DESCRIPTION

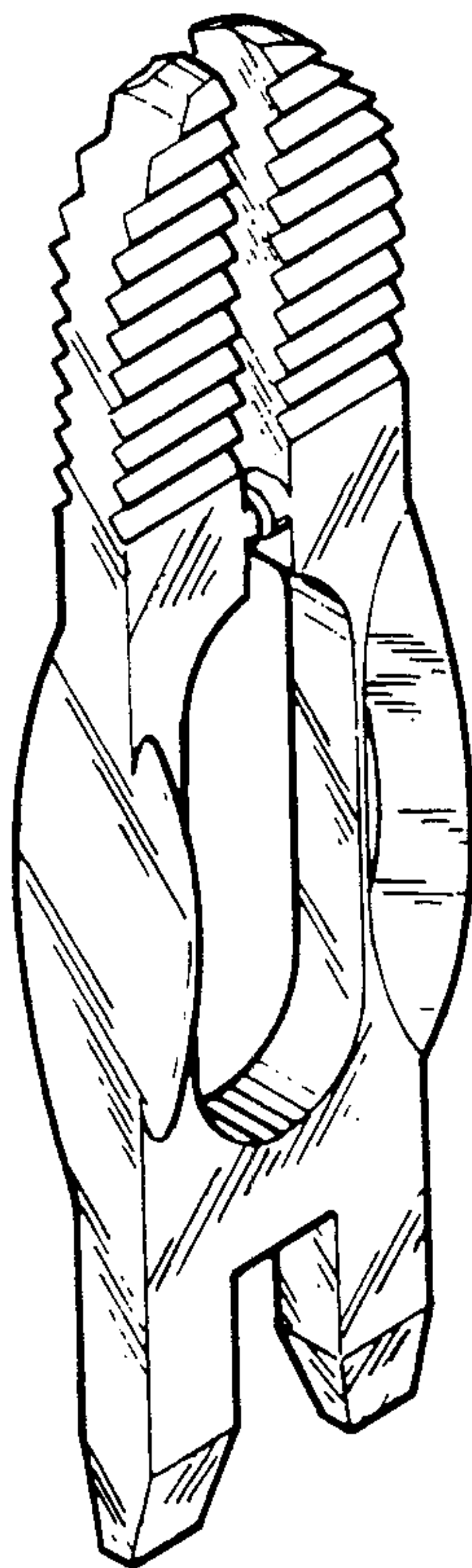
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the clip for holding a liquid-sample cell in a spectrophotometer showing our new design;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view.



