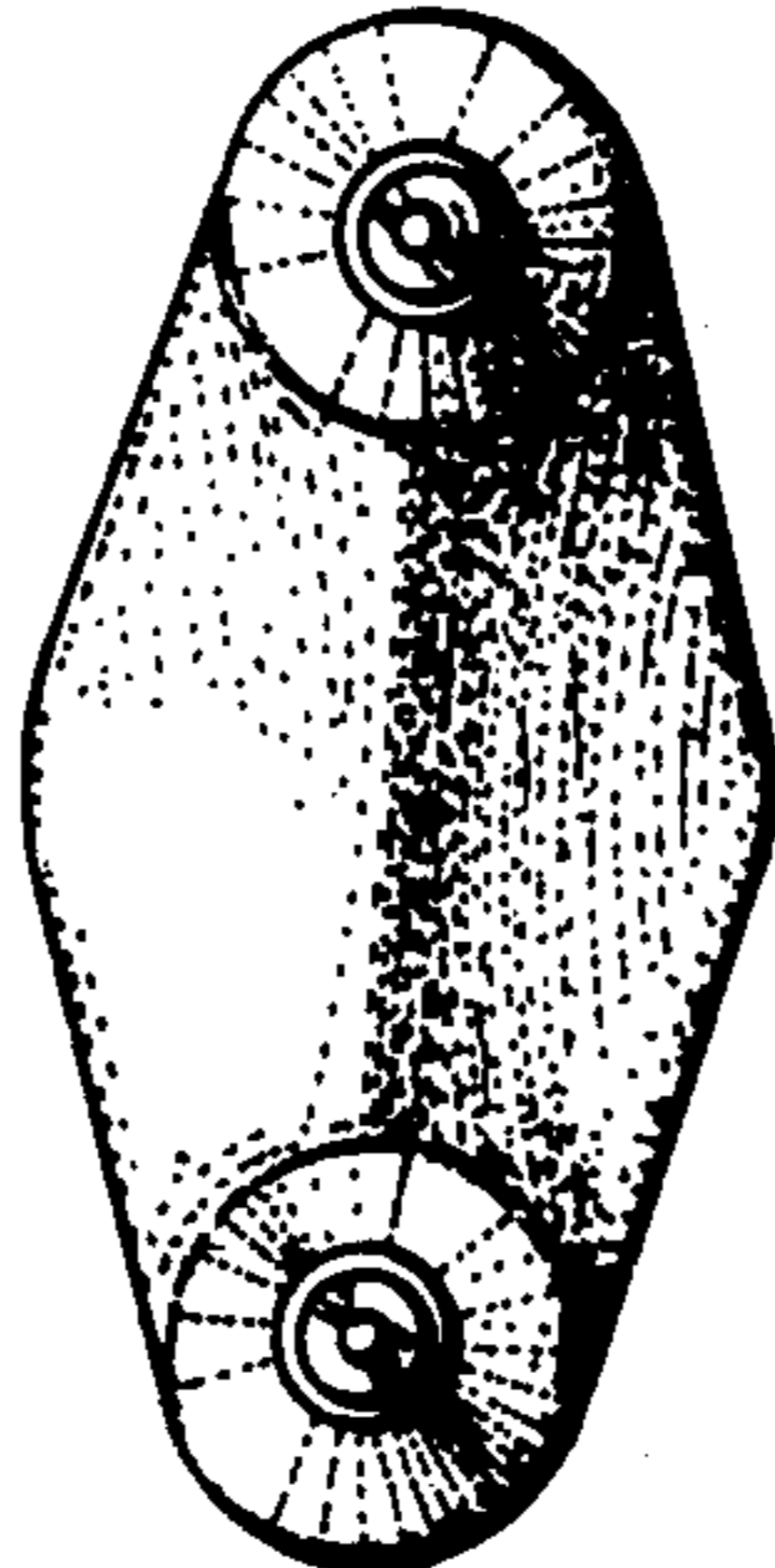
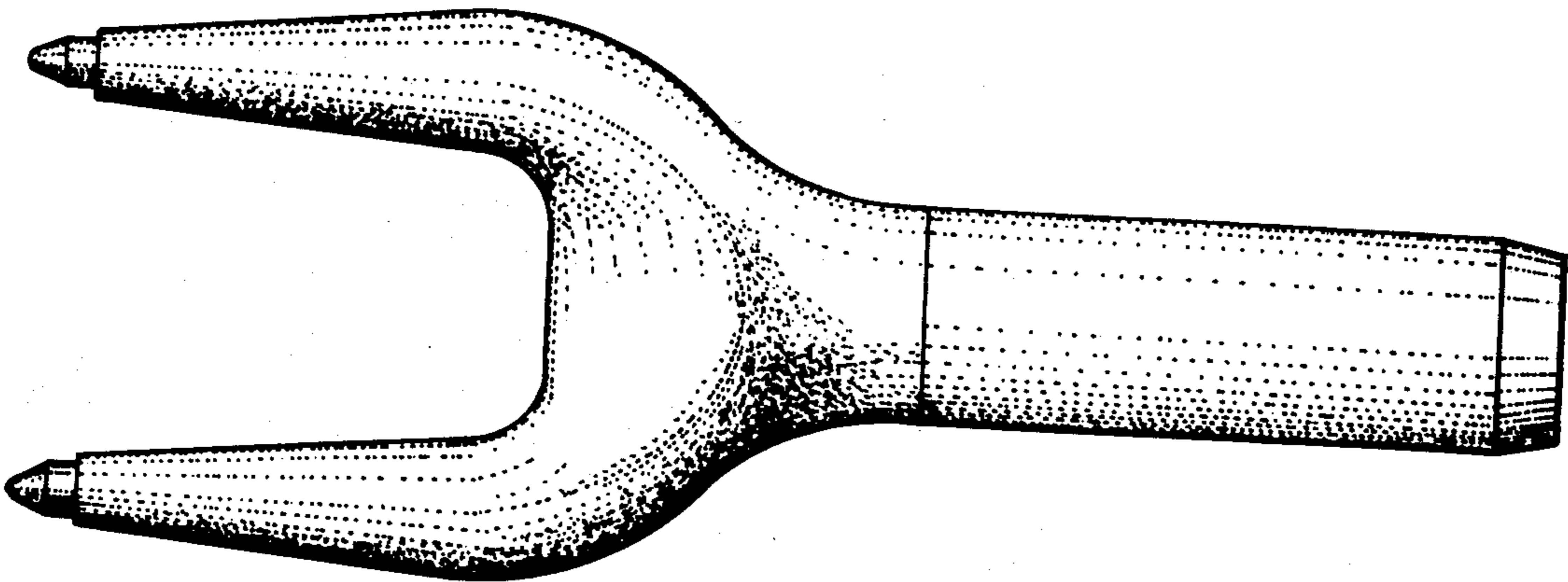

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a head for a cattle prod or similar article, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a head for a cattle prod or similar article showing my new design; FIG. 2 is an enlarged side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image of the side shown; FIG. 3 is a left end elevational view of FIG. 2; FIG. 4 is a right end elevational view of FIG. 2; FIG. 5 is a top plan view of FIG. 2, the bottom being a mirror image of the top shown; FIG. 6 is a side elevational view of a modified form of the head for a cattle prod or similar article shown in FIG. 1; FIG. 7 is an enlarged side elevational view of FIG. 6, the opposite side being a mirror image of the side shown; FIG. 8 is a left end elevational view of FIG. 7; FIG. 9 is a right end elevational view of FIG. 7; and FIG. 10 is a top plan view of FIG. 7, the bottom being a mirror image of the top shown. The fragmentary broken line representation of a cattle prod in FIGS. 1 and 6 is for purposes of illustration only.



