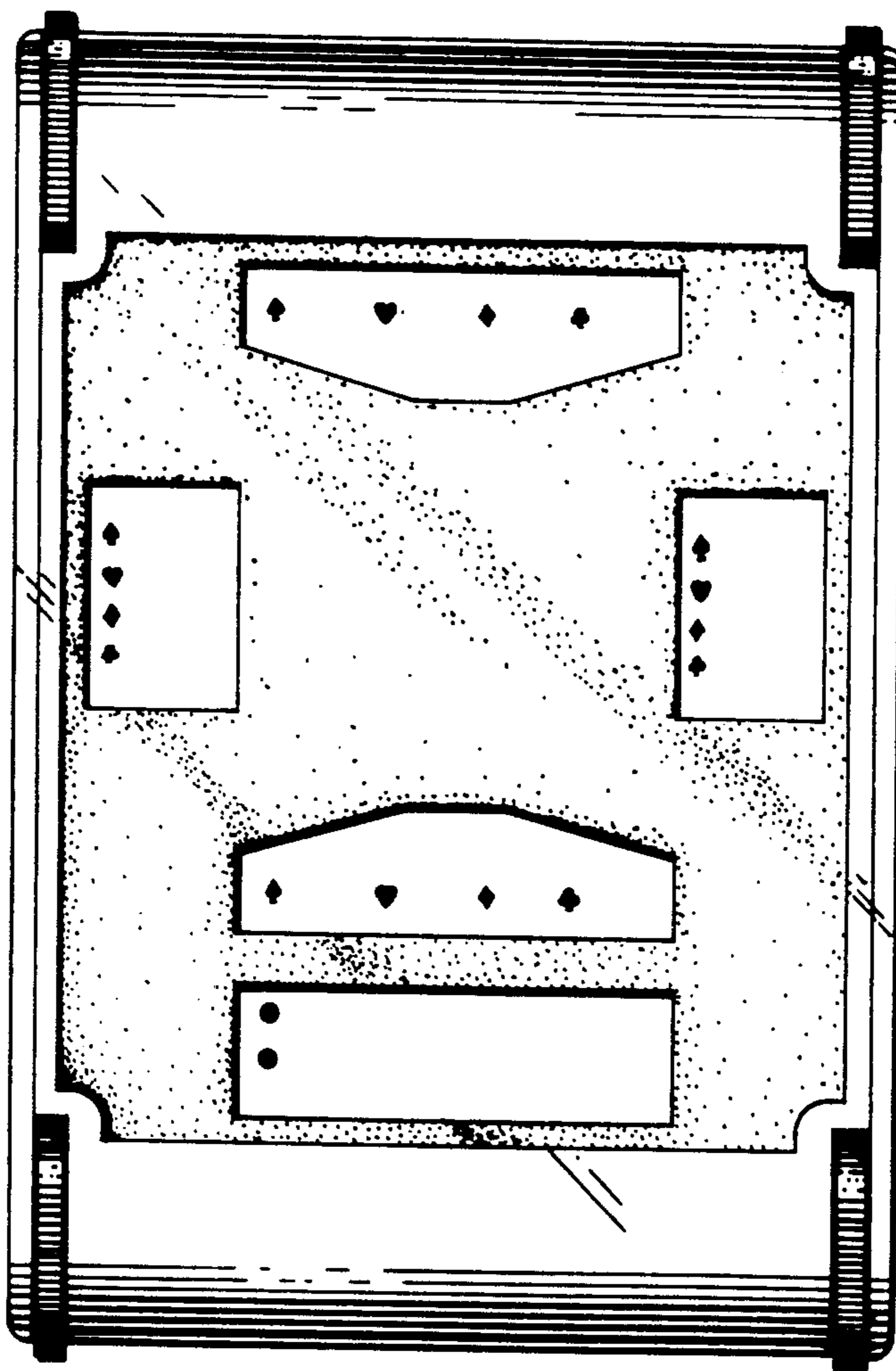

FIG. 4 is a bottom view thereof, the top view being a mirror image.