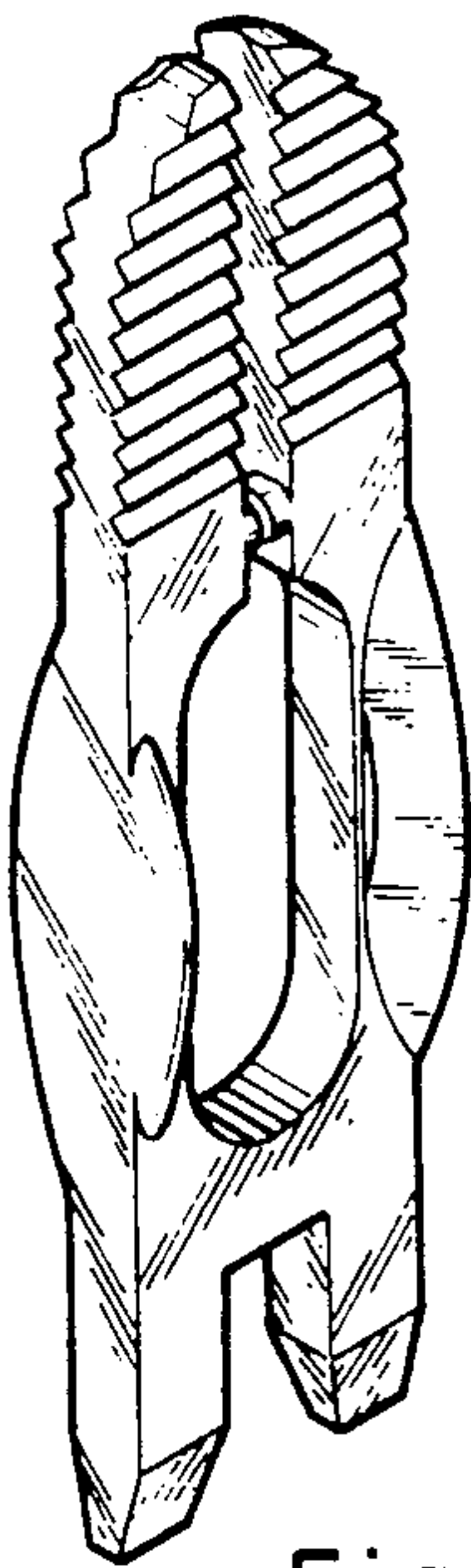

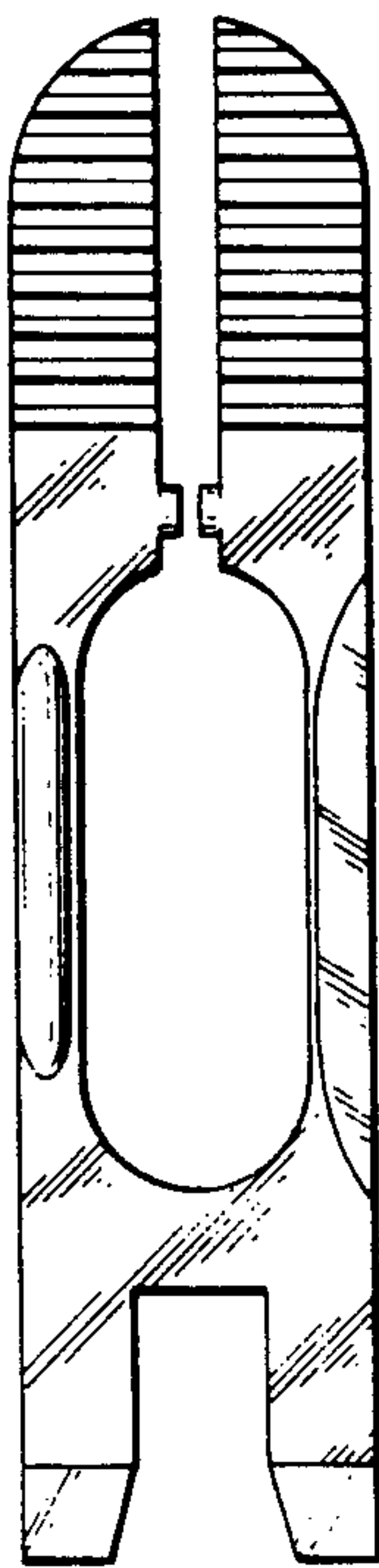

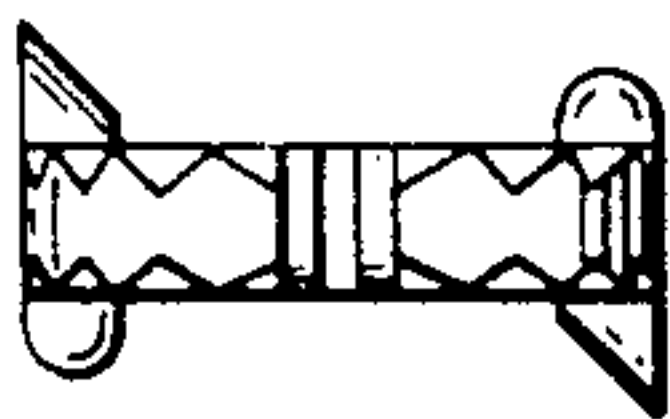

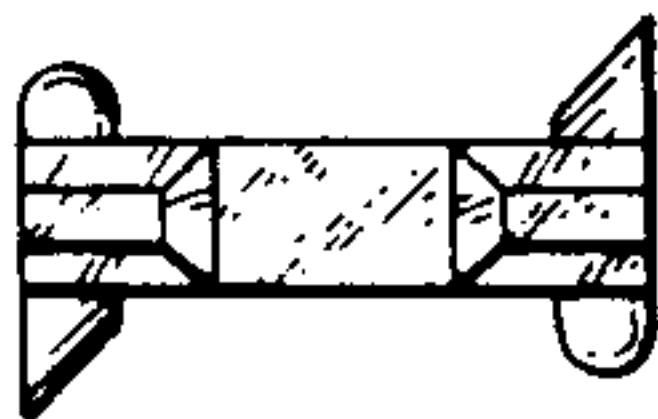

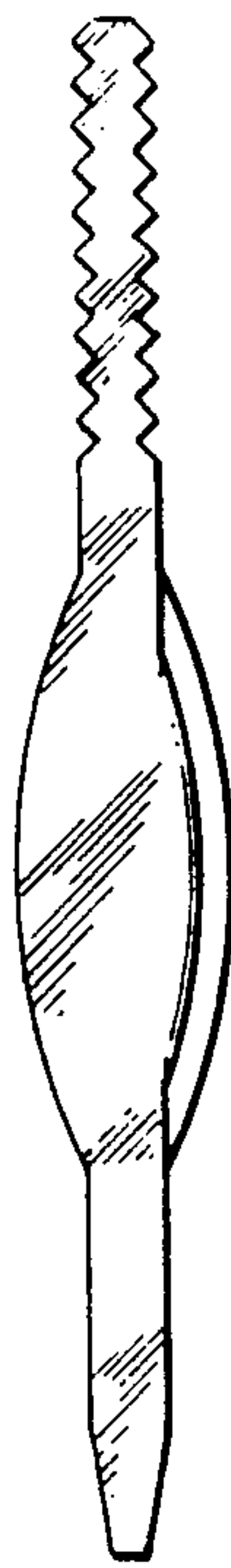
