DESCRIPTION

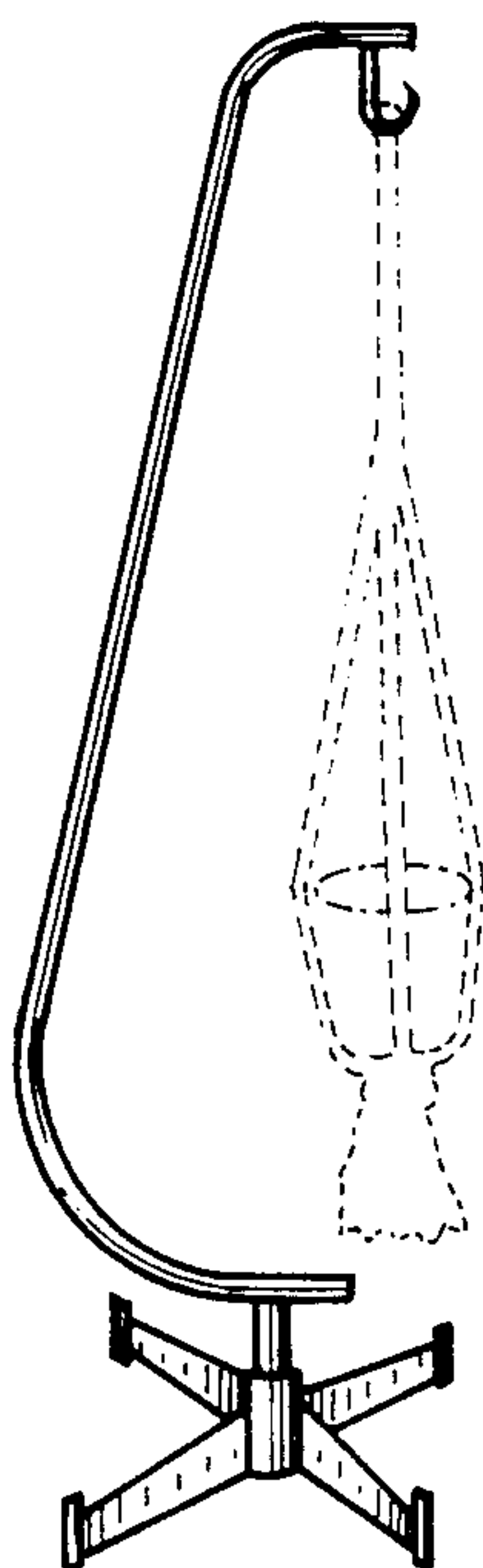
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a support stand for flower pots or the like showing my new design, the hanging flower pot being shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of FIG. 4.



