DESCRIPTION

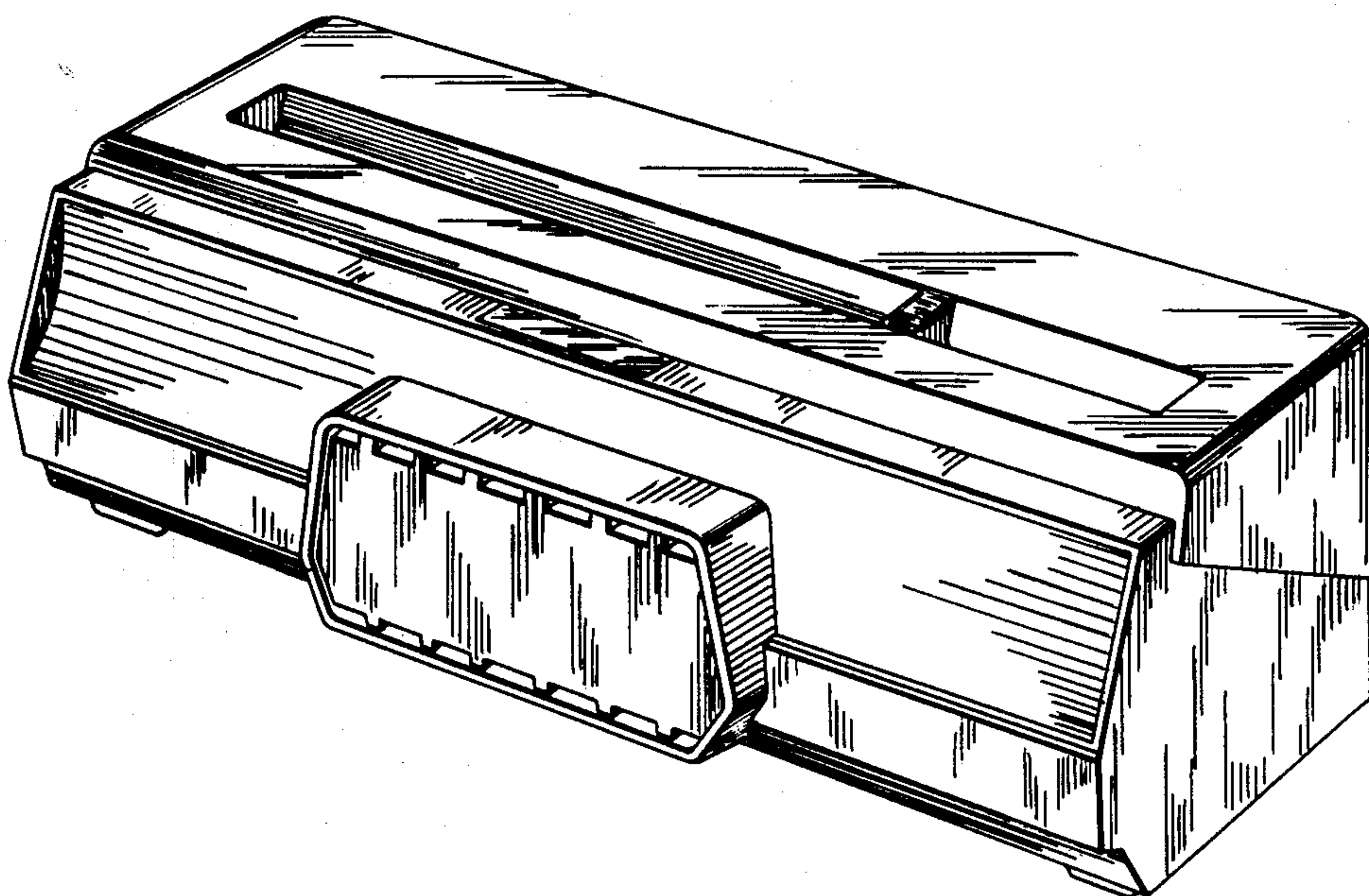
FIG. 1 is a perspective front view of the appliance for cutting, sealing and making plastic bags showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is an elevational view looking at the rear of the appliance.



