The ornamental design for a jig for cutting tile, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of the jig for cutting tile, in the expanded in-use, position.

FIG. 2 is a left side view thereof.

FIG. 3 is a front end view thereof.

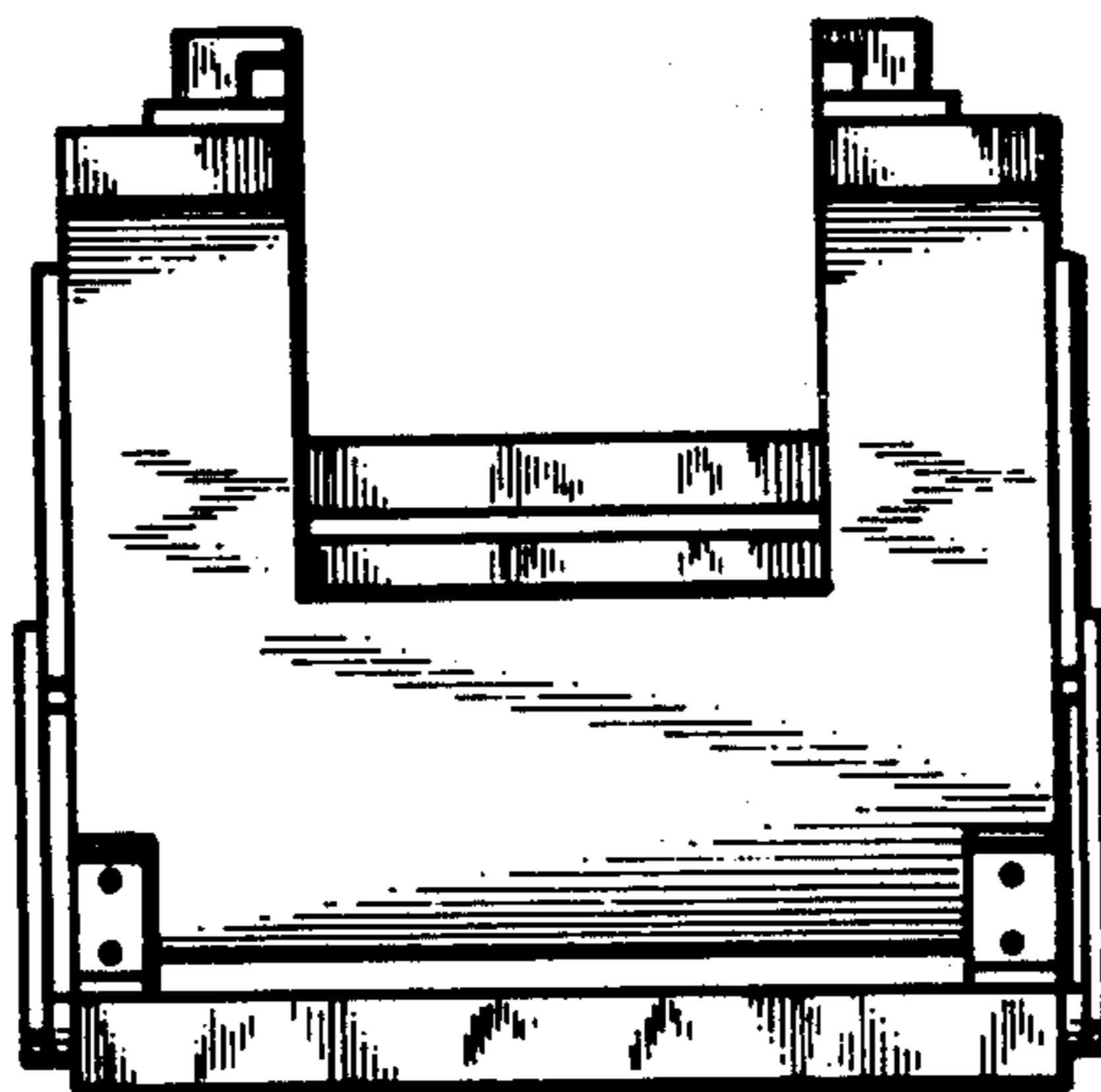
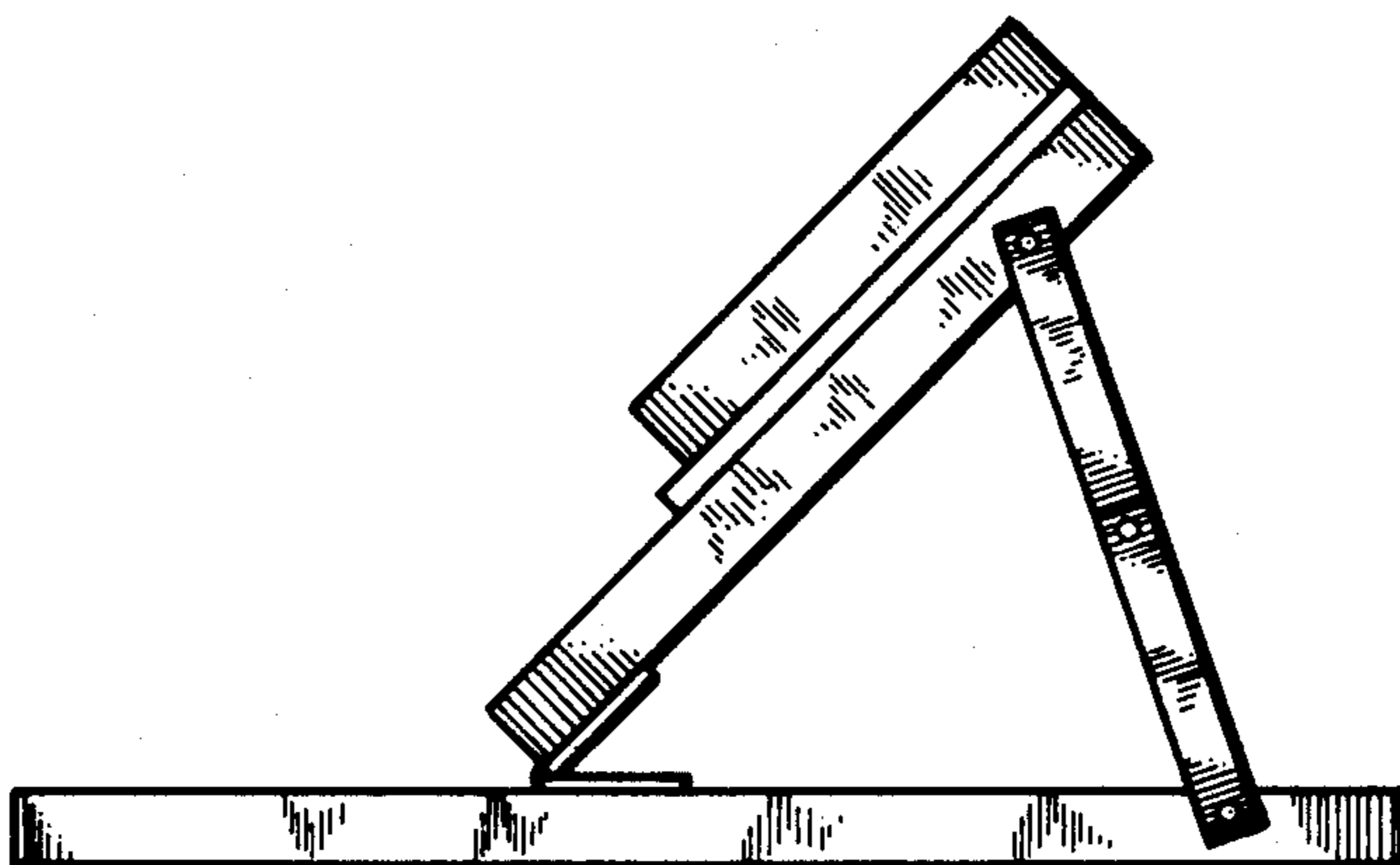
FIG. 4 is a bottom view thereof.

