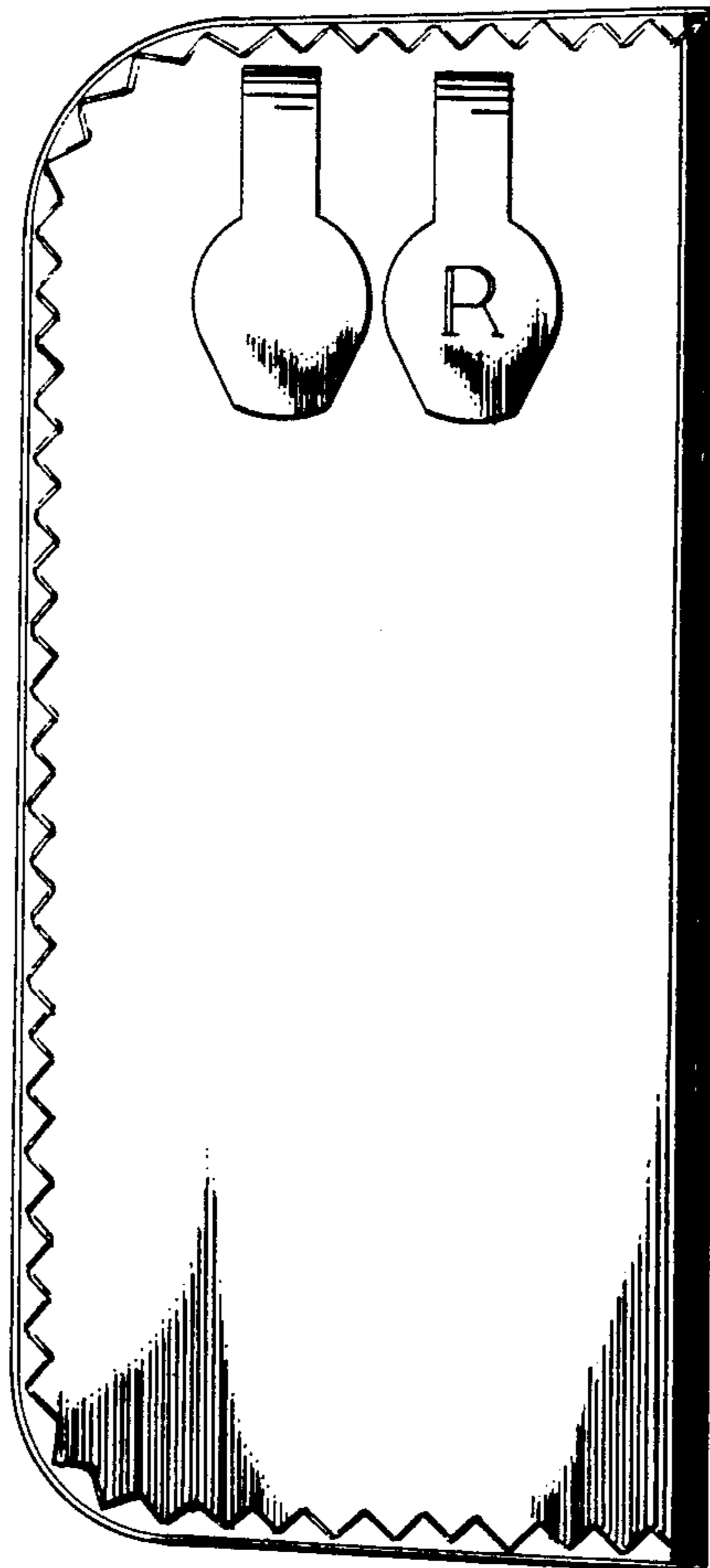

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combination lens and eyeglass case, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a combination lens and eyeglass case showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is an elevational view as seen from the right of FIG. 1;  
FIG. 3 is a view similar to FIG. 1 showing the lens holders open;  
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and  
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 7 is an elevational view as seen from the left of FIG. 1.