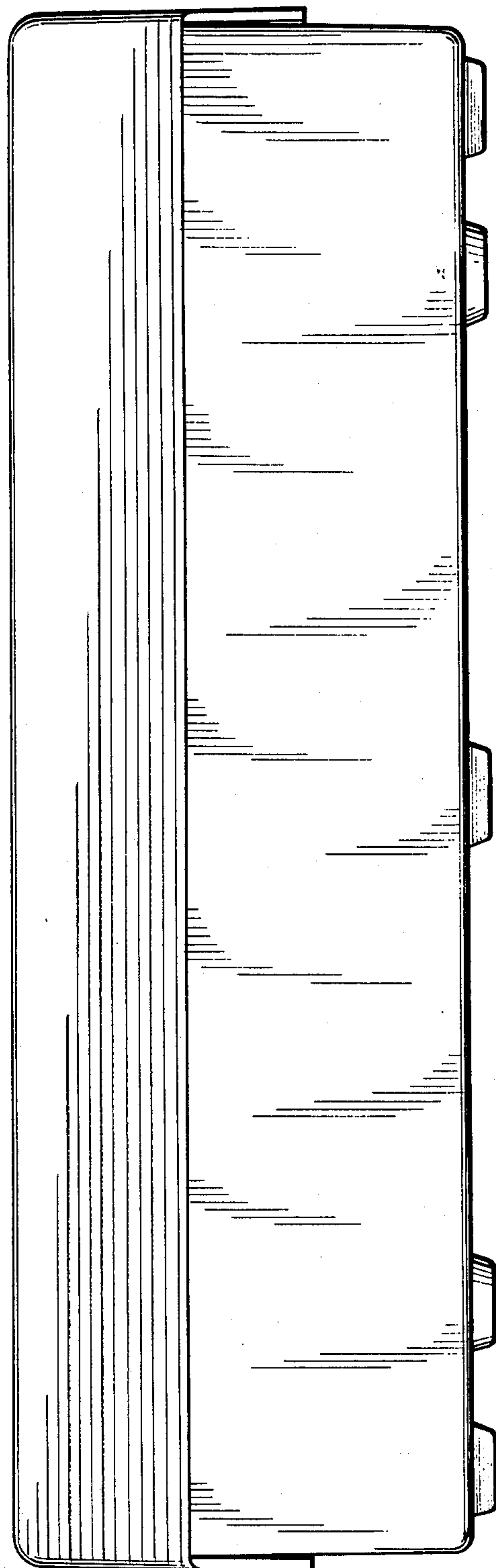
