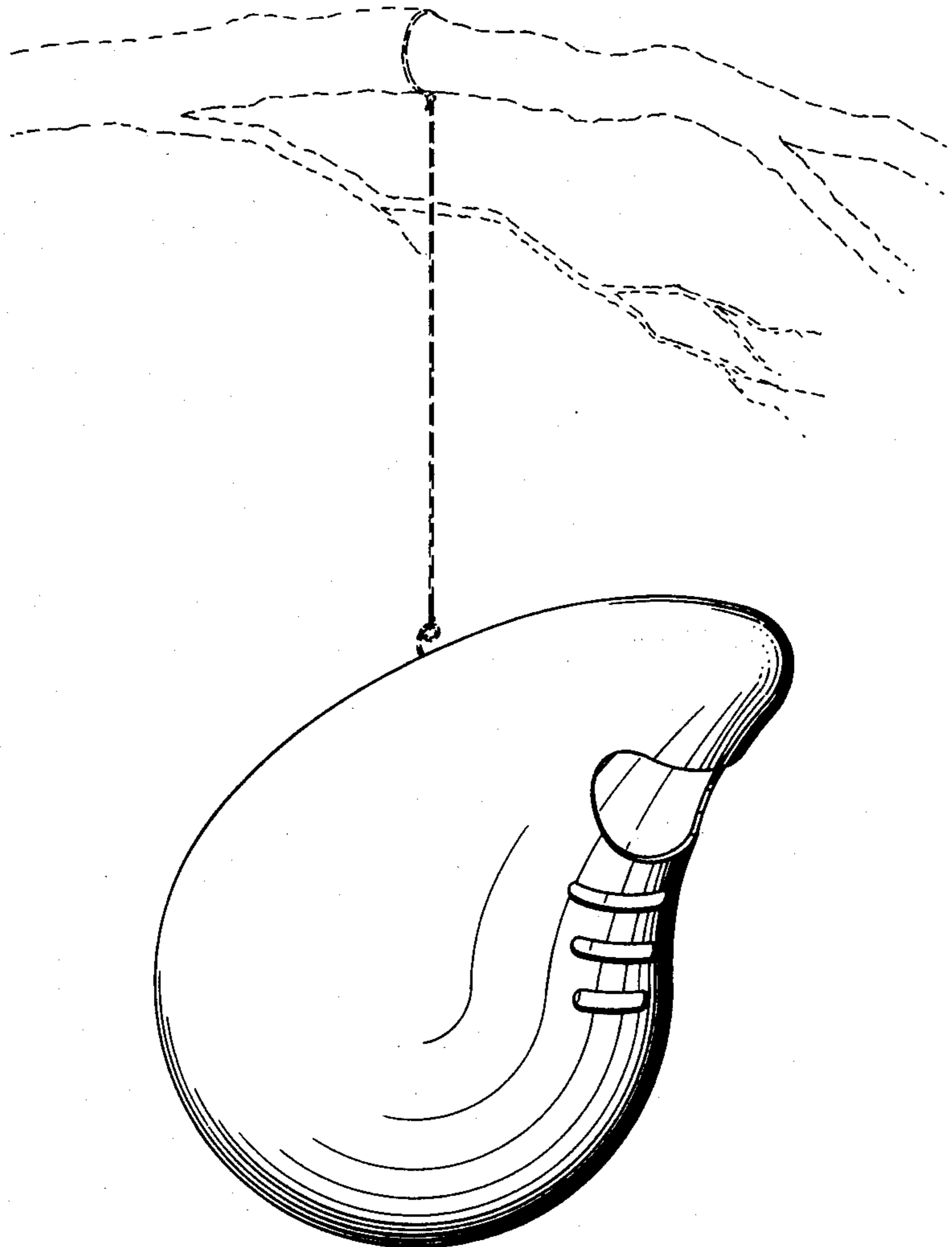

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a hanging birdhouse, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a hanging birdhouse showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is an elevational view taken from the side opposite that shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and
FIG. 6 is another perspective view thereof;
The broken line representation of a tree limb and a support cord in FIG. 1 is for purposes of illustration only.