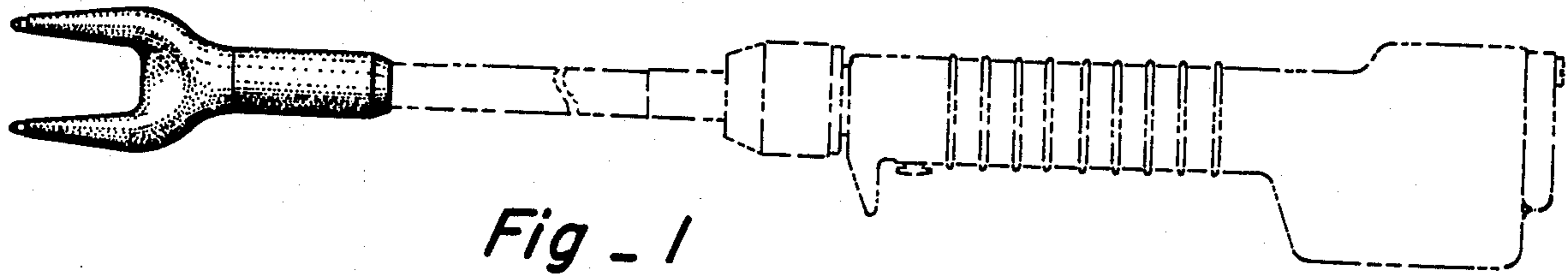

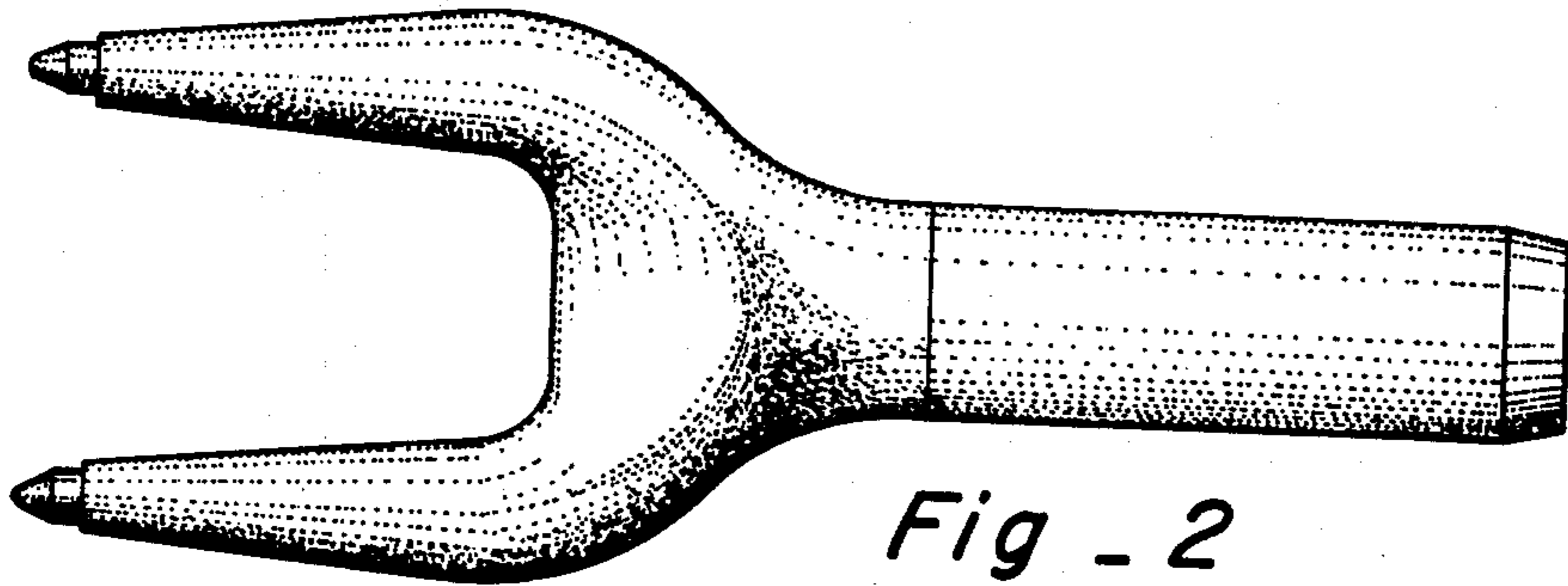

