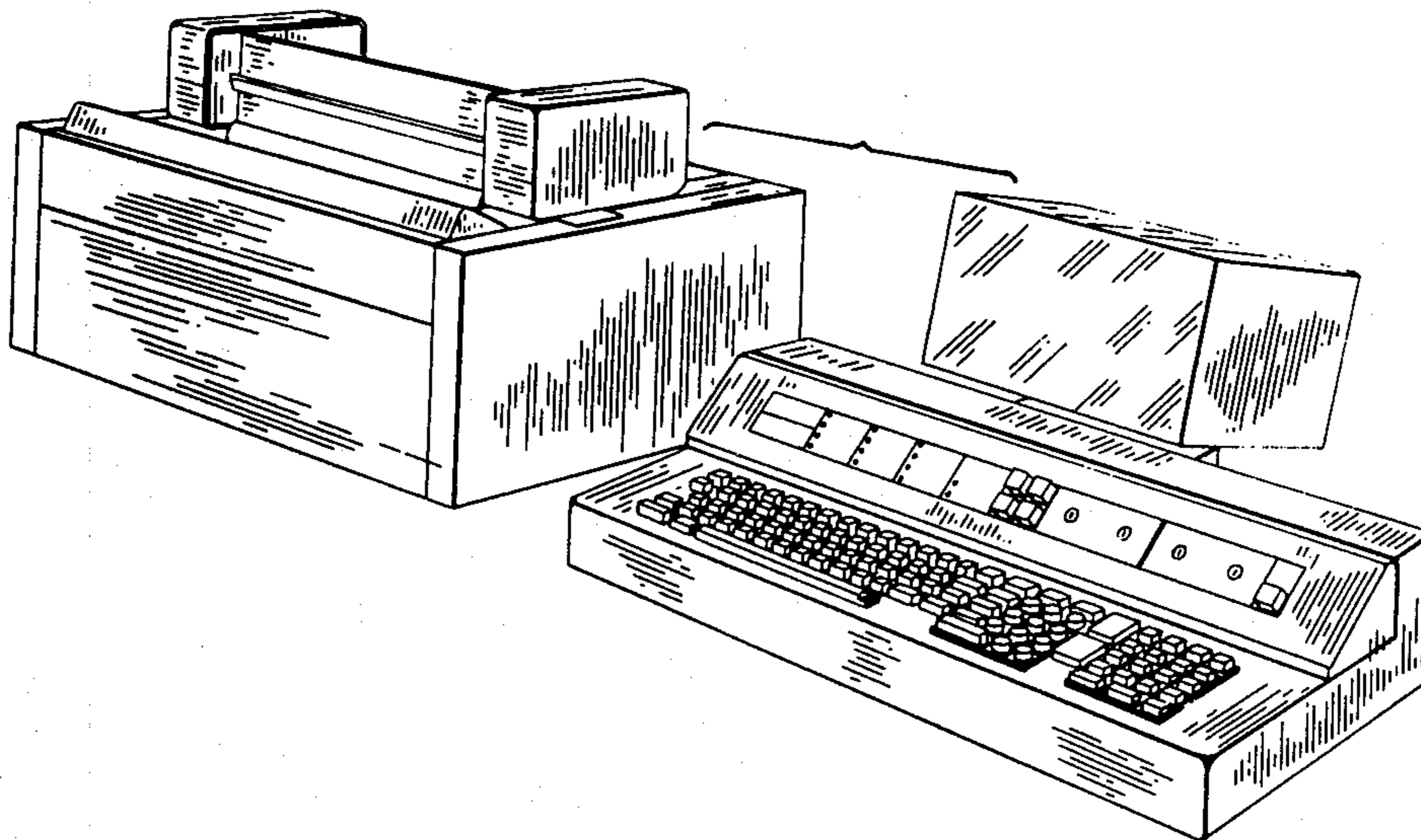

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a desk-top accounting terminal, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the front, right side of the desk top accounting terminal showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a perspective view of the rear, left side thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof, with the components of the terminal shown in an alternate arrangement;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof.



