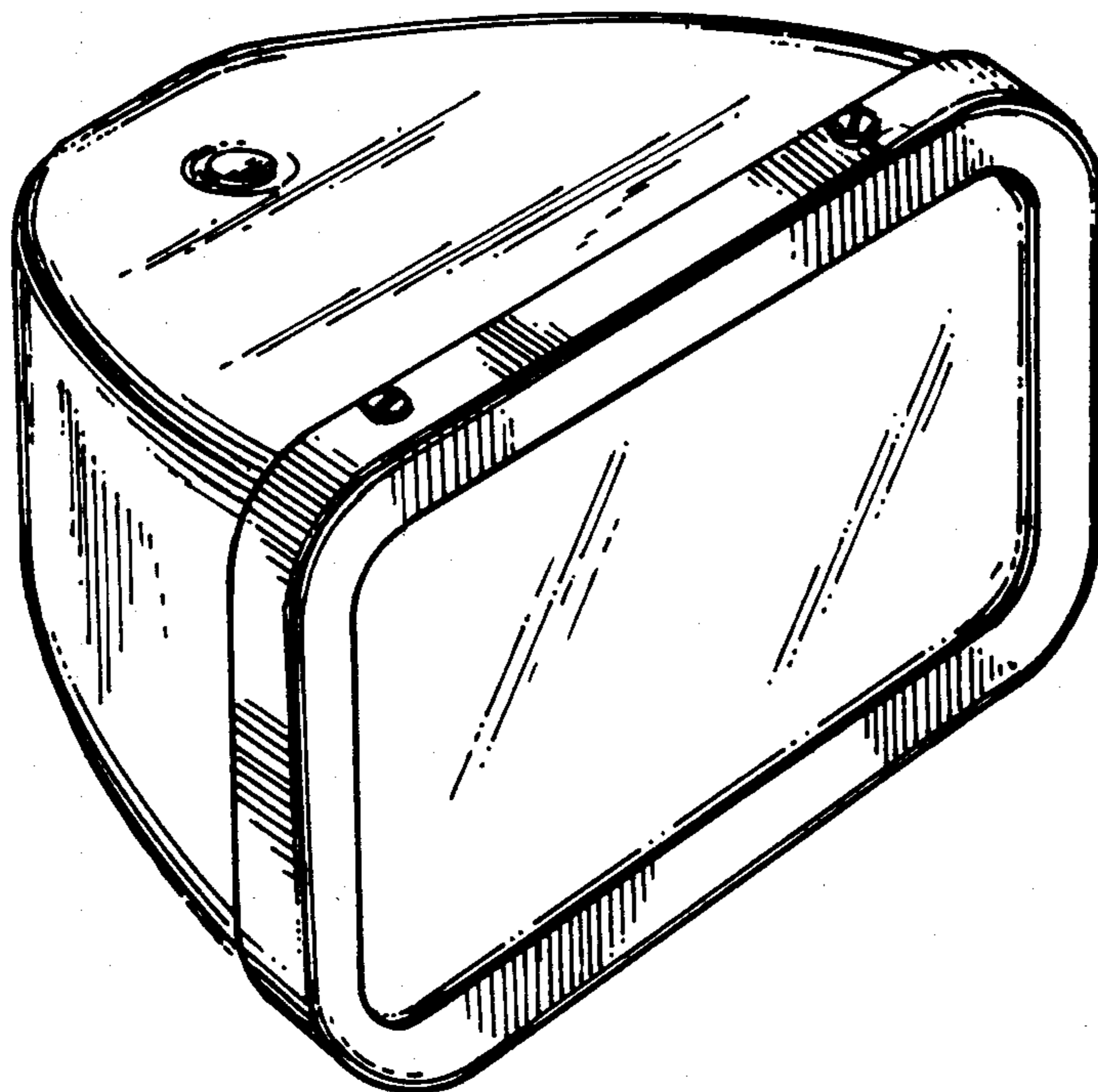

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a headlamp housing embodying the new design;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the housing shown in FIG. 1.



