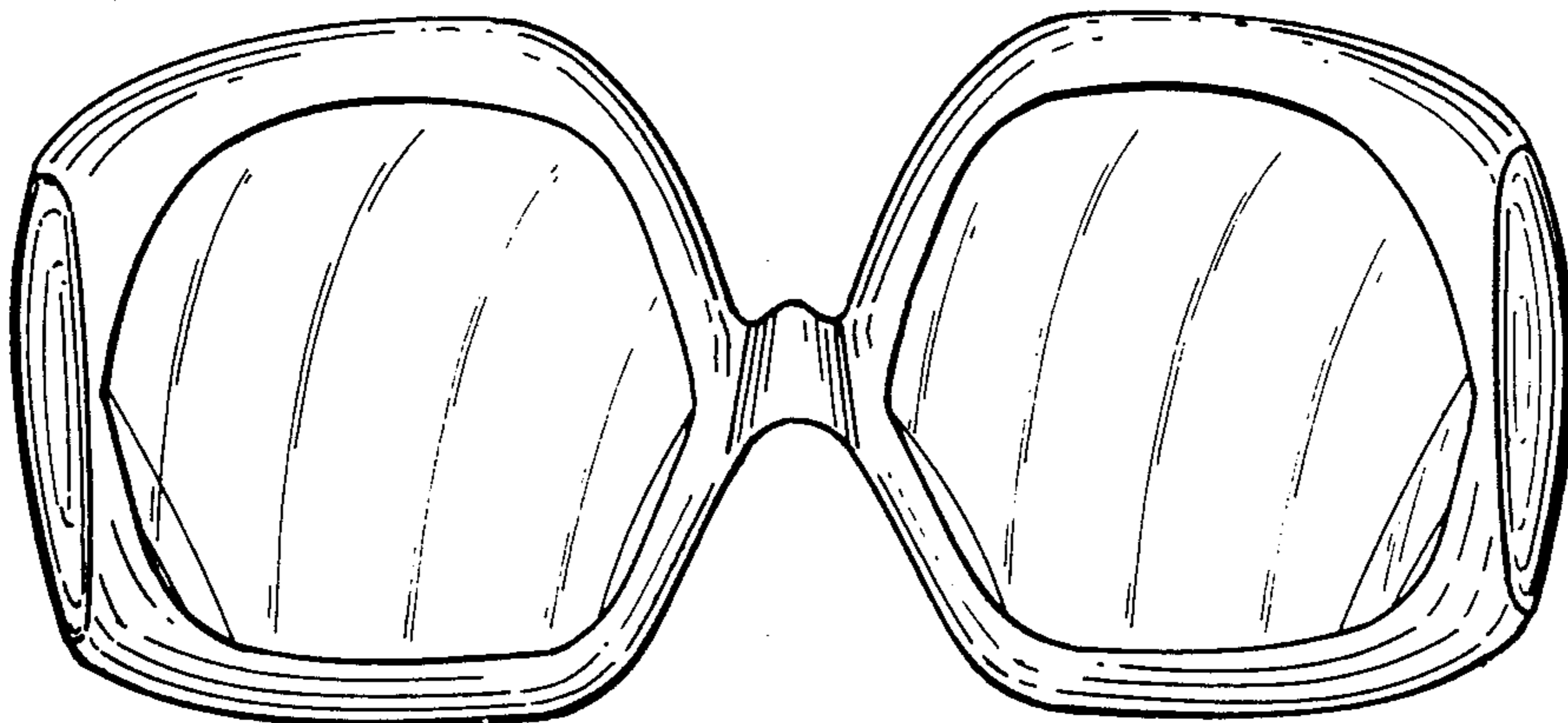