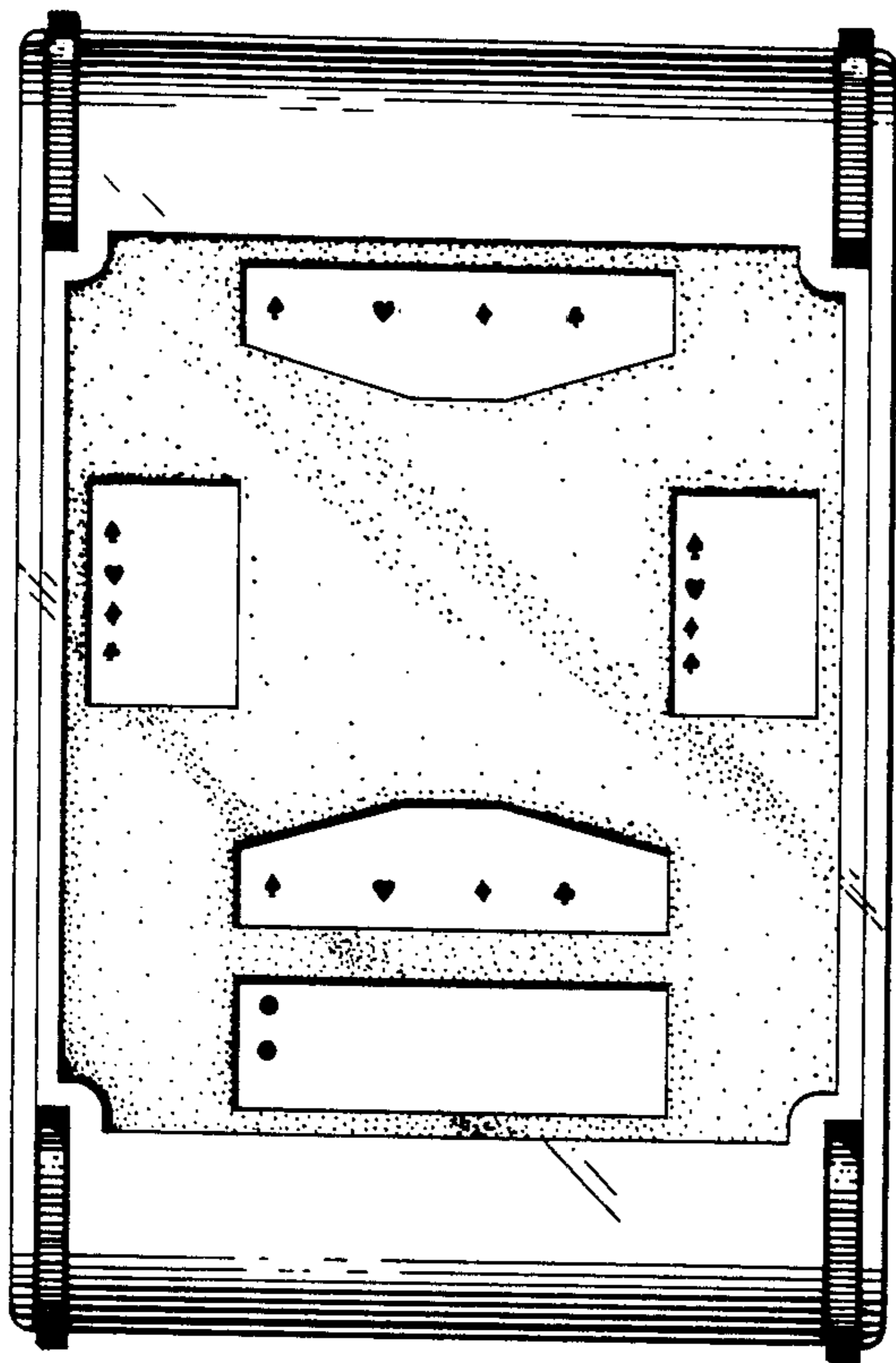

