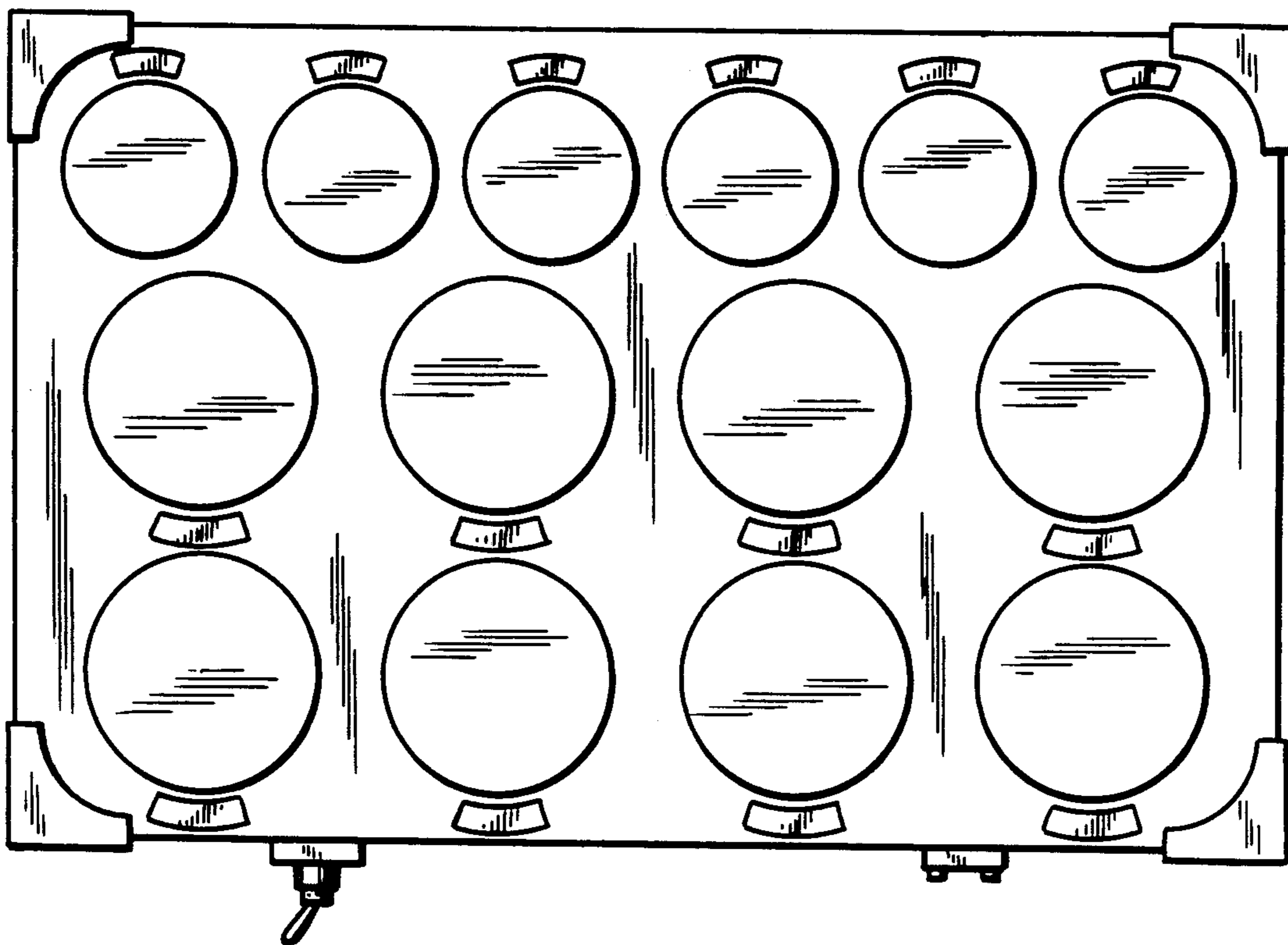

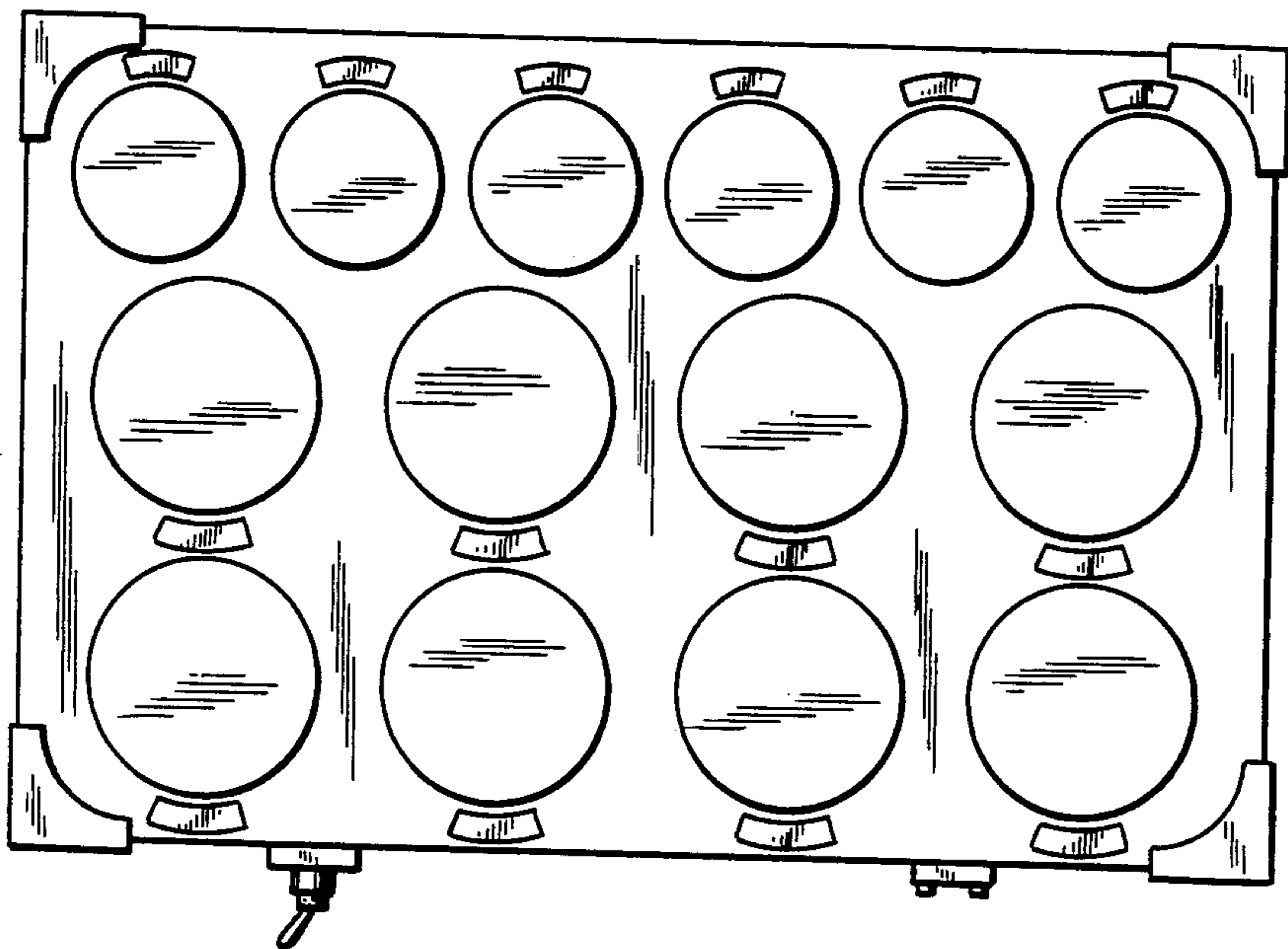
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an electronic percussion musical instrument, substantially as shown.