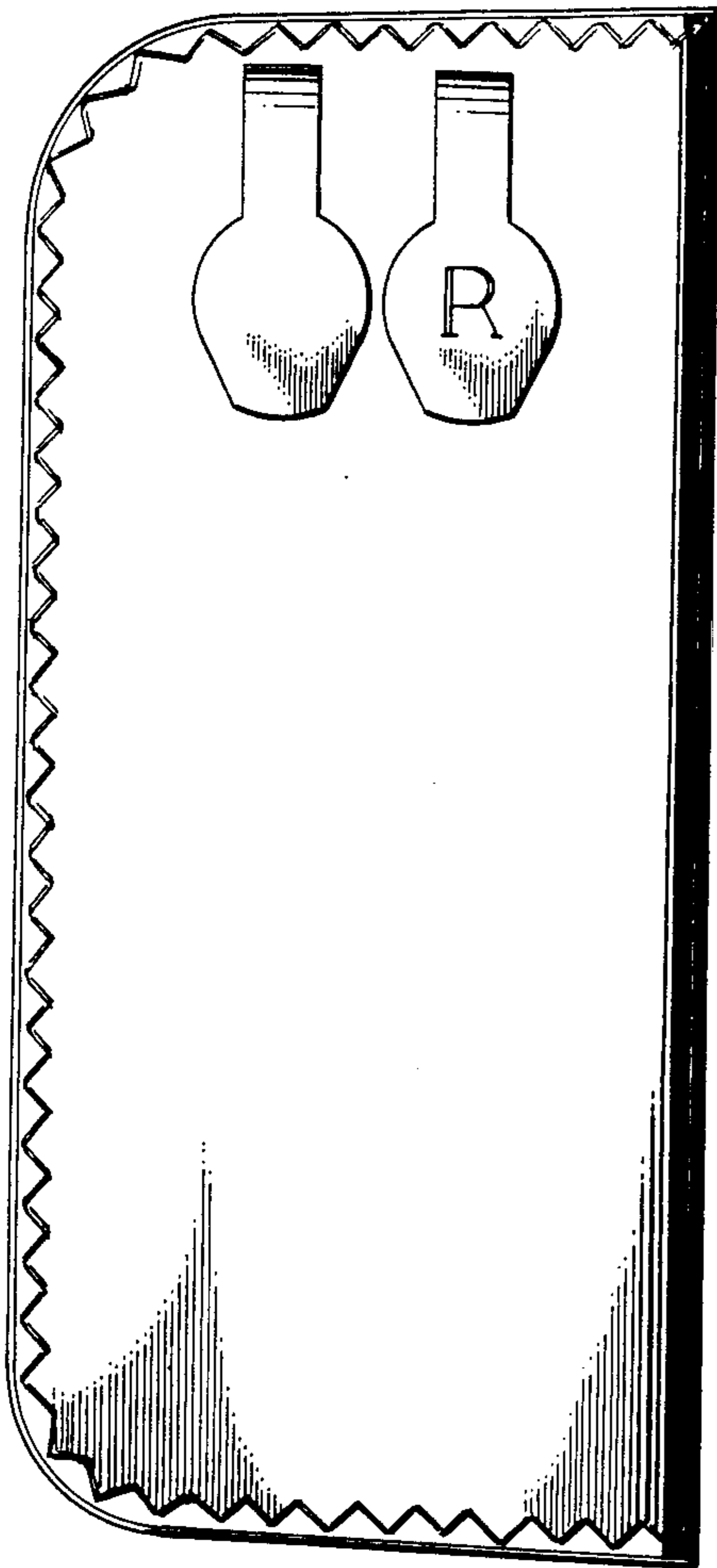

