The ornamental design for an automobile accessory lamp, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an automobile accessory lamp embodying our new design;
 FIG. 2 is a front view of the automobile accessory lamp of FIG. 1;
 FIG. 3 is a rear view of the automobile accessory lamp of FIG. 1;
 FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the automobile accessory lamp of FIG. 1;
 FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the automobile accessory lamp of FIG. 1;
 FIG. 6 is a side view of the automobile accessory lamp of FIG. 1 from the left side thereof;
 FIG. 7 is a side view of the automobile accessory lamp of FIG. 1 from the right side thereof; and
 FIG. 8 is a front perspective view, similar to FIG. 1, showing an alternative embodiment thereof.

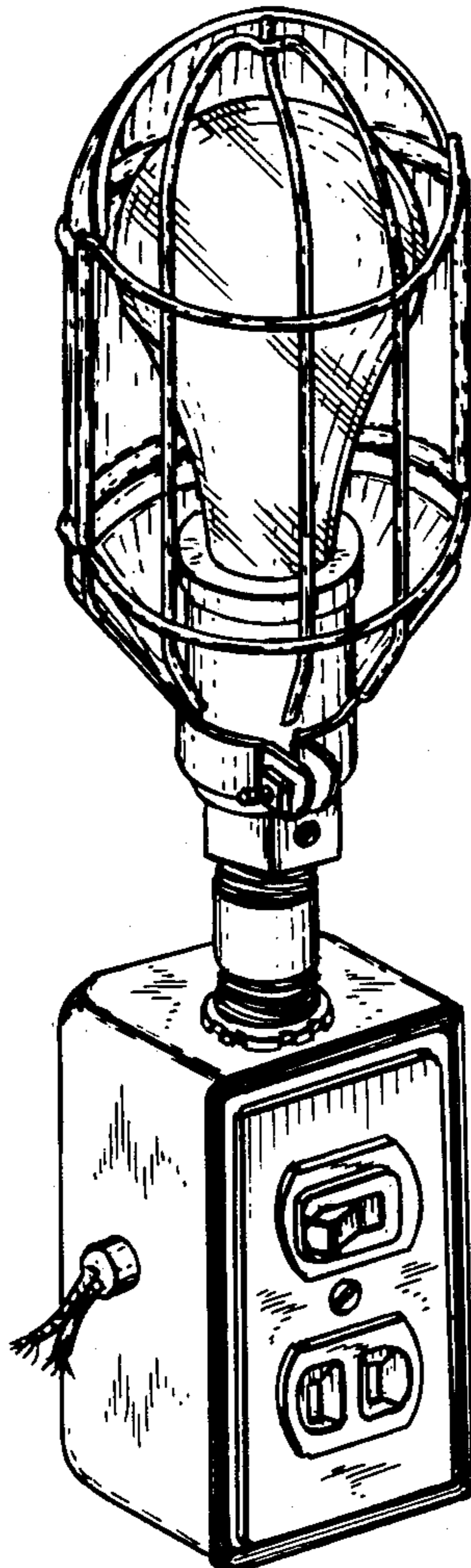

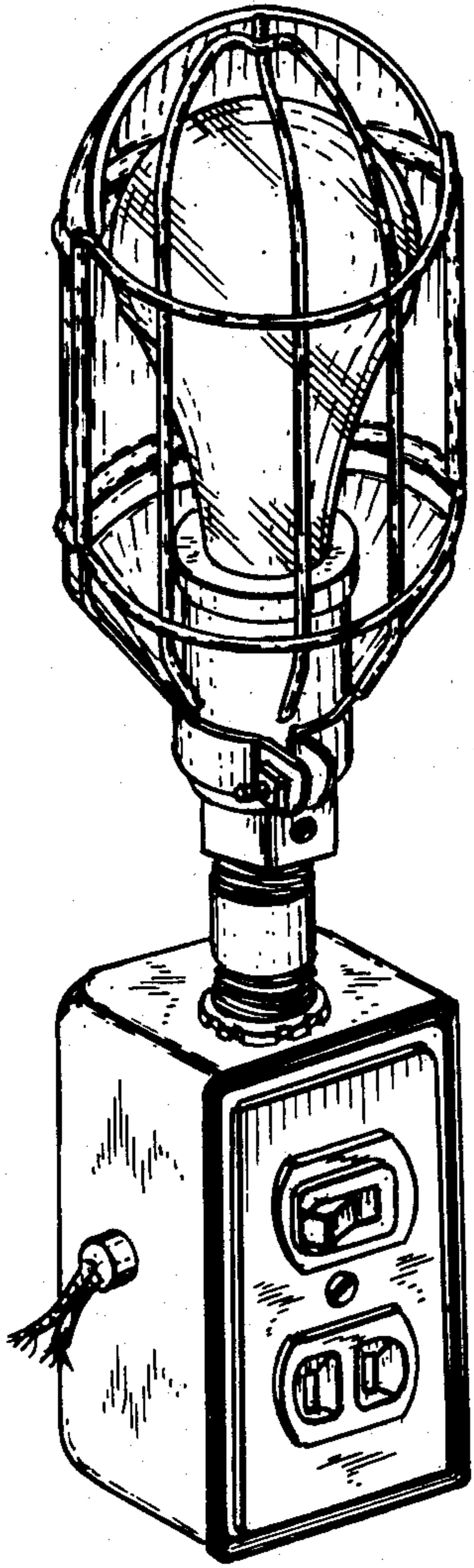

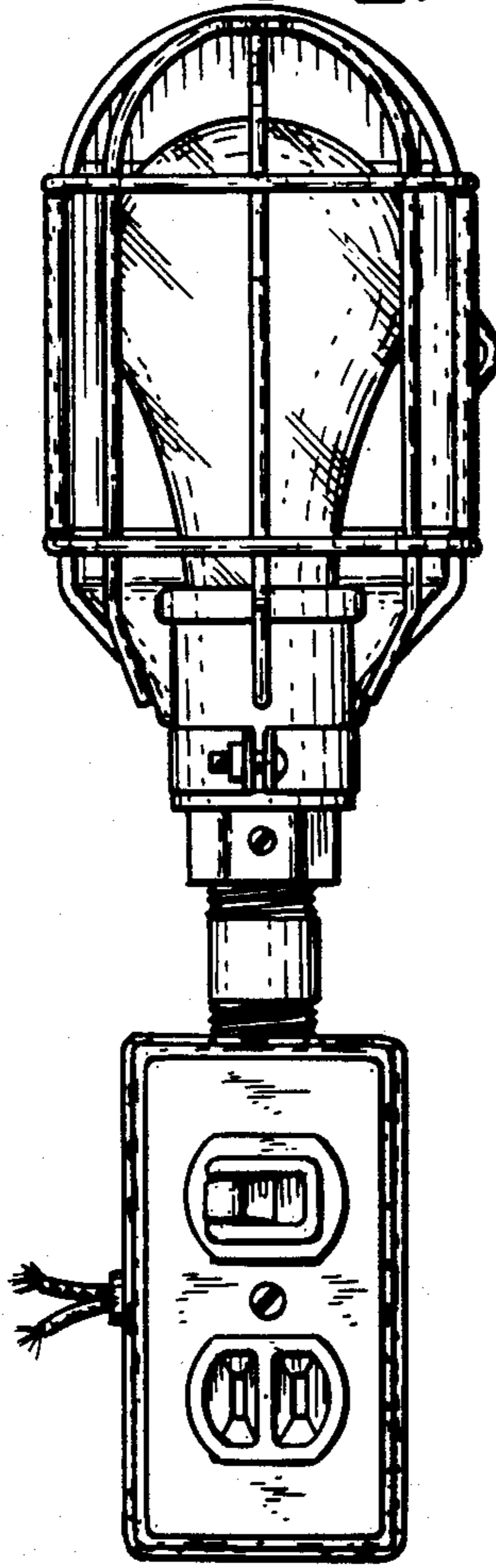