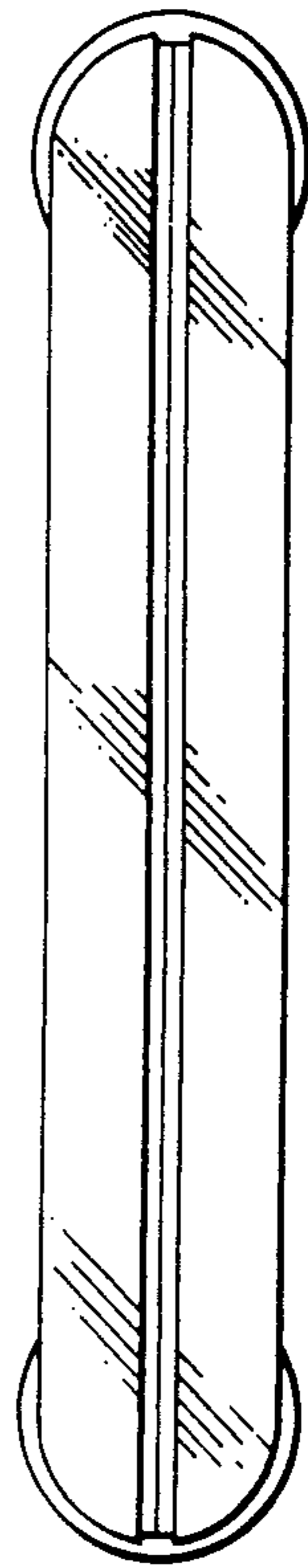

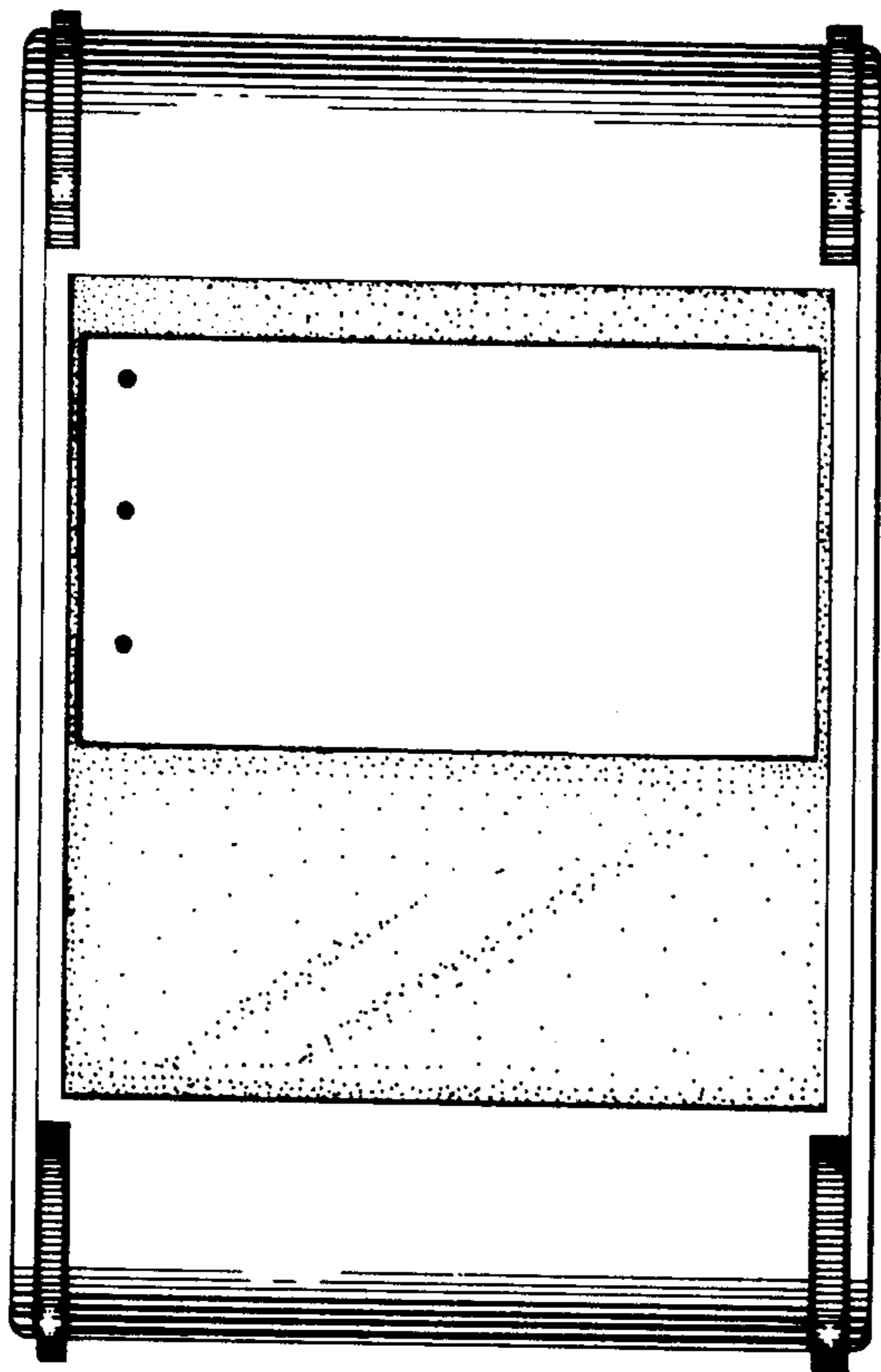