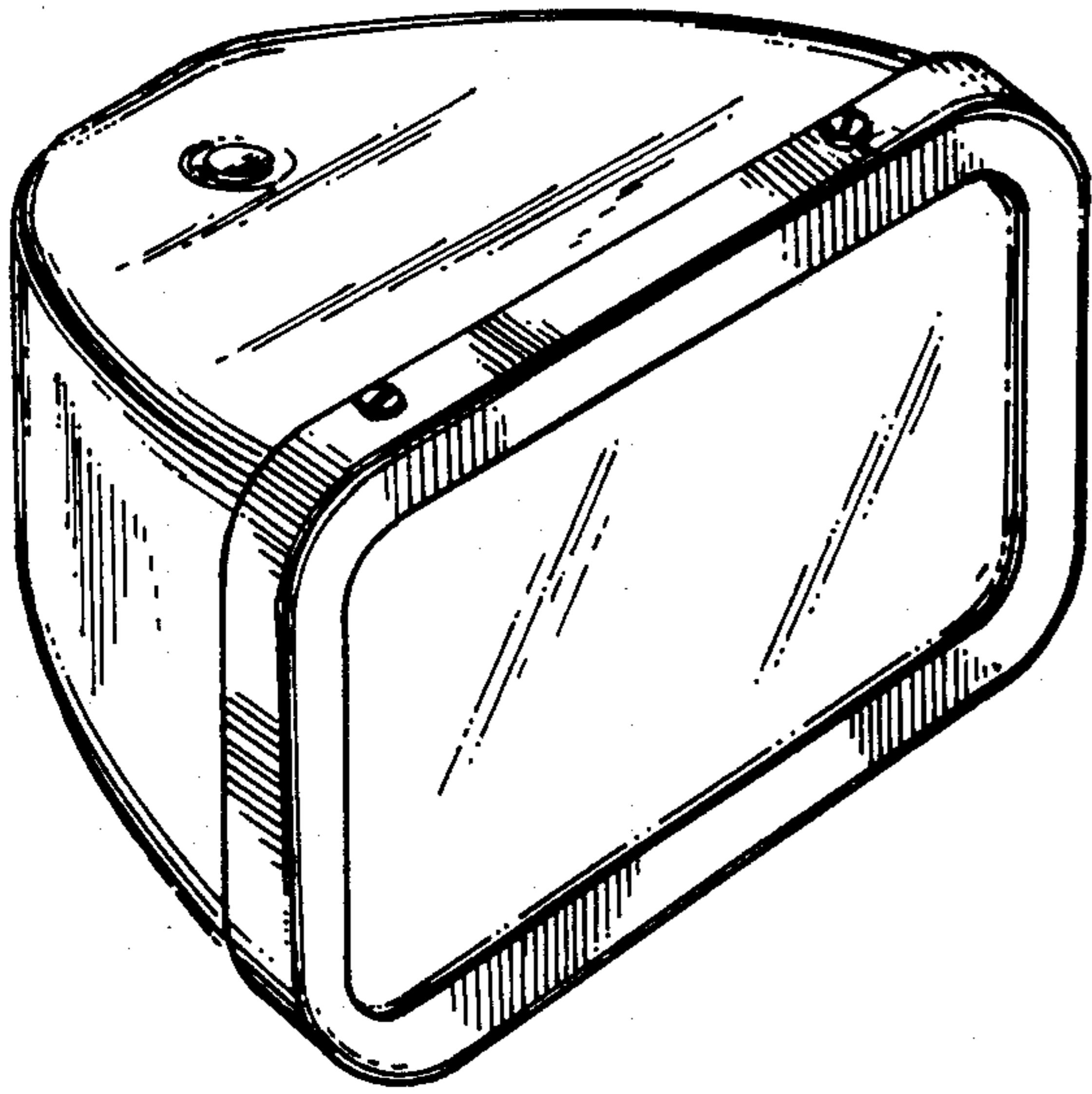

