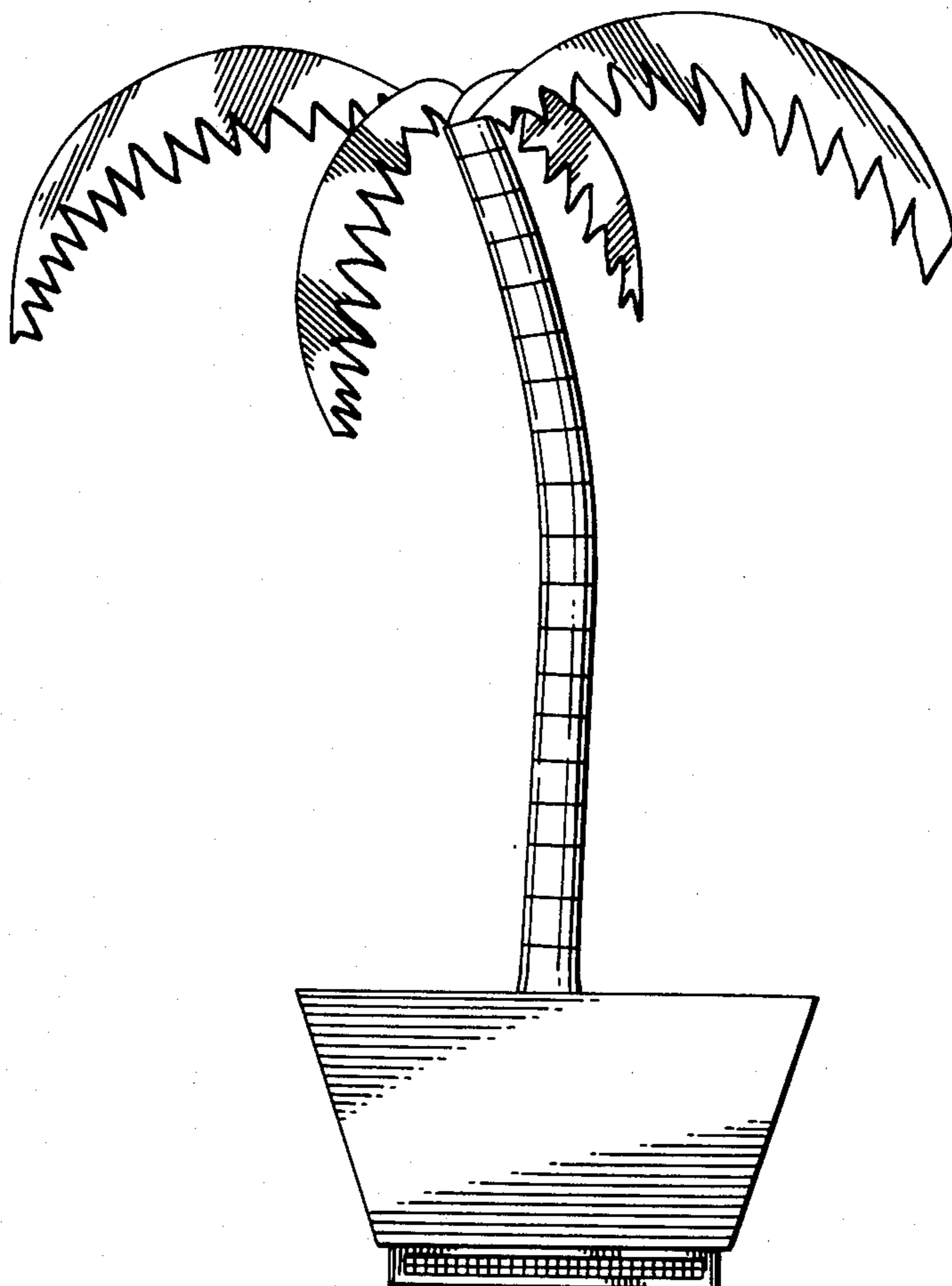

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined merchandise display counter and ceiling air circulator, as shown and described.