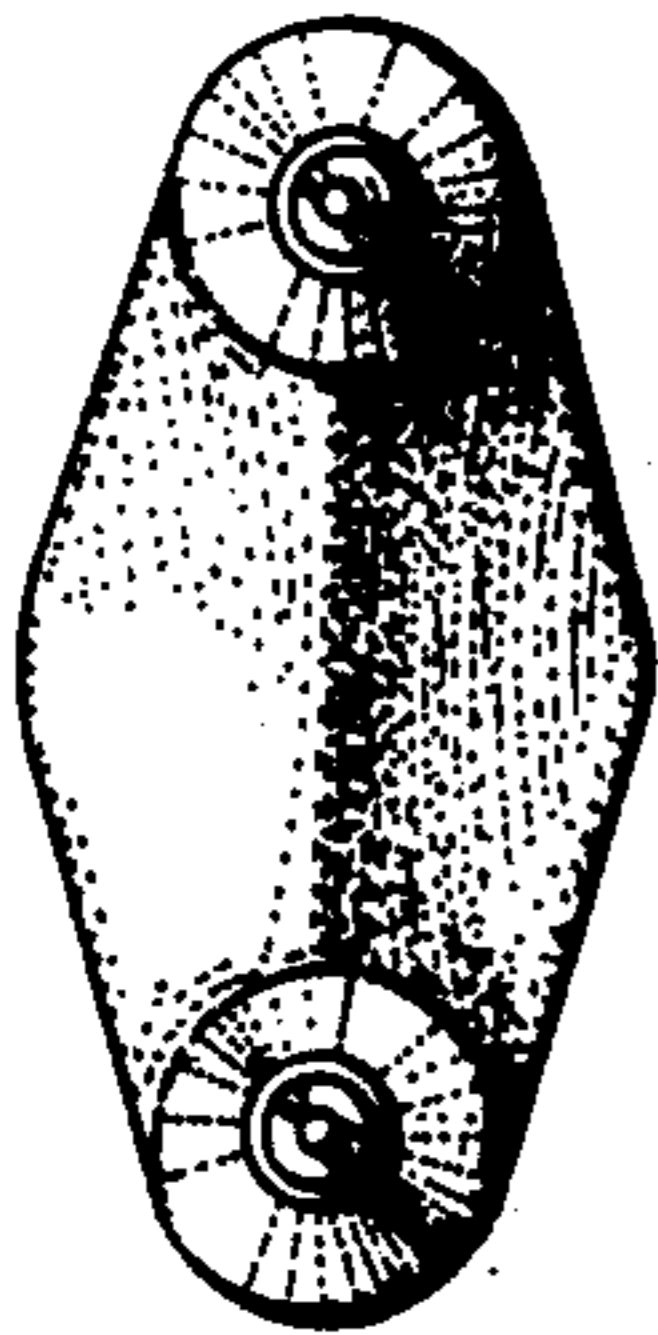

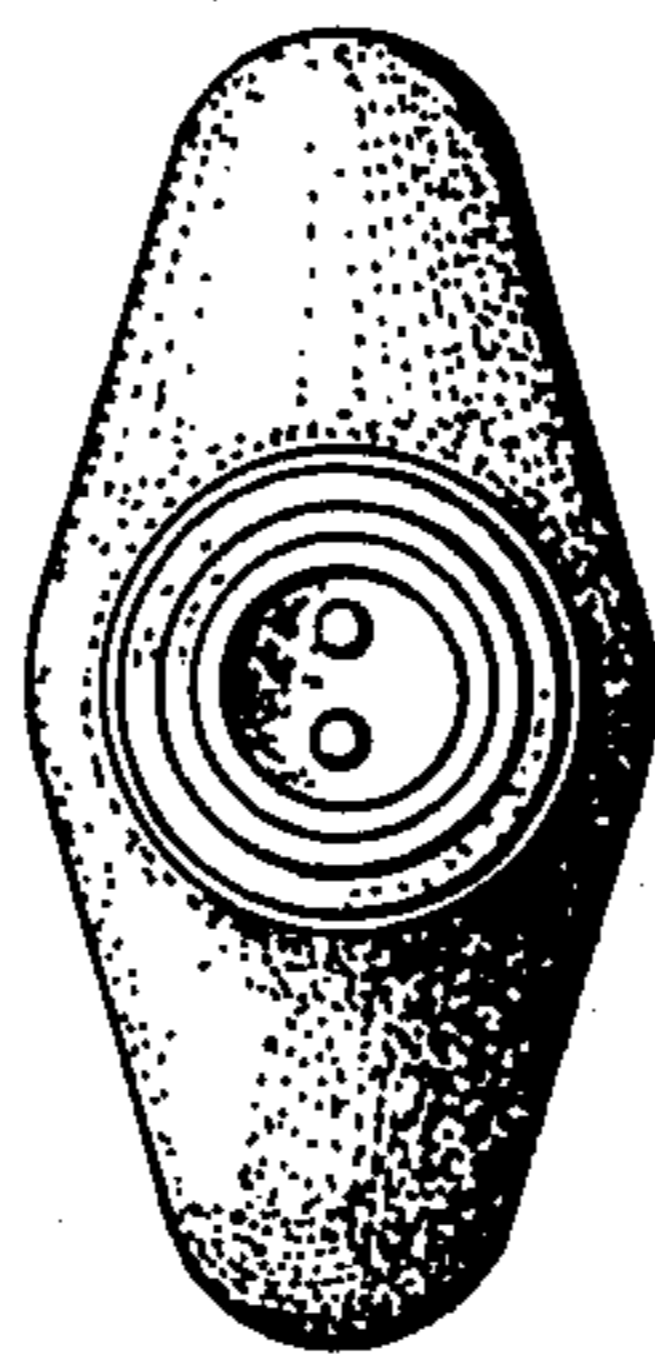