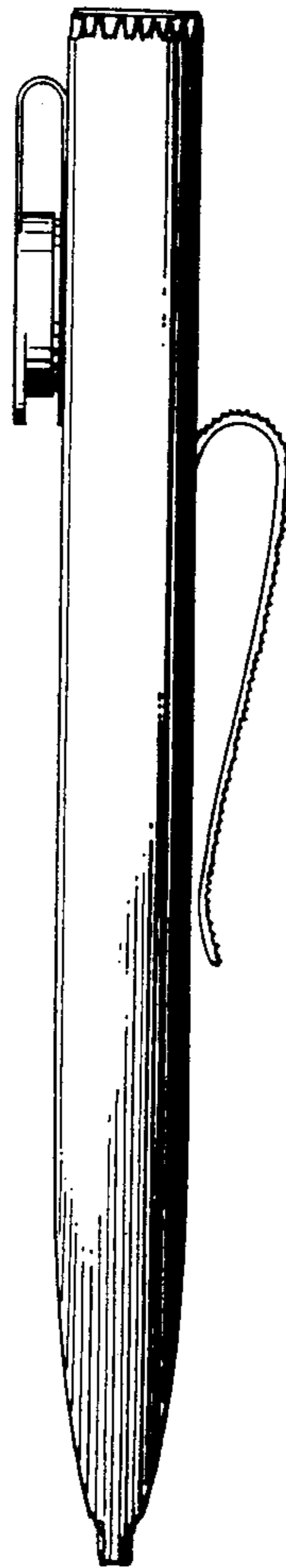

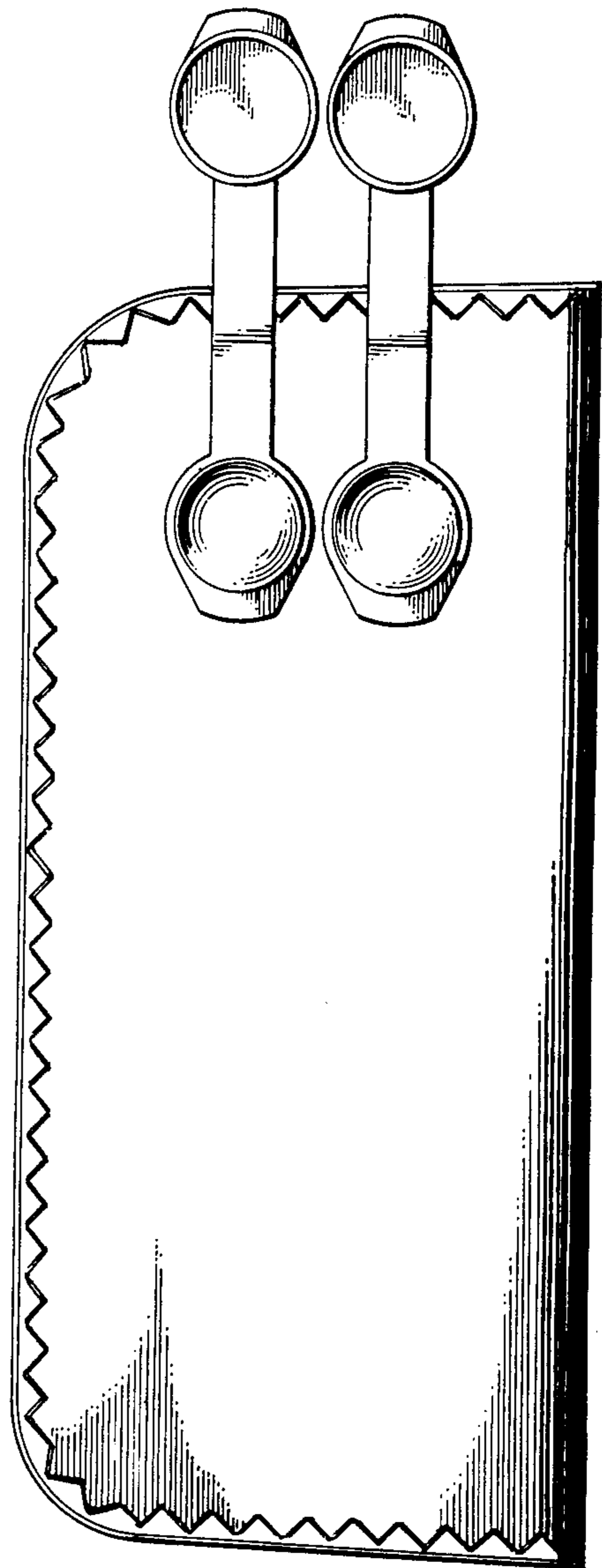

