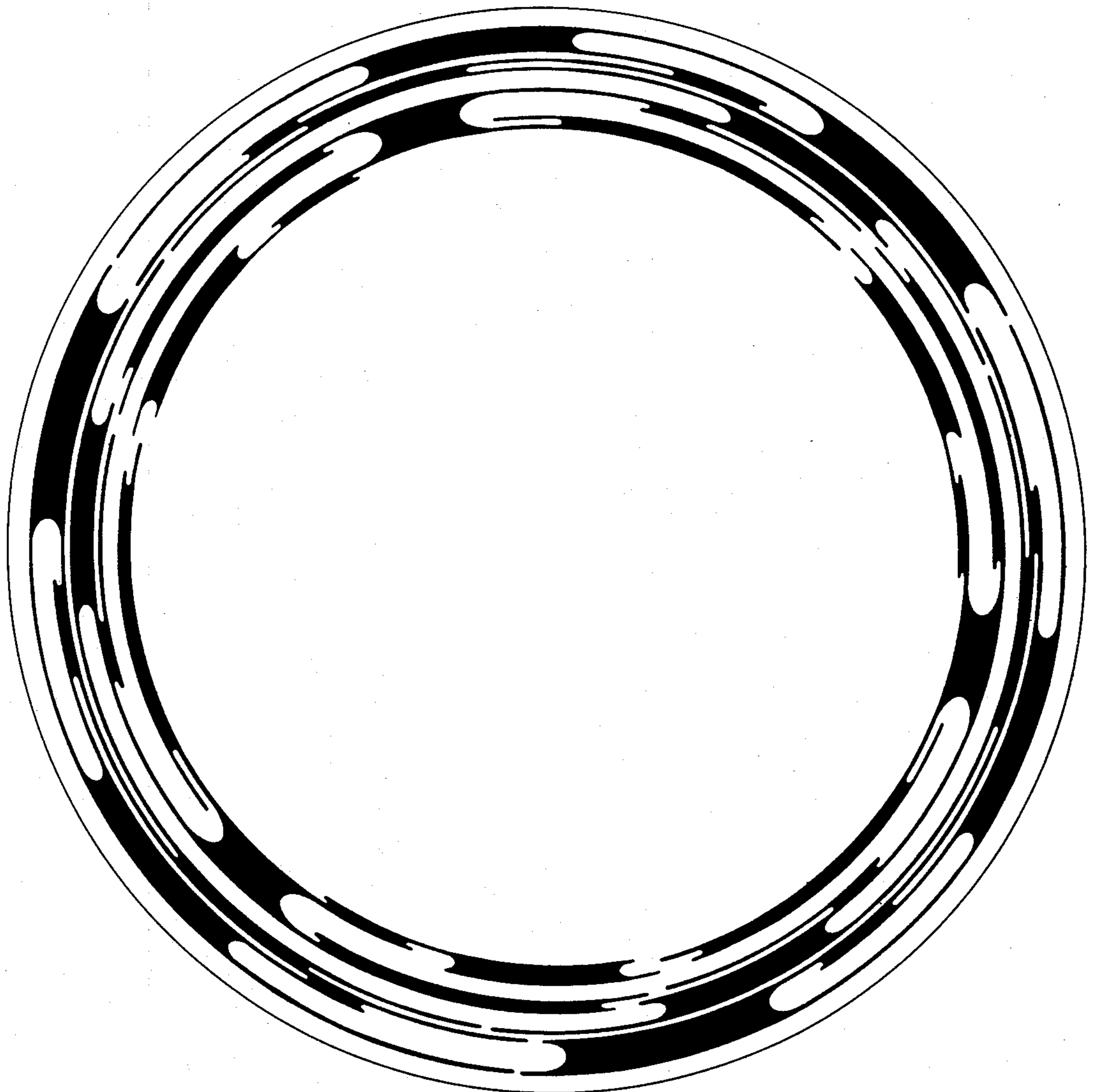

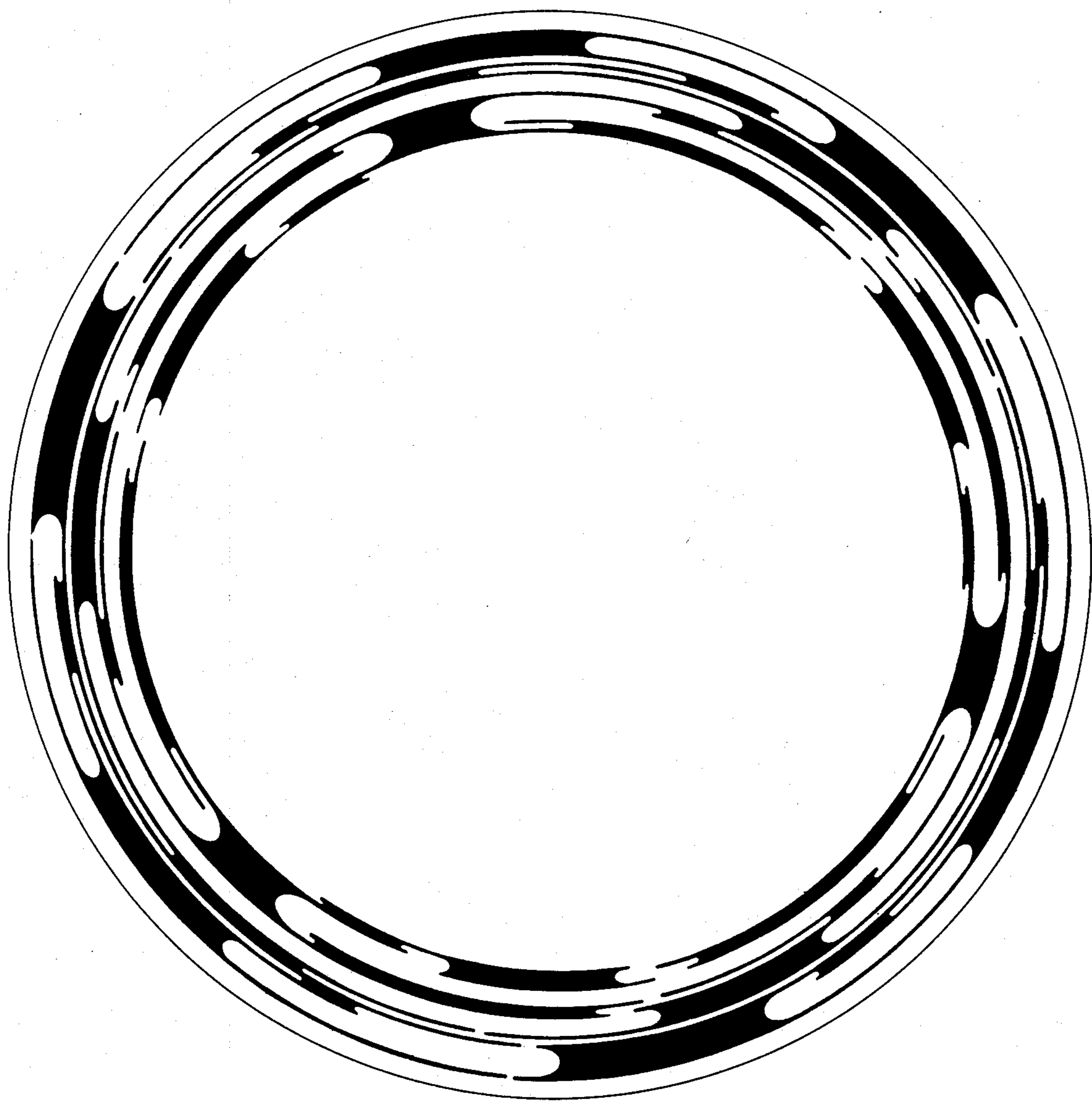
The FIGURE is a plan view of a dinner plate of conven-