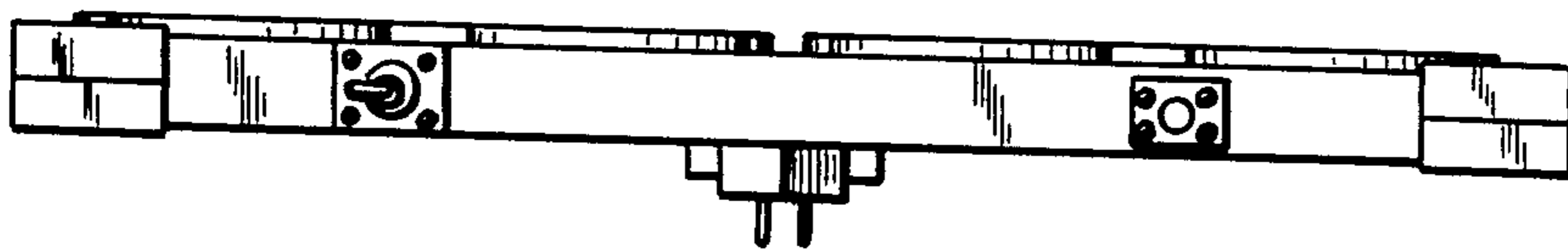
DESCRIPTION

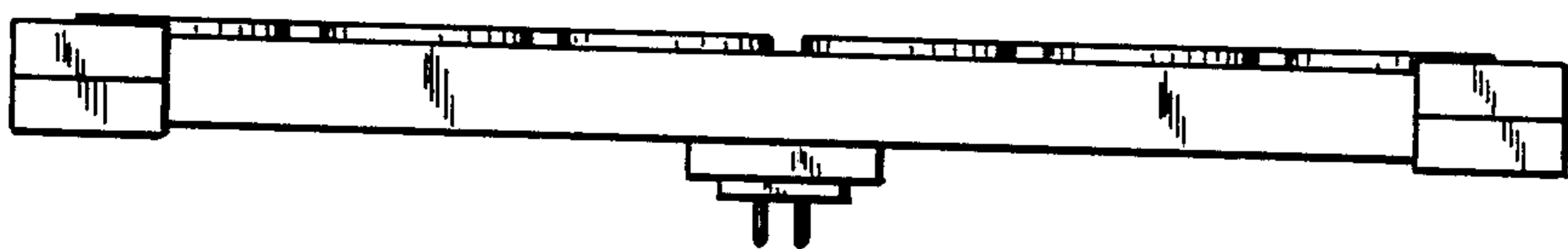




