## **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a photographic

camera or similar article showing my new design, with a hand crank shown in an inoperative position on the right side of the camera or similar article;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the camera or similar article of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view of the camera or similar article of FIG. 1;

1 FIG. 4 is a right-side elevational view of the camera or similar article of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a left-side elevational view of the camera or similar article of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the camera or similar article of FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view of the camera or similar article of FIG. 1;

FIG. 8 is a front elevational view similar to FIG. 2 but showing the hand crank in an operative position extending from the right side of the camera or similar article;


FIG. 9 is a bottom plan view similar to FIG. 3 but showing the hand crank in its operative position depicted in FIG. 8:


FIG. 10 is a right-side elevational view similar to FIG. 4 but showing the hand crank in its operative position depicted in FIG. 8;

FIG. 11 is a right-side elevational view similar to FIGS. 4 and 10 but showing another embodiment of my new design which has no hand crank;

FIG. 12 is a front elevational view of the camera or similar article of FIG. 11; and

FIG. 13 is a bottom plan view of the camera or similar article of FIG. 11.





