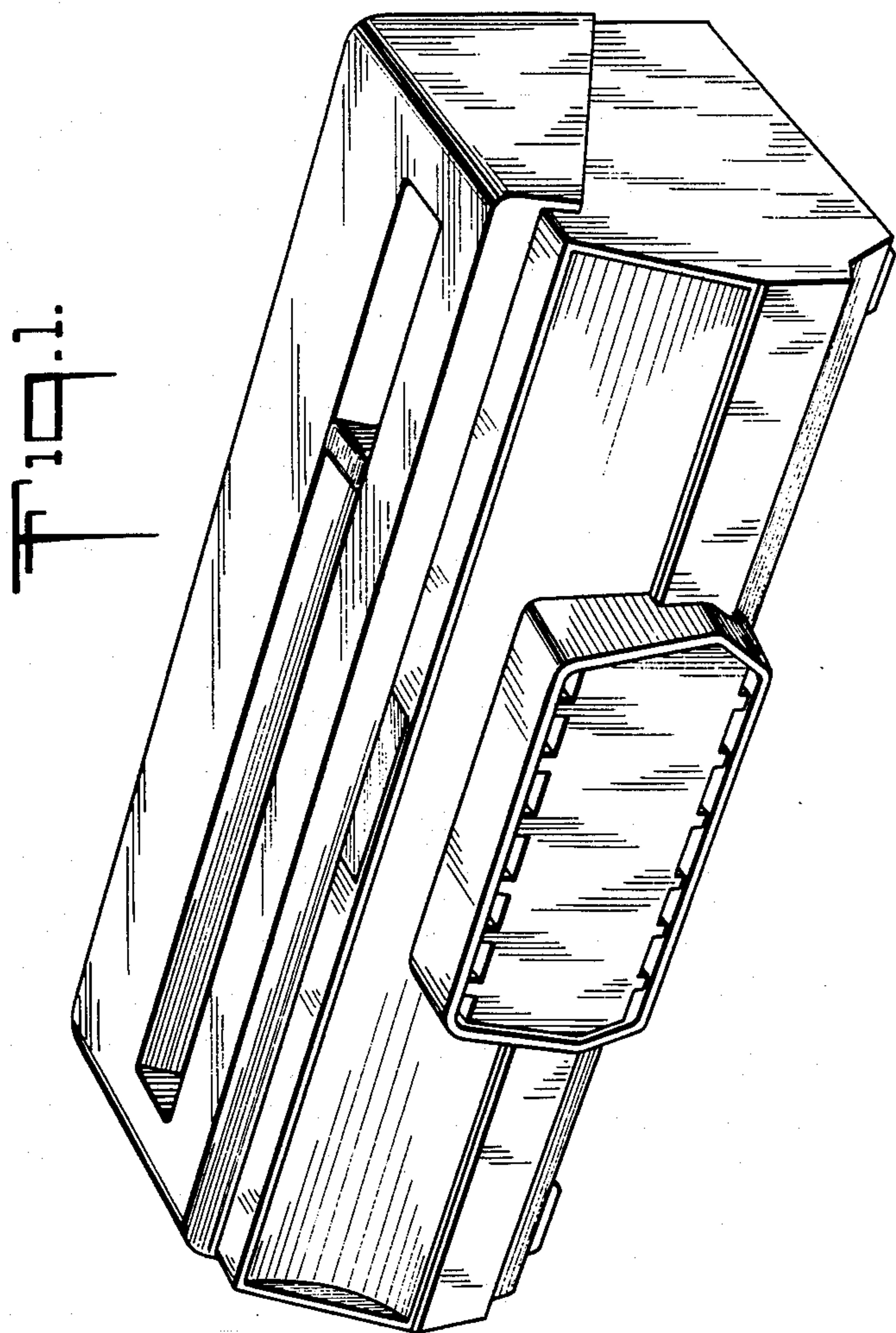
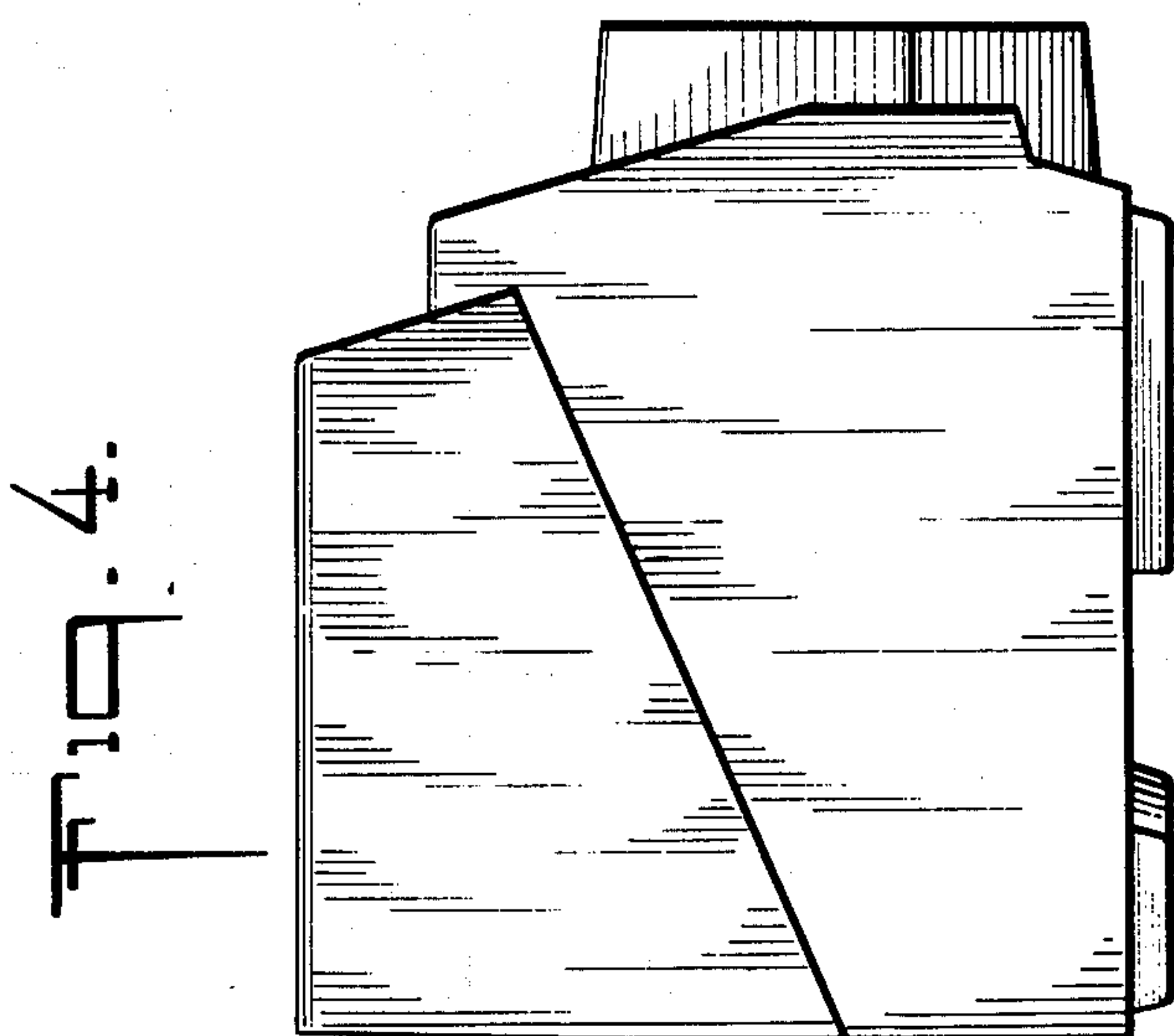