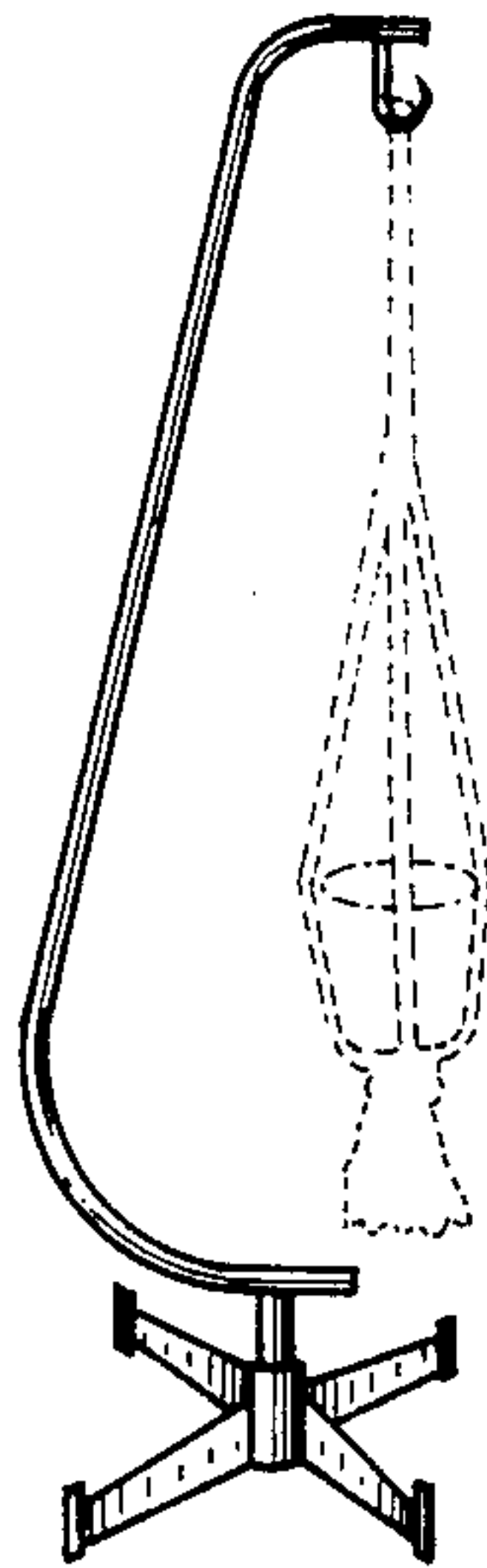

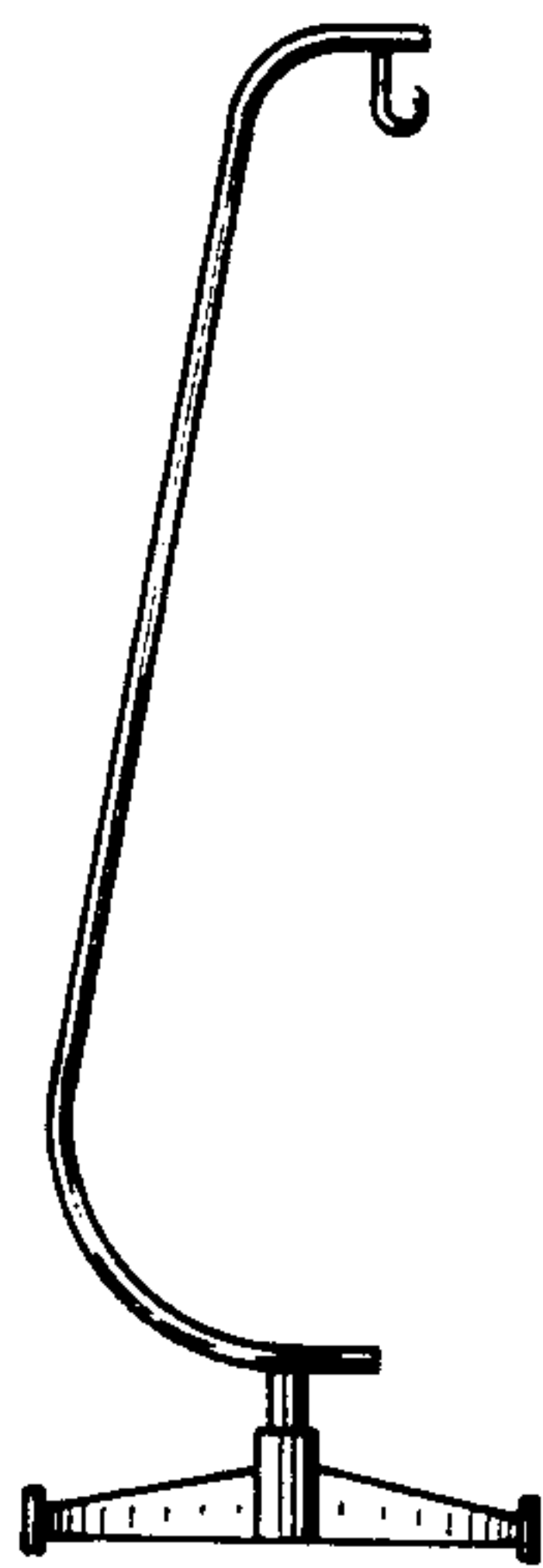