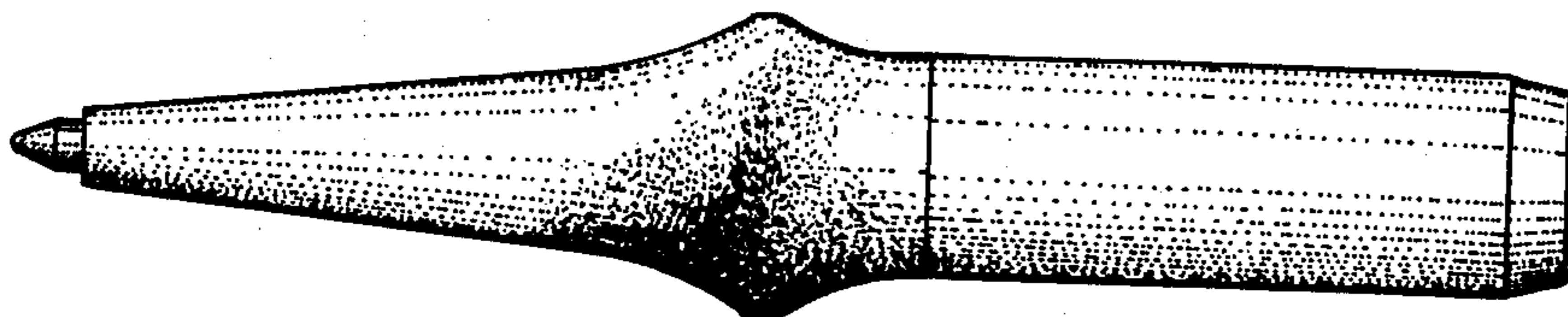