FIG. 5 is a rear end view thereof.

FIG. 6 is a side view thereof similar to FIG. 2 but showing the unit in the collapsed, in-storage, condition.

FIG. 7 is a front view thereof in the collapsed condition.

The right-hand side view is identical to FIG. 2 and FIG. 6 for the open and closed condition, except that it is a mirror image thereof.



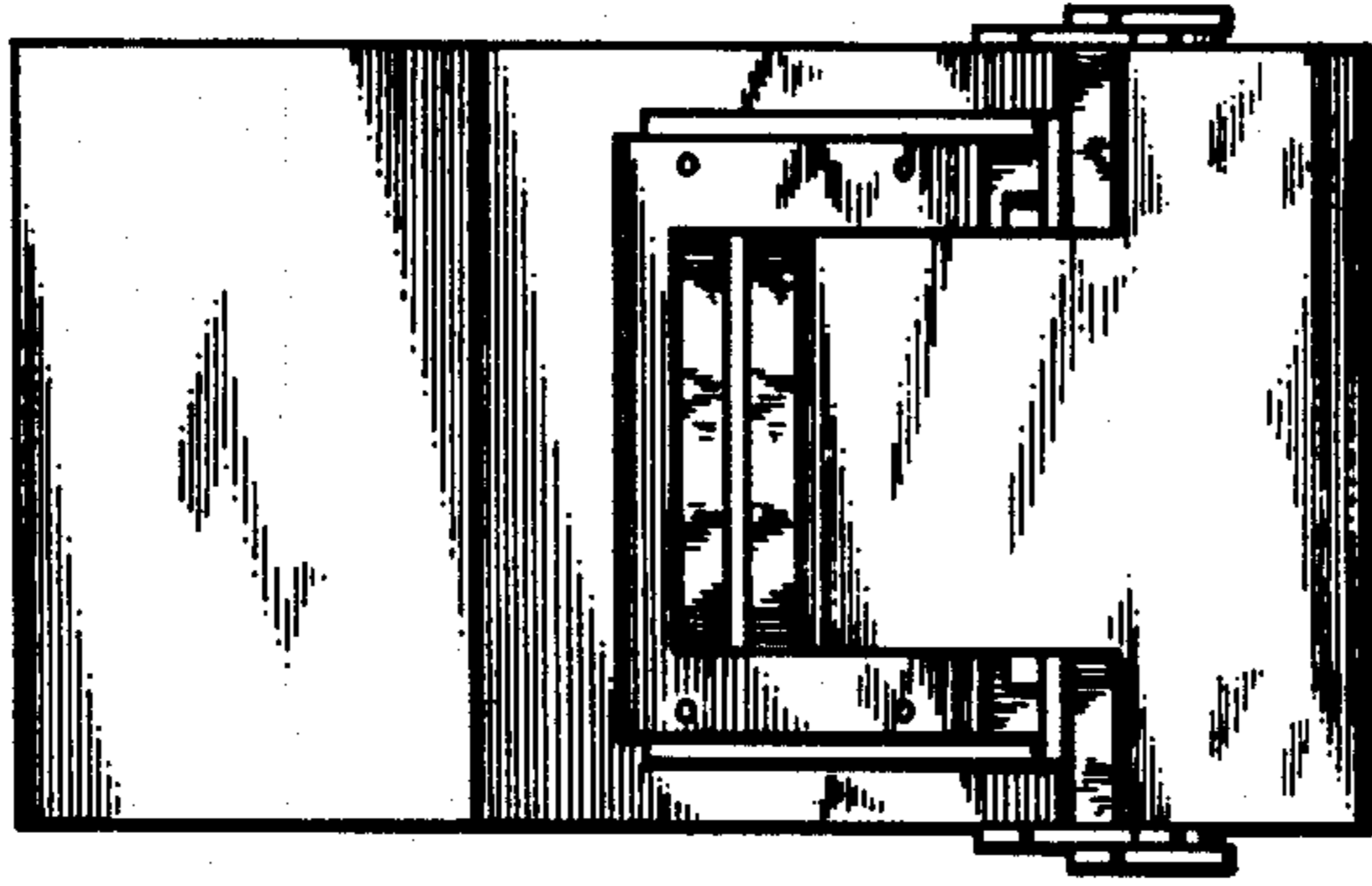

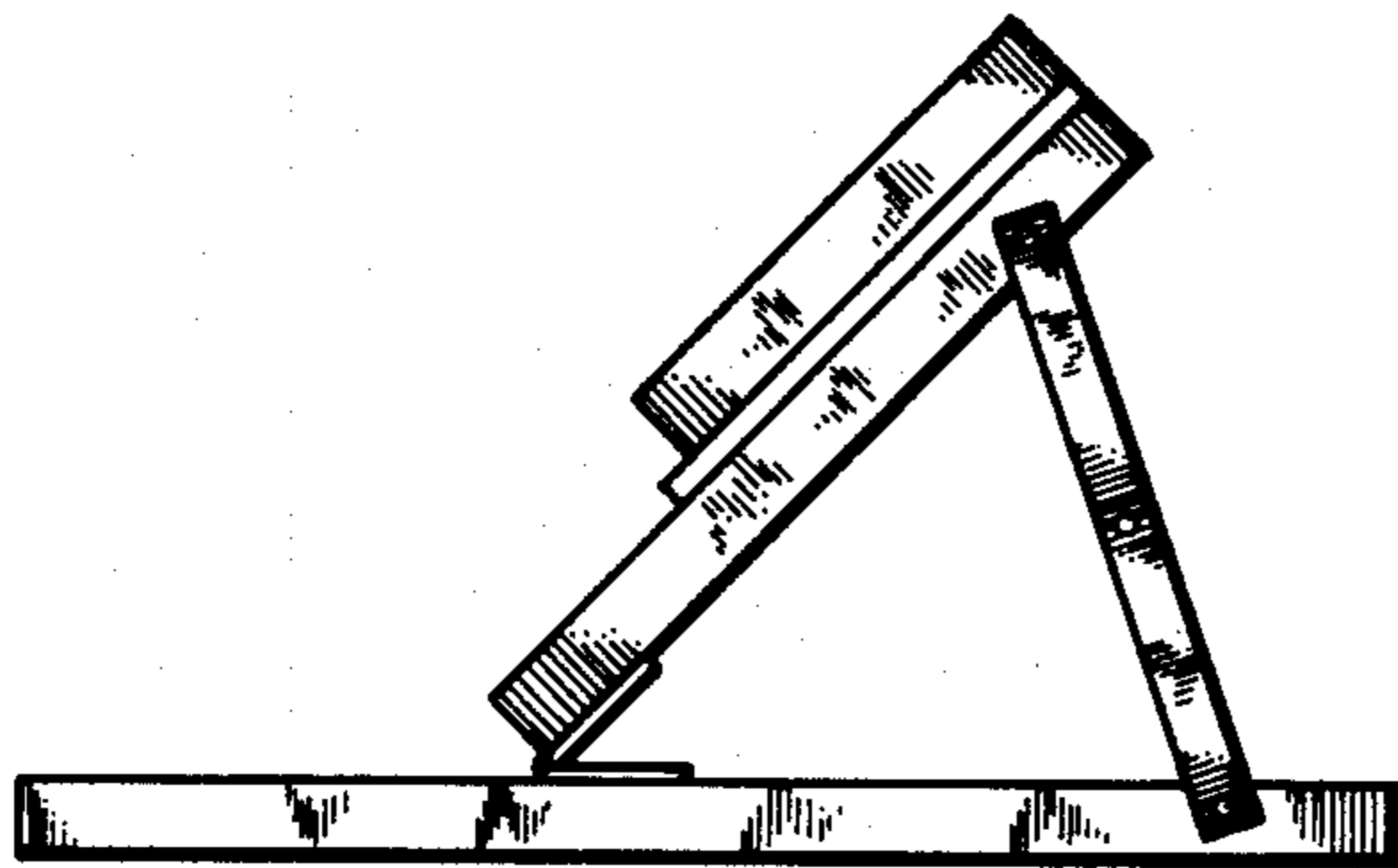