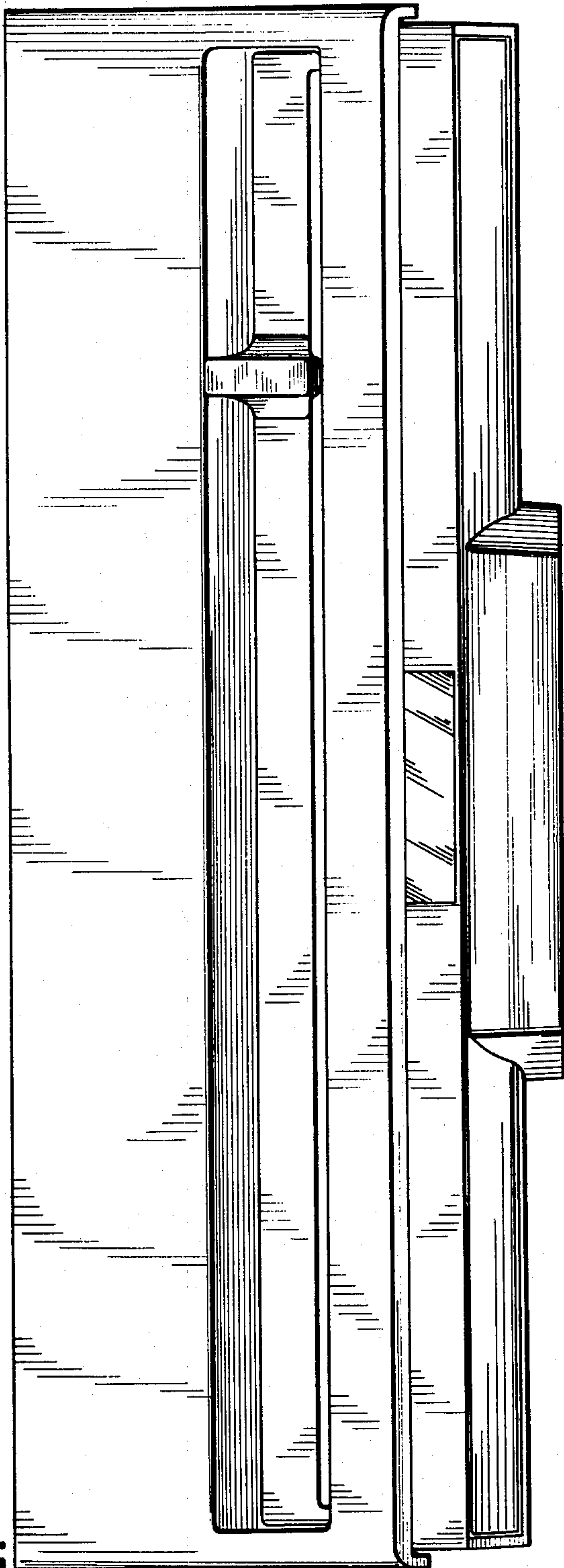