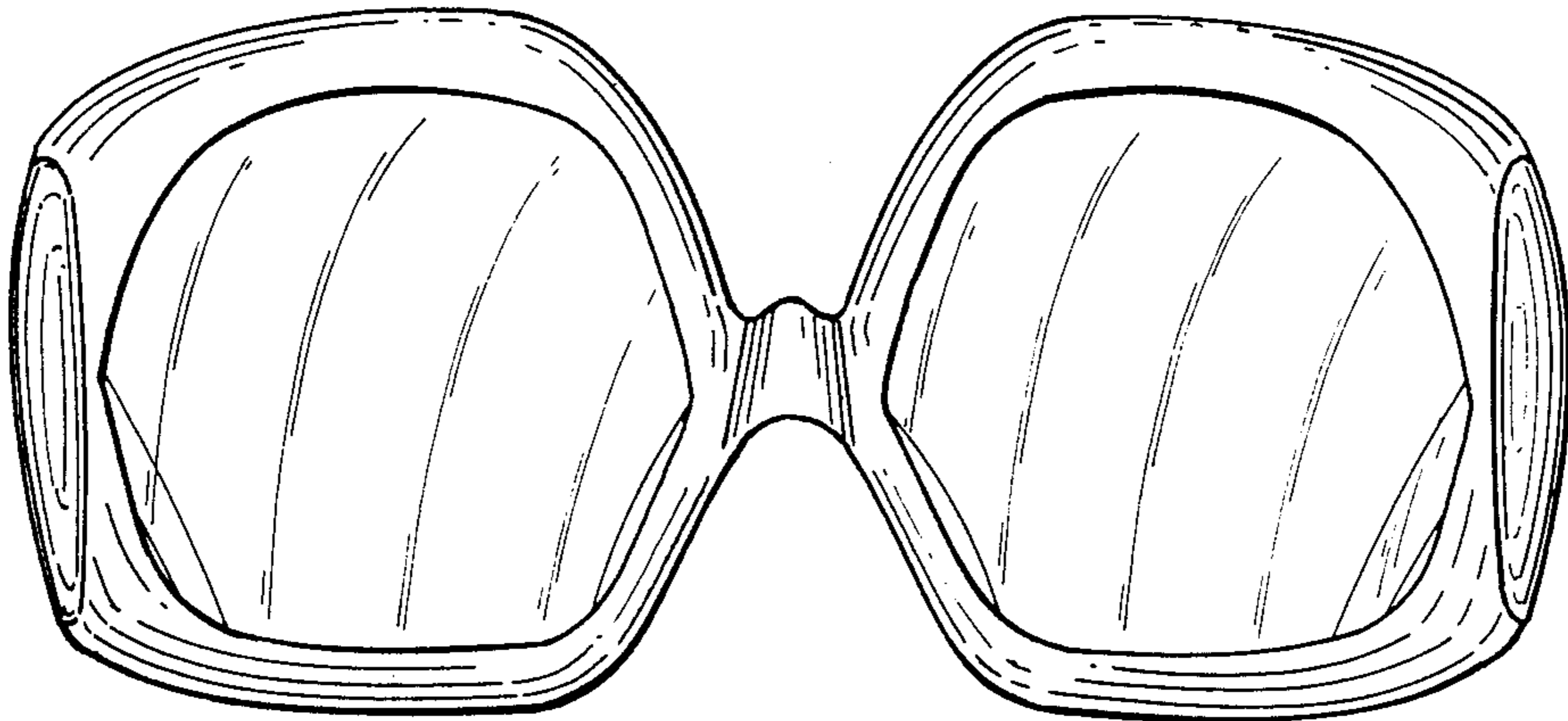

