DESCRIPTION

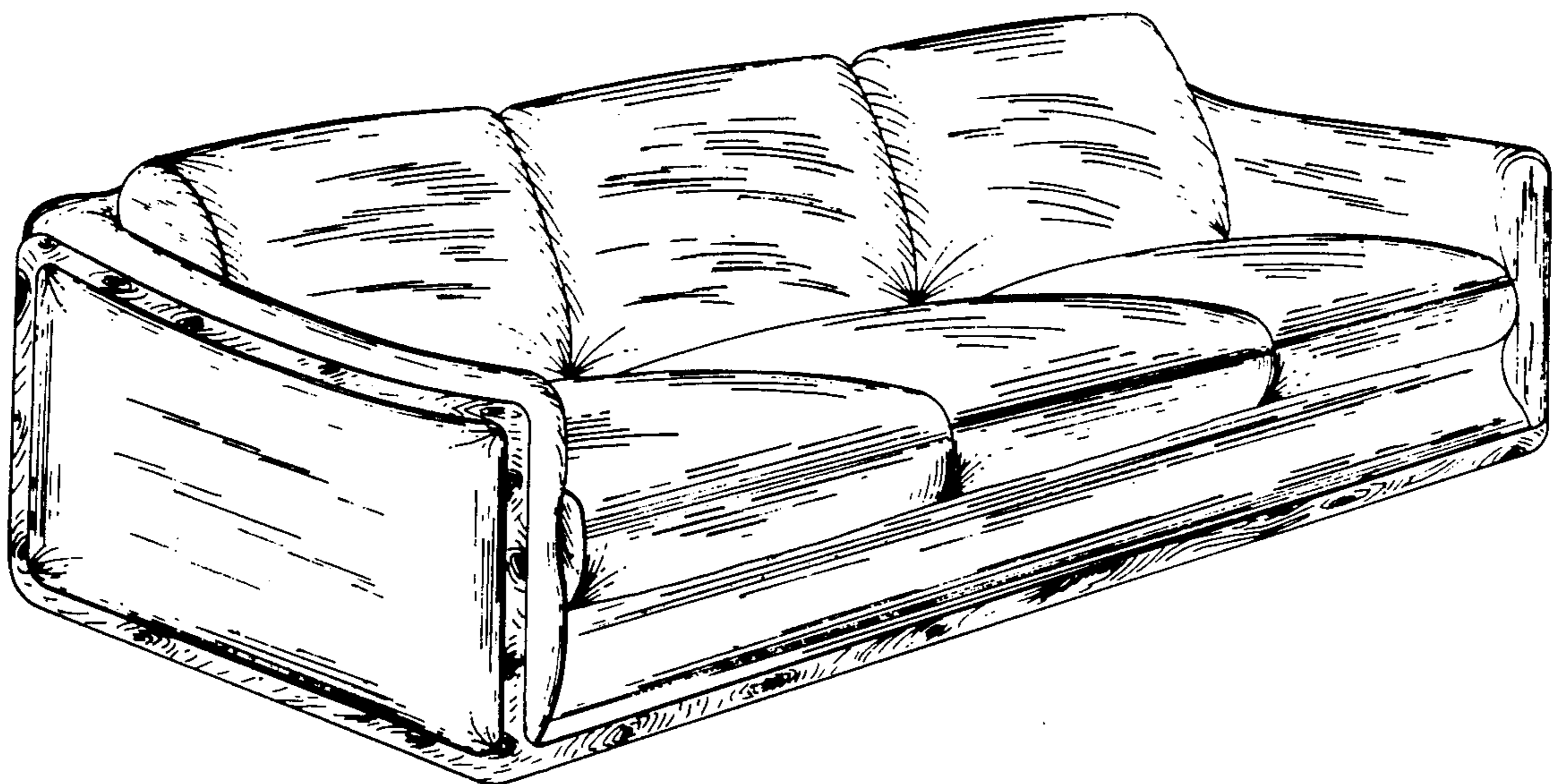
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a sofa showing my new invention,

The end of the sofa not shown is a mirror image of the side shown.