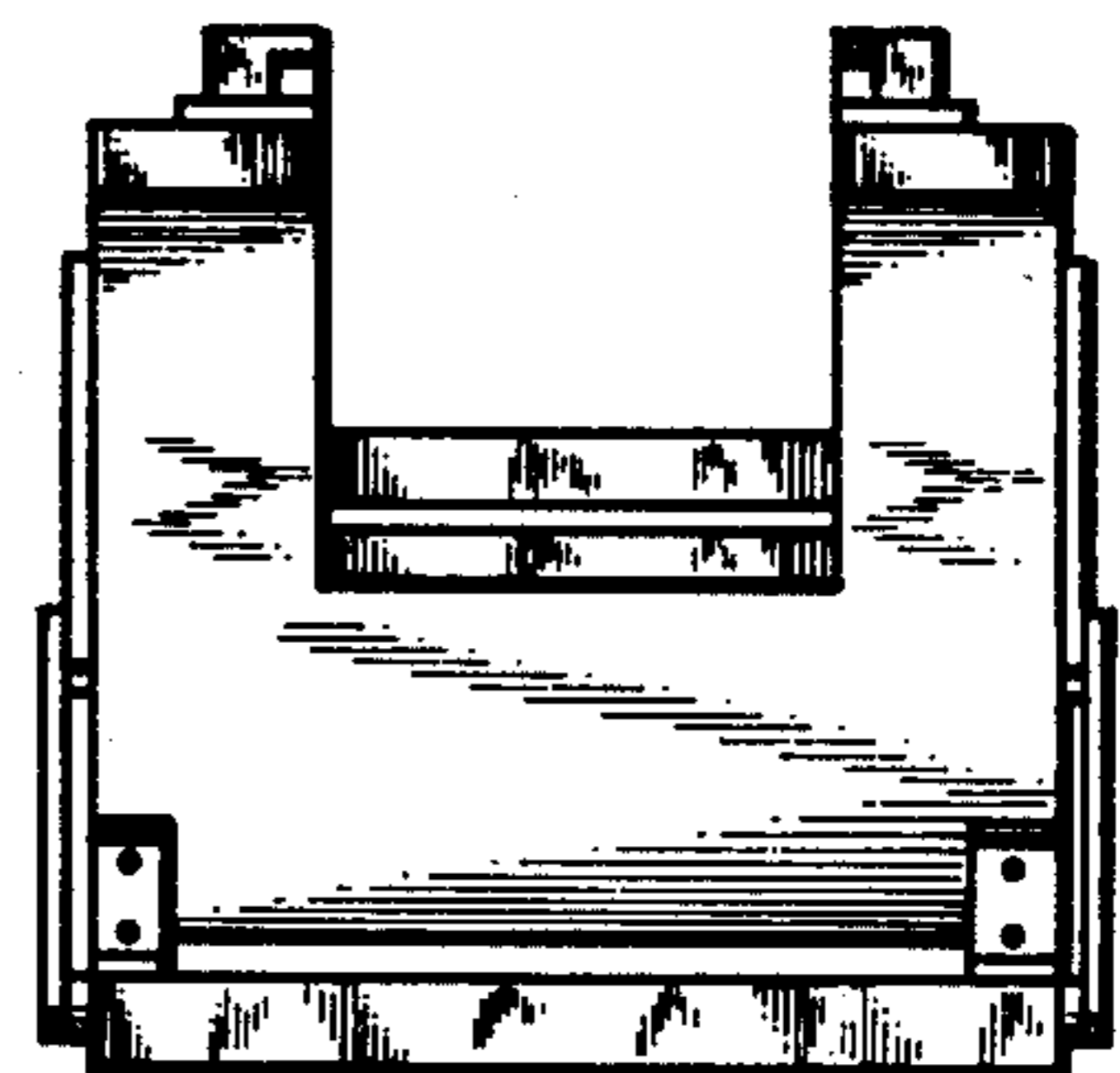

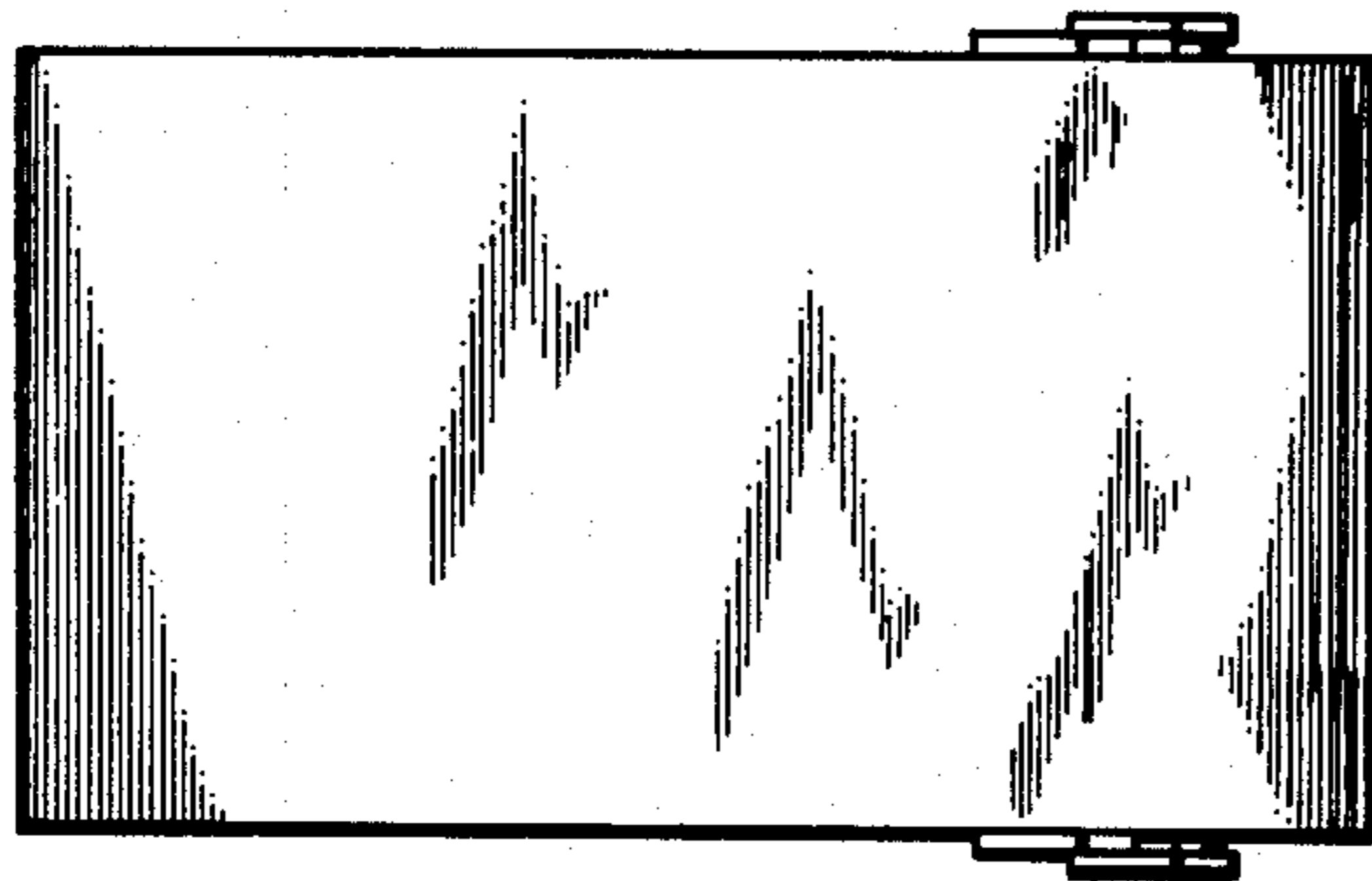

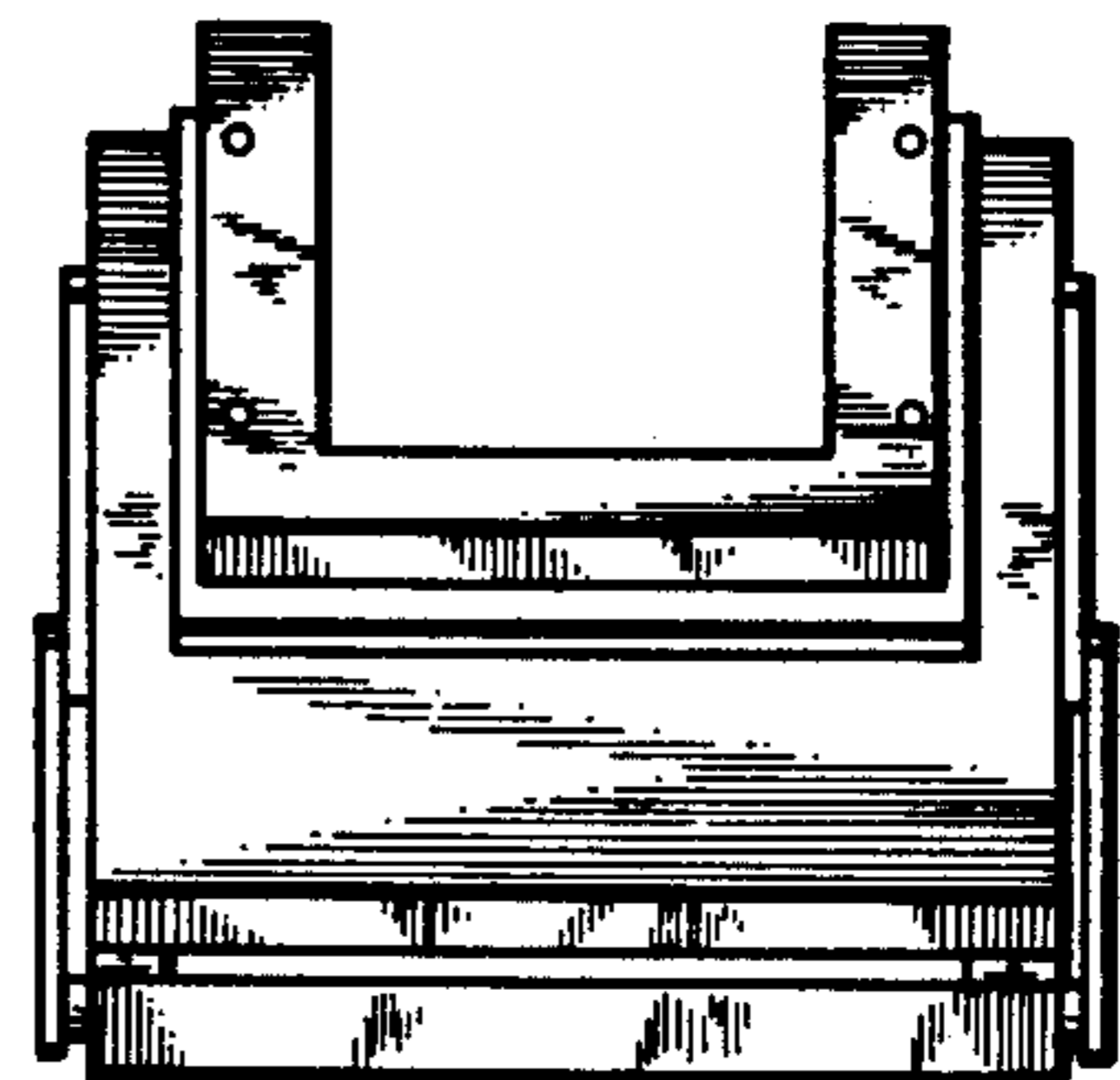
