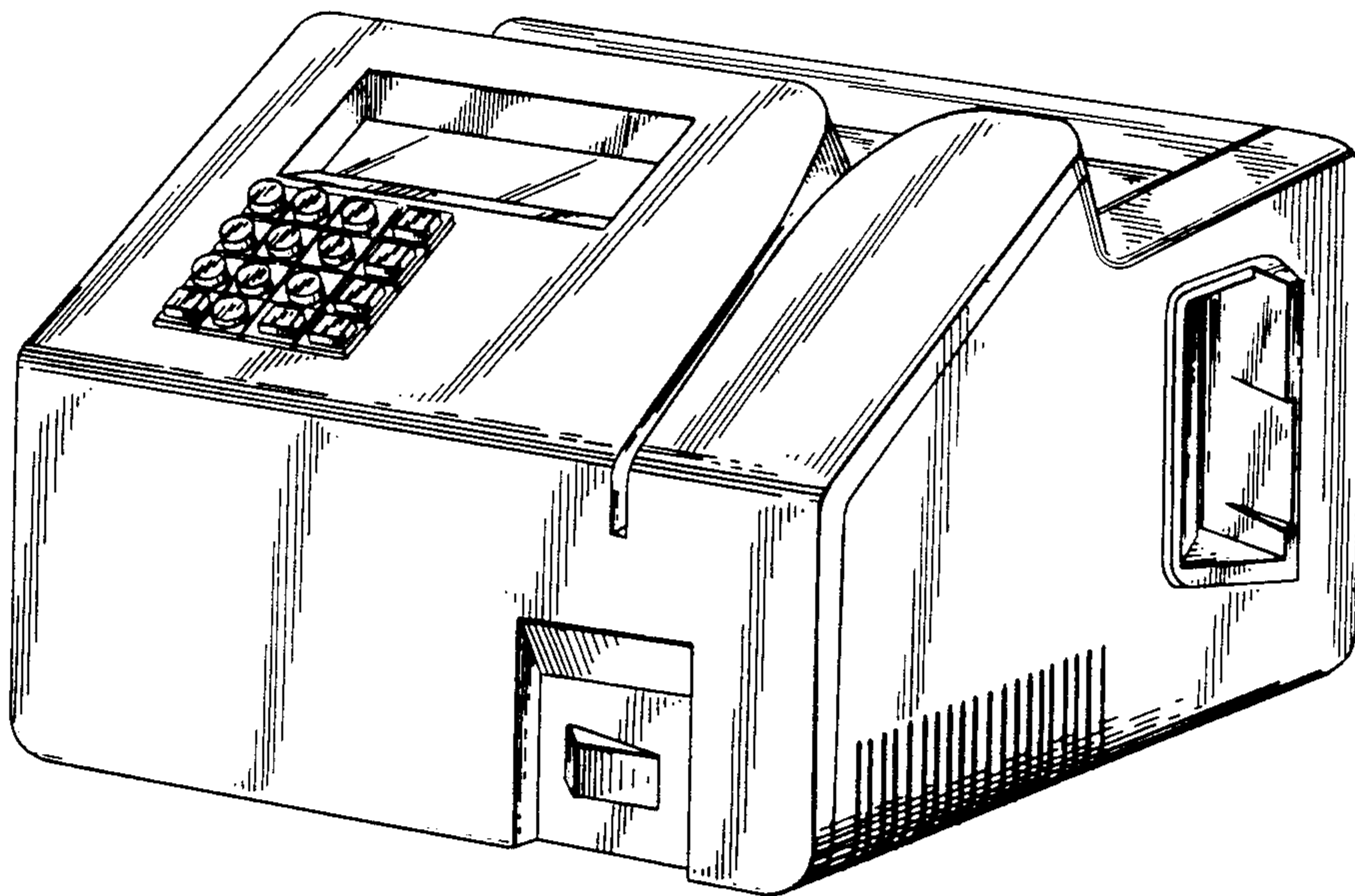

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right perspective view of a financial services
terminal showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof, and
FIG. 3 is a side elevation view thereof.