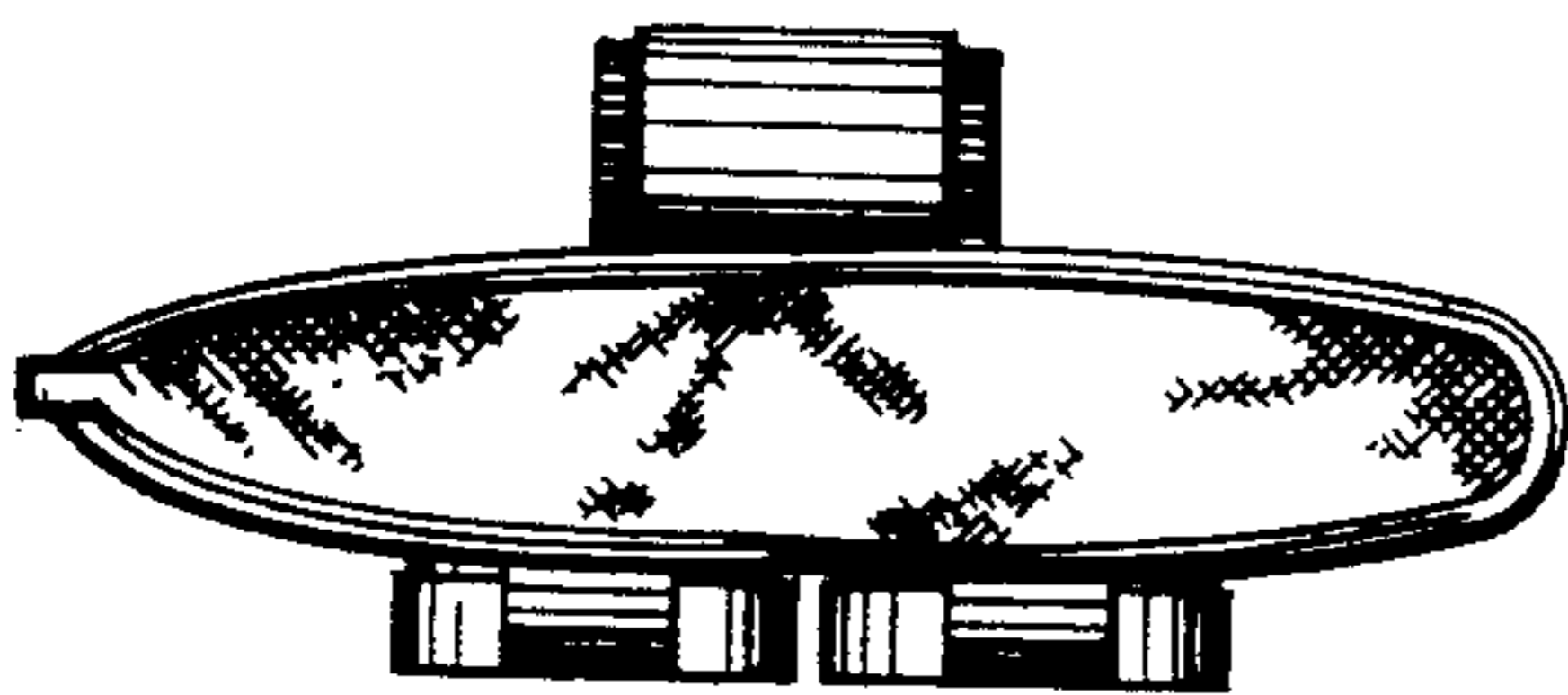