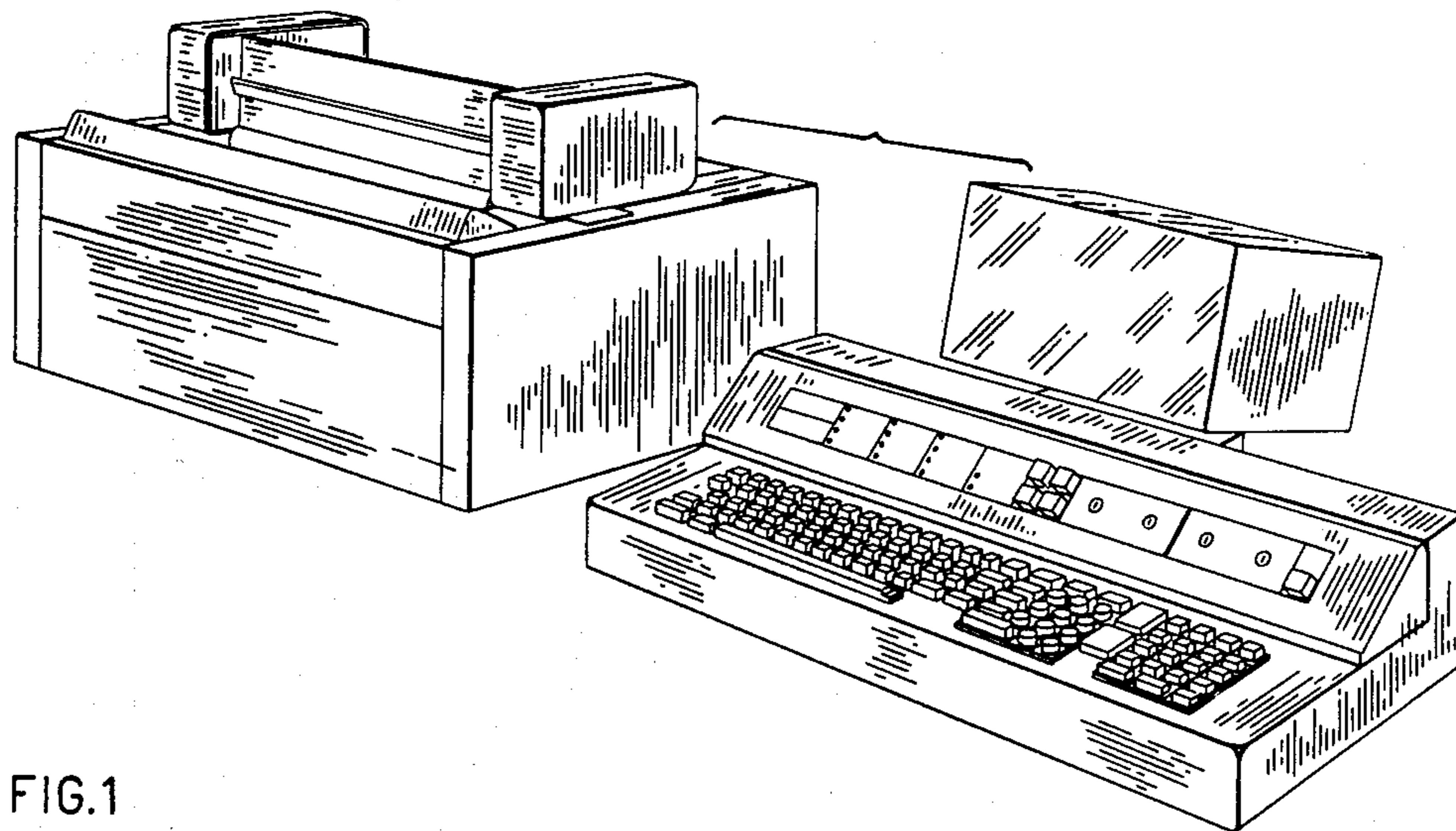