The bottom surface of our financial services terminal is
substantially unornamented.



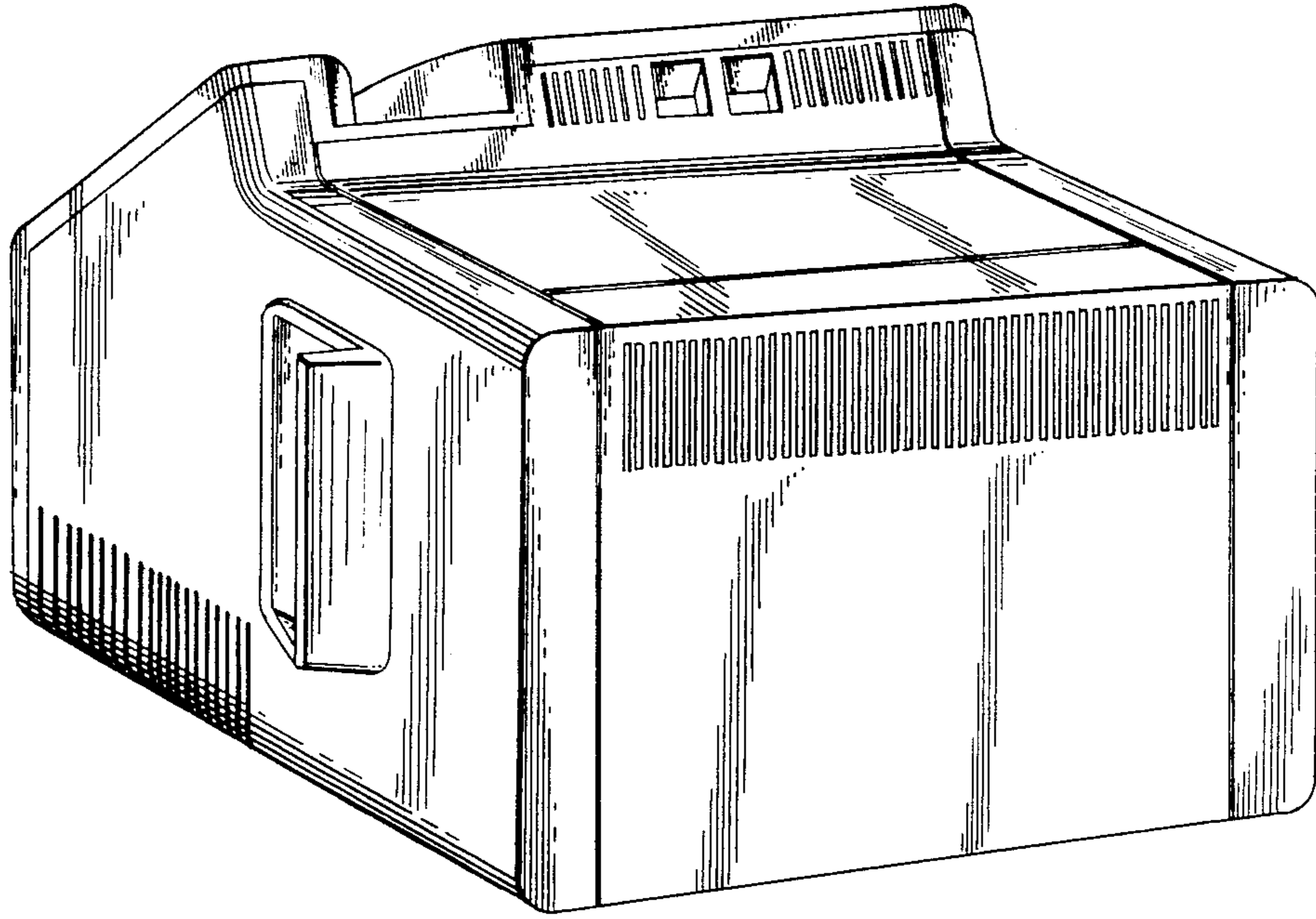