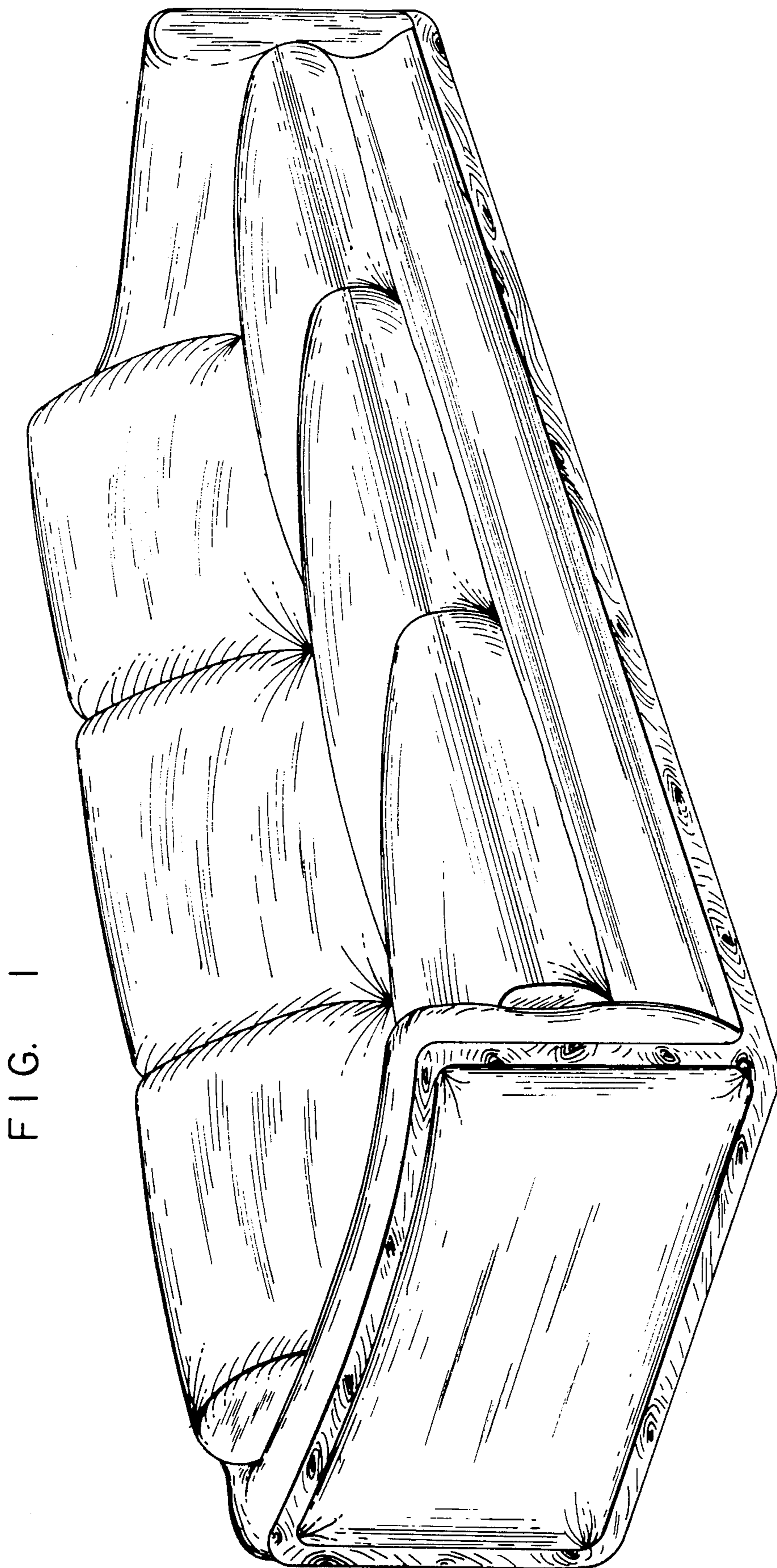

