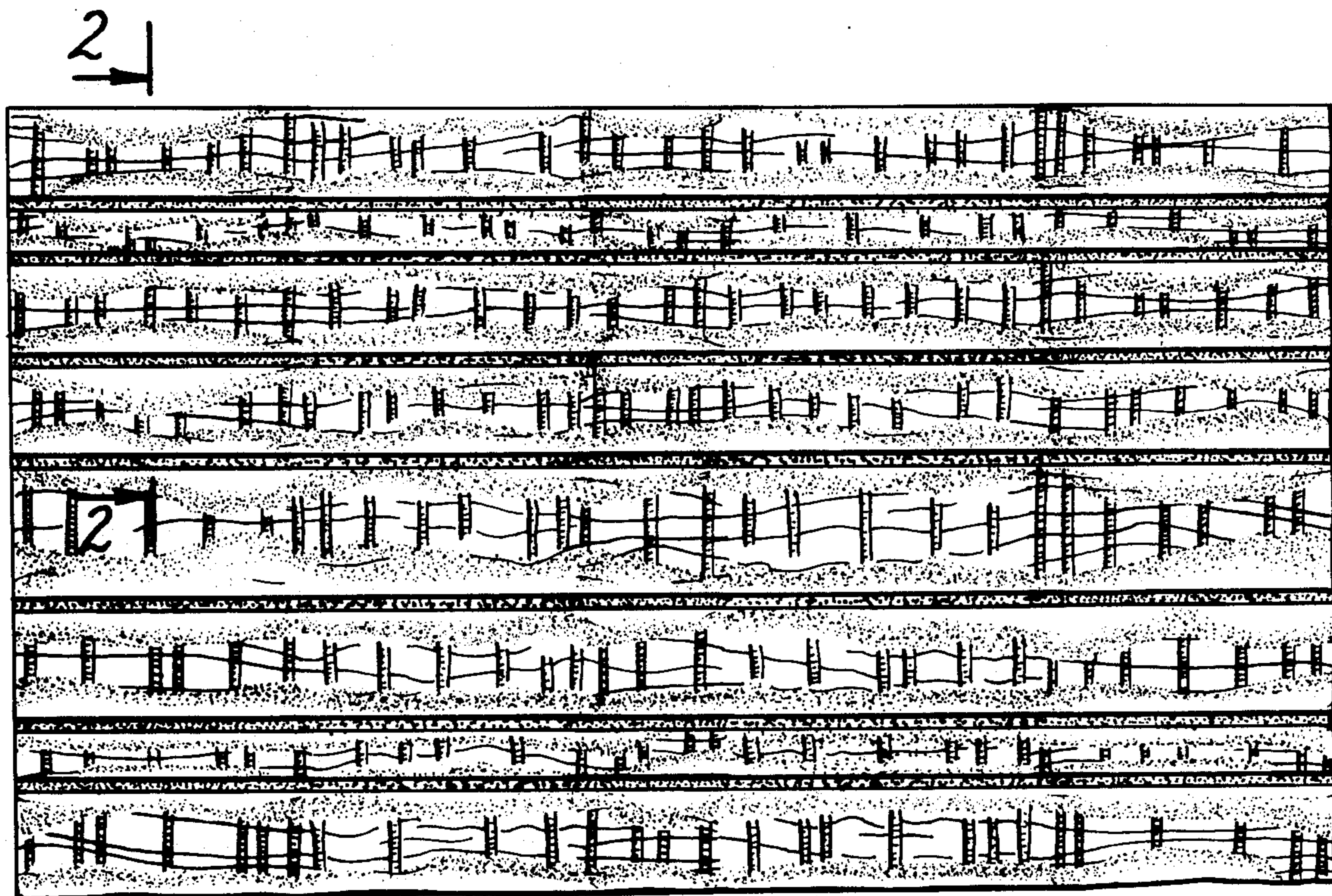

FIG. 2 is an enlarged sectional detail, with parts broken away, taken substantially on line 2-2 of FIG. 1.



