DESCRIPTION

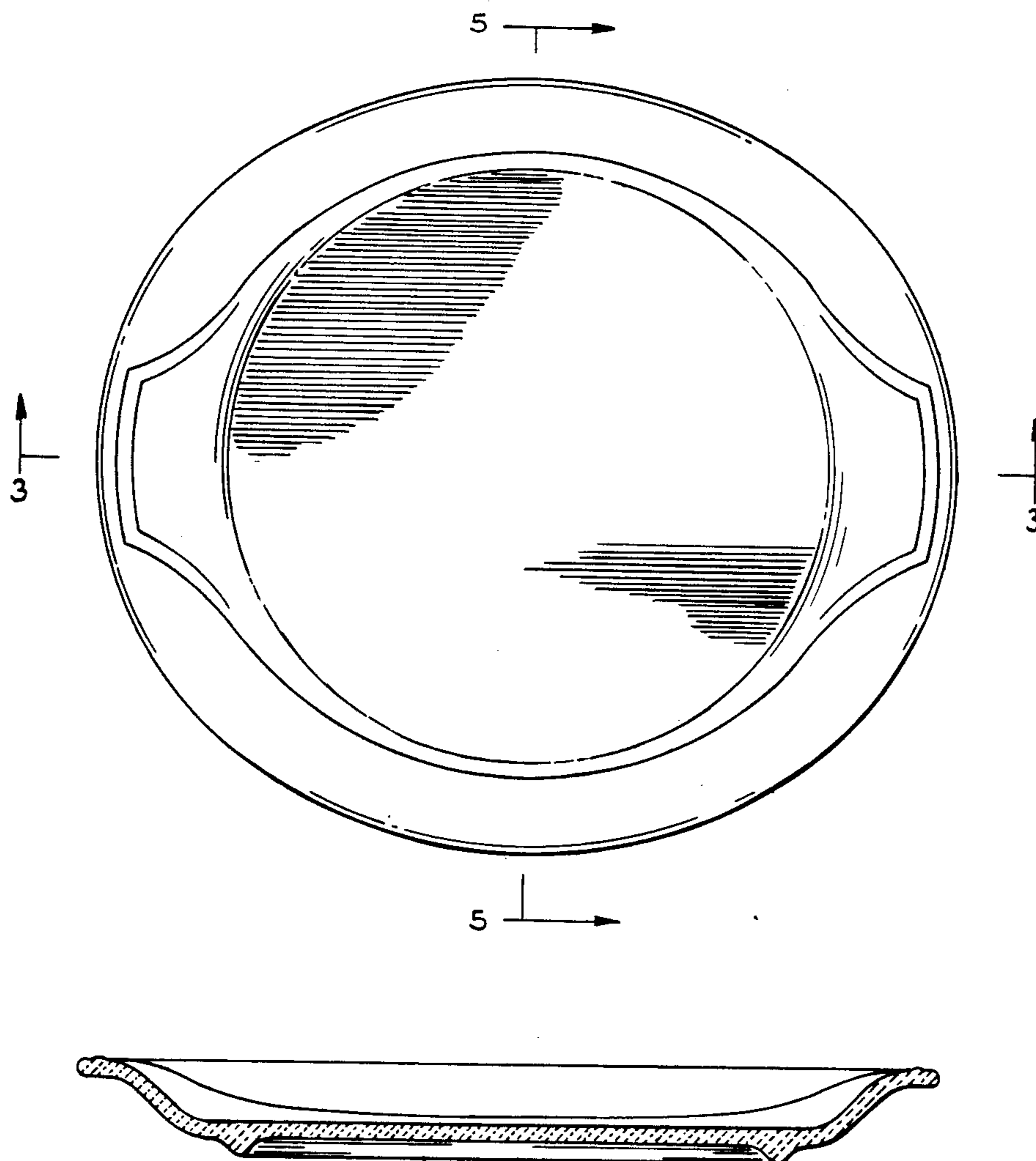
FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a