DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side perspective view of a display stand for packaged articles showing my new design;

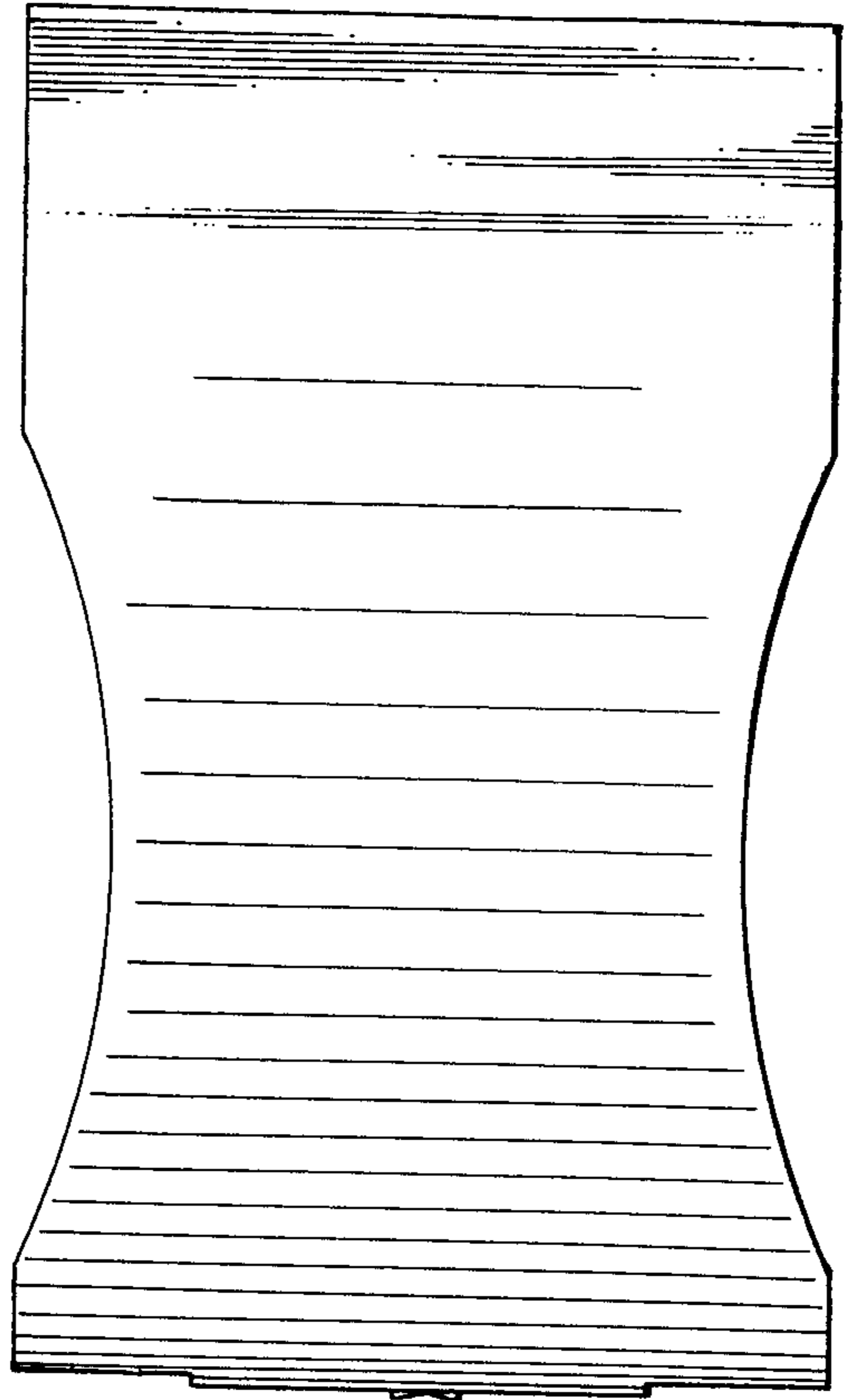

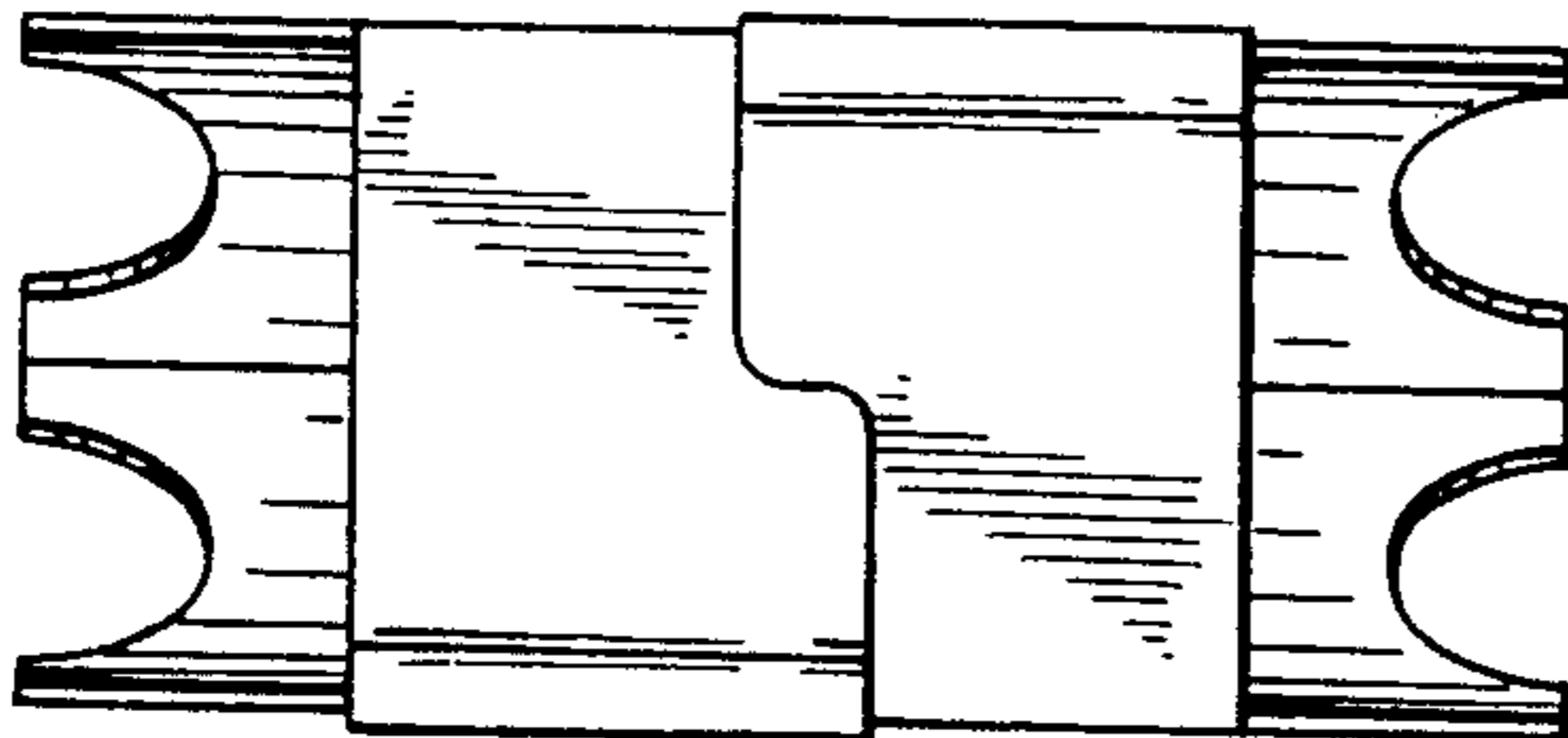