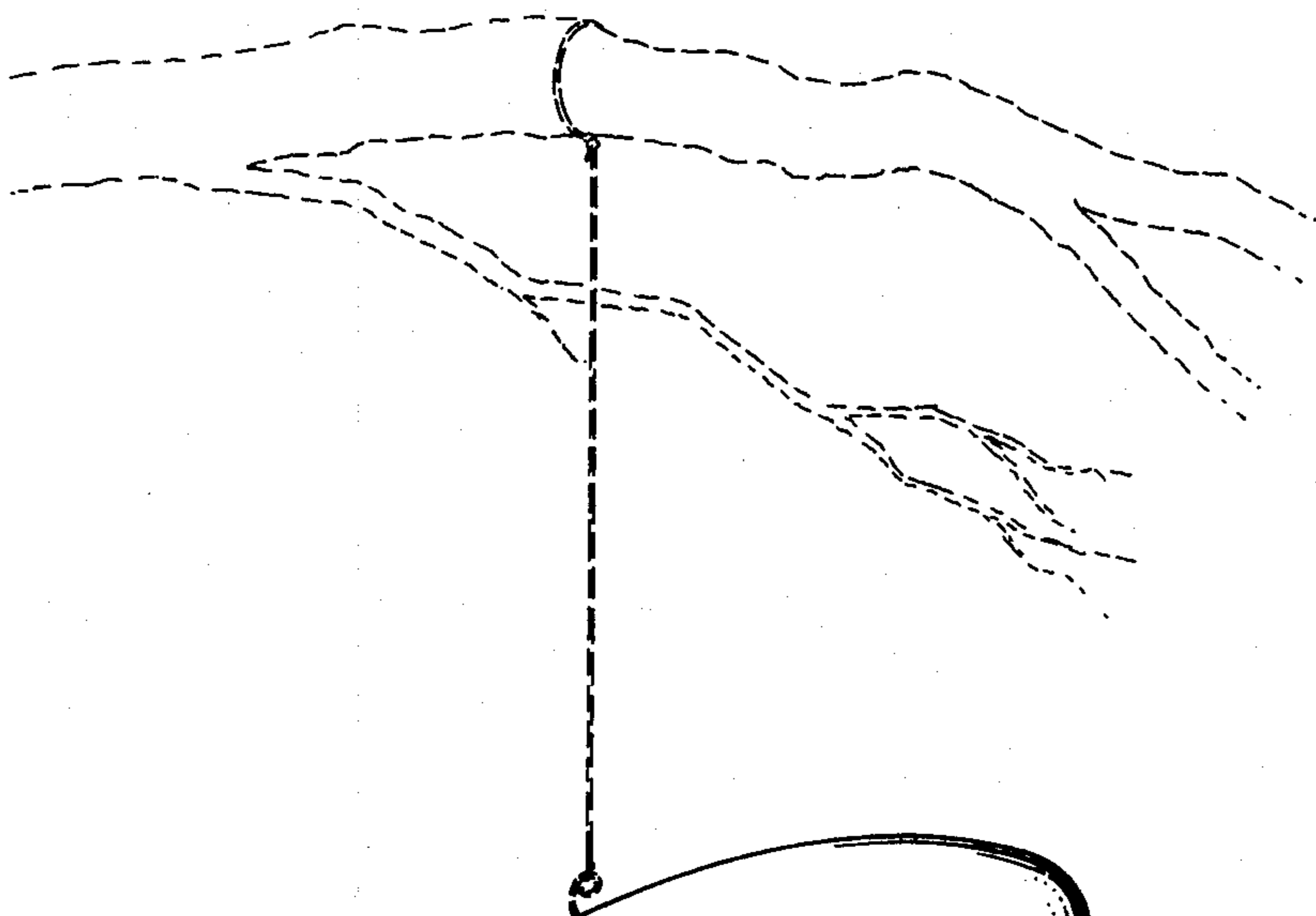

