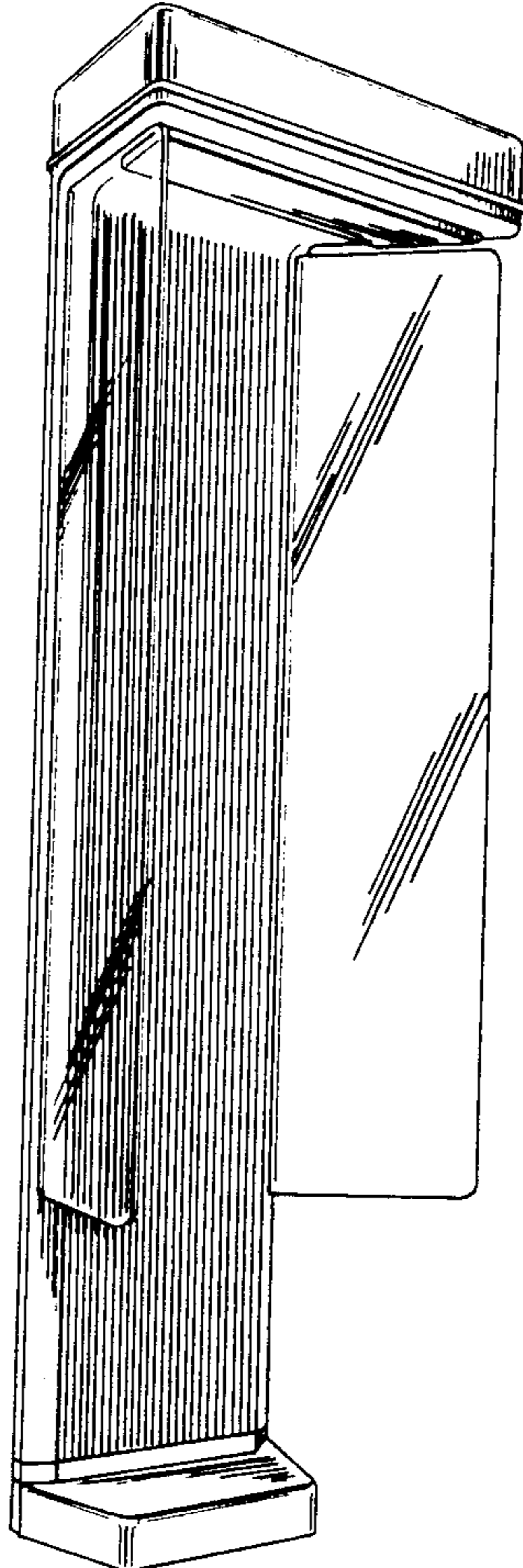

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a telephone stand, