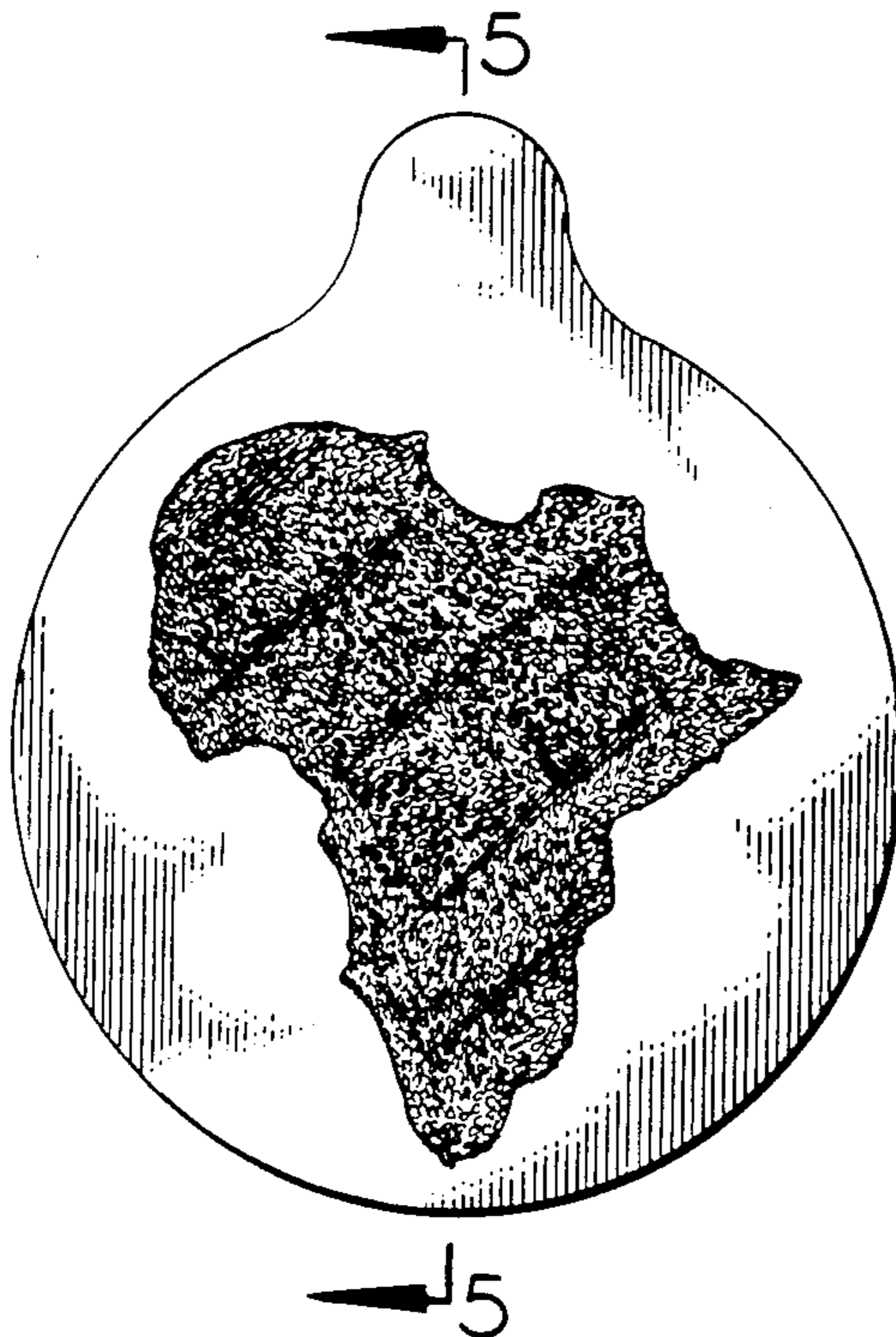

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a soil containing medallion, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an elevational view of the front of a soil containing medallion showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is an elevational view of the right side thereof, the left side being identical thereto; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and FIG. 5 is a sectional view thereof taken along line 5-5 of FIG. 1 and looking in the direction of the arrows.