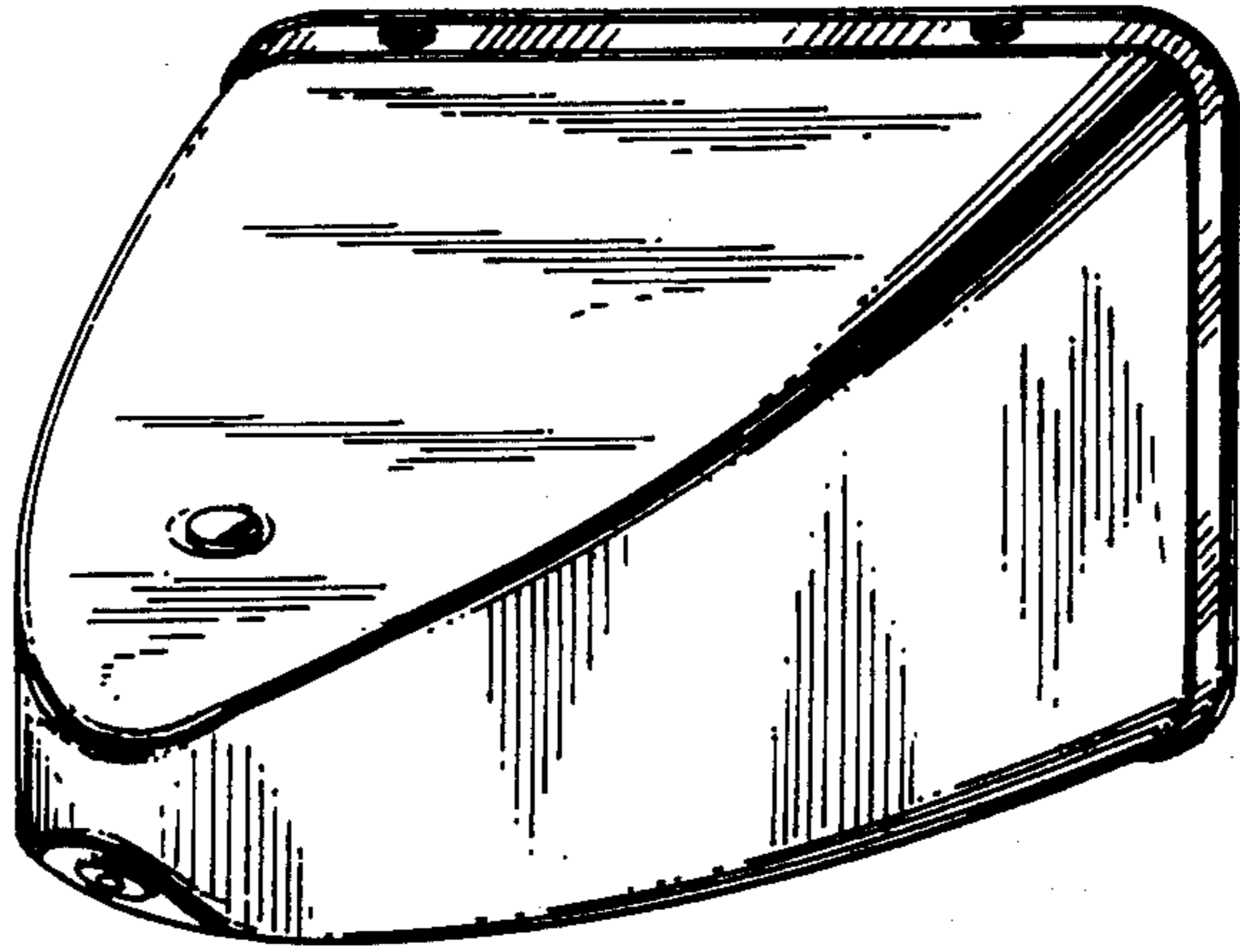