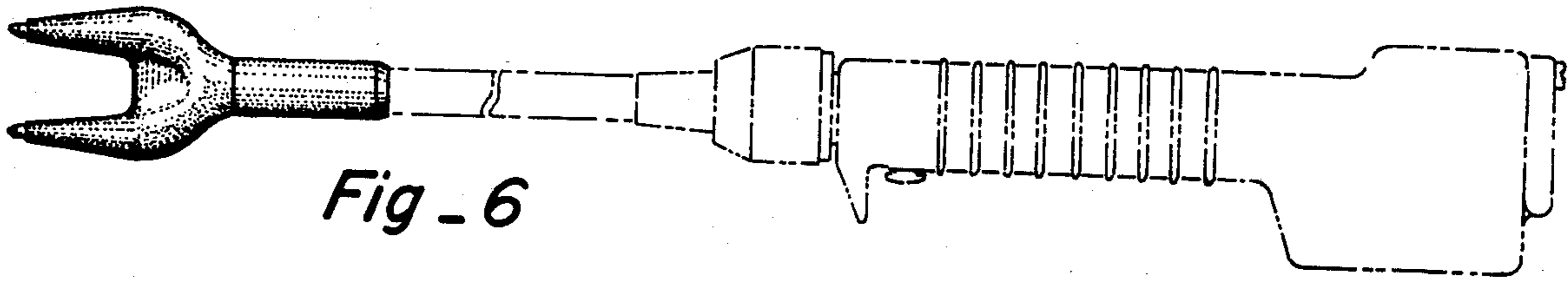

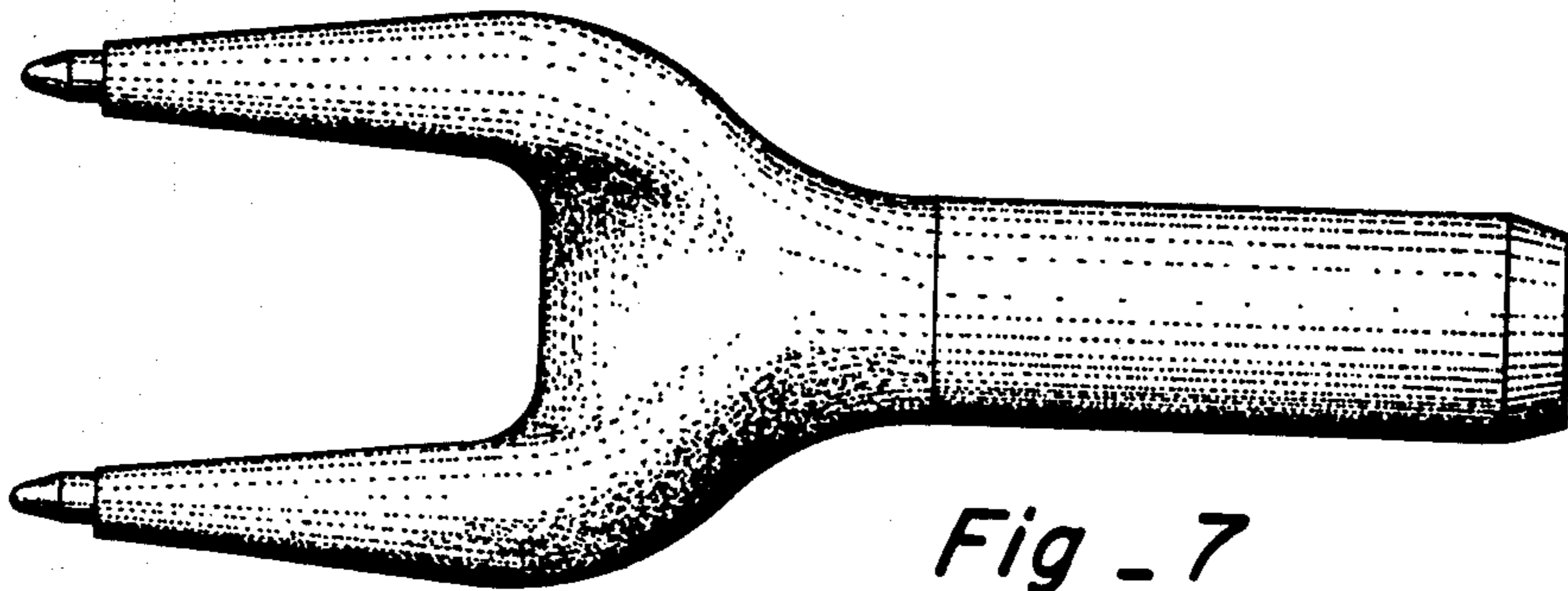