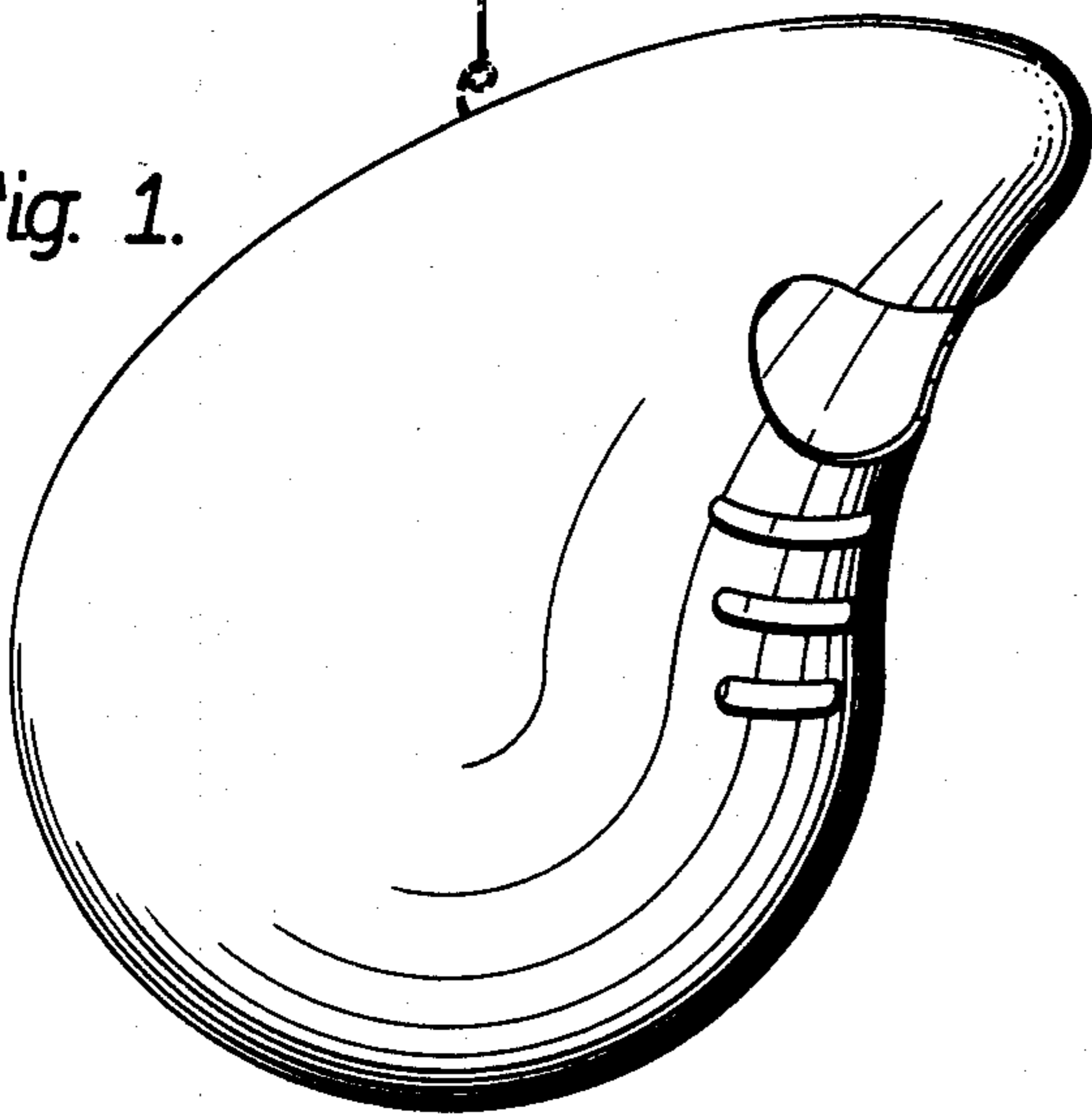