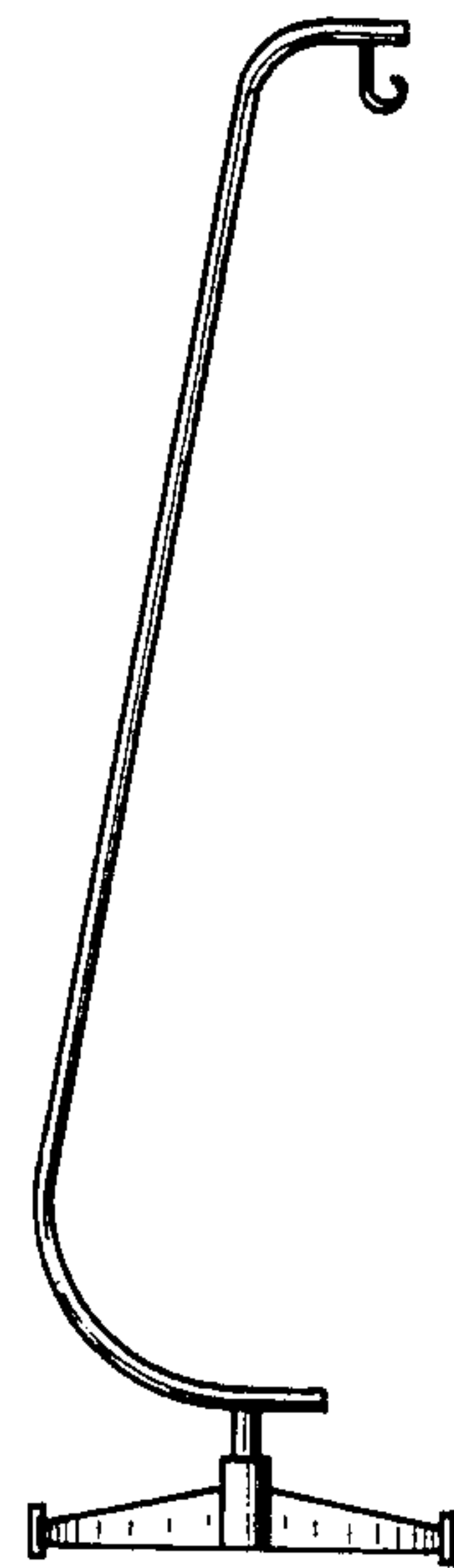

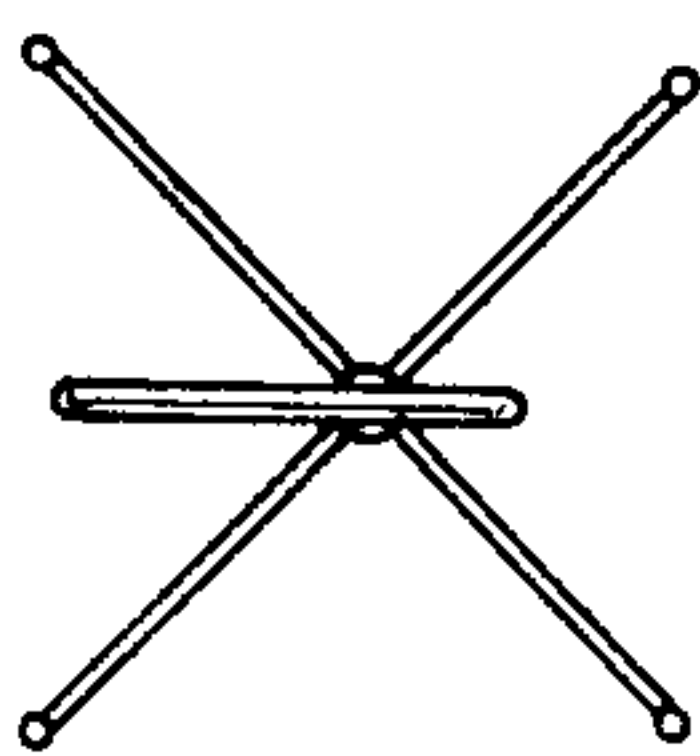

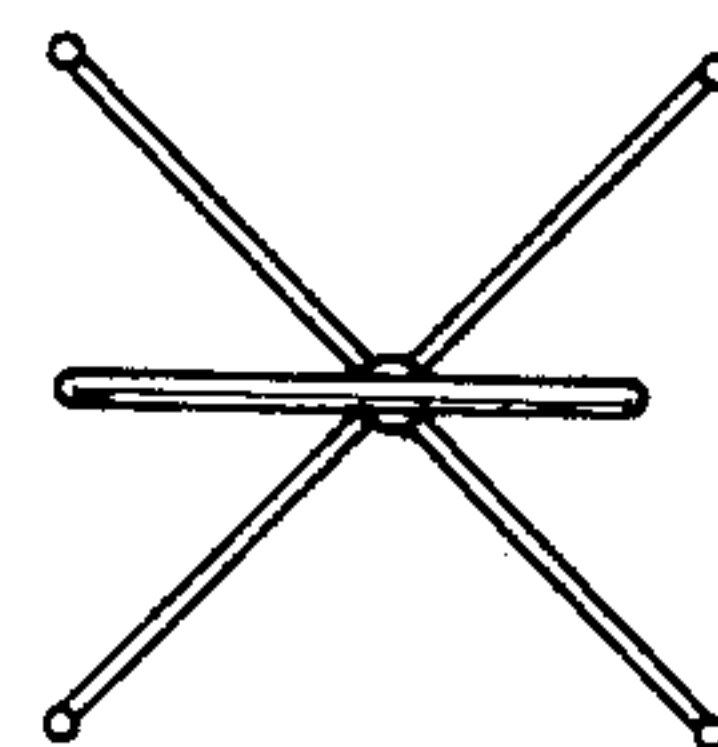