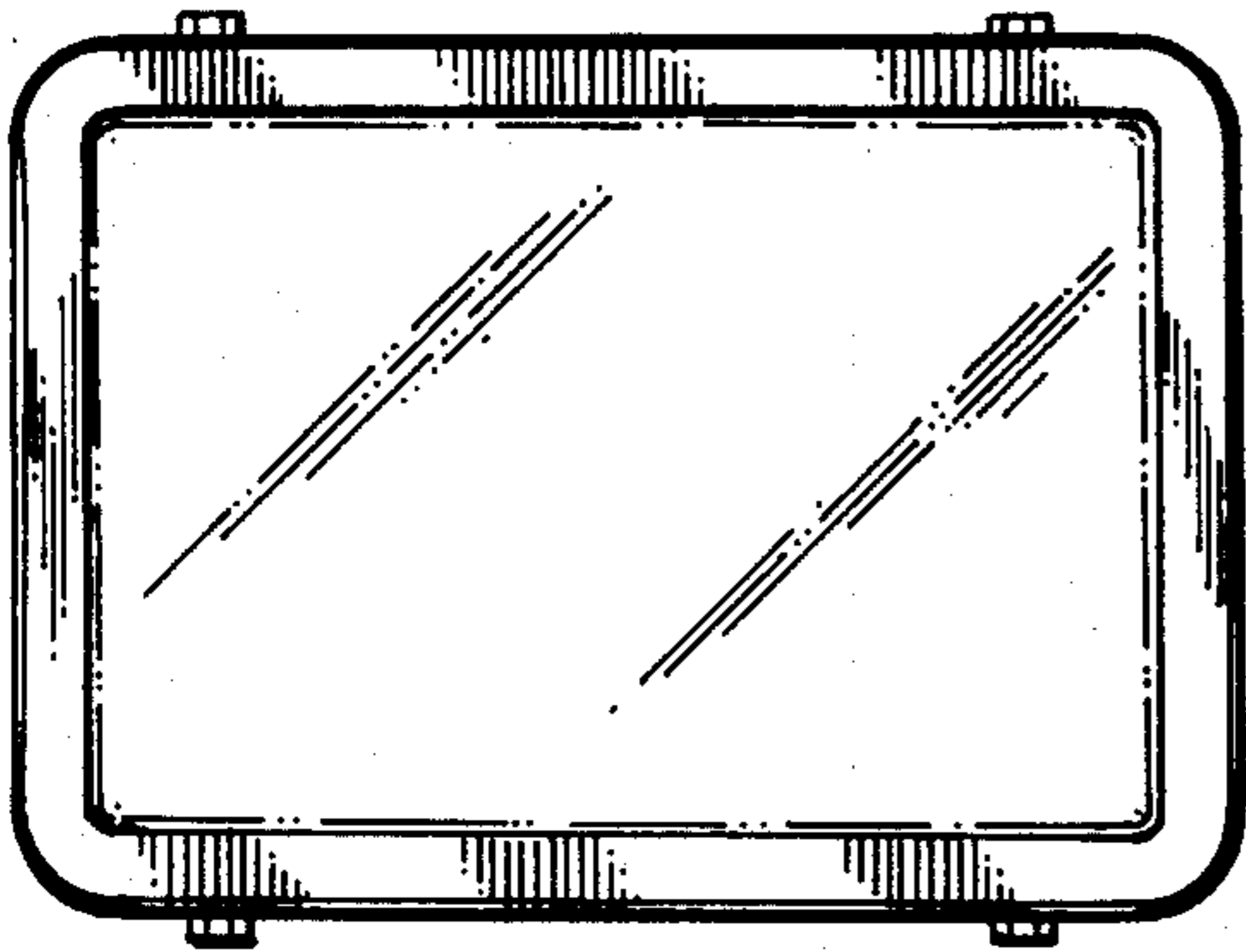

