[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a hockey stick, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of the right side of the hockey stick showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the left side of the hockey stick of FIG. 1:

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is an enlarged side elevational view of the blade and lower portion of the handle of the hockey stick of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is an enlarged side elevational view of the blade and lower portion of the handle of the hockey stick of FIG. 2;

FIG. 7 is a top plan view of FIG. 1 drawn to the scale of FIG. 5;

FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 1 drawn to the scale of FIG. 6;

FIG. 9 is a side elevational view of the right side of a modification of the hockey stick of FIG. 1;

FIG. 10 is a side elevational view of the left side of the hockey stick of FIG. 9;

FIG. 11 is a front elevational view of FIG. 9;

FIG. 12 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 9; FIG. 13 is an enlarged top plan view of FIG. 9;

FIG. 14 is an enlarged bottom plan view of FIG. 10; FIG. 15 is a side elevational view of the right side of another modification of the hockey stick of my new design;

FIG. 16 is a side elevational view of the left side of the hockey stick of FIG. 15;


FIG. 17 is a front elevational view of FIG. 15;

FIG. 18 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 15;


FIG. 19 is an enlarged side elevational view of the blade and lower portion of the handle of the hockey stick of FIG. 15;








Fig.11 Fig.12




Fig.12 Fig.18