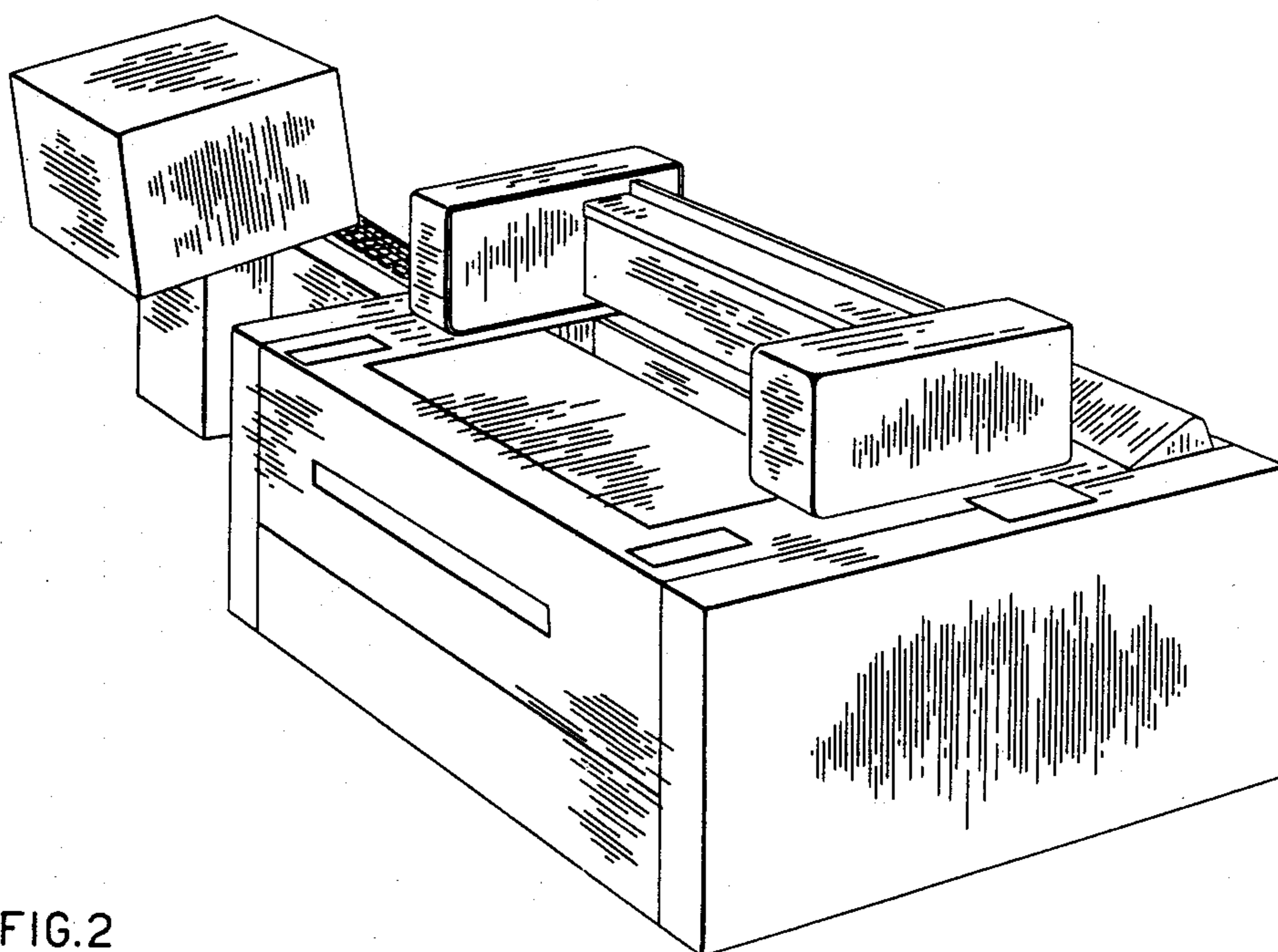

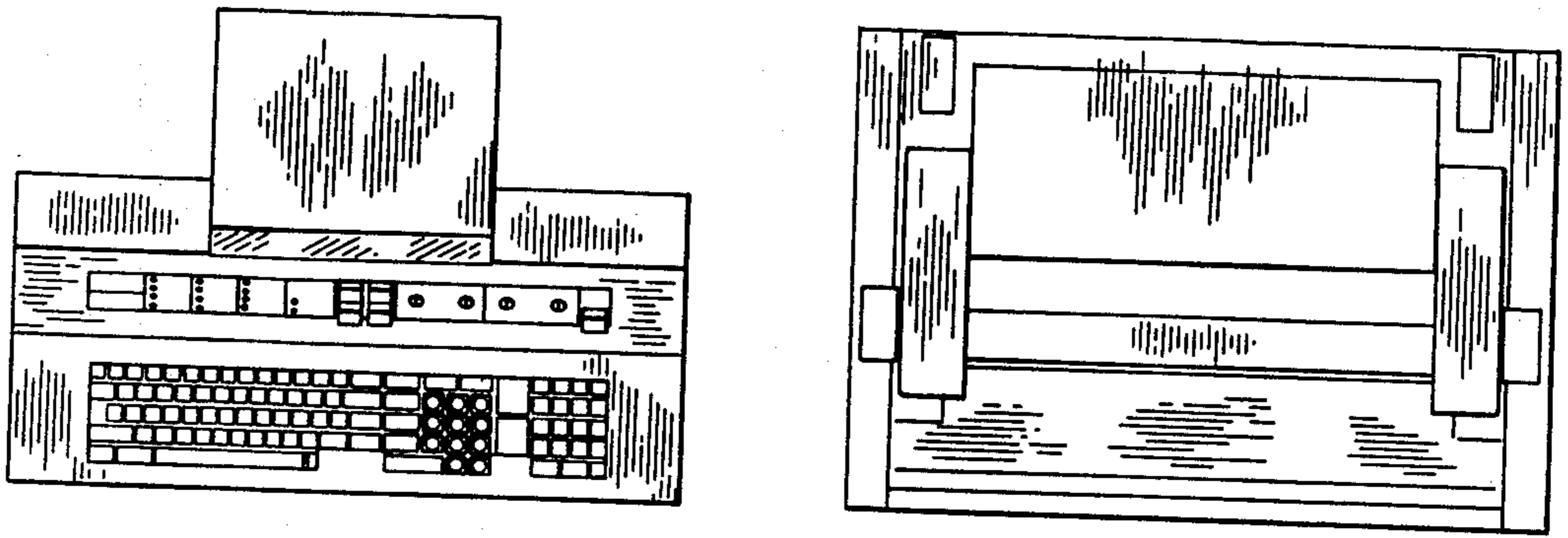

