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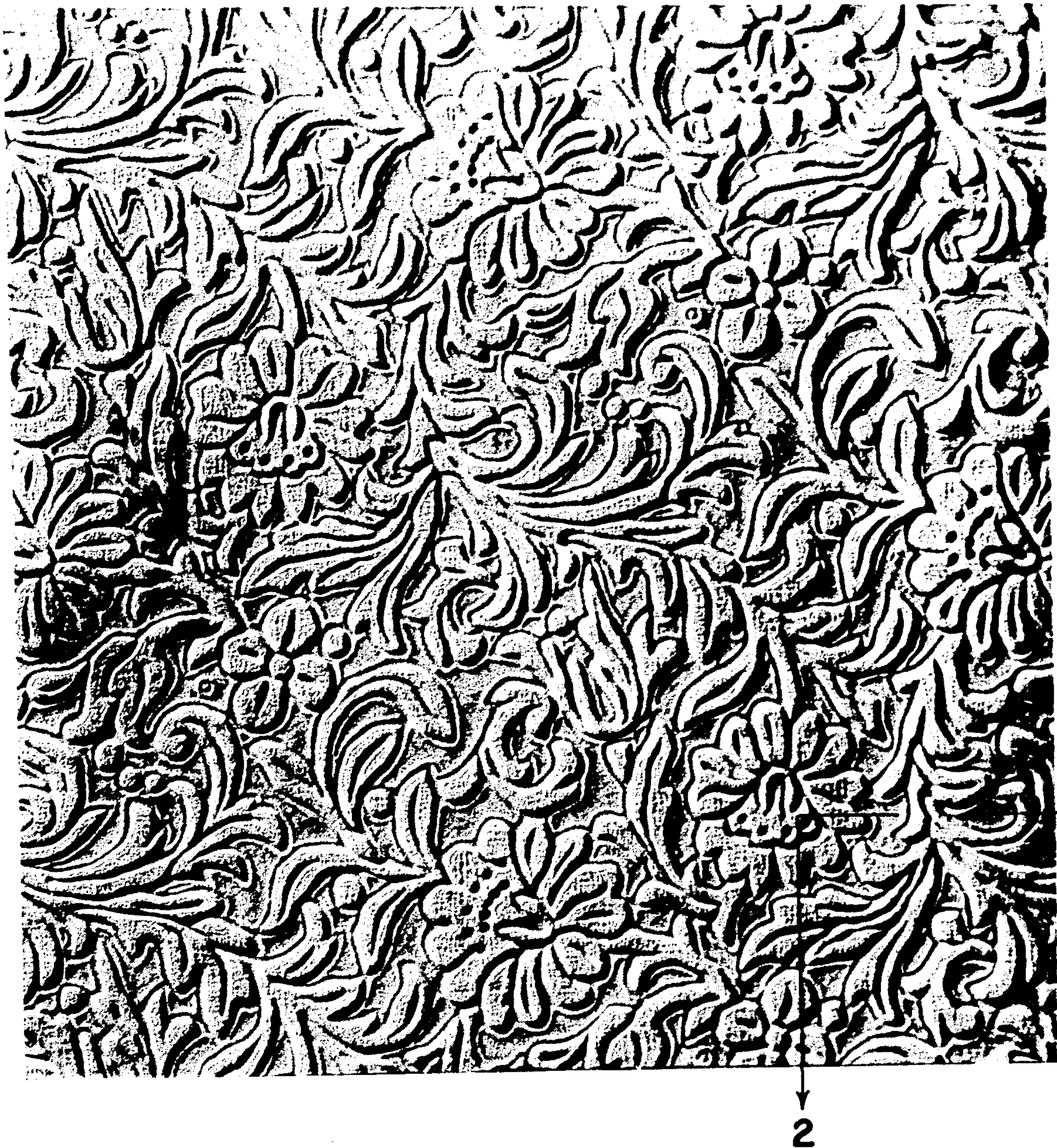

FIG. 2 is a sectional view of the ceiling tile of FIG. 1, taken along the lines 2—2.