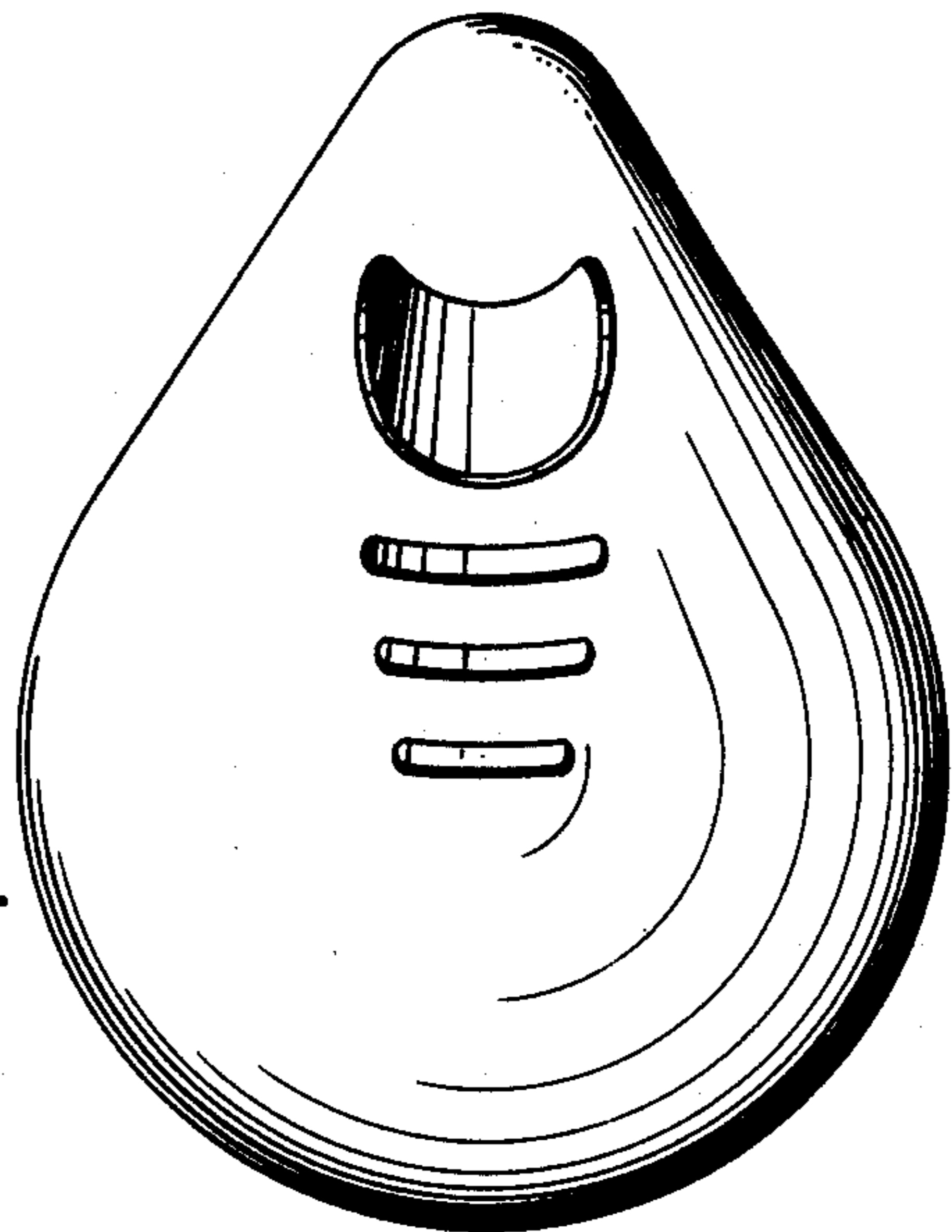

