[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a bass drum stabilizer or similar article, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a bass drum stabilizer or similar article showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is an end elevational view as seen from the left hand portion of FIG. 2; and FIG. 4 is an end elevational view as seen from the right hand portion of FIG. 1.



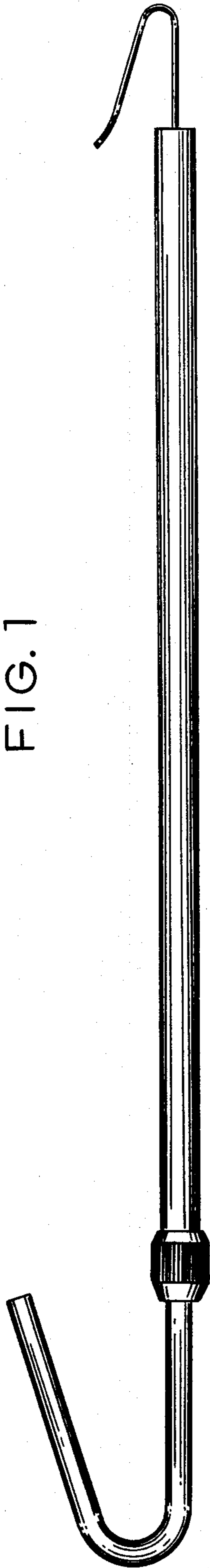

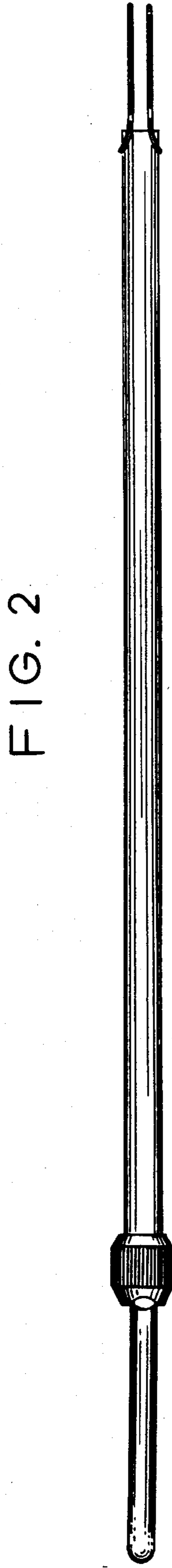