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a telephone stand, FIG. 2 is a front elevational view, FIG. 3 is a side elevational view, FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof, FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of a variation of the telephone stand described above, FIG. 6 is a side elevational view, and FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof.



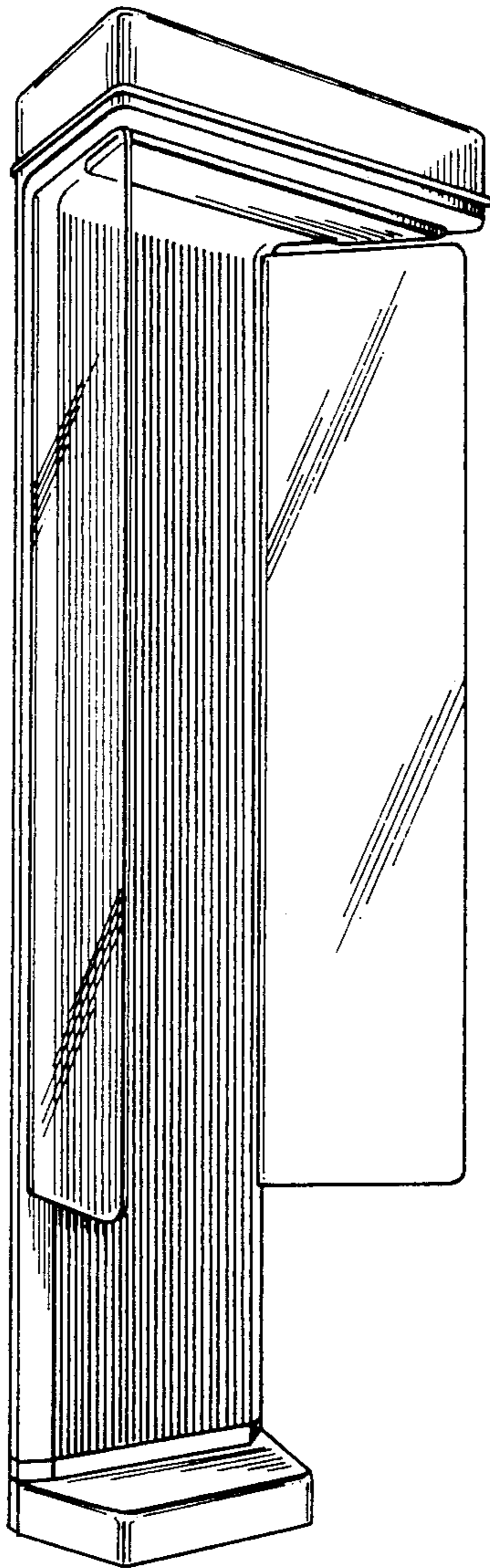

