**DESCRIPTION**

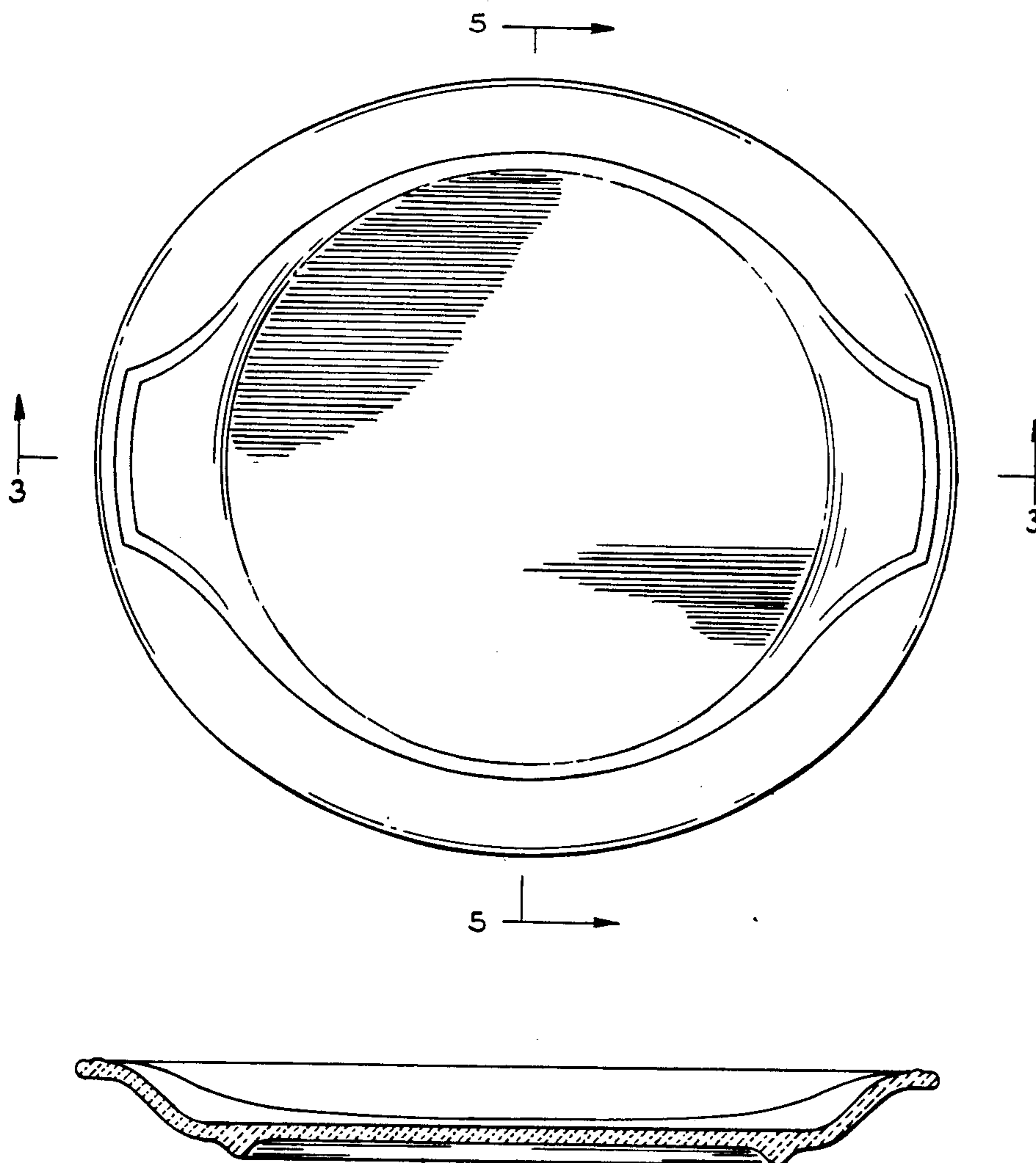
FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a dinner plate showing my new design;