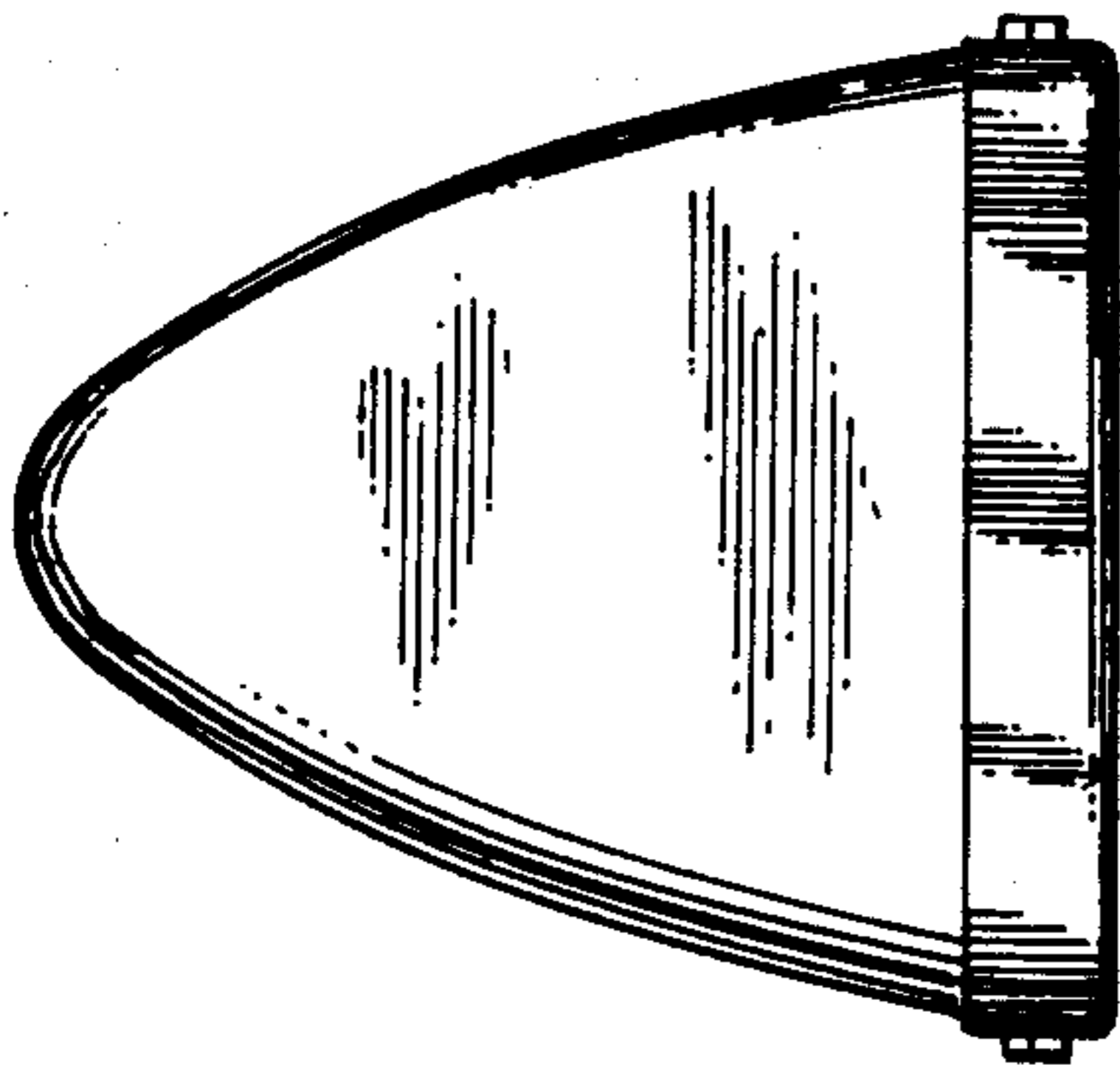