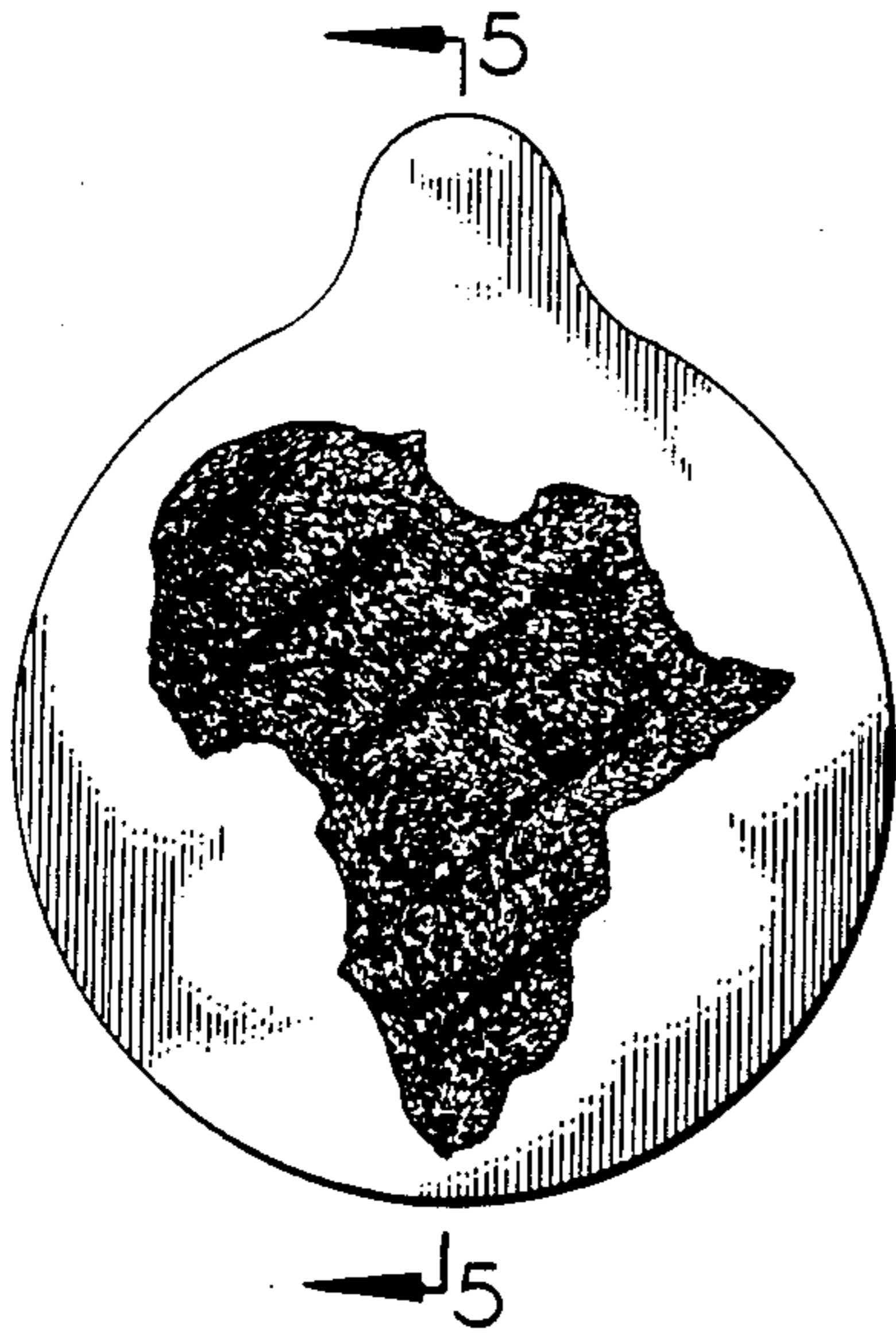

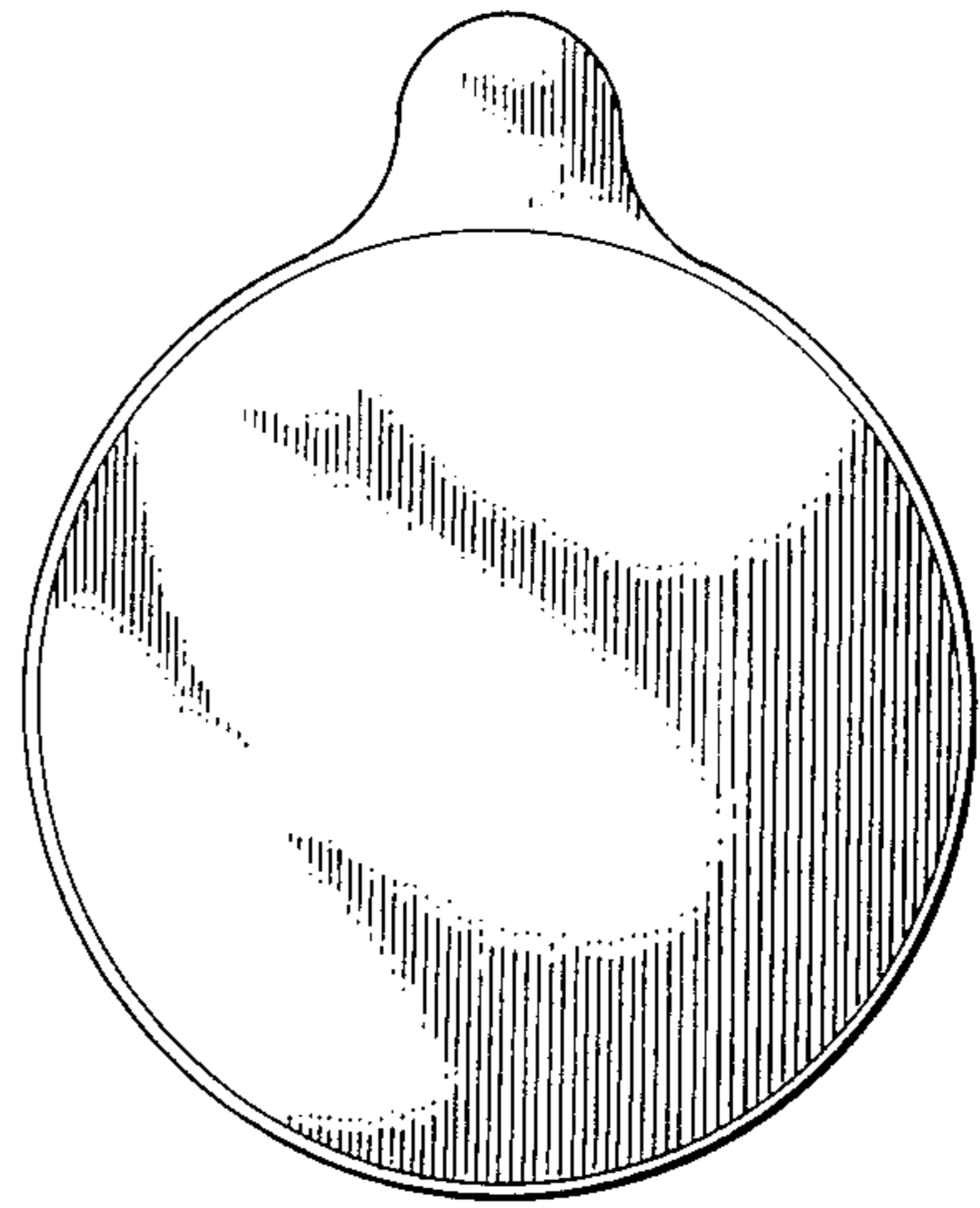