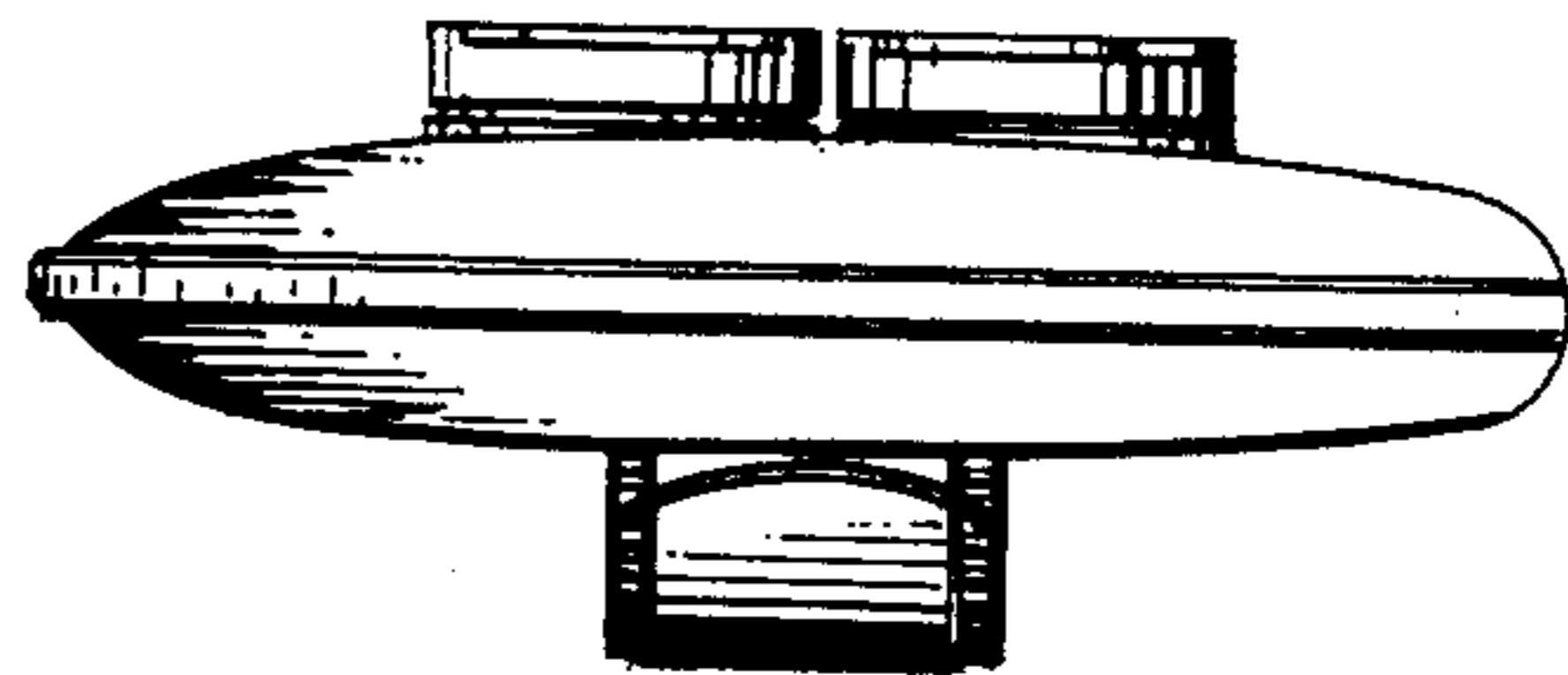

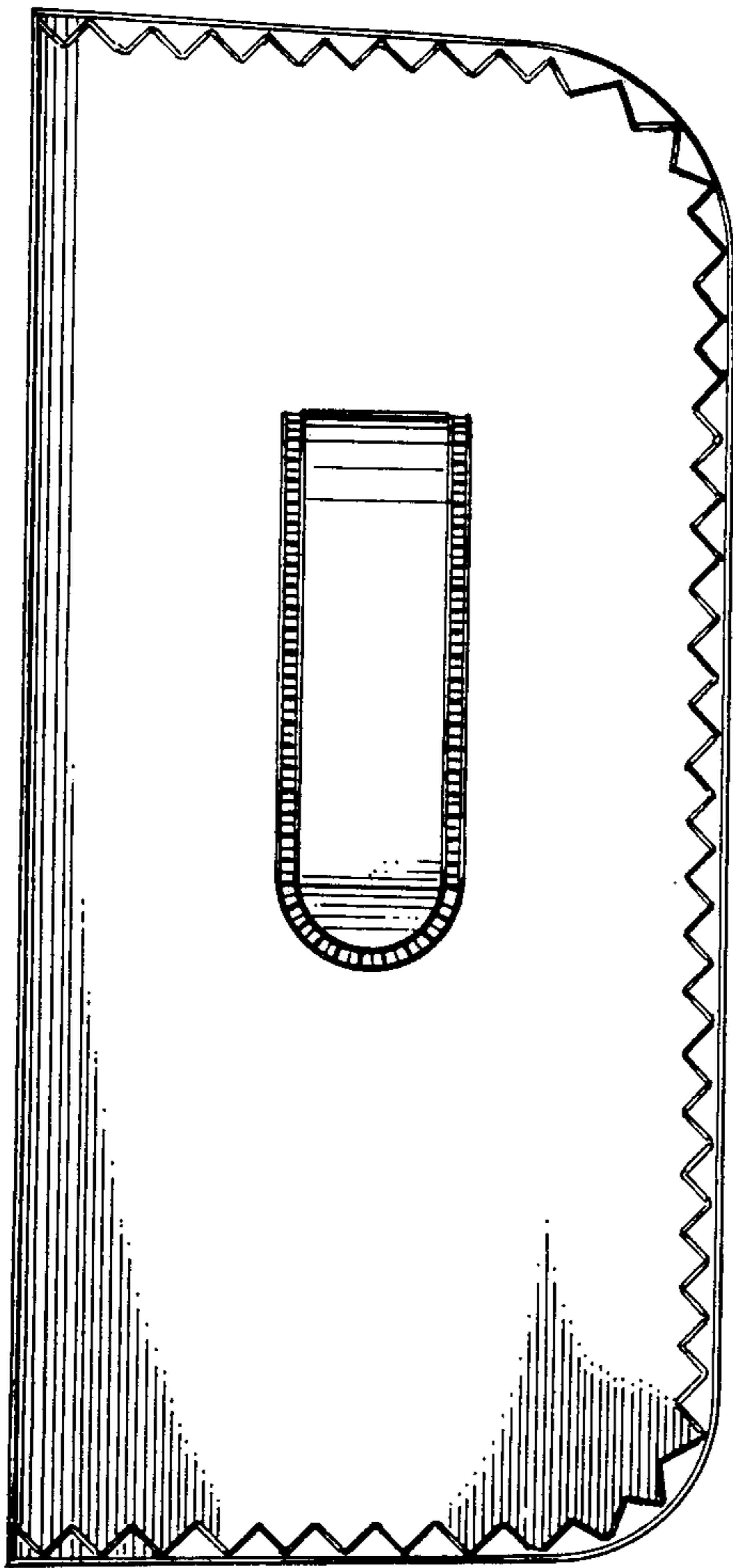