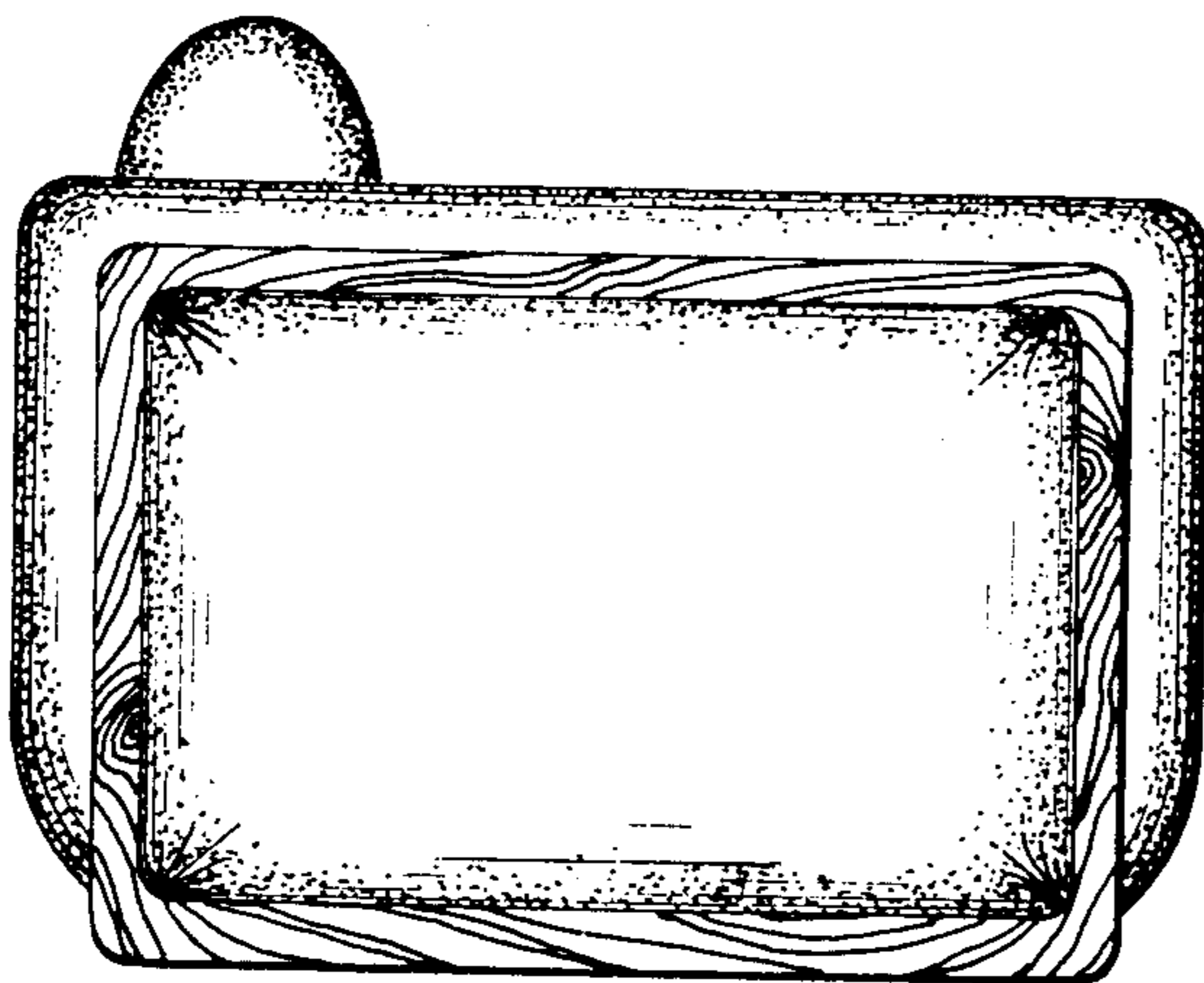
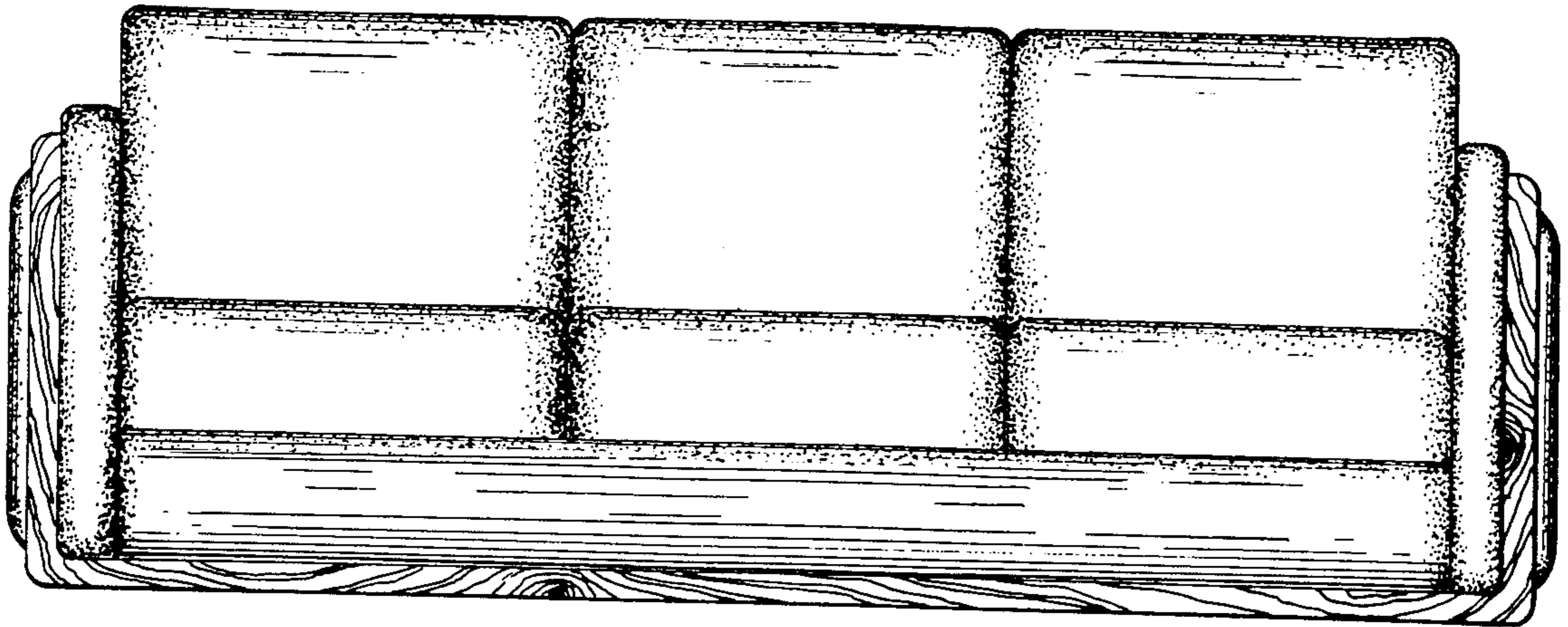