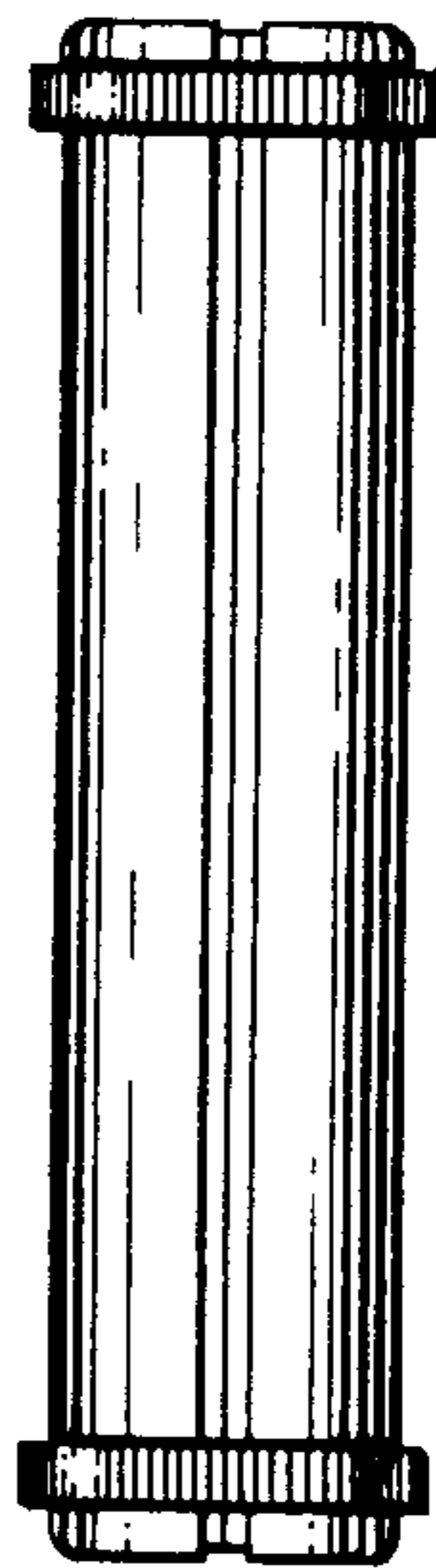