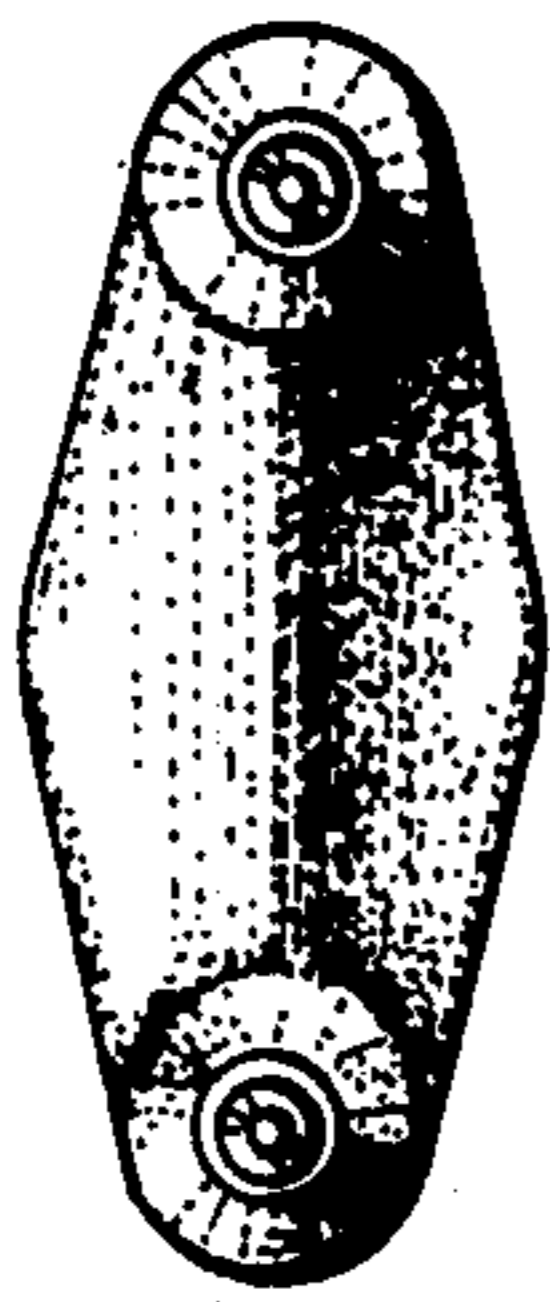

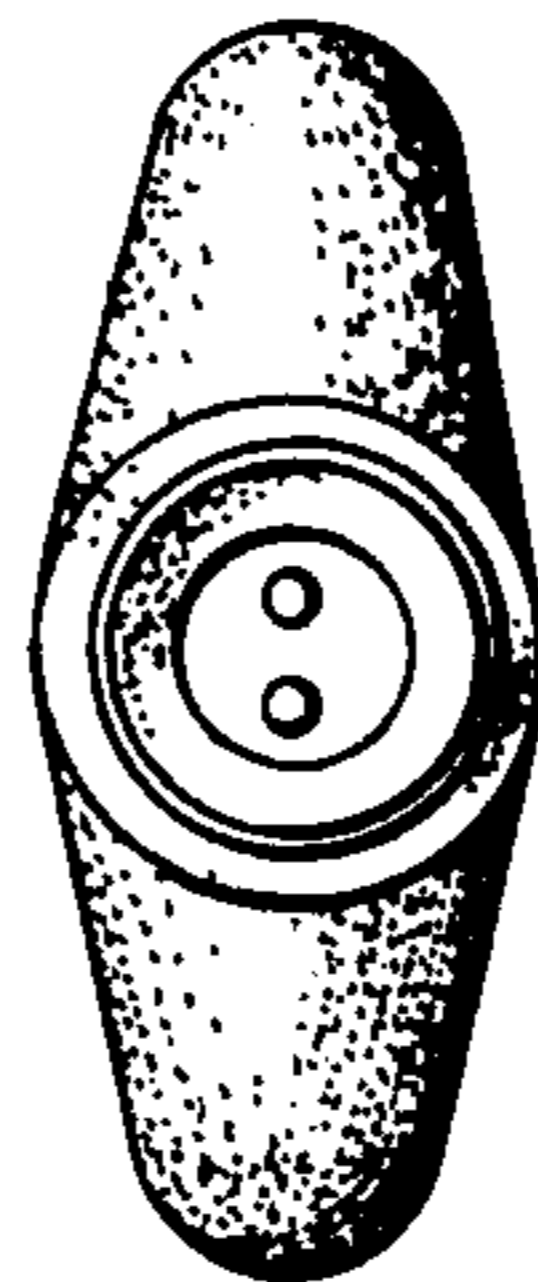
