[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a frying pan, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a frying pan showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof taken partially in section on line 2—2 of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a partial side elevational view as seen from the left or right of FIG. 2;

FIG. 4 is a fragmentary perspective view on an enlarged scale of one of the notches in the rim of the frying pan.

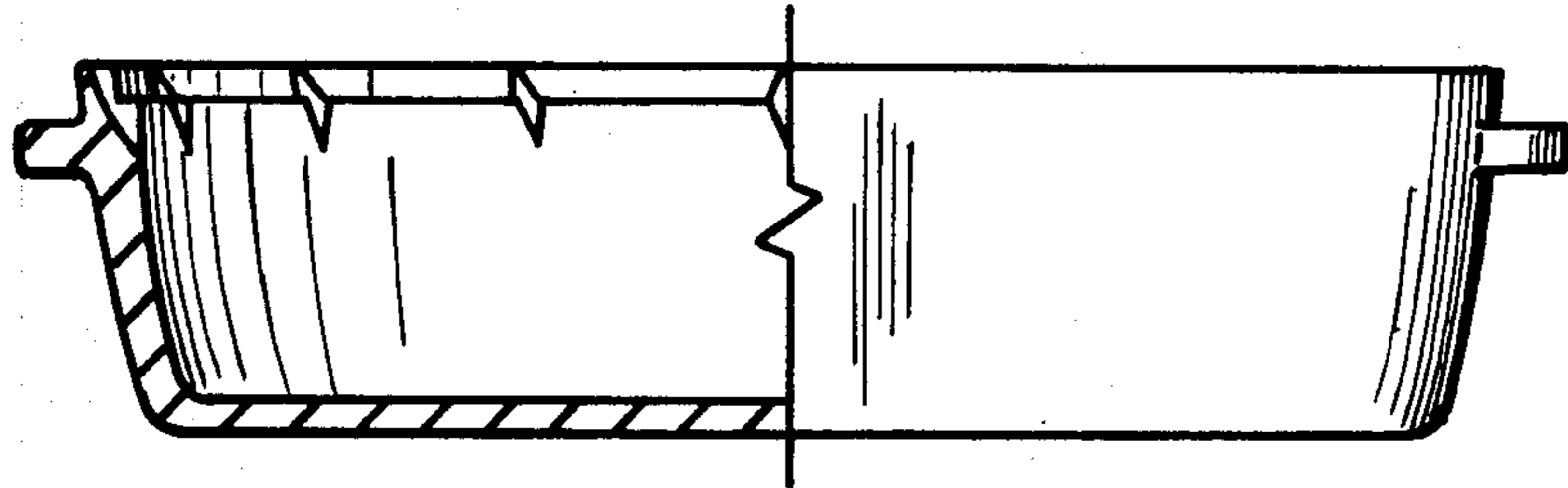

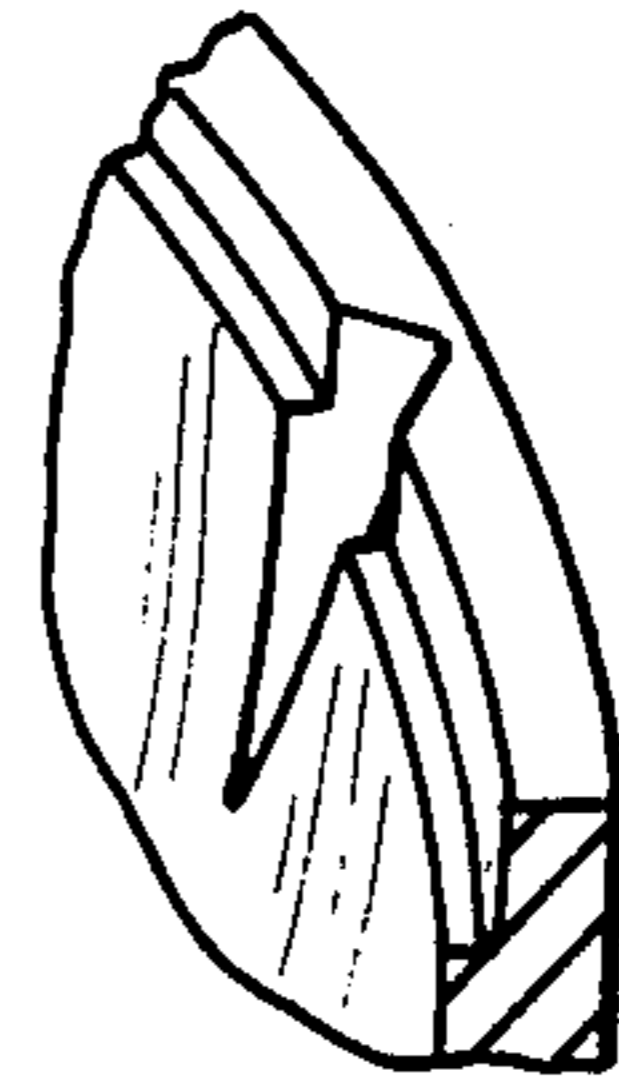
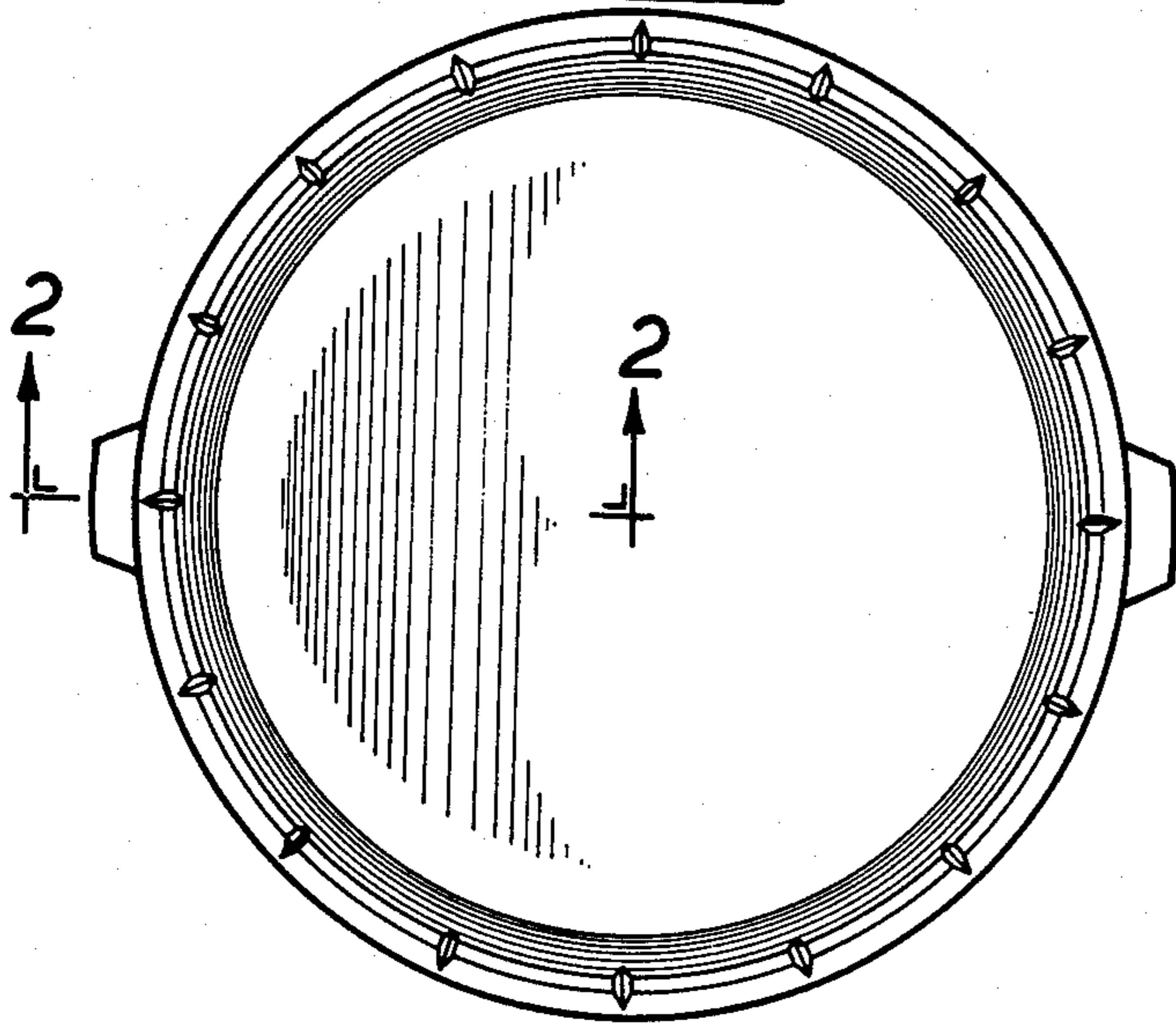