dinner plate showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a transverse sectional view thereof taken on line 5—5 of FIG. 1;



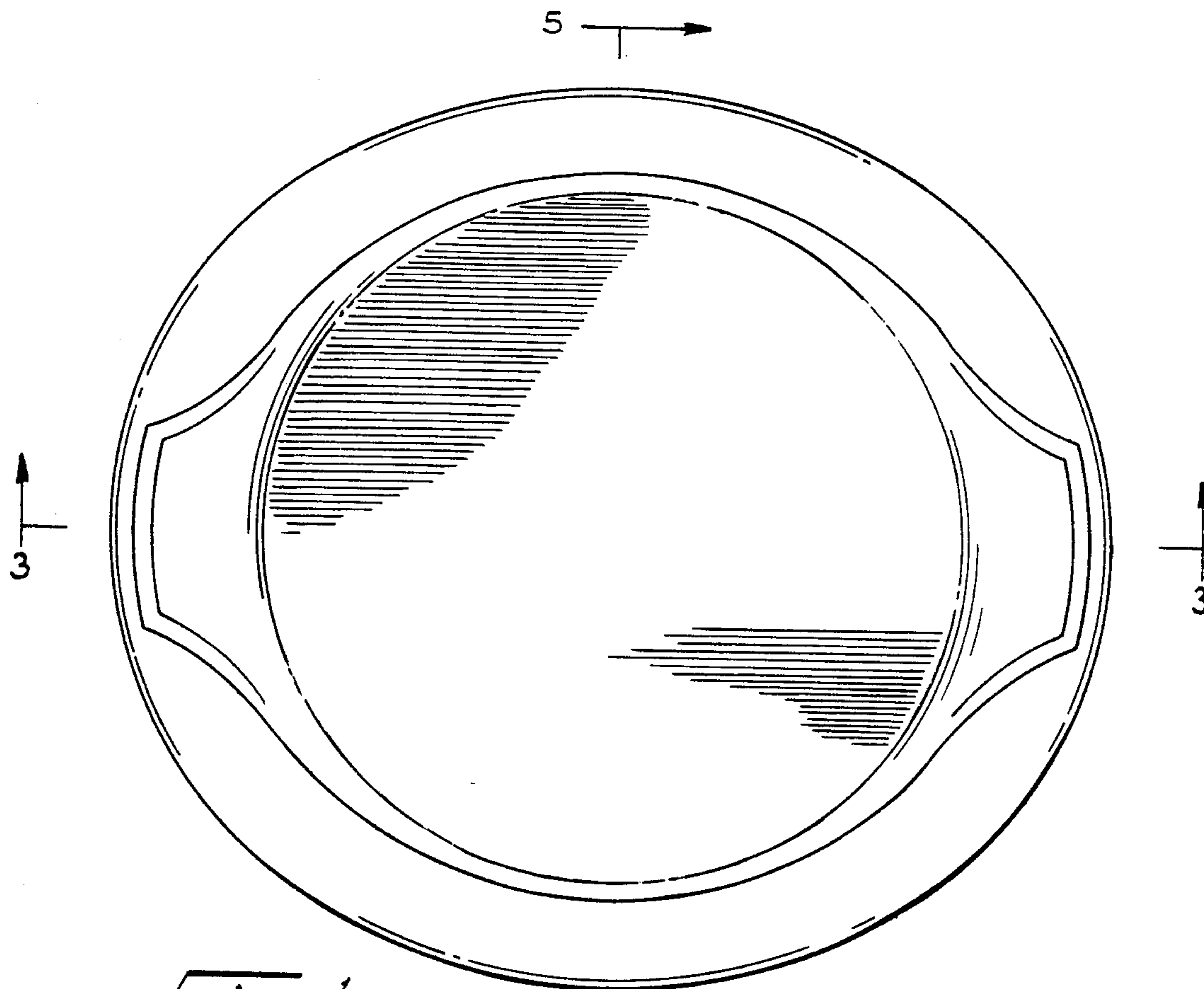

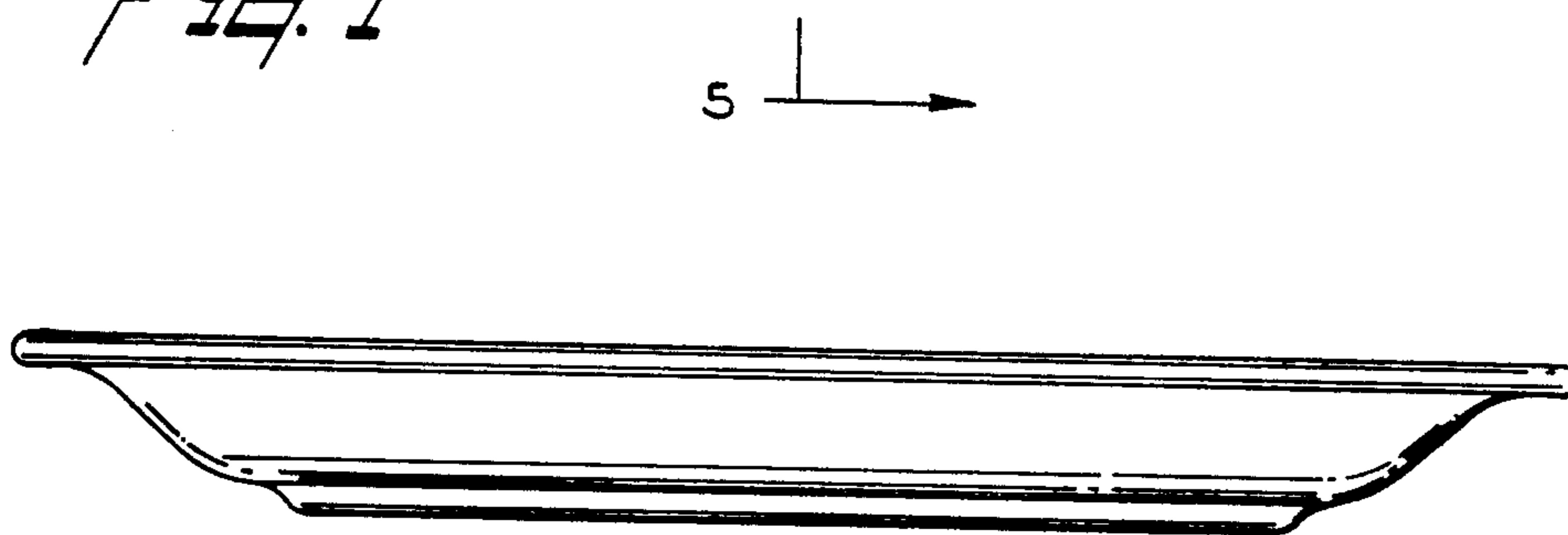

