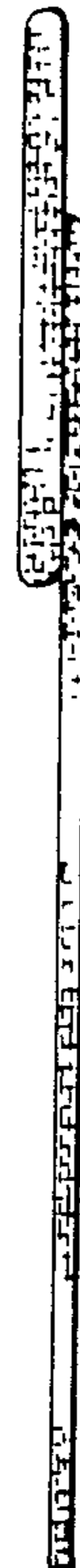
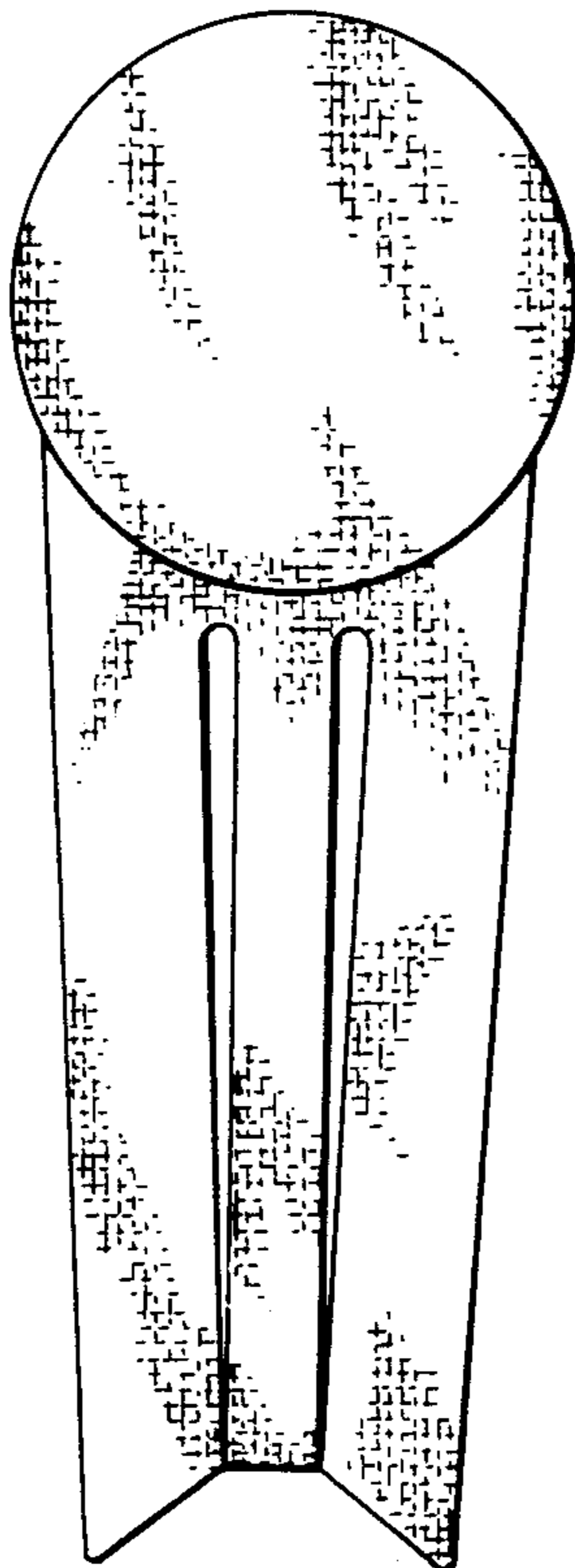
The ornamental design for neckwear, as shown and described.

The rear of both views is plain and unornamental, and is obscured and concealed when the neckwear is worn.



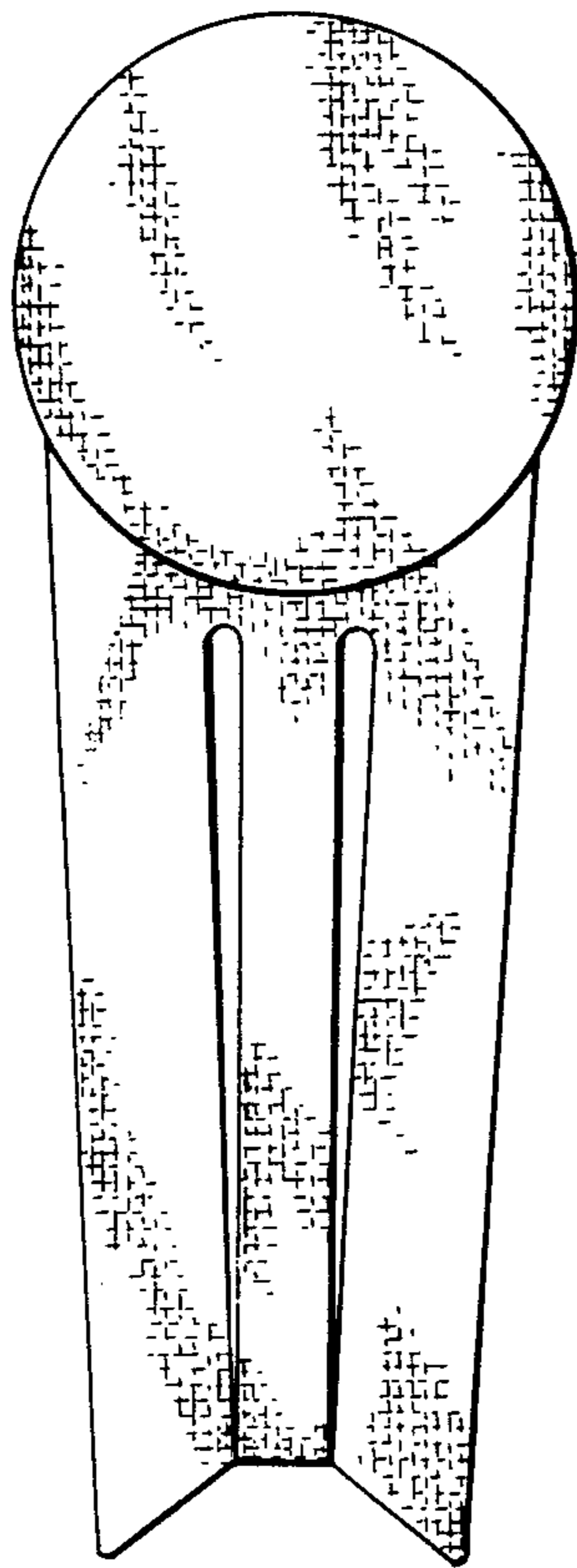