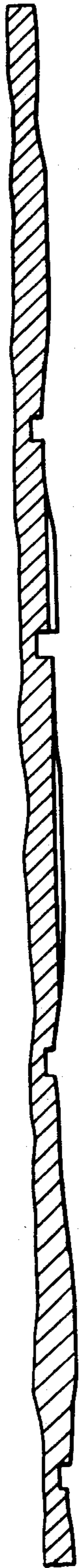

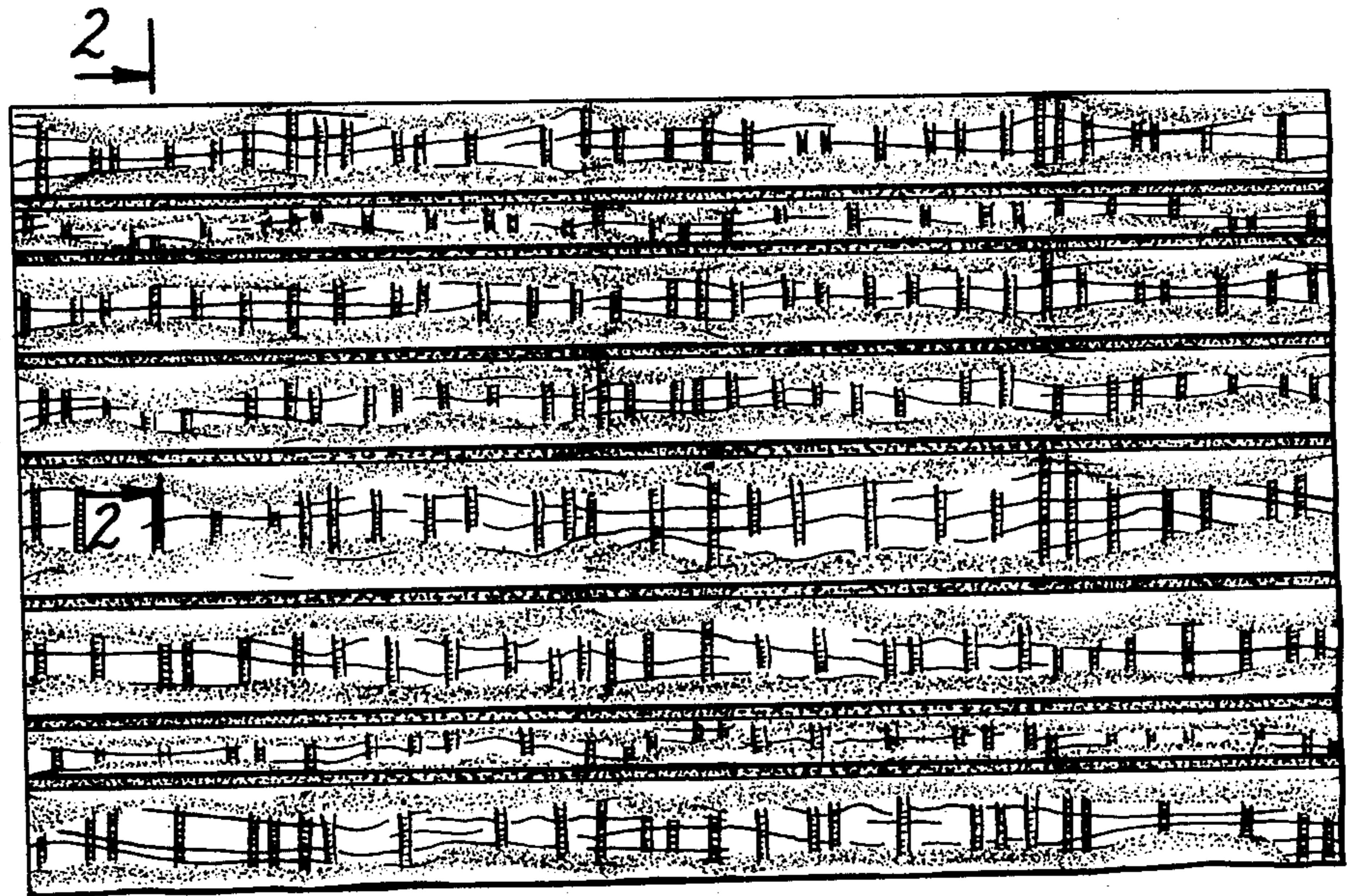