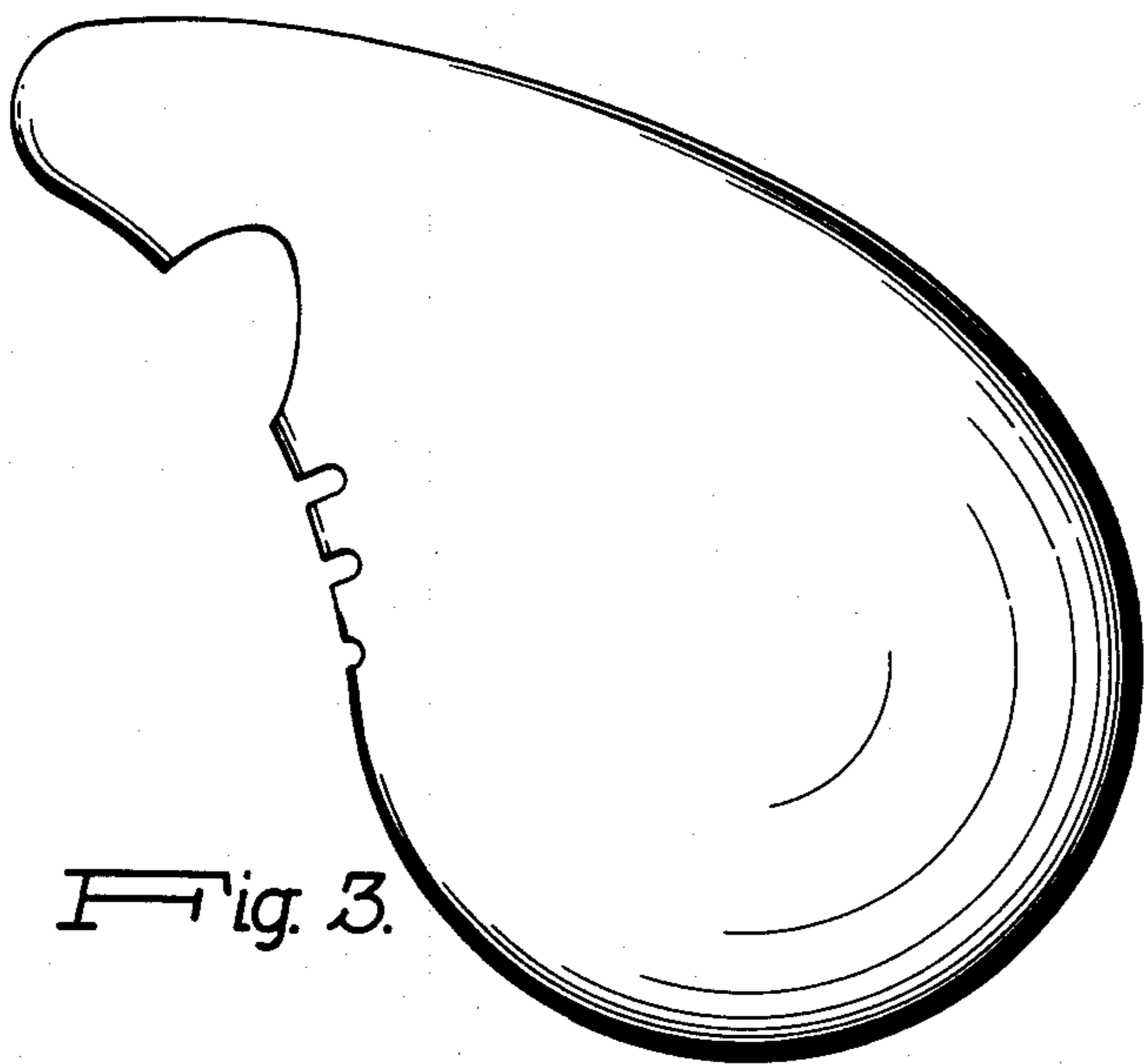

