DESCRIPTION

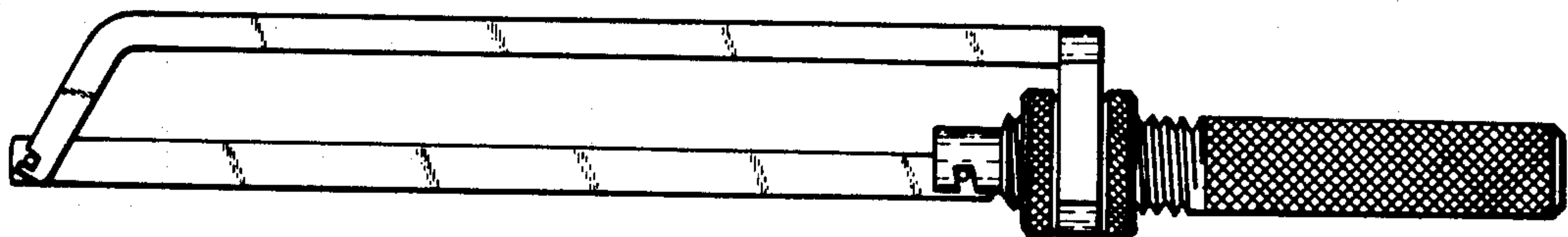
FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of the hacksaw design of my invention, the opposite side being the mirror image thereof,

FIG. 5 is an end view of the design as taken from the right of FIG. 1.



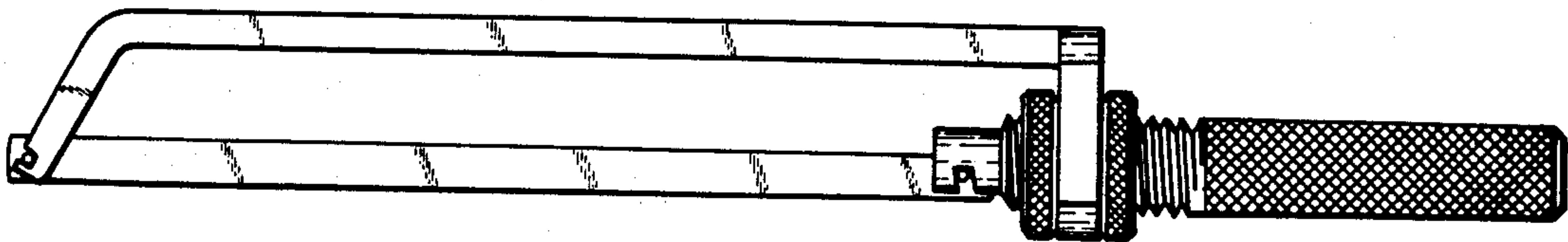

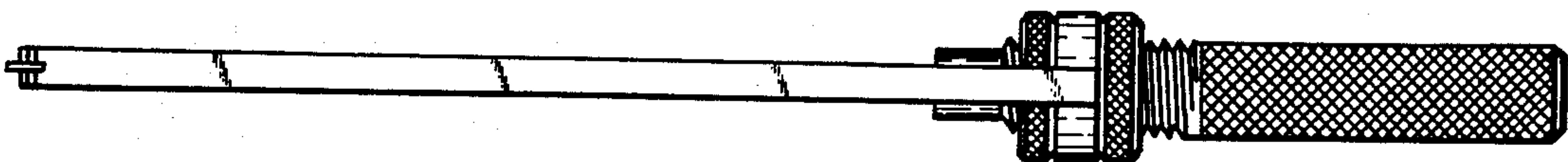

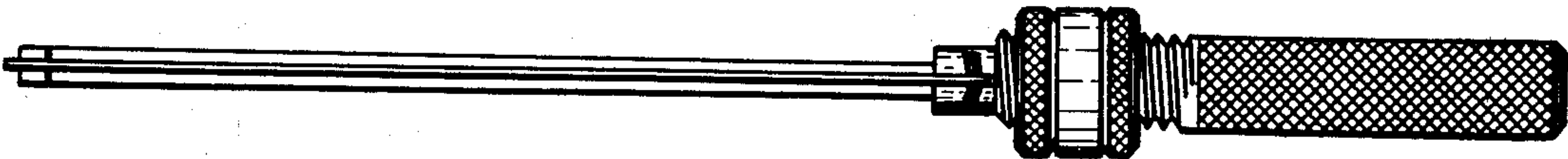

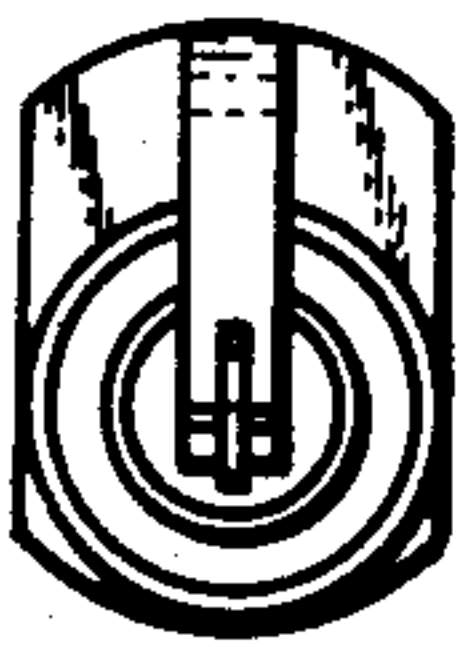