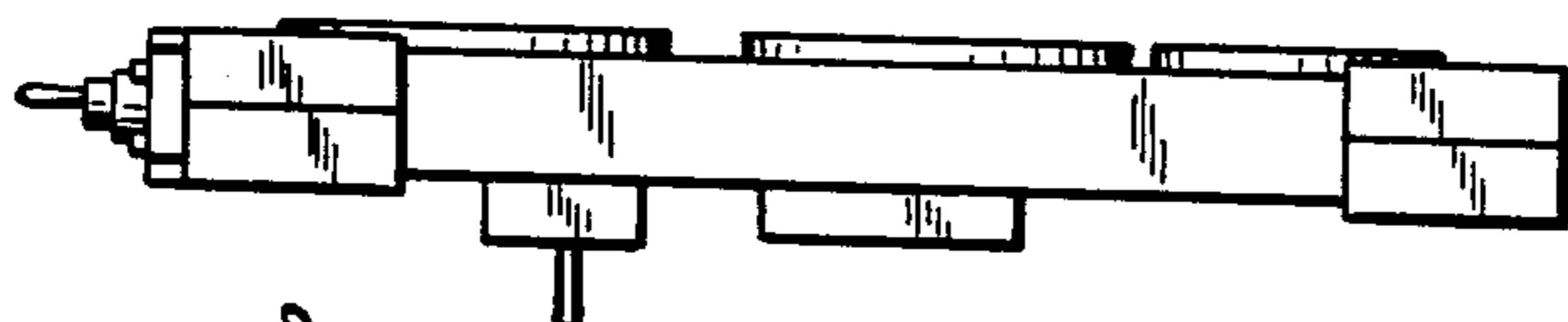

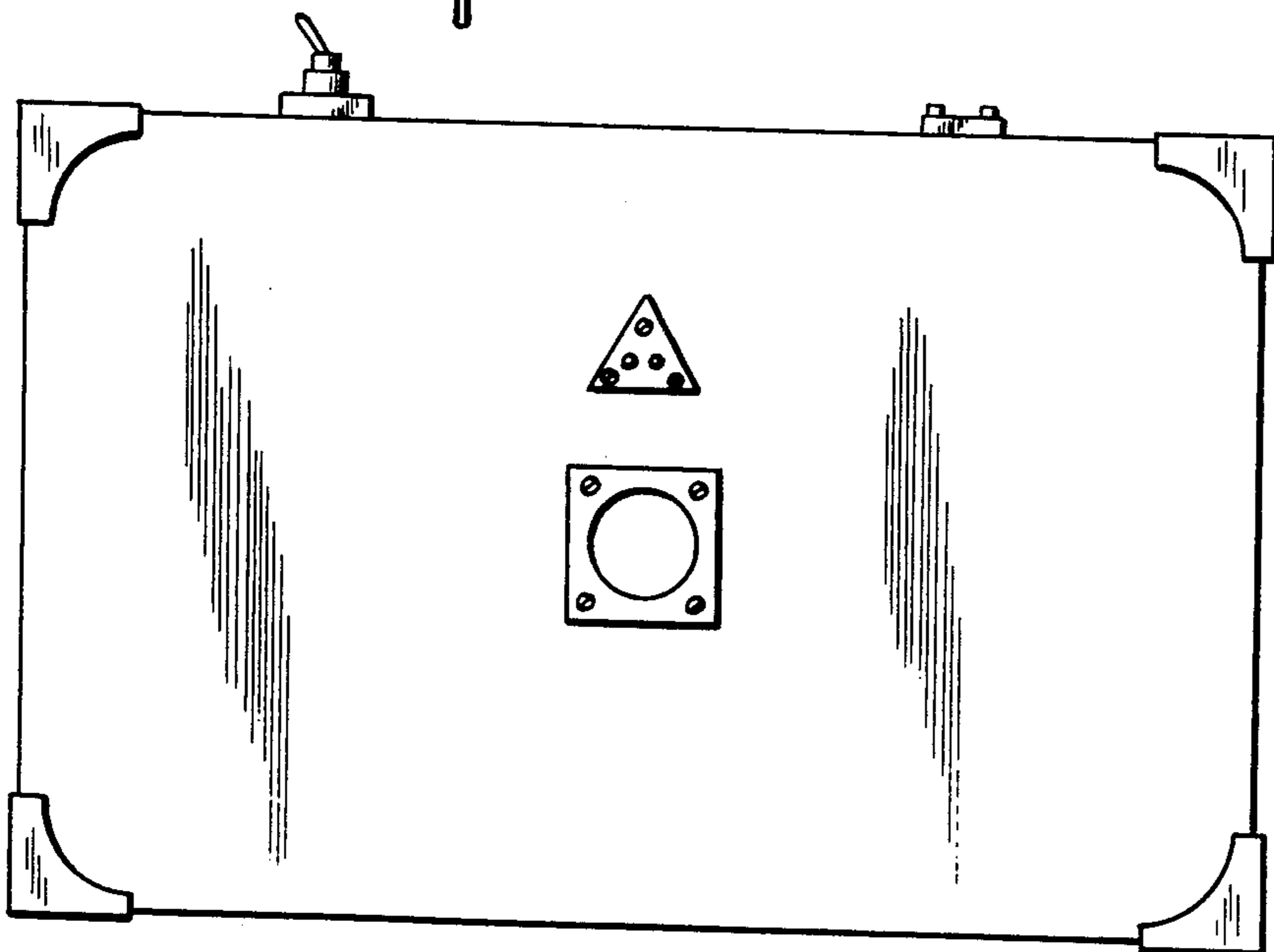