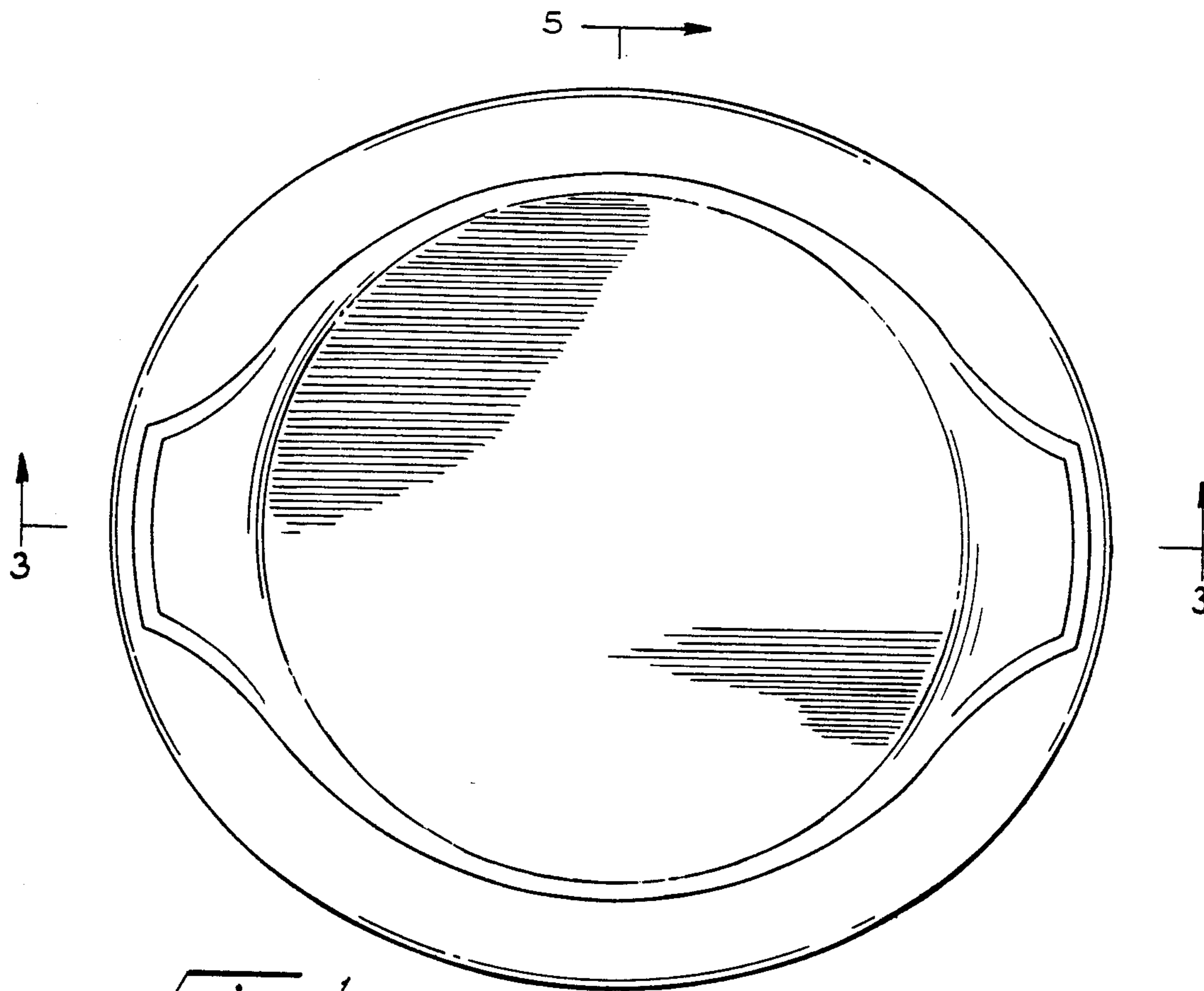
FIG. 2 is a side elevation thereof;

FIG. 3 is a longitudinal sectional view thereof taken on line 3—3 of FIG. 1;