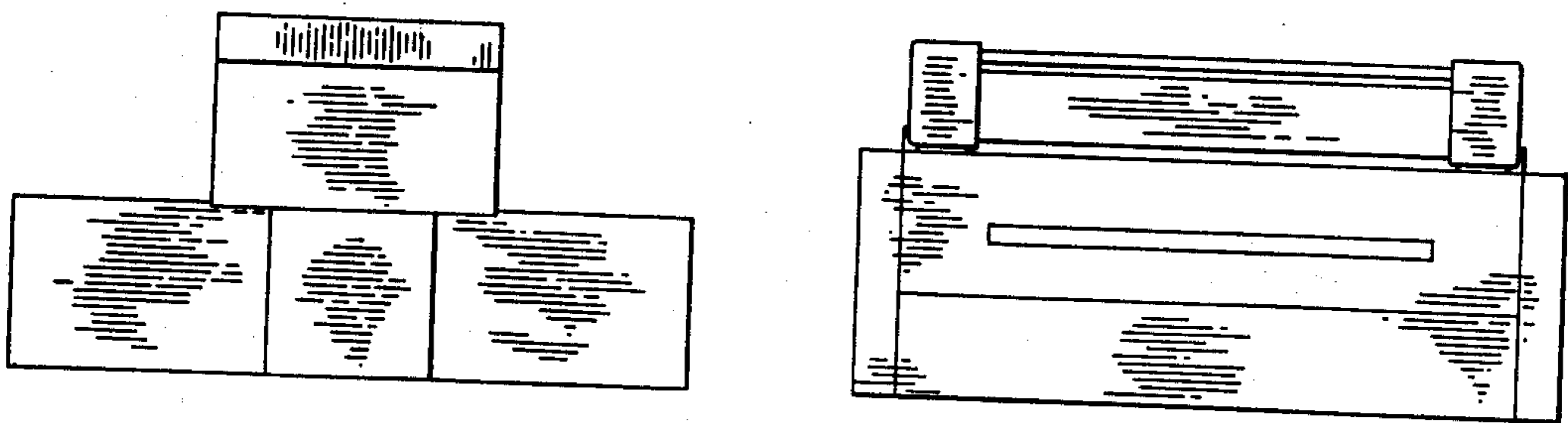