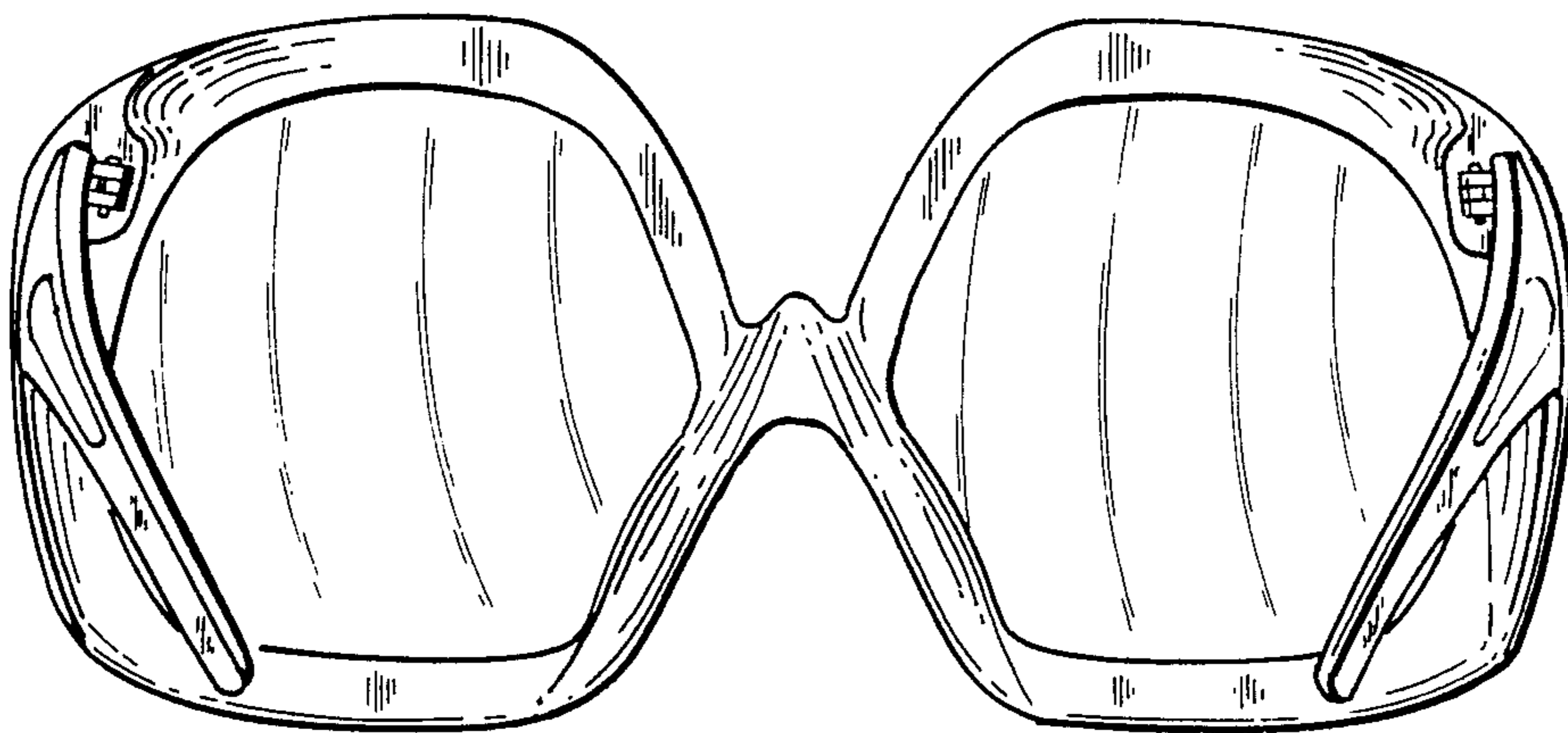

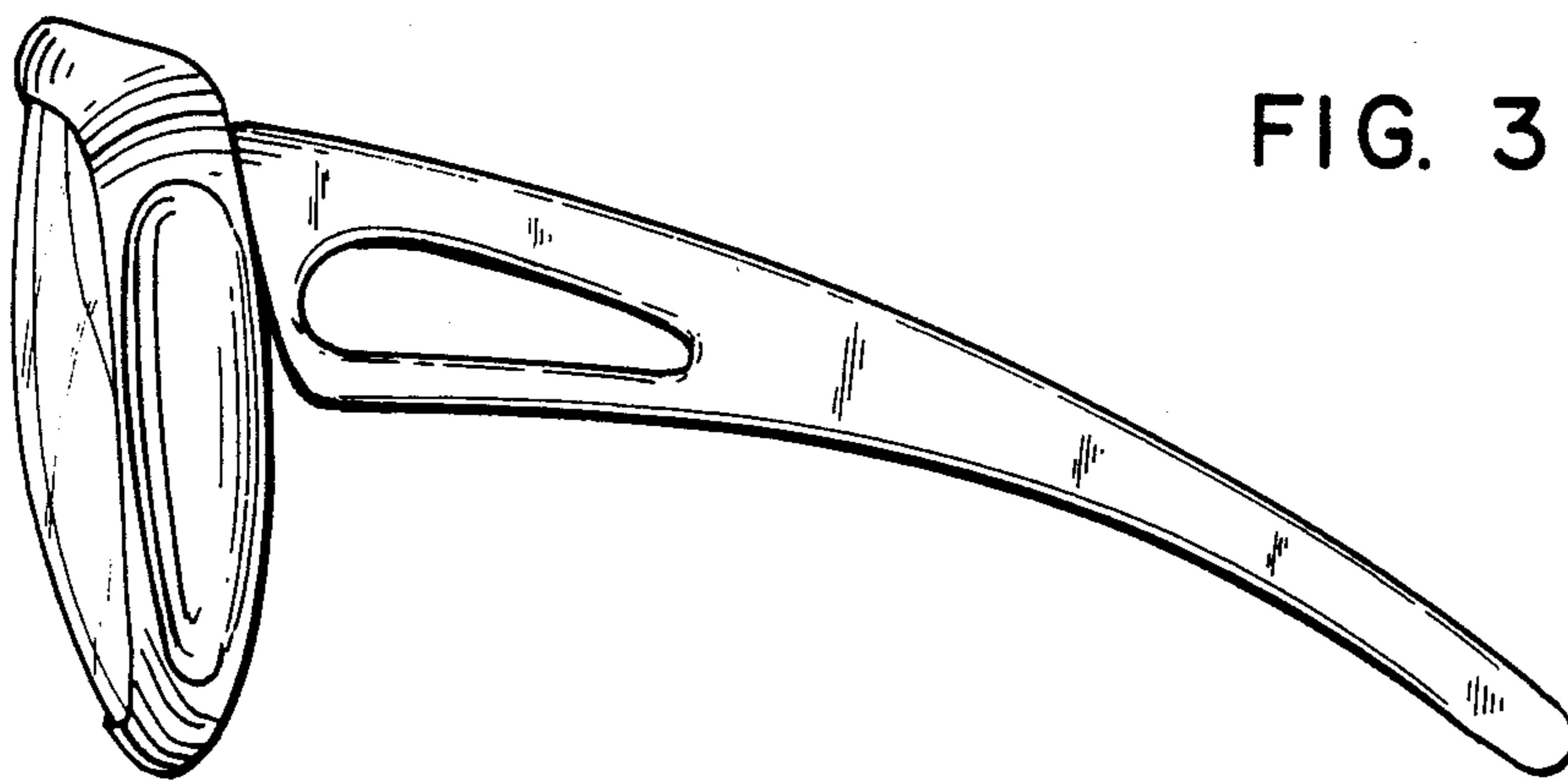