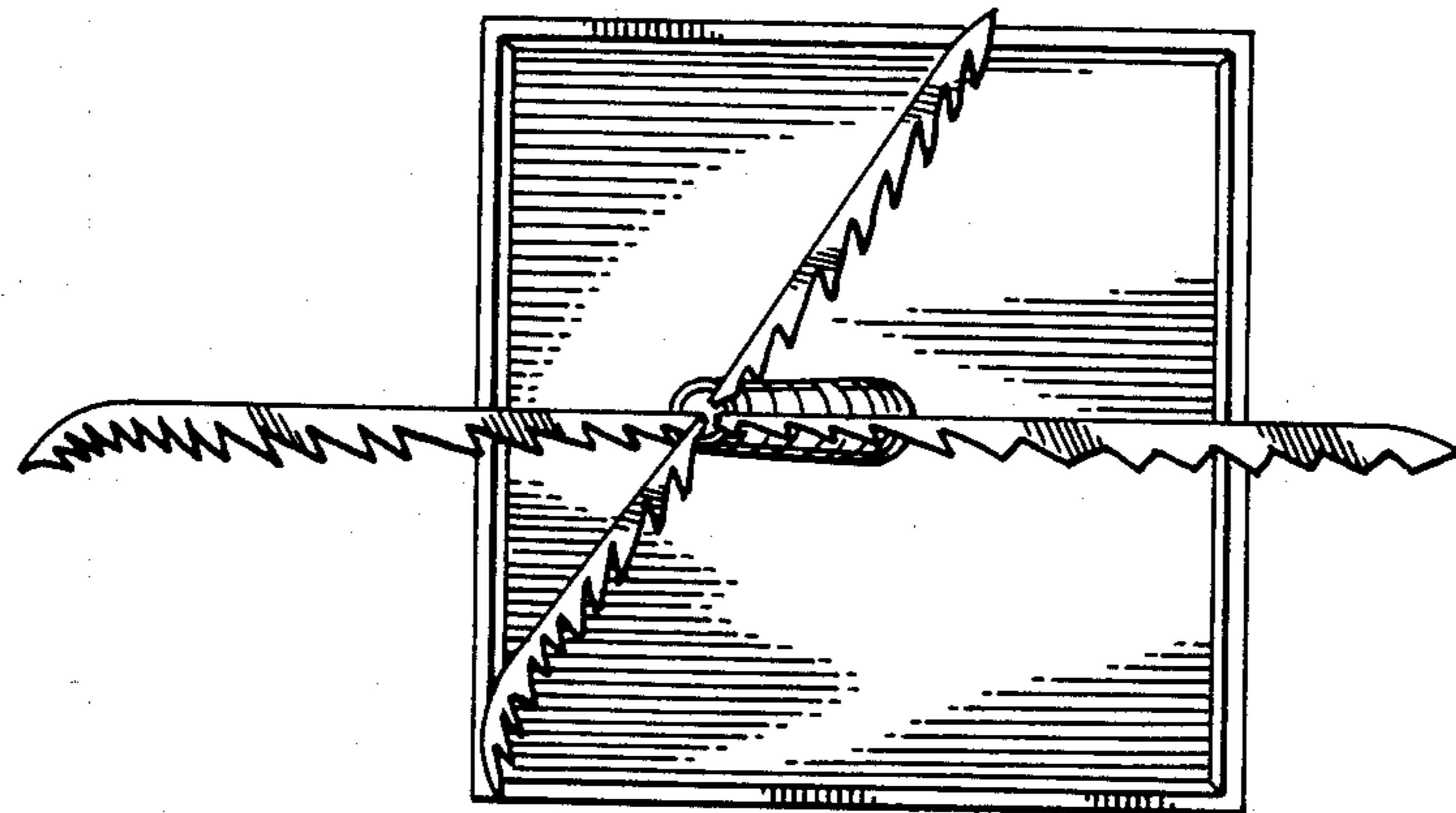