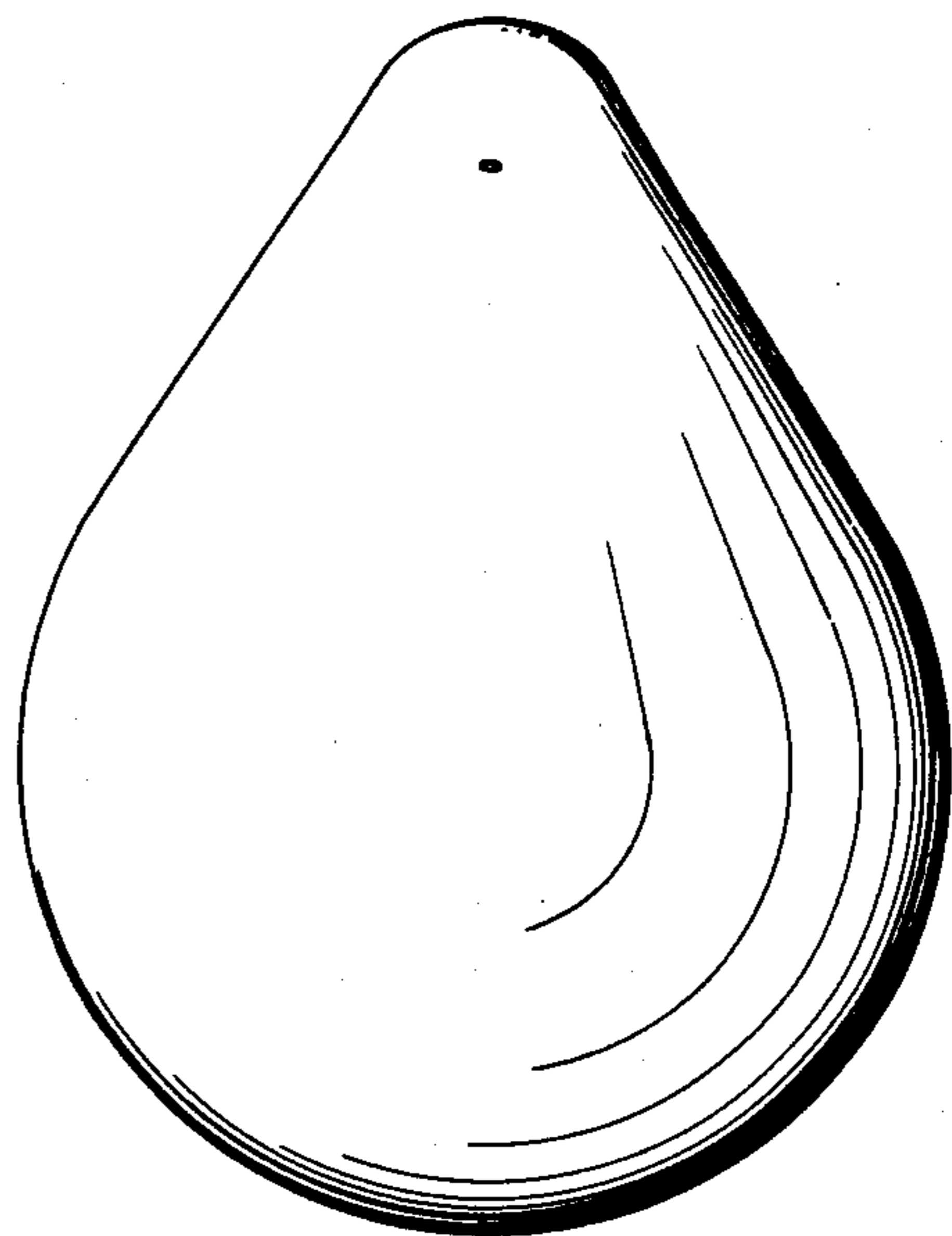