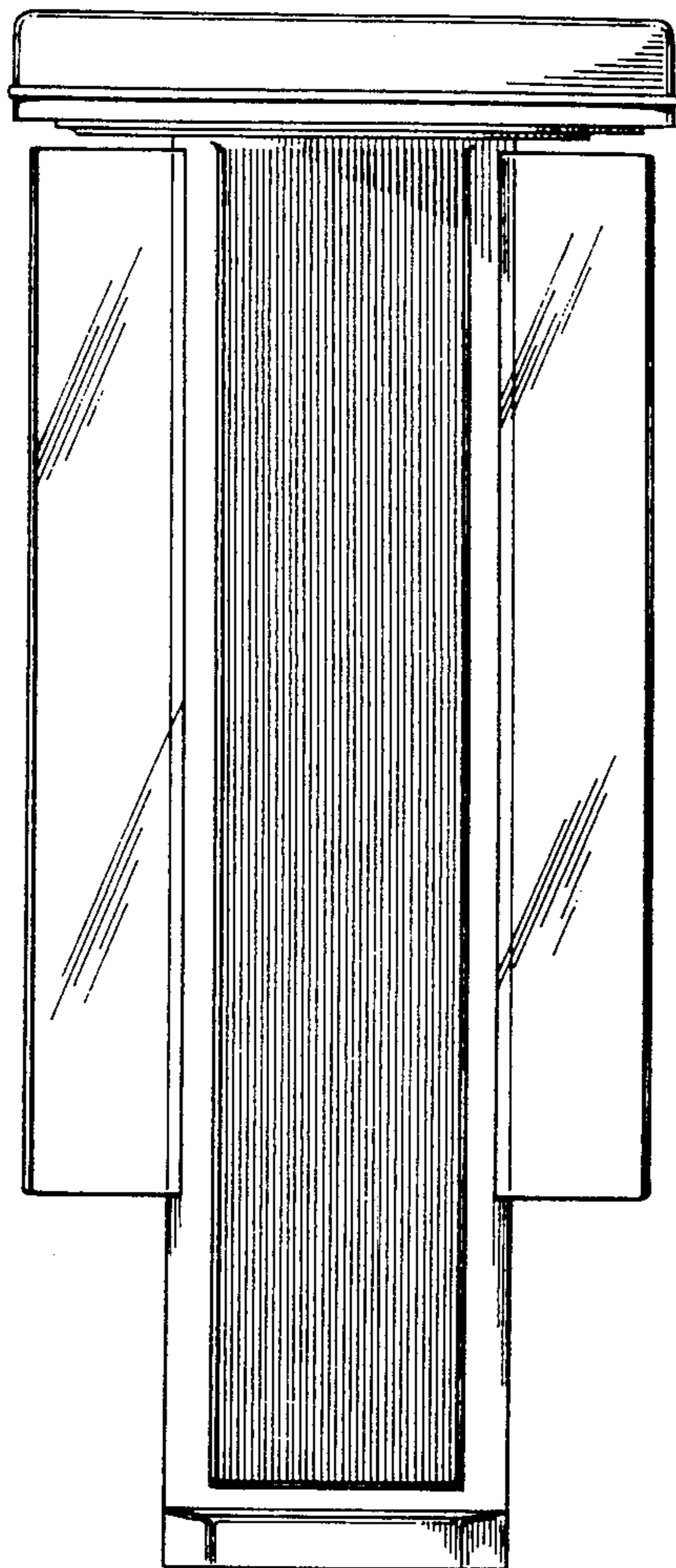

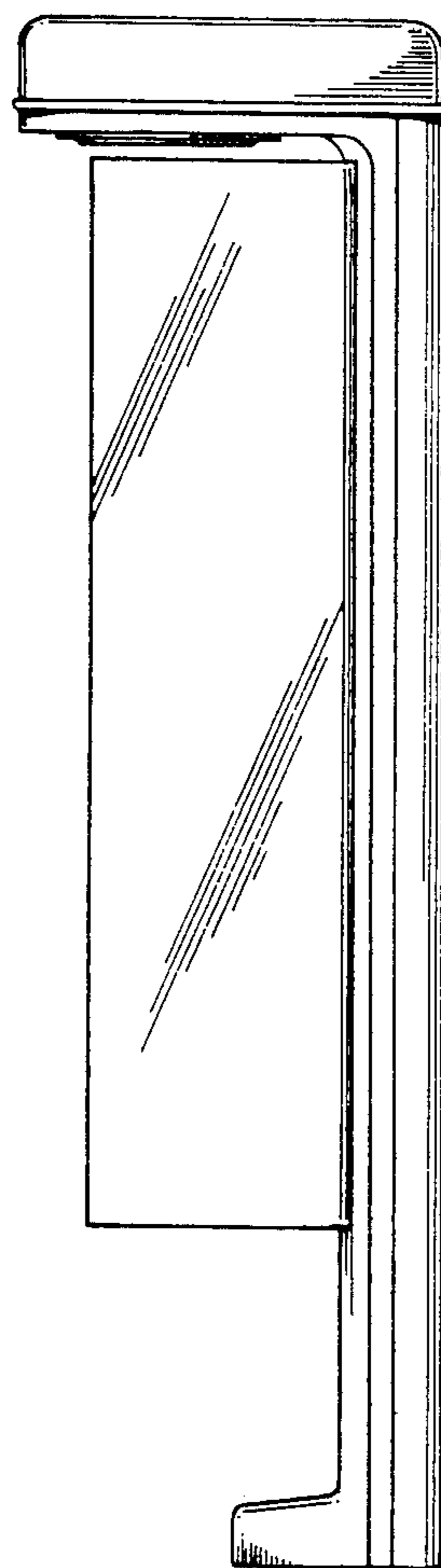

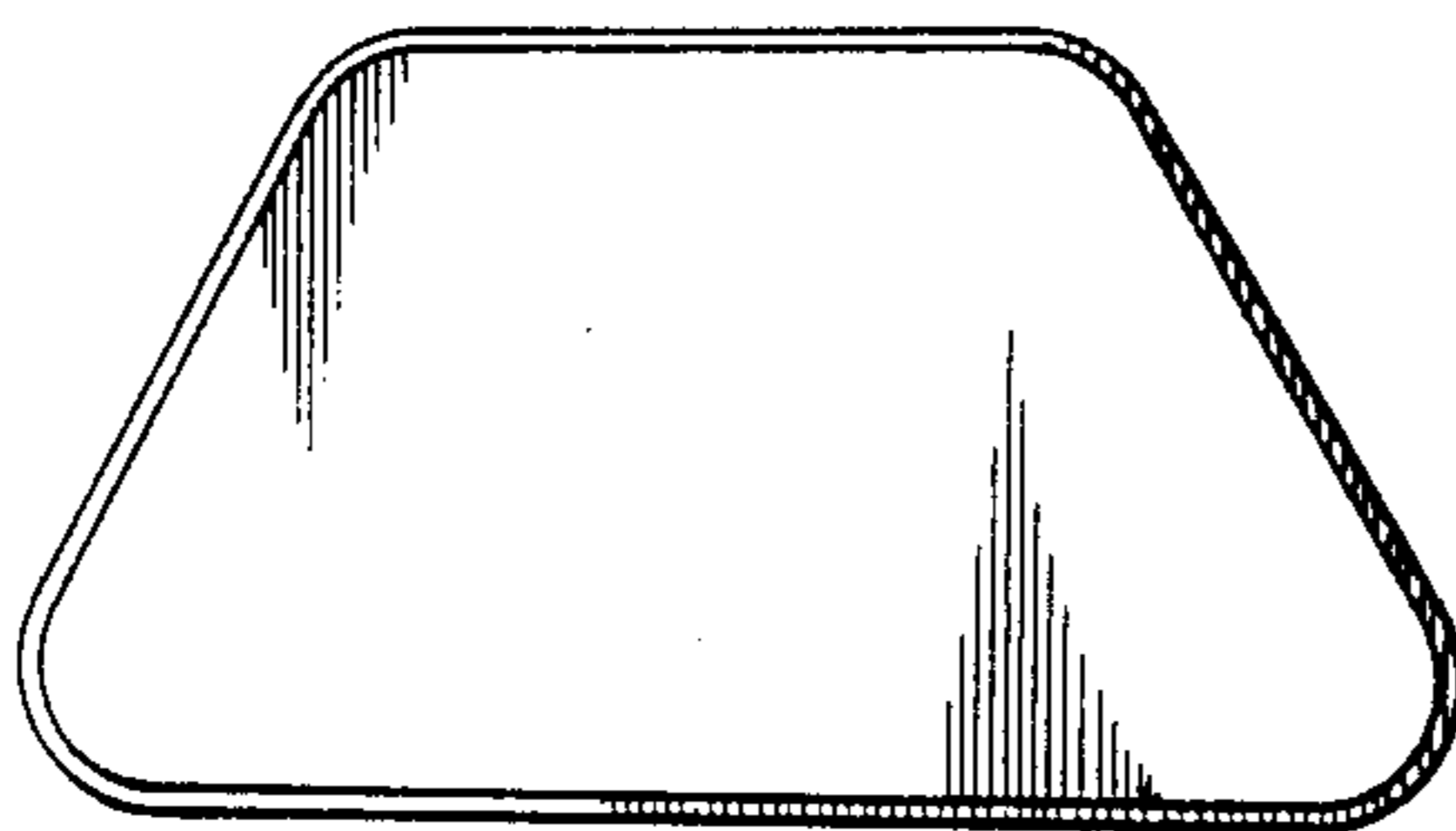