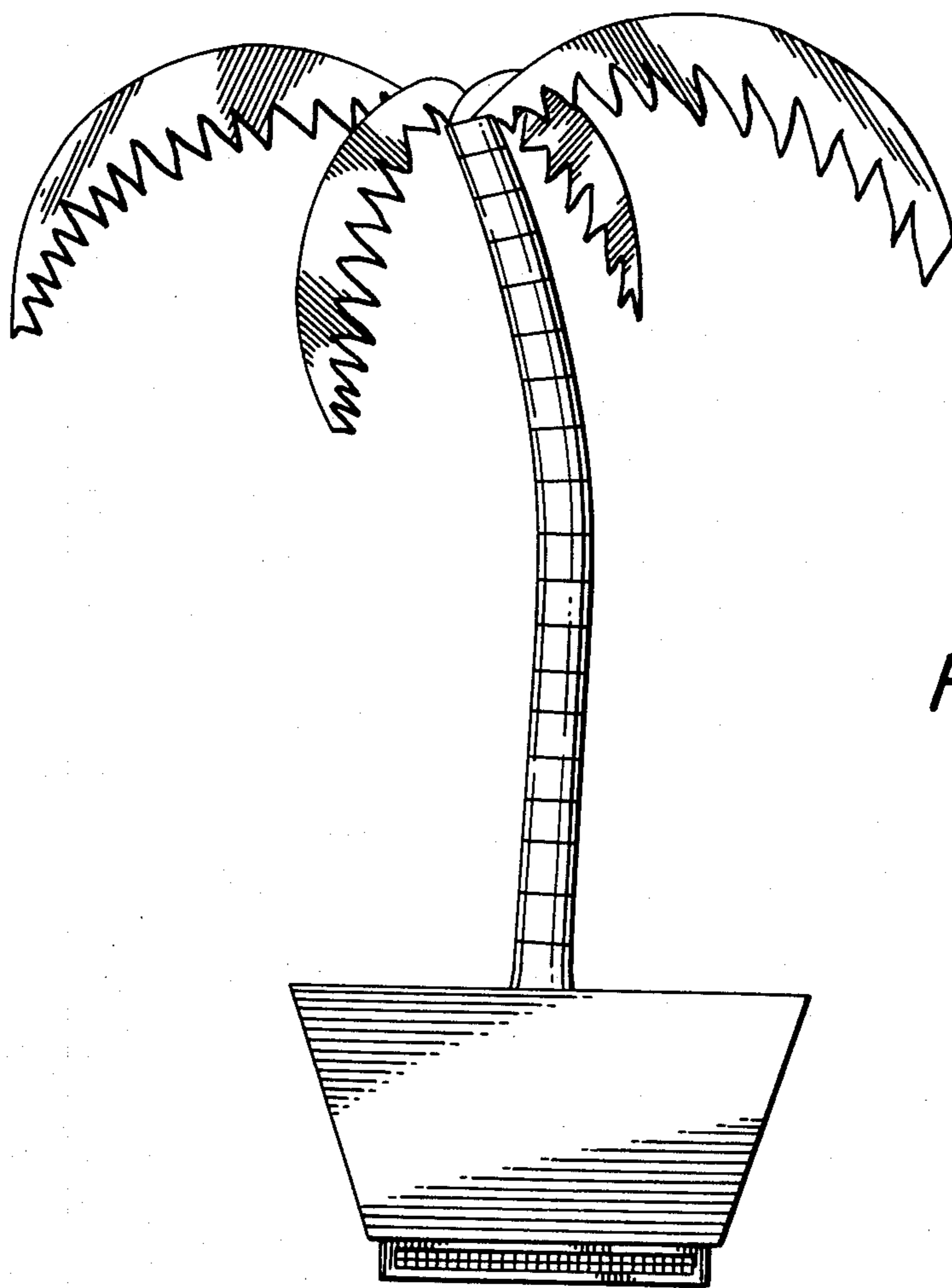