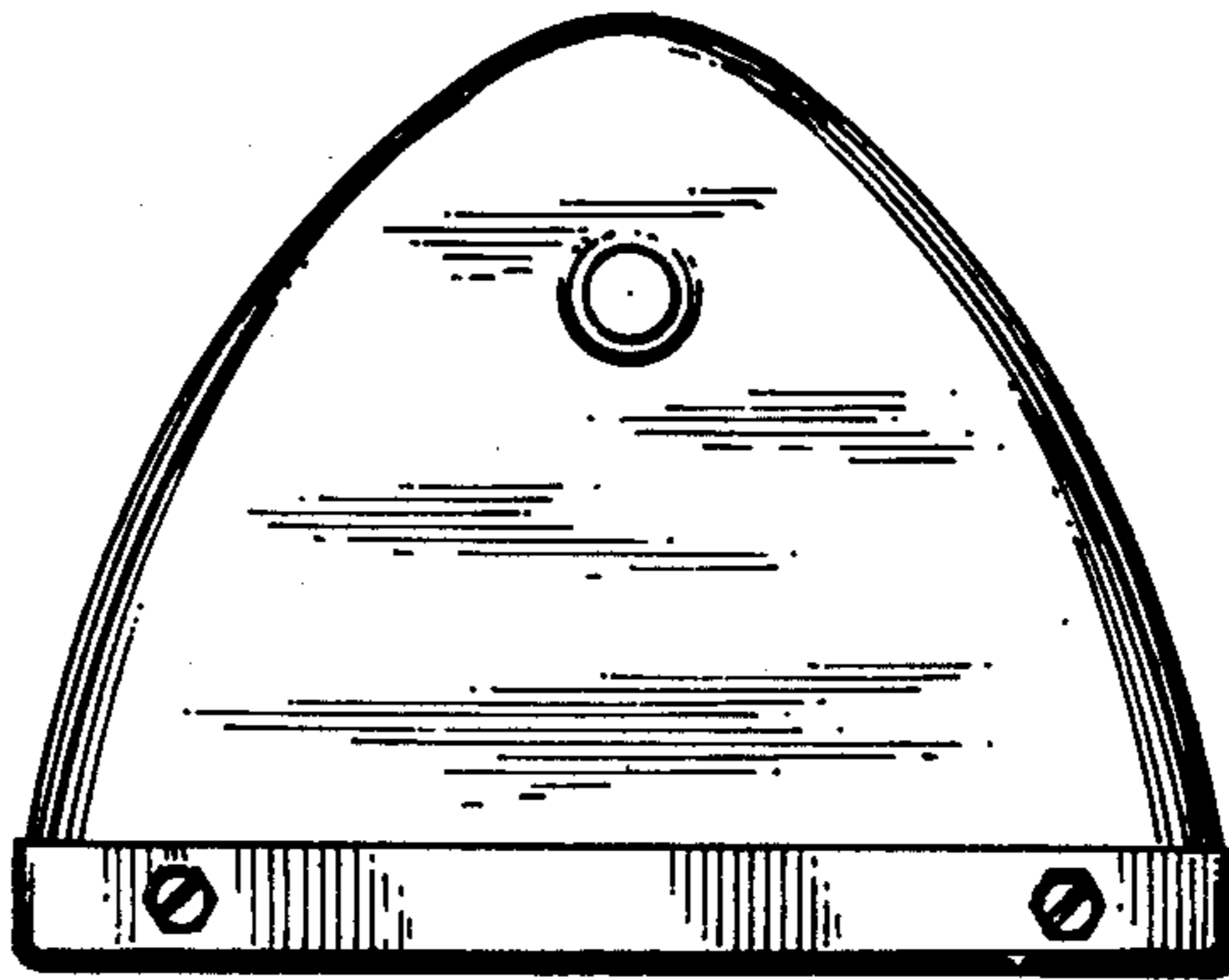