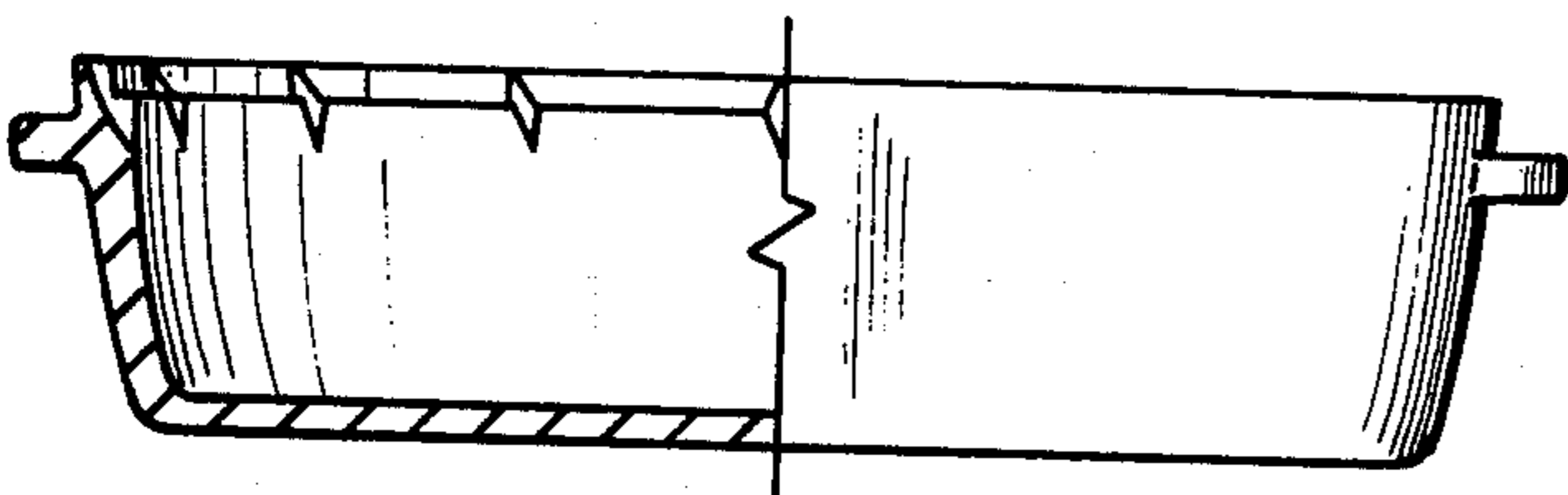

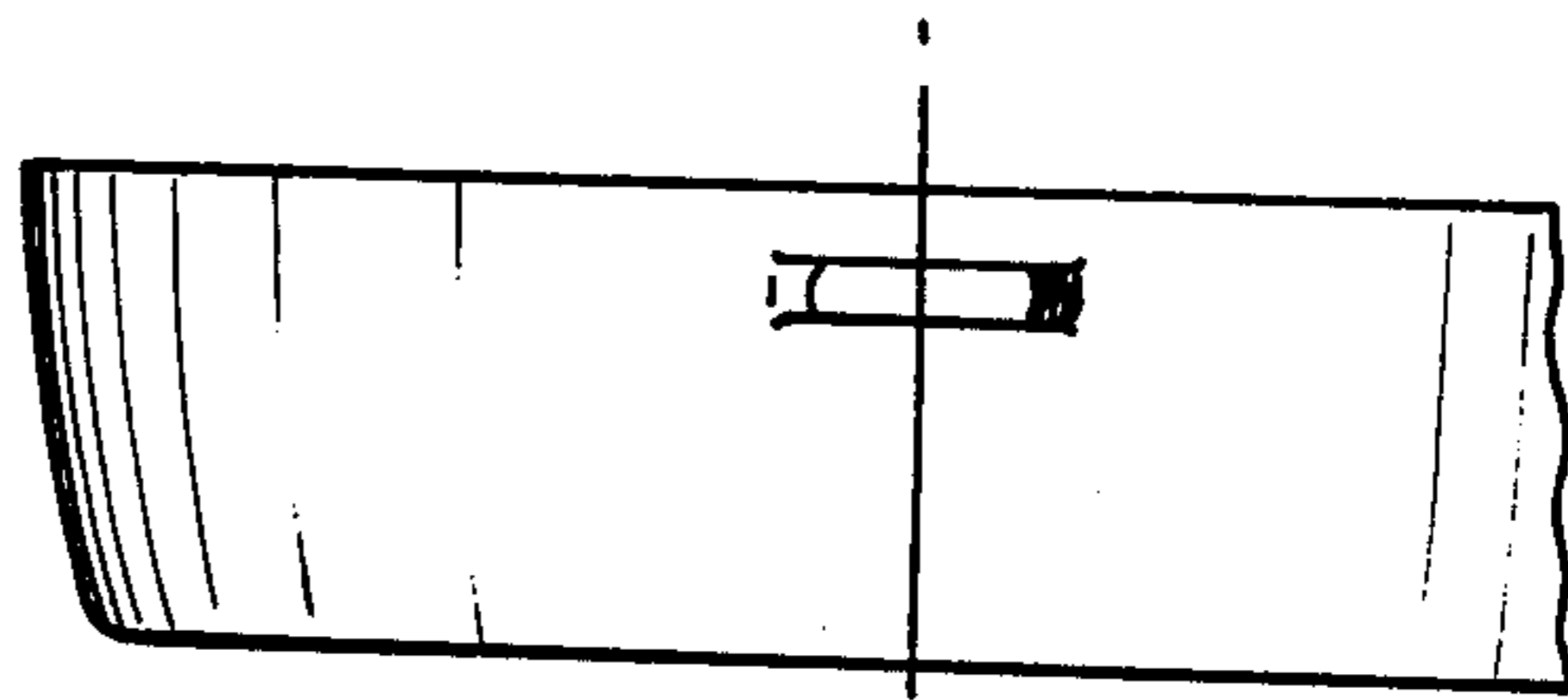