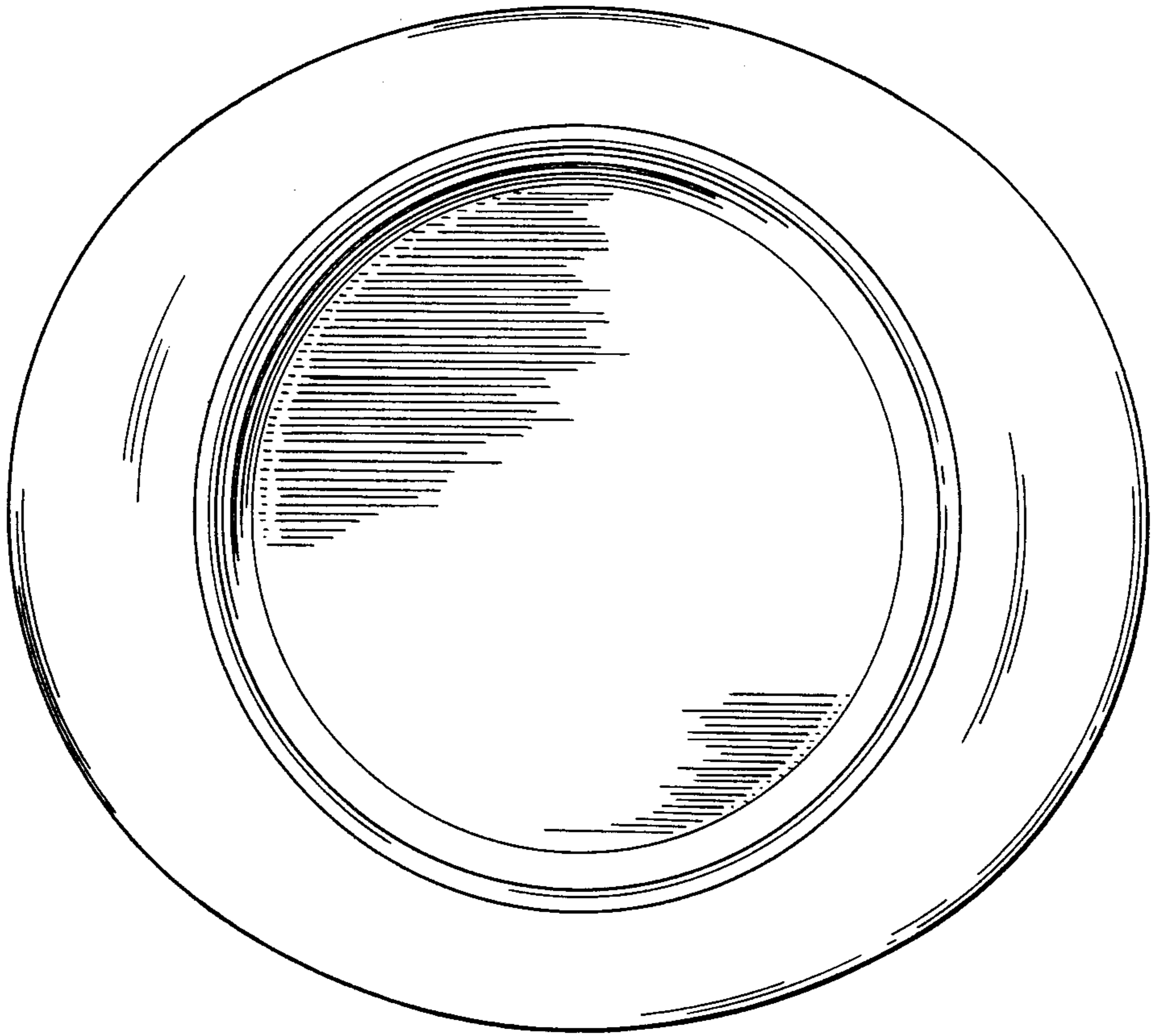

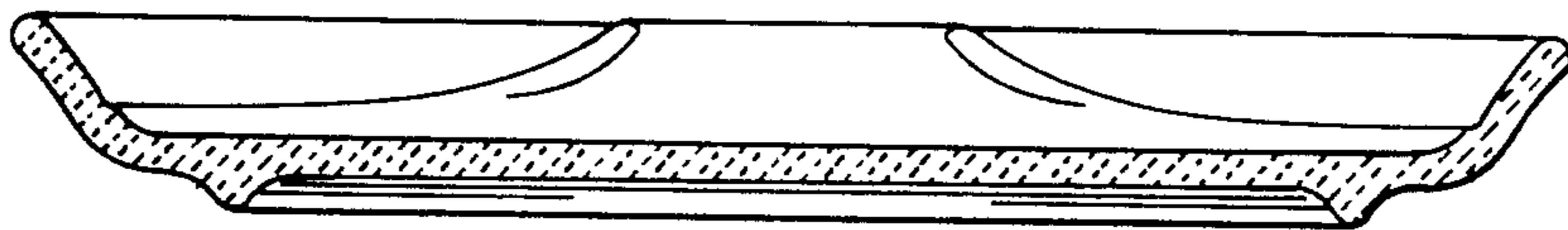