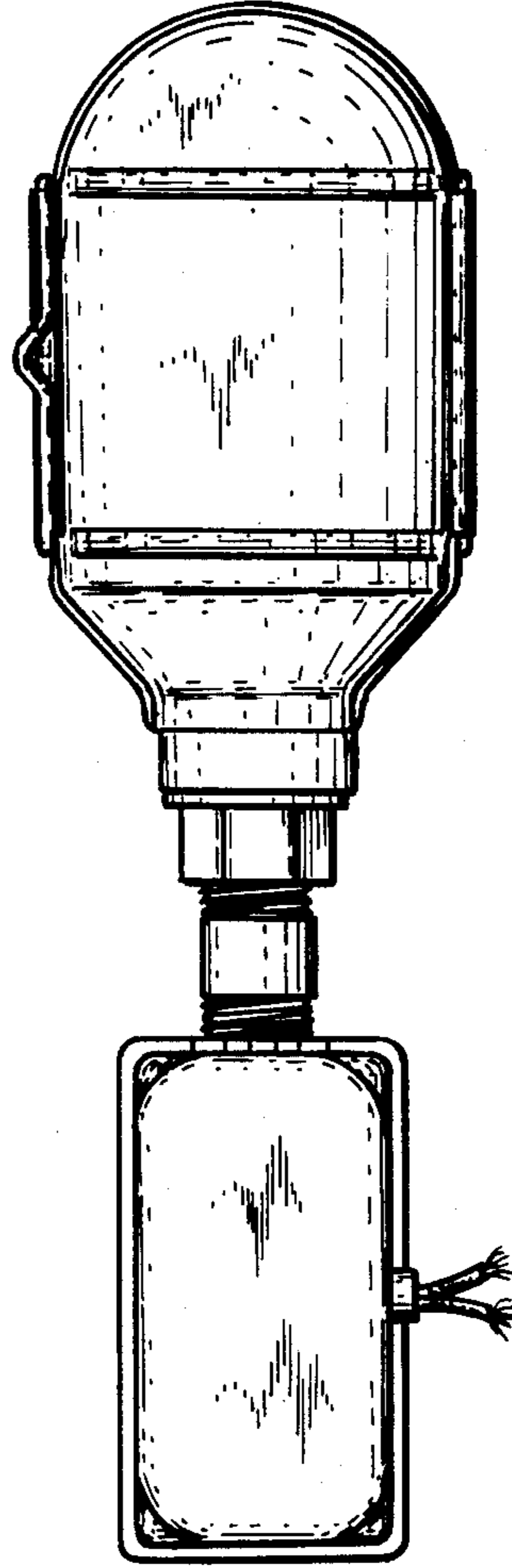

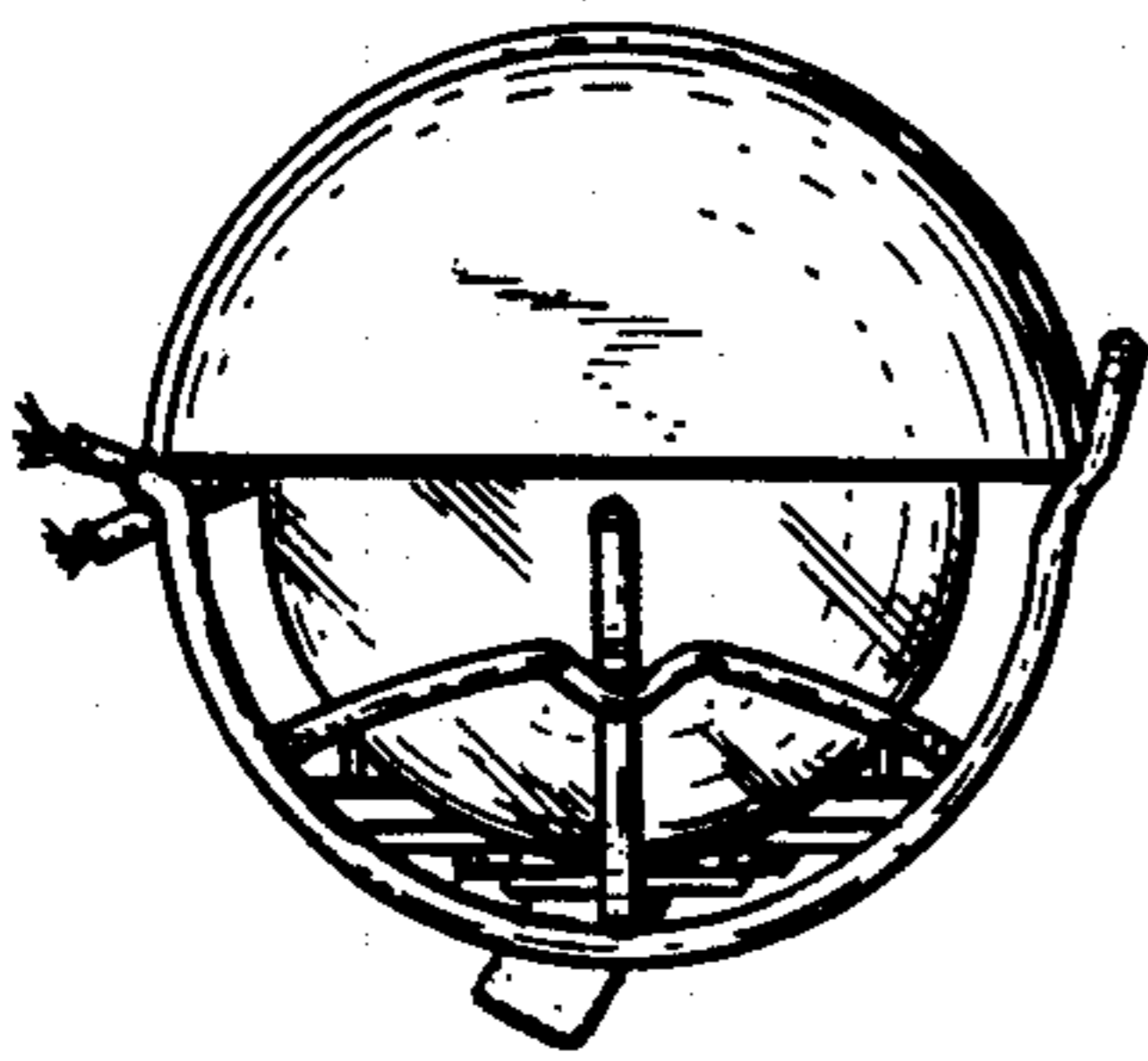

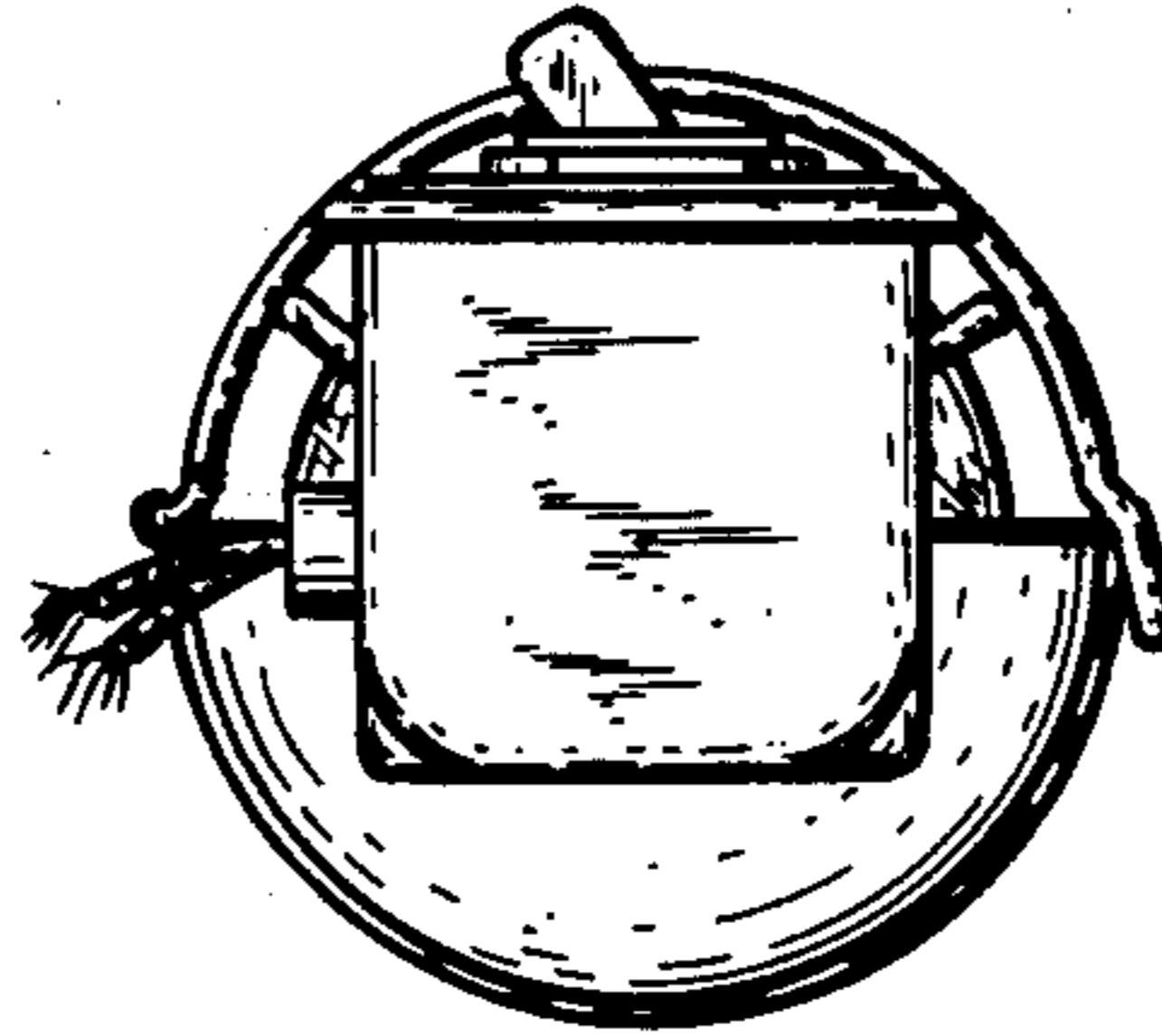

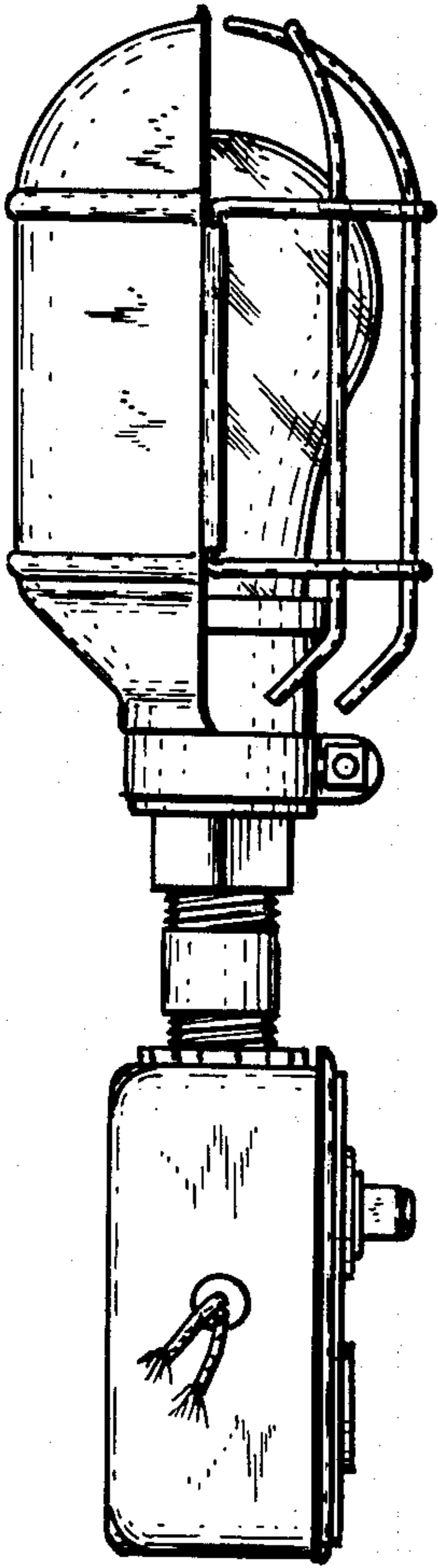

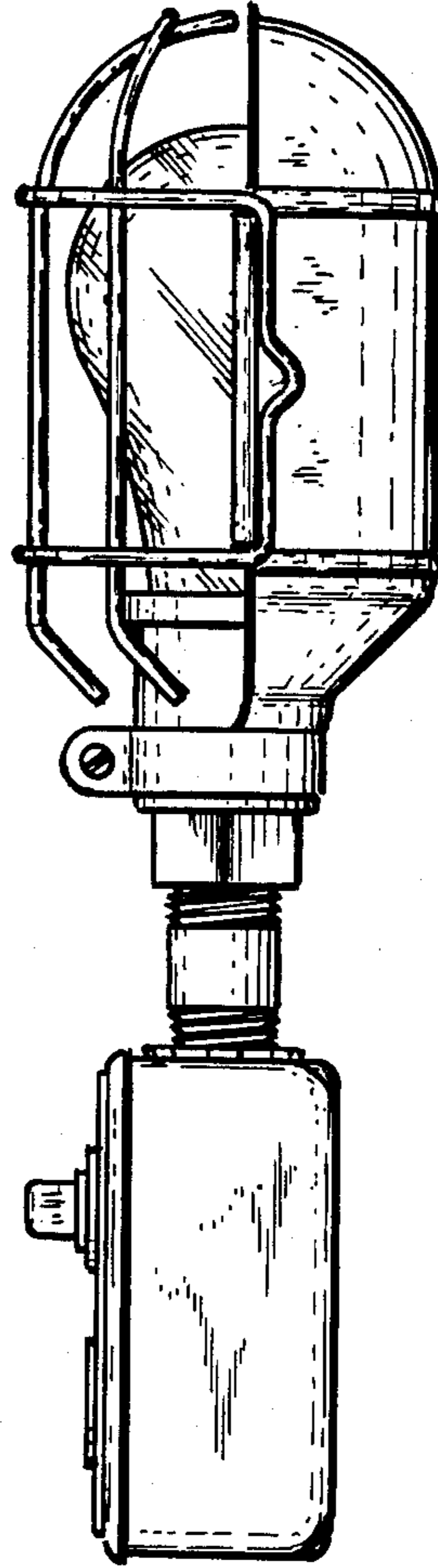