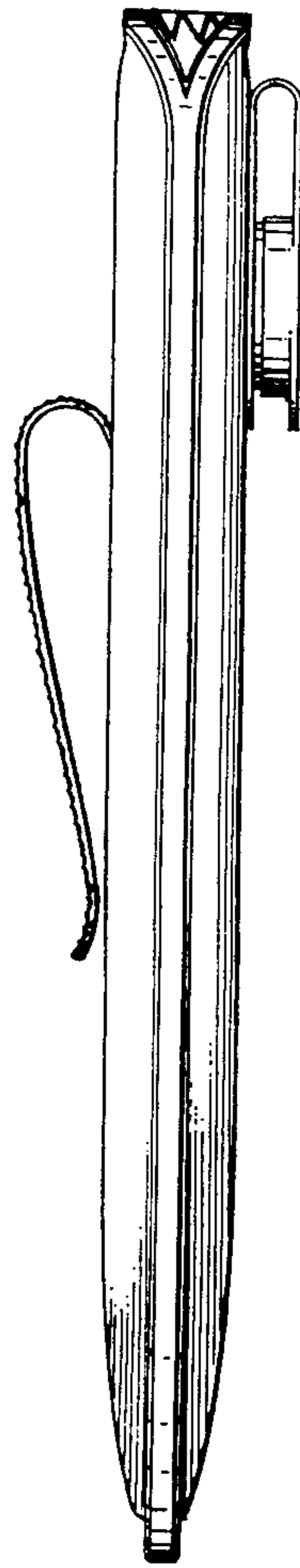