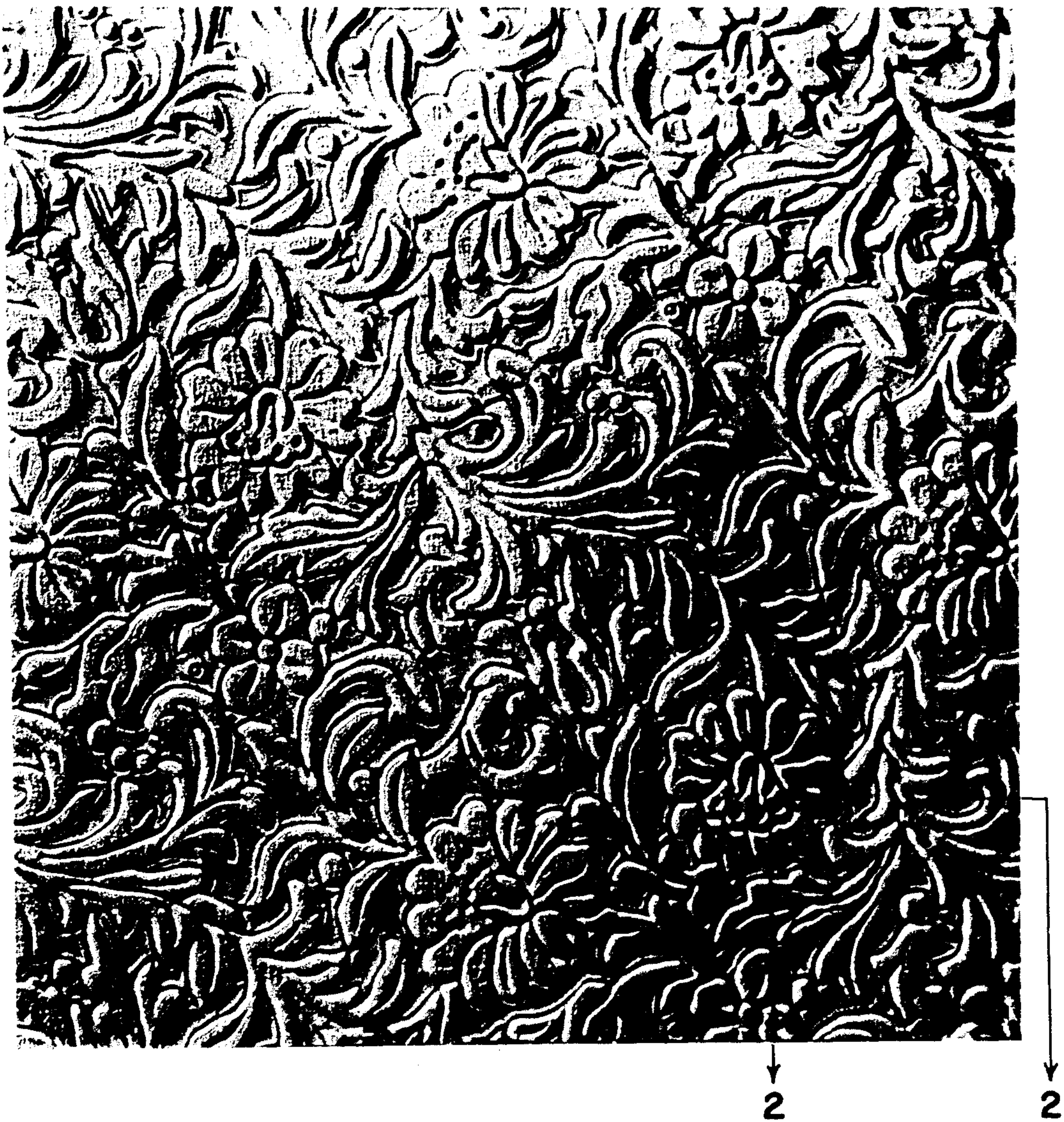

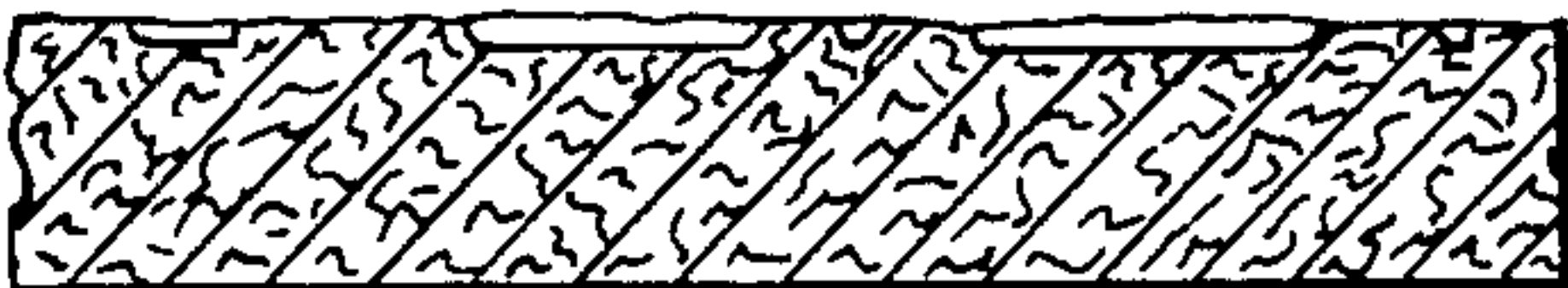