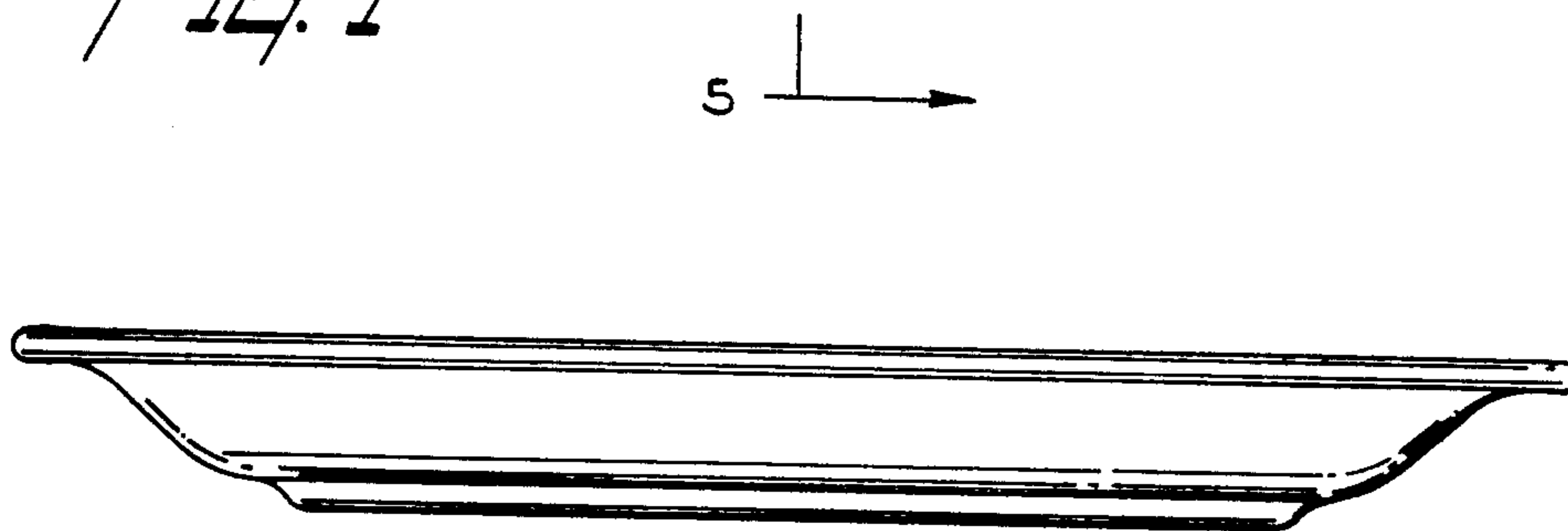
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a transverse sectional view thereof taken on line 5—5 of FIG. 1;