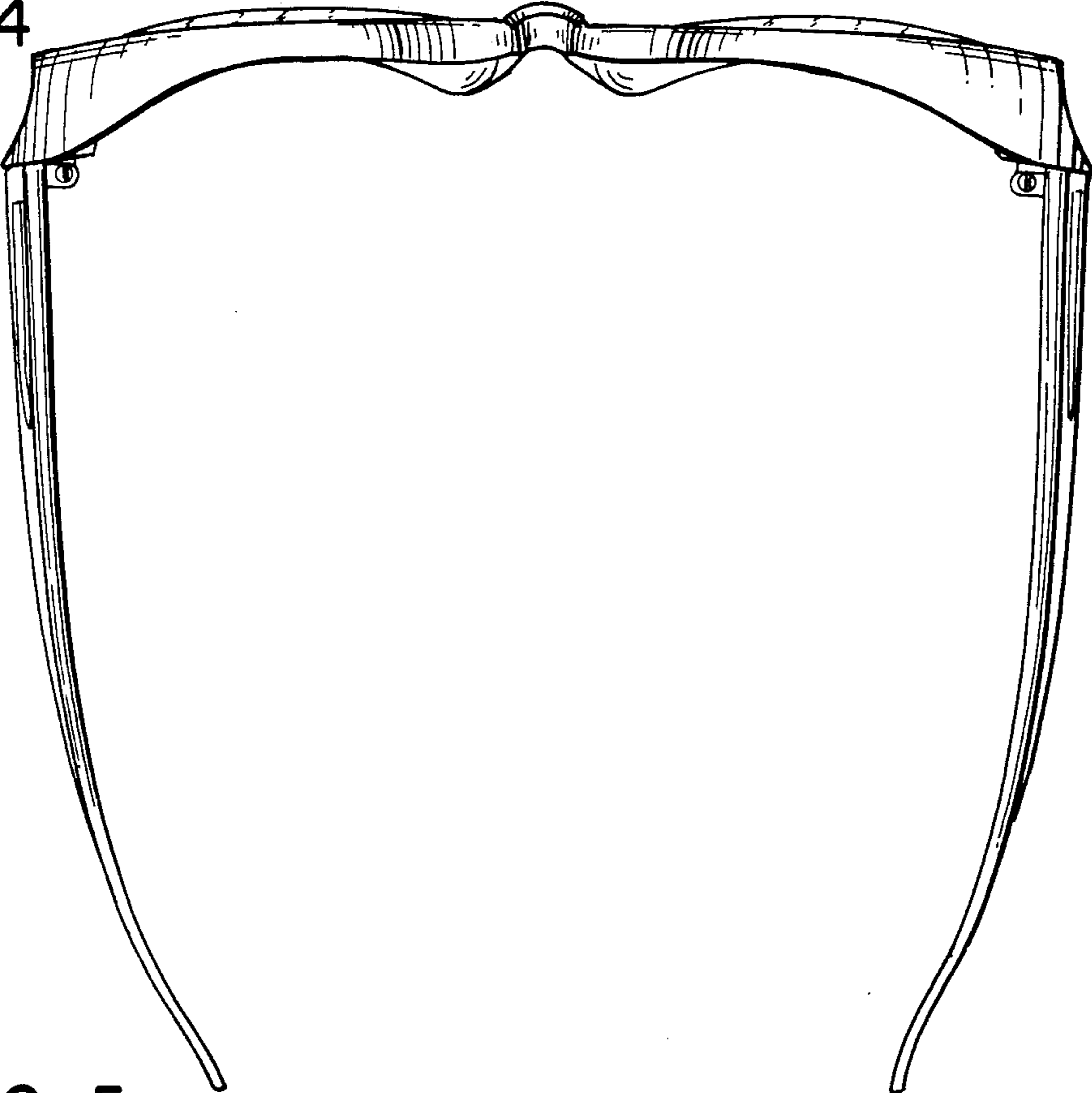