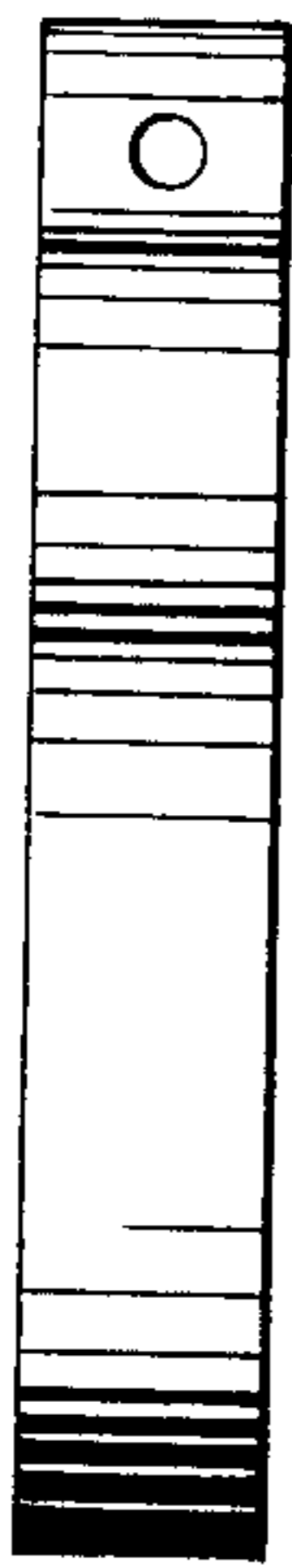

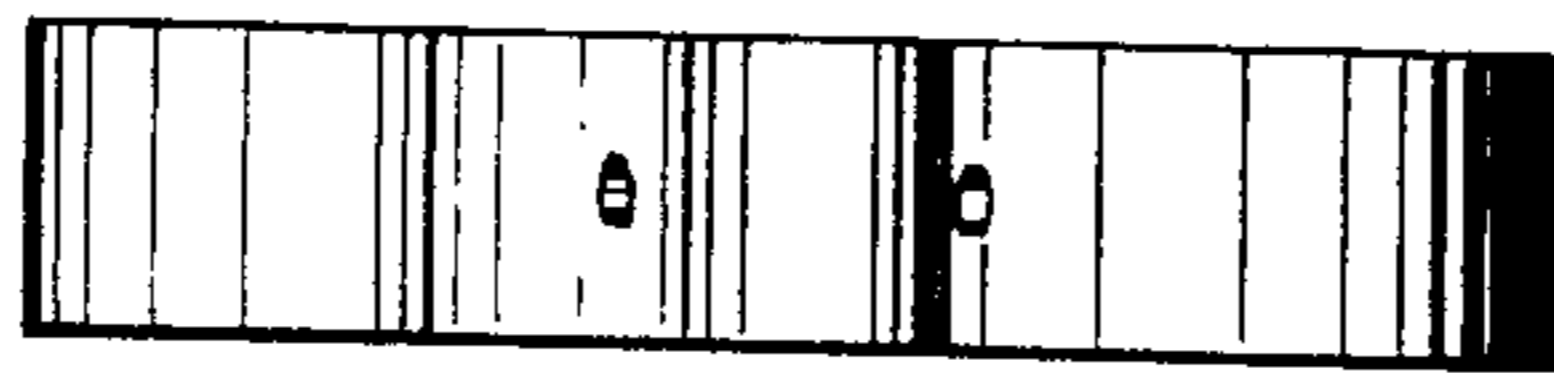