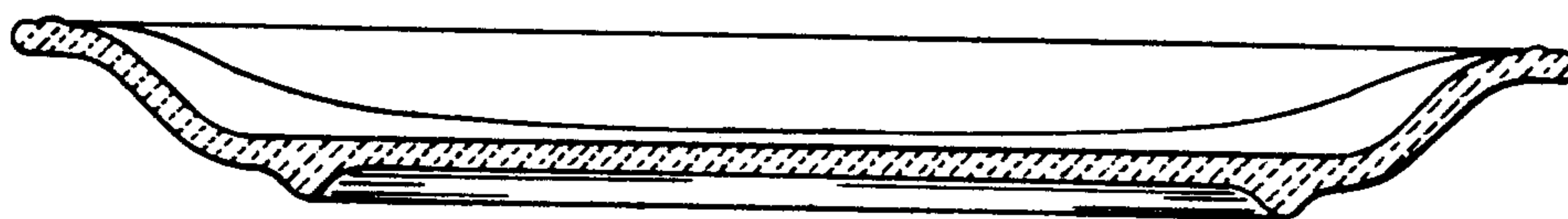




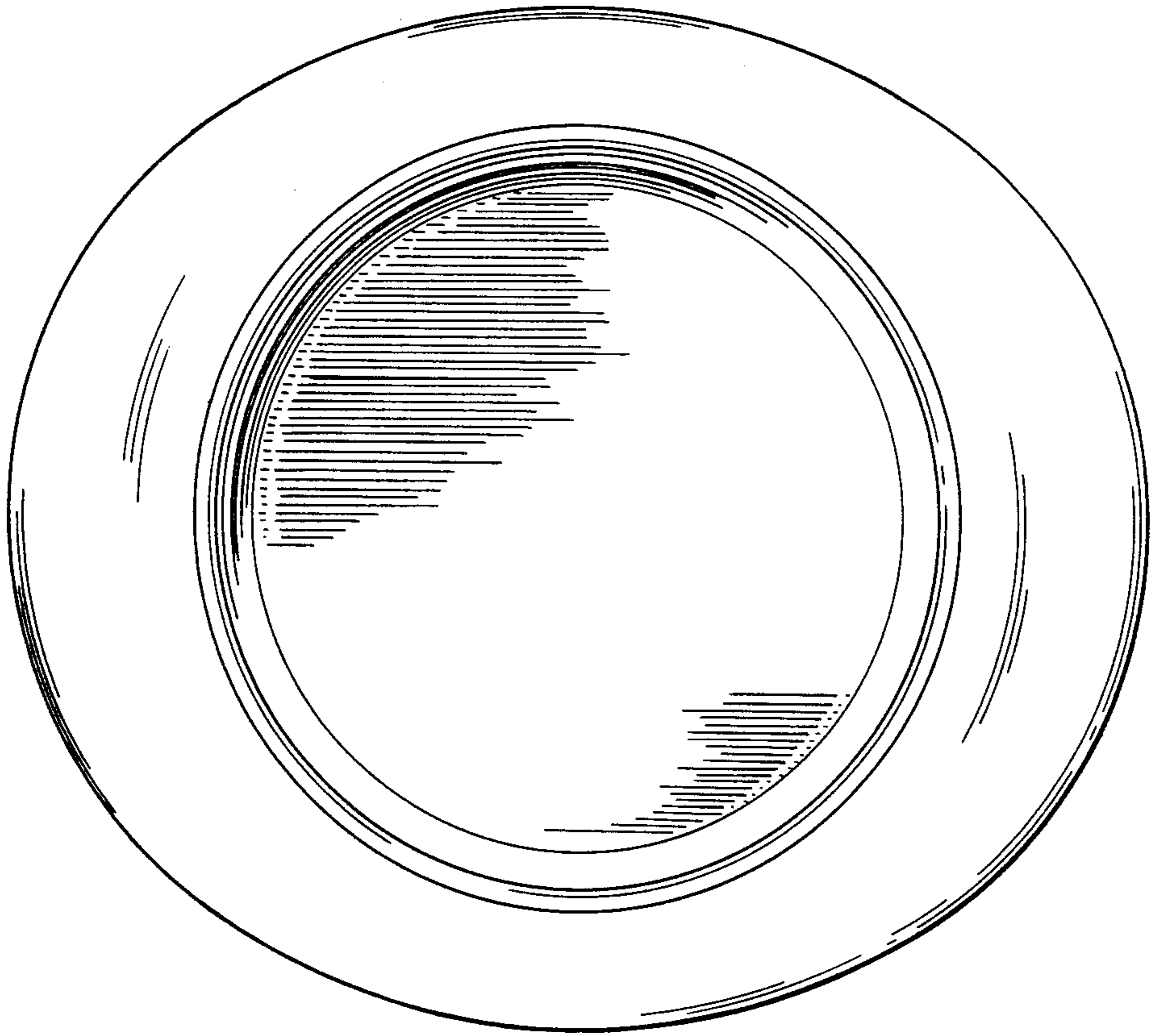

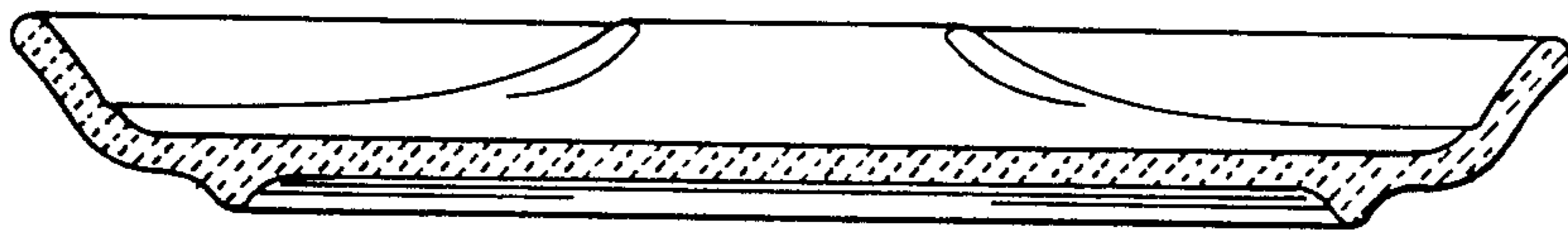