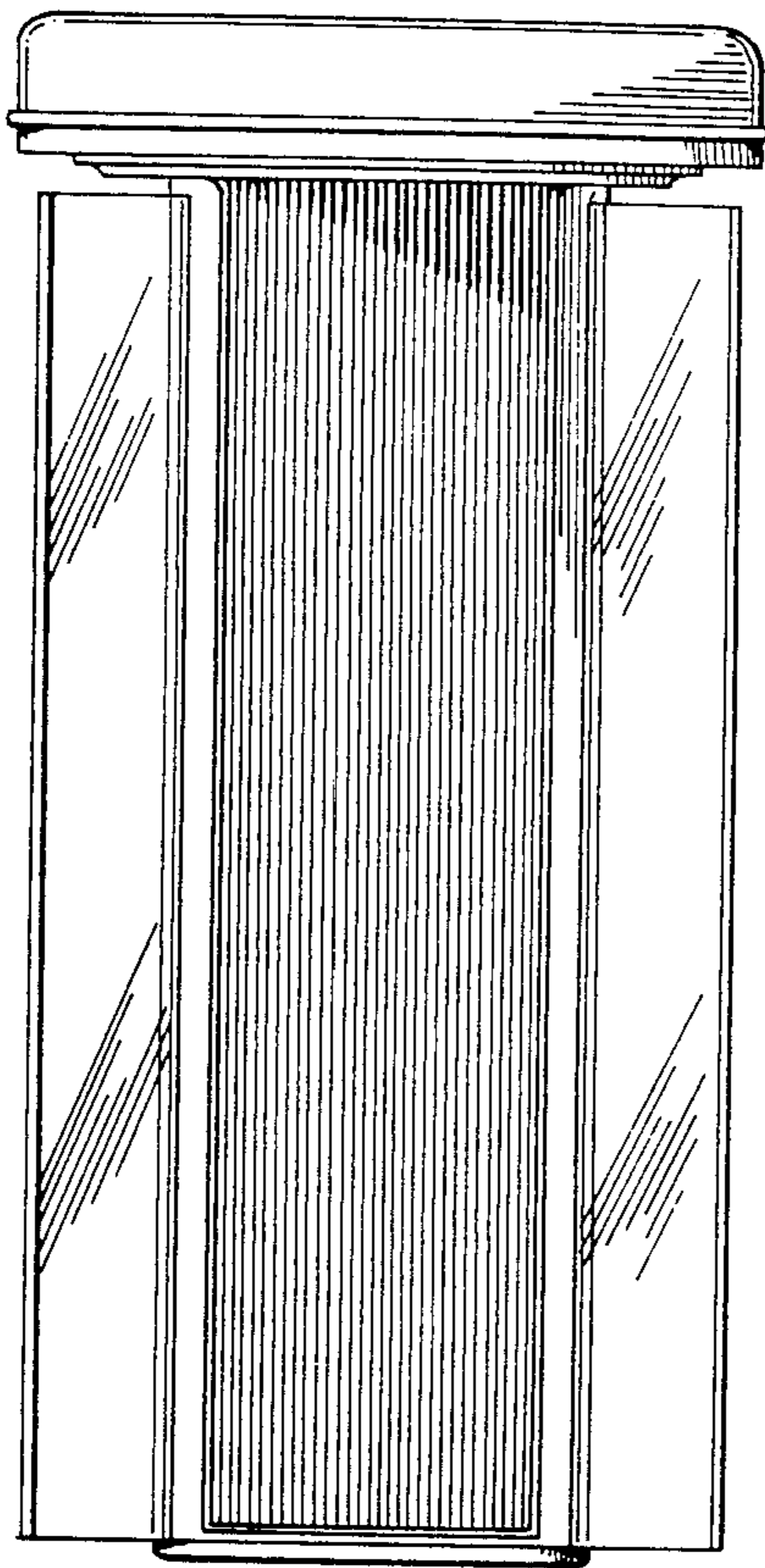

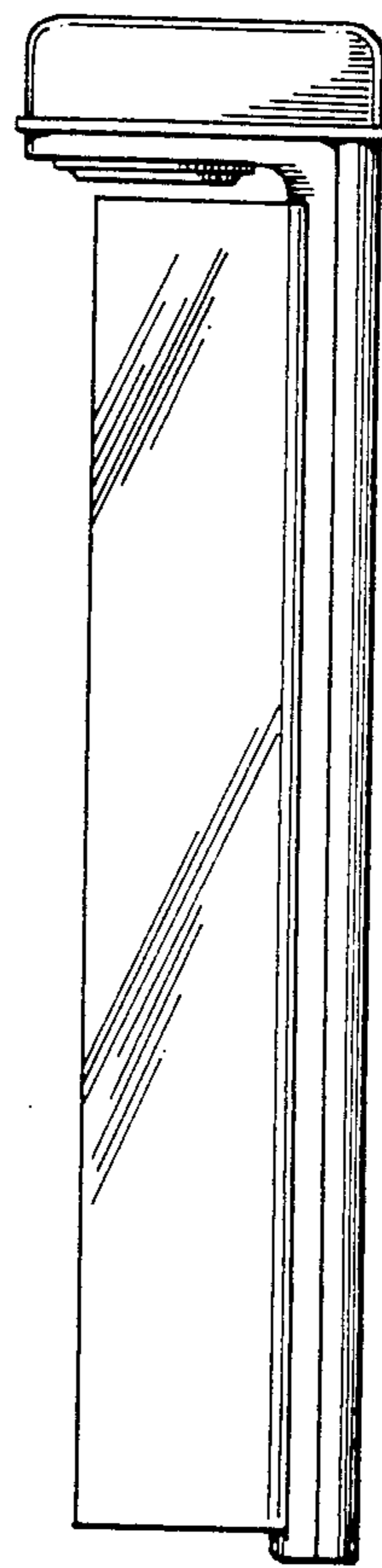

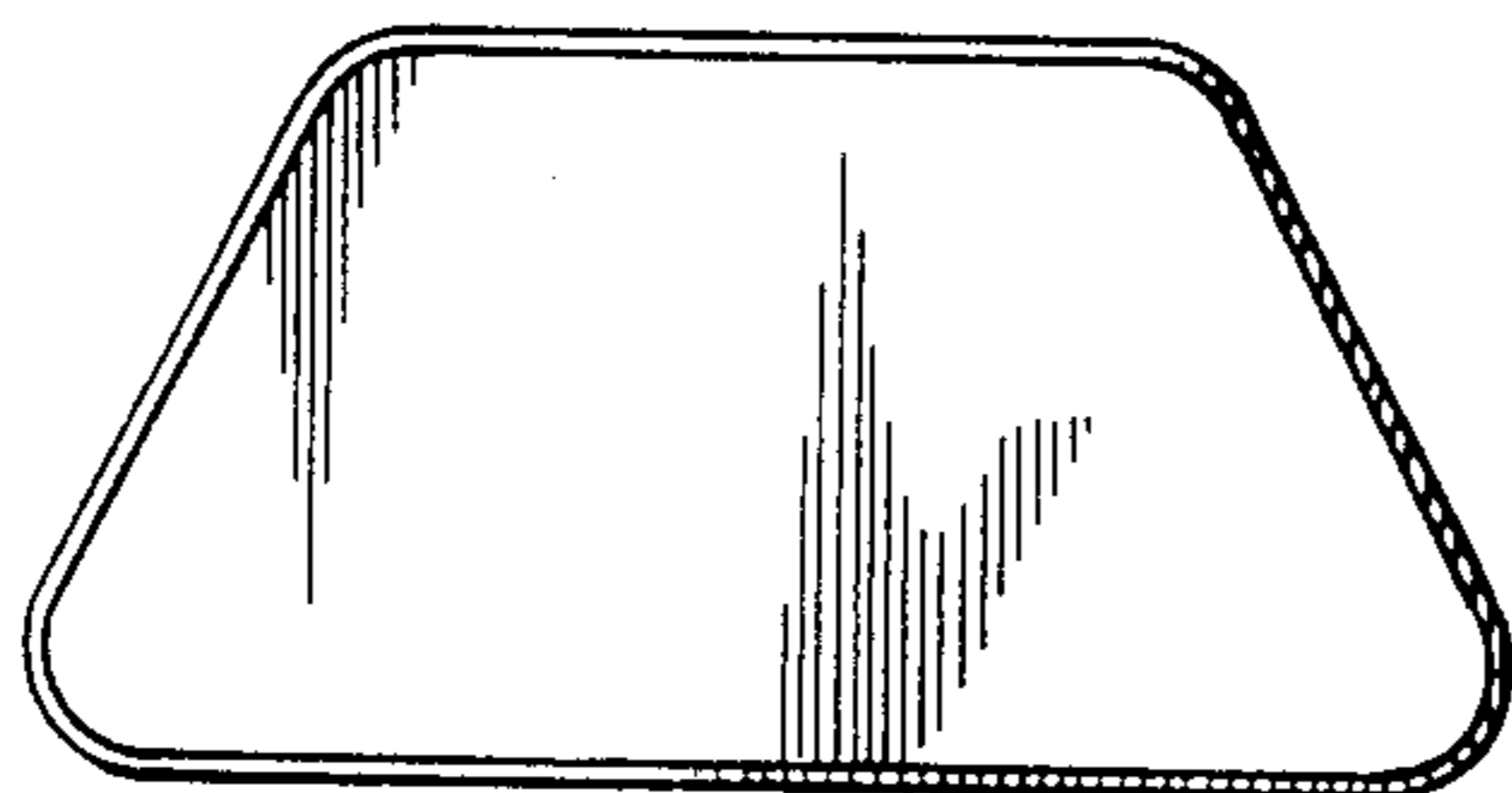