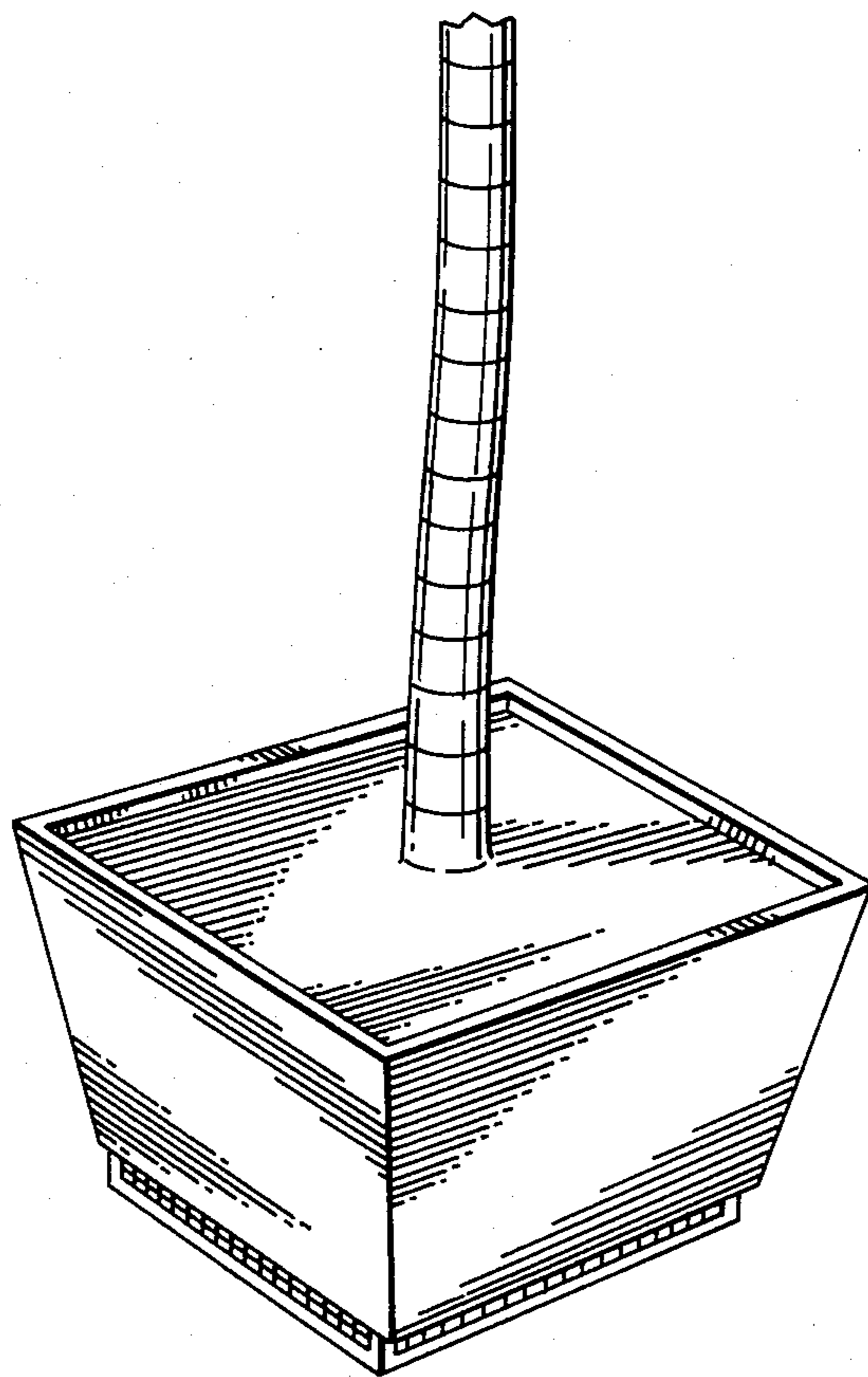