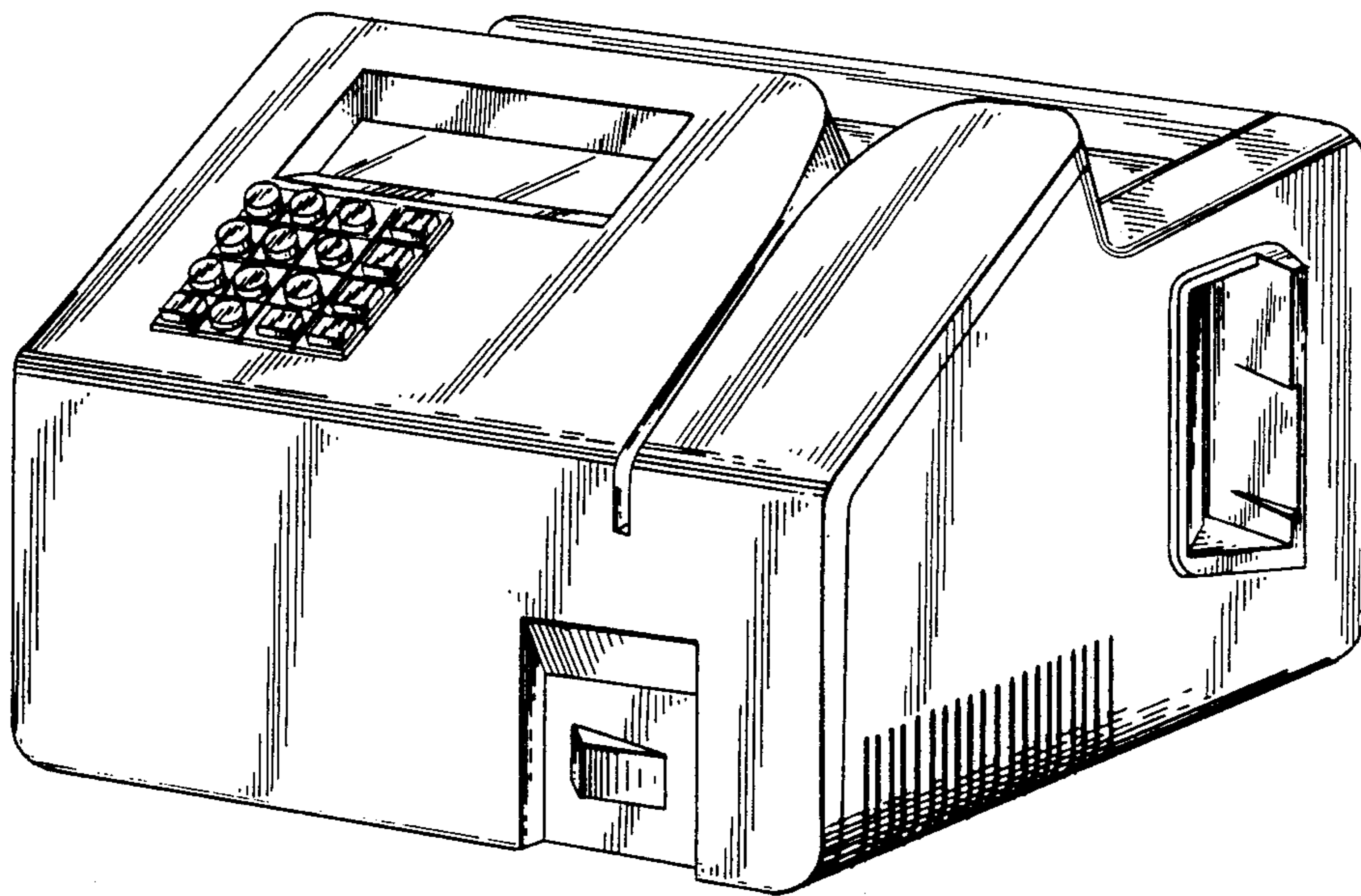

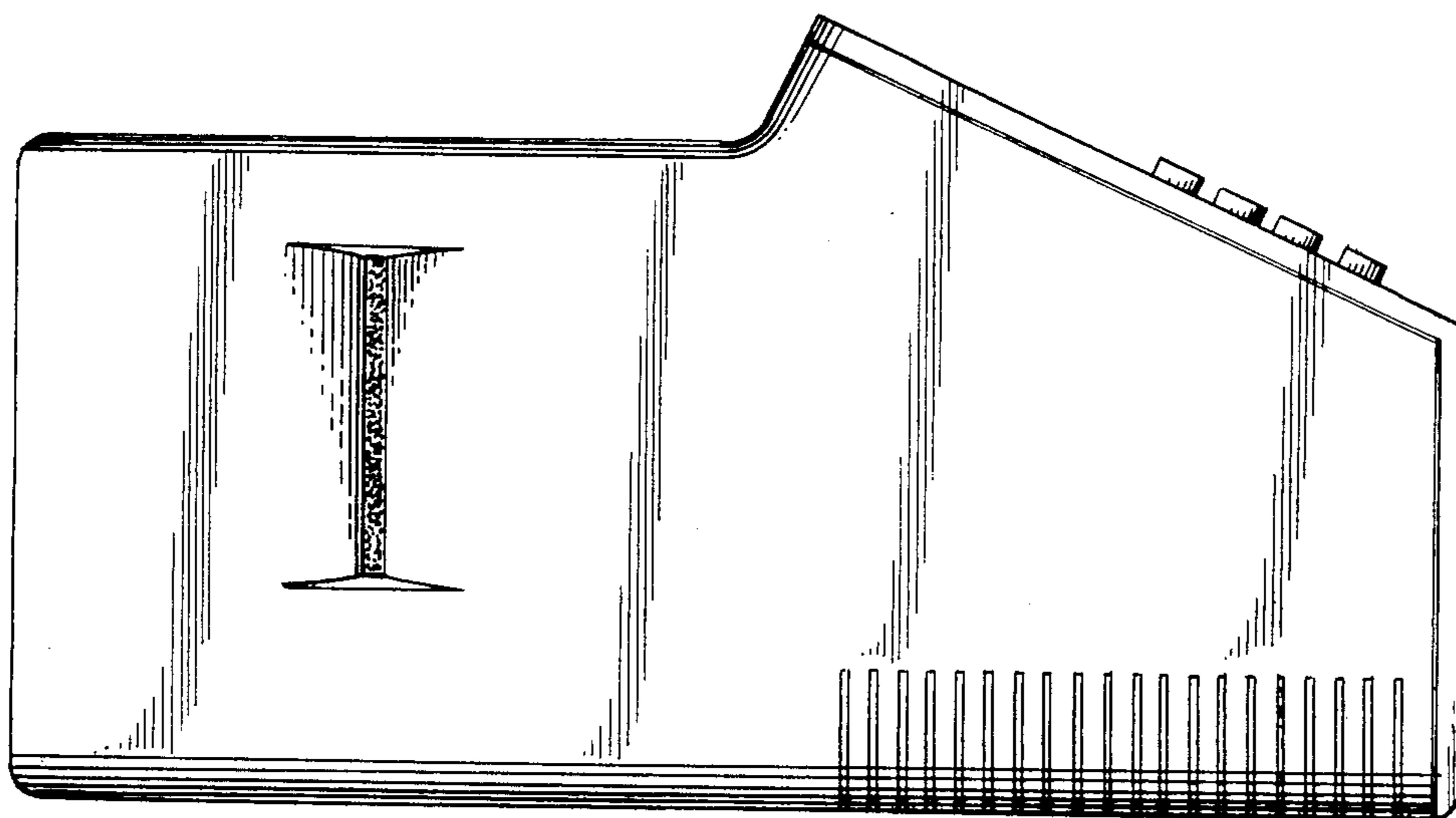