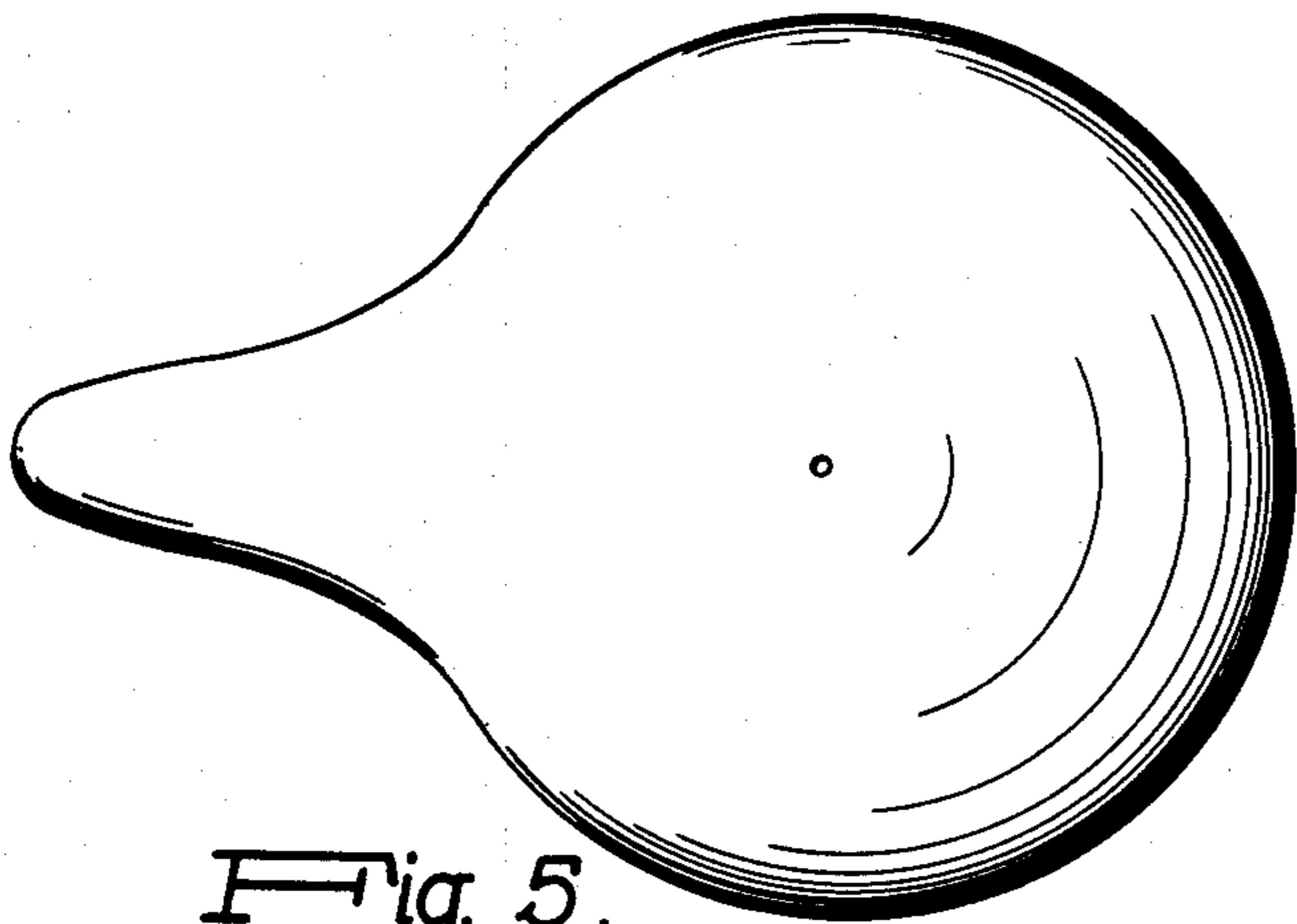
